The Wiltshire FA have re-introduced the Wiltshire Premier Shield for Season 2019-20 after a break of 7 seasons. Whilst previously the competition involved just the 4 sides playing at Step 4 and above, the re-introduced Shield will now include the clubs playing at Step 5. This means there will be 10 teams entering this season's Shield and we will be one of the lowest level teams in the cup competition. The 10 teams will be Swindon Town, Chippenham Town, Salisbury, Swindon Supermarine, Melksham Town, Highworth Town, Westbury United, Bradford Town, Amesbury and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The one and only season we have played in this competition before was Season 2001-2 when we defeated Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the First Round 1-0 before knocking out Swindon Supermarine 2-0 in the Second Round. We eventually went out at the Semi-Final stage losing 2-0 to Swindon Town.

## Welcome to Burnham

Good afternoon and may I firstly extend a warm welcome to Paul Shone, his players and support staff to this UHlsport Hellenic League fixture here at the Gerard Buxton Ground. A warm welcome also to the supporters from Burnham who have made the long journey along the M4 to be here today. As with a number of sides from the East, this could be their last ever visit to play us in a league fixture given the restructuring that is scheduled to take place in the summer.

Burnham arrive here on the back of two excellent wins over Reading City and Windsor, two sides we have failed to beat this season and these two wins has seen them move above ourselves in the league table. In the four league meetings between the sides to date, each team has won their respective home games in the two seasons the clubs have met. Hopefully that trend will continue here this afternoon as it would mean that we would secure our first home league win of the 2019-20 Season. Given the form Burnham are in though we know for sure this will be another tough game here this afternoon in what is a very competitive Premier Division this season. After suffering relegation at the end of Season 2017-18, Burnham immediately bounced back at the first attempt winning Division One East last season, finishing four points clear of runners-up Thames Rangers.

## Brackley Town Saints

Whilst Burnham come into today's game in a run of good form, we in contrast have now suffered back-to-back defeats and if we don't start picking up points soon are very likely to be involved in a relegation battle for the rest of the season. At least last Saturday against Brackley Town Saints we finished much better than we started with a much better second half performance as we tried to get back into the game. To be honest after the first half it couldn't have got much worse as we trailed 4-1 having conceded four goals that could and should have been prevented. The players know they let Sam and the supporters down in the first half but at least they came out with fight after the break and scored almost immediately with Carl Evans getting his second of the game. Matty Bennett scored what the Your Sport Swindon video coverage confirmed was a perfectly good goal, as everyone present apart from the referee's assistant thought on the day, but that and the first half injury to Caine Bradbury that denied us much of the engine room in midfield was typical of some of the things that have gone against us this season. This bad luck and the conceding of sloppy goals from set pieces has to end soon and hopefully today we be the day when things change for the better. TJ coming on at half time certainly helped us as an attacking threat and hopefully he is now free from injury. I know Sam has been busy this week trying to get a couple of signings across the line and hopefully by the time you read these notes he has got his targets on board.

Then, after Alex Stott had twice spurned opportunities when through on goal, dangerous teammate James Hammond showed the forward how it was done, latching onto his partner's through ball before lifting a deft chip over a stranded Lehmann.

Whatever strong words were said in the Bassett dressing room at half time, they had an immediate effect. Bassett pulled a goal back within two minutes of the restart. Pagliaroli and Gio Wrona played a short corner and the latter delivered a cross from the right to the far post, which Evans headed in for his second of the game. Minutes later, substitute TJ Bohane, whose introduction made a positive impact, came close, forcing a Crowther save with his header from an Alfie Presley cross.

In contrast to Bassett, Brackley had started the second period somewhat nervously. But they soon settled and twice came close to re-establishing a three-goal advantage. First, Jordan Godfrey's deep left-wing cross caught the wind and Lehmann was forced to smartly redirect himself in order to tip wide. Lehmann then guided Goddard's rising first-time effort from the edge of the area over the bar.

Bassett continued to ask questions at the other end, Bohane seeing a low free kick parried by Crowther with the 'keeper doing well to get his body in the way of Matt Bennett's rebound shot. A rash decision to come off his line then presented Callum Parsons with a half chance to steer a shot in from the left side, but his attempt was headed away.

With nine minutes to go, Bassett had the ball in the back of the net, Bennett brilliantly adjusting his body to hook in from Parsons' clever reverse pass. However, a questionable offside decision ruled it out. There were no doubts over Brackley's goal at the other end with four minutes remaining. Catching Bassett on the break, Stott's switched play from right to left, picking out Hammond, who stepped inside Aaron Oakley before coolly slotting away.

That was game over. Yet Parsons, Pagliaroli and Bohane all came close to grabbing what would, at this point, have been consolation goals in the dying minutes of the game.

If any spectators had only observed the second half, they'd have been forgiven for thinking it was Bassett who were on top. But that had followed a pitiful opening 45 minutes in which the hosts seemed devoid of any fight once they found themselves behind for a second time.

