This means there will be 10 teams entering this season's Shield and we will be one of the lowest level teams in the cup competition. The 10 teams will be Swindon Town, Chippenham Town, Salisbury, Swindon Supermarine, Melksham Town, Highworth Town, Westbury United, Bradford Town, Amesbury and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The one and only season we have played in this competition before was Season 2001-2 when we defeated Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the First Round 1-0 before knocking out Swindon Supermarine 2-0 in the Second Round. We eventually went out at the Semi-Final stage losing 2-0 to Swindon Town.

Ladies Match Report v Keynsham Town Dev (H)

Welcome to Brackley Town Saints

A warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Brackley Town Saints for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture. We hope all from Brackley enjoy their short stay with us this afternoon and we wish them a safe journey home.

Last season Brackley were heavily involved in the title race, eventually finishing third just three points off top spot. Anyone who witnessed the game here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground in October last year will recall that Brackley played some neat passing football that day and we can expect the same here again this afternoon. The young Brackley side have been together a few years now and have matured into one of the better footballing sides in the division. Whilst they have not started as well as last season many expect them to again be involved at the top end of the league table and a win on Wednesday night saw them move up from 11th to 6th place in the league table.

Despite that defeat last season here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground our record against Brackley Town Saints is pretty good, that loss was the only game out of eight that we have played that we have lost to today's visitors. We have won on three occasions with four games ending in draws and it could be another close one here this afternoon.

Binfield

I reckon that Sam or Bully must have run over a black cat in the summer because we are certainly not having the luck this season. Last Saturday in very difficult wet conditions we gave one of the favourites for the title a real test and, but for one lapse of concentration, would have taken something out of the game. We created the better changes and as Sam told the Swindon Advertiser we should have got something out of the game and Roger Herridge knew his side had been in a big battle for the three points. How good Binfield are was demonstrated on Tuesday night when they went to Windsor and won 5-0.

Shrivenham

Having played so well on Saturday I really expected us to get something out of our visit to Shrivenham. The teams turned round 0-0 at the break but a penalty changed the game and whilst stand-in keeper Bully rolled back the years by saving Nick Stanley's 68th minute penalty, unfortunately former Bassett striker Steve Robertson, as always seems to be the case when we play Shrivenham, was on hand to smash in the rebound. A second goal six minutes from time from another former player Antonio Gerrish saw the game slip away from us. Although Brad Pagliaroli pulled one back with a stunning strike three minutes from time, a third deep into injury time finished us off. Another local derby defeat. Here's hoping we can do better in the two derby games coming up against Fairford this month.



Royal Wootton Bassett Town 4 Keynsham Town Dev 3

At half time of their home encounter with Keynsham Town Development, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies were well in command. A superb, hard-working performance saw them earn a 3-0 lead against last season's South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division runners-up. It appeared to be an unassailable position. However, a poor second half display saw Bassett gift Keynsham a way back into the game. And it seemed as if the home side were going to walk away from the game with a point at best. Somehow though, they managed to sneak a victory, Hayley Huckin's second of the game, scored against the run of play, proving vital to seal the win by the odd goal in seven.

Bassett had been in dominant form in the first half. They

went ahead after just three minutes. Hannah Gulliver's cross evaded everyone in the box but Huckin was able to chase down the loose ball and swung in a deliver of her own, which Lauren Kayll header home. Bassett continued to mount pressure after taking an early lead, with Huckin's pace proving particularly problematic for the visitors. After failing to find the net in conventional fashion, the forward eventually converted to double Bassett's advantage, scoring directly from a cross. It was a second goal that her team richly deserved. And Kayll soon extended it further with an outstanding goal. Kayll's clever dummy allowed her to beat her marker and she smashed a drive into the top corner.