# Match report v Brackley Town Saints (H)

## First half misery condemns Bassett to heavy defeat

**Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Brackley Town Saints 5**

League meetings between the two teams may only stretch back as recently as 2010. But at a spirited, much improved second half display may have allowed Royal Wootton Bassett Town to emerge with a smidgen of pride still intact from their home defeat against Brackley Town Saints. However, a miserable performance in the opening period meant they were on the receiving end of a heavy 5-2 loss that keeps Sam Collier's side mired in the bottom three of the Hellenic League Premier Division.

Two soft goals conceded from corners, a deflected free kick and a well-worked move that easily carved open the hosts' defence saw Bassett enter the half time interval 4-1 down against a Saints side who, although neat and tidy as usual, were certainly not as strong as the team who came close to landing the title in 2018-19.

And although Bassett matched - and arguably bettered - their opponents following the restart, the damage done in the opening 45 minutes proved fatal for their chances of getting anything from the game.

Collier's side were a goal behind after just four minutes as Ollie Goddard lost his marker and steered in Harry Brock's hanging corner.

The visitors' lead barely lasted five minutes though, Carl Evans beating Saints 'keeper Matt Crowther to the ball to head in from Caine Bradbury's free kick delivery.

After that equaliser Bassett appeared to be in the ascendancy. Brad Pagliaroli blazed narrowly over from a tight angle before dragging inches wide of the left post with a right-footed shot after Wayne Turk's interception in the middle of the park.

However, after failing to translate that brief spell into anything positive, midway through the half Bassett found themselves behind again. It was a rather unfortunate goal to concede, Dean March's free kick deflecting off the wall and leaving a wrong-footed Declan Lehmann no chance to keep the ball out.

The response from Bassett was pitiful – and they quickly folded. 2-1 became 3-1 when another Brock corner was flicked on at the near post by an unmarked March and fell at the feet of a wide-open Sam Hartley at the far post to guide home.

## Ladies Team

Well done to the Ladies side for another fine win last Sunday against Bideford that sees them close to within three points of league leaders Callington Town with two games in hand. Tomorrow the Ladies travel to Bideford to play the reverse fixture which would normally have heralded the start of the second half of the season (knowing how fixture Scheduler in FA Full-Time works) if it hadn't been for the four postponed games either due to cup matches or the weather. The Ladies are certainly having an excellent first season at the higher level in what appears to be, Torquay United aside, an even and very competitive league. The next home game for the Ladies is in the Wiltshire Women's County Cup a week on Sunday (17th) where they look to defend the trophy they won last season.

## U18 Floodlit Side

Unfortunately last week's Under 18 game at home to Pewsey Vale was postponed due to a late call off by Pewsey owing to them being unable to raise a side in half-term week. The late nature of the call off was disappointing and will be subject to normal league discipline procedures. Our next two Under 18 fixtures have been postponed by ourselves due to the management team being away and the other qualified coaches apparently being unable to step in. Hopefully this is the last time this happens and in future we allow, say, the Development Team manager run the side. In my view there would be no better way for him to get to know the Under 18 players and assess whether they are ready for adult football.

## Joshua Carey's Award

Congratulations to Joshua Carey who collected the Wiltshire FA Rising Star of the Year award that he won in the summer at the County Ground last Saturday before the Swindon Town match against Walsall. An award well deserved for all his efforts at the club with coaching. It was also pleasing to see Ella Broad pick up the referee's award, still the best referee I have seen in matches watched so far this season, pleasing as well to see Rod Wirdnam also getting an award. Rod is still officiating in the North Wilts Youth League even though he is now in his 80's. When I was manager at Bassett Sports Rod was registration secretary in the Wiltshire League as well as being a referee and he always used to ref my friendlies. Another whose efforts over the years thoroughly deserve to be recognised.

## Next Up At The Gerard Buxton Sports Ground

Next up here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground is some Vet's action on Monday when the Defence Academy. Following that high flying Corsham Town Res visit in the Wiltshire League as Steve Yeardley's side look to do the double over their opponents. The Ladies then have that County Cup game against Melksham before the next First Team game when Fairford Town are here a week Tuesday for a local derby and the return of many ex-Bassett players.

# Hellenic Premier Round-up

## Saturday 2nd November

The Second Round of the Buildbase FA Vase saw a number of UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division sides in action. **Binfield** hosted Combined Counties League Premier Division Redhill at Stubbs Lane and the Moles made it safely through to the next round winning 3-1 thanks to two goals from the prolific Sean Moore and an own goal. **Longlevens AFC** made the 440-mile round trip to South West Peninsula Football League club Falmouth Town. Longlevens took the lead just before half-time but could not hold on as it finished 2-2 after 90 minutes. However, Falmouth won the game in extra time to go through with a 3-2 score line, Harry Emmett and Bradley Martin scoring for Longlevens. **Windsor** were up against Southern Combination Premier Division Eastbourne Town at Stag Meadow and took a heavy beating going down 7-1, Kai Davis with their consolation goal a minute from time. **Fairford Town** and **Westfields'** games in the FA Vase were both postponed on Saturday.