Huckin then almost made it four within five minutes of the restart but her header from a Kayll delivery was well saved by Lucy Bidgood who had taken over in goal at half time for Keynsham. That almost proved costly. The visitors got one back with a long range effort from Hannah Simms on 53 minutes: And she grabbed a second in almost identical fashion within a minute of registering her first. Huckin then passed up a one-on-one opportunity before Laura Jefferies' goalline clearance at the other end kept Bassett in front. A two goal lead was then restored on 66 minutes. It came well against the run of play, Huckin bursting past her marker before slotting home. But Keynsham weren't subdued. A pair of corners led to shots narrowly off target before Simms got her third with quarter of an hour to go, again beating Alice Farnell from distance. The game was therefore finely poised going into the final minutes. Bassett has an opportunity to finally put the game to bed but Jefferies curled inches over from a free kick. Three minutes later Farnell did just enough to deny Emily Plummer a free run at a cross. The ball fell to Sophie Allen though but she saw her shot deflected wide. A brave claim from Farnell from the resulting corner then proved to be the final action of note, the Bassett 'keeper suffering a knock but, courageously, helping preserve all three points in a tense, thrilling contest.

Bassett slip to another derby defeat

Shrivenham 3 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Barrington Park

League meetings between the two teams may only stretch back as recently as 2010. But at least until last season Royal Wootton Bassett Town appeared to hold the whip hand over Shrivenham. That is emphatically the case no more as Bassett suffered a fourth straight defeat against their local rivals, falling to a 3-1 away loss after a second half in which they were clearly second best.

The teams had fought out a goalless first half at Barrington Park. It had been a typical derby contest with plenty of effort on display, but little real quality. The best the visitors mustered was an opening for Gio Wrona, who saw Curtis Meare block his shot with his feet, while Jack Allan twice spurned chances for the hosts.

Both sides would therefore have fancied their chances coming out of the interval. Come full time, however, there was one clear winner. Bassett had an opportunity five minutes after the restart when Meare was forced to guide an Aaron Oakley header over the bar. But Shrivenham upped the pressure after that. Nick Stanley, Steve Robertson and Allan all narrowly missed the target with a trio of chances around the hour mark. Then, on 68 minutes, Allan was brought down in the box. Stanley produced a weak penalty that Matt Bulman, stepping in for Declan Lehmann between the sticks, comfortably parried. But Robertson, a constant thorn in Bassett's side since his departure, was quickest to respond to the rebound and slid the ball beneath the 'keeper to put his side ahead. The home side's lead was doubled with six minutes remaining. Bassett failed to clear from a corner and amongst a mini scramble in the box Antonio Gerrish was able to poke the ball over the line. Brad Pagliaroli's long range effort in the final minute of regulation time did offer a small glimmer of hope for Sam Collier's side. However the forward's first goal since August proved inconsequential as Allan latched onto Zac Skinner's stoppage time through ball before rounding Bulman and adding Shrivenham's third.

After Saturday's promising display in a frustrating defeat against Binfield, this was another case this season of Bassett taking a step backwards. They'll have the chance to right their current derby woes in the next couple of weeks though, with a pair of fixtures against Fairford Town to come. However, with the Reds flying high in the table, securing some form of local bragging rights this season will be a tough task.

Ladies Team

The Ladies team returned to winning ways last Sunday with a 4-3 win over visitors Keynsham Town Development who had finished as league runners-up last season. Looking comfortable at the interval with a 3-0 lead, Keynsham came back hard at us after the break but the Ladies hung on for three valuable points. A match report of this game is included later in today's programme. The Ladies are at home again tomorrow when Bideford Ladies visit the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground in a battle between the two sides promoted at the end of last season. The two sides will certainly get to know each other as the return match at Bideford is seven days later.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town manager Sam Collier hailed a 'great performance' from his side despite suffering a 1-0 defeat to Binfield in the Hellenic League Premier Division.Binfield's Sean Moore struck just after the hour to ensure the visitors left with all three points and Bassett were consigned to their fifth defeat of the season.

But after a tricky start to the season in which – by the manager's own admissions – Bassett were conceding too many goals, Collier felt his team performed admirably when defending their own goal on Saturday.

Collier admitted he 'felt sorry' for his players after one lapse in judgement meant the different between the two sides at the Gerard Buxton Sport Ground.

He said: "I thought it would be quite a scrappy game because of the weather and the wind, but the pitch was magnificent, and I thought it was a great performance from us.

"We played very well, but it was just one error between the midfield and the defence that ended up giving them the chance to sneak one in.

Other than that, they didn't have any other chances. We worked hard and created lots of things, but unfortunately we didn't get the rub of the green on Saturday – these things happen."

Opponents Binfield have only lost two games out of their nine played so far this season and sit in fourth – a position that Collier feels will not be too far away from their eventual finishing spot.

The Bassett manager therefore reiterated his belief that his players should take confidence from their performance as they head into their local derby against Shrivenham on Tuesday night.

Collier said: "Binfield are a decent side, certainly. They will be in the top three or four come the end of the season with the players and the money that they've got, I'm sure.

"But apart from the goal, they didn't cause any real problems. Our back four and the midfield were outstanding defensively.

"I felt a bit bad for the lads afterwards because we didn't get anything out of the game and we certainly deserved to get something out of it".

Saturday 26th October 2019

The wet weather took its toll last Saturday with five games postponed due to waterlogged pitches, with just three league fixtures getting the go ahead. Starting the day fourth in the table **Reading City** were hosts to third placed **Fairford Town** at Rivermoor. A win for either of these two opponents would see the victor move into second spot in the table. On a pitch where both sides struggled to get a foothold Reading took a very early lead, McKoy Palmer scoring in the opening minute of the game, despite losing Matt Stockhill to a red card some twenty minutes in they went in at half time 1-0 leaders. Though the second half was all the visitors scoring three goals without reply to move into second place in the table. On target for Fairford were Connor Thompson and former Royal Wootton Bassett Town players Nathan Hawkins and Mason Thompson.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town, whose fortunes had improved in the past two previous fixtures faced consistent **Binfield** at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. All square at half time the visitors went in front as Sean Moore took advantage of a defensive lapse, latching onto a ball over the top before slotting past Declan Lehmann. That was enough for The Moles to take all the points, possibly a harsh result for the hosts who felt they deserved something from a tight contest. With so many fixtures postponed a win for either 12th place **Shrivenham** or 10th place **Brackley Town Saints** playing each other at Shrivenham Recreation Ground, would see considerable upward movement for either club. Seam Moore was again amongst the goals, bagging a brace, the others coming through Josh Helmore, Josh Howell and Jack Thompson-Wheeler. **Burnham** were 2-0 home winners over **Reading City** to move out of the bottom three. **Easington Sports** also picked up three valuable points at the bottom end of the table with a narrow 2-1 win over **Virginia Water**. **Holmer Green** remain second from bottom after a 2-0 home defeat against **Flackwell Heath**. 



Brackley Town Saints opened the season with a local midweek derby against Ardley United and it was honours even as the points were shared following a 1-1 draw. The FA Cup saw them drawn against last season's Hellenic League champions Wantage Town in the Extra Preliminary Round and a replay was needed to settle matters against their Southern League opponents. Following an initial 1-1 draw at Wantage, Wantage triumphed 2-1 in the replay. Progress was however made in the Bluefin Insurance Challenge Cup, Brackley safely making it through to Round Two courtesy of a 4-2 home win over Old Bradwell United Development.

On their return to league action a solitary strike from Matt Hammond gave them a narrow 1-0 away Bank Holiday Monday win at promoted Easington Sports. The first league defeat of the season came at the hands of Longlevens, the Gloucestershire side winning 2-0 at Brackley. The Saints bounced back immediately in their next outing with an impressive 4-1 away win over one of the sides who were one of their main challengers at the top last season, Brimscombe & Thrupp, Brackley returning from Gloucestershire with all three points following a 4-1 win. Brackley were to last just one round in the Floodlit Cup, losing 2-0 away at Didcot Town Development.

Back in league action, their second trip into deepest Gloucestershire was not as fruitful as their first, as they lost 1-0 away at Lydney. Interest in their County Cup, like the Floodlit Cup, was short lived, as they lost 4-0 away at Desborough Town. Another trip to Gloucestershire in the league followed and again Brackley suffered a defeat on the road as they went down 4-0 again, this time at Bishops Cleeve to make it three defeats on the bounce. After this three game losing streak they certainly took it out on their next league opponents Holmer Green, seven different scorers contributing to an emphatic 7-0 home win over the struggling Holmer Green side. Interest in the Bluefin Challenge Cup was ended at Stagg Meadow Windsor, as Virginia Water won a penalty shoot out after the game had finished 1-1.

League leaders Westfields were narrow 2-1 winners over Brackley in Brackley's next league outing, a goal 10 minutes from time by leading scorer Ryan Knight was not enough to prevent Brackley losing their fourth league game of the season. Interest in the FA Vase was ended by West Bridgford who left St James Park celebrating a 3-2 win after extra time that saw them progress to the next round of this prestigious national competition.

A hat-trick from Ryan Knight gave Brackley all three points in a high scoring game against visitors Windsor, a goal from Andrew Ingram two minutes from time to make it 3-2 causing some nerves at the end of the game but Brackley held on to take the three points. A second trip to Stagg Meadow to play Virginia Water, this time in the league, saw another 1-1 draw at the end of 90 minutes as the two sides shared the points.

Last Saturday Brackley travelled to the other side of Swindon but it was not to be a good day for them as a solitary goal 18 minutes from time from former Bassett player Steve Robertson settled matters in Shrivenham's favour. Wednesday night saw Brackley entertain near neighbours Ardley United in the return fixture from the opening game of the season. A 2-0 win thanks to goals from Alex Stott and James Hammond saw Brackley climb five places in the table up to sixth spot.

Brackley Town Saints • Club History

Brackley Town Football Club was formed in 1890 and were initially a prominent side in the area, but fell away, with most of the period before World War II being spent in the Oxfordshire Senior Football League, before a switch to the North Bucks and District League in the post war years. In 1968 they took a step down the ladder by joining the Banbury & District League.



In 1974 they moved back to the North Bucks League and also moved to their current St James Park ground in Churchill Way. Once Hellenic League members Brackley Town are now playing in the National League North and were winners of the FA Trophy in 2018.

Brackley Town Saints share St James Park with Brackley Town FC. Originally set up as the Brackley Town development team, Brackley Town Saints were placed in the uhlsport Hellenic East Division after their formation in 2014.

In our first season of senior football the squad finished second and therefore eligible for promotion. This meant that we could not continue as a development team as Brackley Town could not have a team in that guise at step 5.

We would have to become an independent club with separate club officials and administration. The management team travelled to Wembley Stadium to present the new club to the FA and were accepted as a step 5 club, officially becoming Brackley Town Saints FC.

With promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division secured the squad consolidated its position in 2015/16 whilst getting to the Bluefin Cup Final and the Buckingham Charity Cup Final, both Finals finishing in defeat, losing to very late goals in both games.

Progress continued both on and off the pitch and the club has competed in both the FA Cup and FA Vase, other success has been measured in the number of players that have left for step 3 and 4 clubs.

Last season was by far the most successful as Gordon Kille led his young squad to third place in the league, narrowly missing out on promotion. With the majority of that team secured for 2019/20 Saints will be looking to go one better this term, under new boss Chris Hurley.

Football can be a harsh game at time - and Royal Wootton Bassett Town were reminded of that fact when beaten 1-0 at home by Binfield. Sam Collier's side performed very well, frustrating their high-flying visitors who enjoyed limited opportunities in front of goal and playing well in difficult conditions. Altogether, Bassett deserved to take something from the game. In the end, however, they wound up empty-handed. One defensive lapse in concentration proved costly. On the hour mark Carl Evans failed to deal with a long ball played in behind, and Binfield forward Sean Moore took advantage, racing onto the loose ball before beating Declan Lehmann. Earlier Bassett had enjoyed the best chance of the first half. Excellent link up play between Jonny Davoile and Callum Parsons set up Gio Wrona, but the ball slid away from the midfielder just a little too much and he was unable to get his shot off when well placed. After going behind, Bassett pushed for an equaliser which didn't arrive. And to compound matters they were left feeling frustrated by a late claim for a penalty that was turned down after it appeared as though there had been a handball on the line. The performance overall was promising enough to suggest that Bassett are turning the corner after a difficult start. It's hoped though that positive results will soon follow.

So far this is the season for Chichester City. The Step 4 club have made it all the way to the first round for the first time in 60 years – and then got a bye straight into the second! For those who missed it, the bye came because of League One Bury's demise. There were an odd number of clubs in the first round proper draw so it was decided the final ball in the hat would progress straight through, with the £36,000 prize money cheque thrown in for good measure. Of course, no football club or fan wants to be seen benefiting from someone else's misfortune but it seemed fitting that the lowest ranked club left in the competition were the lucky recipients. They've even made a donation to the Bury start-up club, which they didn't have to, showing they understand the importance of the football family. The players celebrated wildly on TV and fair play to them. They now get the chance to draw a plum tie in the second round and even dream of reaching the third round – what a story that would be.

Like many others, Chichester City will be grateful for the financial benefits of the FA Cup too. The FA recently doubled the prize fund and this season we saw losing money in the qualifying rounds. The FA see the competition as a great way to put the money from TV deals back into football and it is certainly huge for clubs providing they spend it right. And that's one of the big talking points – how does a club spend their money wisely? For some that might mean signing that striker that will win promotion. For others it's purchasing new equipment or renovating the tea bar.

Our friend from The Non-League Show, Tim Fuell, penned a column in last Sunday's NLP on the very subject. As someone involved at Hayes & Yeading he is seeing first-hand how big a cup run can be with their first round proper tie against Oxford United selected for live TV. Check the column out if you can, but Tim brings up the idea of how money can be best spent – how about a voucher to be used by clubs at FA recommended outlets? So instead of the money being wasted on the team, an investment is made into the club's infrastructure or is used to improve the ground. You'll no doubt have your own views but anything that can be to the benefit of a football club long term is surely the way to go?

We'll enjoy telling the FA Cup stories over the coming weeks and plenty of clubs will soak up the national spotlight. While the actual games are great in the moment, it's important the cup money leaves a lasting legacy too. **By Matt Badcock**

On This Date

Looking back over the history of the club we appear to have played only eleven times on this date, **2 November**, I suspect a few games were lost to waterlogged pitches during the Rylands Way era. The bad news for Sam it is not a lucky date for the club, of those eleven games, only four have been won whilst six have been lost. We drawn just once on this date. Whilst not a particularly good date for the club it is not too bad for Sam himself as he scored in both the last two games on this date, although both games were lost.

The first game traced on this date was back in 1901 when we played Baptist Social Union in a friendly, winning 4-2. The first official league game on this date was not until after the Second World War, when we lost 6-2 away to the School of Infantry in 1946, Harold Hunt with both our consolation goals.

There was just the one game in the 1950's when in 1957 we drew with Pinehurst YC at Rylands Way, Geoff Simpkins and Graham Tyler with our goals in a 2-2 draw. The 1960's was not a good decade for us on this date, or in general really, as we lost the two games played and were pretty poor for most of the decade. A 5-3 defeat away at Paulton Rovers in 1963 was followed by a 5-2 defeat away at Melksham Town in 1968. The earlier fixture saw two goals for Dave Lamb, Colin Prior with the other. The game in 1968 saw Martin Oxborrow and Dave Challis find the net for Bassett.

Just one game was played in the 1970's and it was in the Wiltshire Senior Cup away at Corsham Town. Goals from Phil Keep and John Brewer saw us through to the next round courtesy of a 2-0 win. There was also just one game in the 1980's, a narrow 1-0 defeat at home against near neighbours Purton.

Perhaps our finest win on this date came in 1991 away at Highworth Town. Two goals from Scott Vincent plus one from Paul Burke, years before he ever dreamt of managing the First Team, with Matt Fletcher adding a fourth in a 4-2 win against our noisy neighbours. The 1990's was certainly a good decade as we also won in 1996, goals from Paul Harrison, Gary Ashford, Dominic Franklin and Ian Curtis giving us a fine 4-0 away win at Letcombe.

Just two games have been played in the 21st Century and we have yet to win this century (sounds worse than it is)! 2010 saw us go down 5-2 at home against Oxford City Nomads, Sean Bailey and Sam Collier with our consolation goals. Sam was at it again in the last game played on this date back in 2013 when Ardley United were our visitors. His effort was the only one we registered as we went down 2-1. Hopefully today will see us win for the first time this century on this date and also for the first time at home in the league this season. Today feels like a day when bad records are there to be broken.