Back in the Premier Division, whilst **Royal Wootton Bassett Town** were losing 5-2 to **Brackley Town Saints** (see elsewhere in the programme for the match report), **Holmer Green** were losing 4-0 at home to **Bishops Cleeve** at Watchet Lane. Jack Watts registered a first half hat trick for the visitors, with Kai Mahon adding a fourth in the second half. The games at **Brimscombe & Thrupp** (against **Reading City**), **Burnham** (against **Shrivenham**), **Lydney Town** (against **Ardley United**) and **Tuffley Rovers** (against **Easington Sports**) were all postponed due to waterlogged pitches.

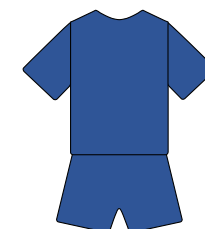
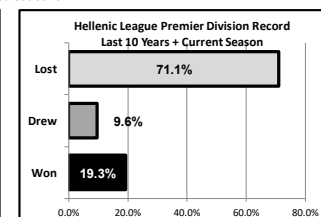
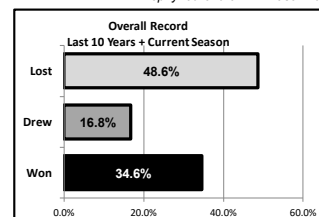

# Opponents History

## Burnham FC • Club History



Founded in 1878, Burnham FC is the second oldest club Buckinghamshire. We played in the early years, with considerable success, in various leagues, before joining the Great Western Combination in 1948.

The 2012-2013 season without doubt was the most successful in the football clubs history. The First Team won the Division One Central Southern League championship earning promotion to the newly sponsored Calor League Premier Division (Southern League) while our Reserves won the Hellenic League Division Two East championship at the first time of asking and themselves earned promotion to Division One East where they will now come up against the First Teams of many of last seasons opposition.

We moved to the Wycombe Combination in 1964 and then spent one season (1970/71) in the Reading Combination. In 1971 the club were elected to the Hellenic League winning both the Premier Division and League Cup in 1975/76. We were also twice beaten finalists in the League Cup. In 1977 the club were elected to the Athenian League and were twice runners-up before the league folded in 1984.

We competed in the London Spartan League in 1984/85 winning both the Premier Division title and the League Cup. The summer of 1985 bought about the amalgamation of the football club with Hillingdon Borough FC who had lost their ground and were about to fold. We played in the Southern League as Burnham & Hillingdon FC but reverted back to the former name of Burnham FC in 1987. Season 1994/95 saw us finish bottom, resulting in relegation to the Hellenic League. After 3 seasons in the Hellenic League finishing fifth, third and again third in 1998/99 the club won both the Premier Division title and the League Cup, thus gaining promotion back to the Southern Football League. Season 2006/07 saw the club achieve their highest league position, finishing 3rd, thus qualifying for the end of season Promotion Play-Off semi final, unfortunately losing to the eventual winners Swindon Supermarine.

In cup competitions Burnham reached the Quarter Final of the FA Vase in 1977/78 and then went one better in reaching the Semi Final in 1982/83 losing over two legs to Halesowen Town by 4-2. In the home leg the clubs record attendance of 2400 was achieved. We have twice reached the Third Qualifying round of the FA Cup and in 2005/06 reached the First Round Proper for the first time ever before losing at home to Aldershot Town. In the FATrophy we reached the the Fourth Round (the last 16) in 1999/2000 before losing to Scarborough in a replay after a creditable 1-1 draw at The Gore. In the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup we have reached the Semi Final twice before losing on both occasions to Chesham United.

The club have in recent years re-developed The Gore and now boast a fine stadium. The new complex has a new stand, modern dressing rooms, club bars and offices and an independently run Gym and a Nursery School all under the one roof. Burnham FC also have a Car wash installed in the car park which delivers a very good service. From May 2018, Burnham Football Club are looking forward to a new era for the coming season, under completely new Management. The Directors, Malcolm Higton, Rod Saunders and Michael Boxall have all retired and a new Chairman has taken over, Solicitor and former professional Footballer, Glen Skivington. The football team has the very experienced Manager, Paul Shone, in charge and he is already building for promotion from Hellenic League Div 1 East at Step 6 of the national football league structure back to the Hellenic Premier League at Step 5.

The new Management team, with Adam Wardle as Treasurer, Naseem Bashir as Director of Football and Coaching and Gary Reeves as club and football Secretary

The First team play in the uhsport Hellenic Football League and the under 18 youth team play in the Allied Counties Youth League, the club is also a Berks & Bucks Buddy club with local youths Burnham Juniors. Also in 2018 the Club became a pledge club (Berks & Bucks) which supports Disability in football

In season 2018-19 the Blues won the Hellenic Div One East and were promoted back to step 5 and the Hellenic Premier It was a great season with over 170 goals being scored in 51 games, a cup final appearance in the subsidiary and progressed through 3 rounds of the FA Cup before being beaten by Billericay Town.

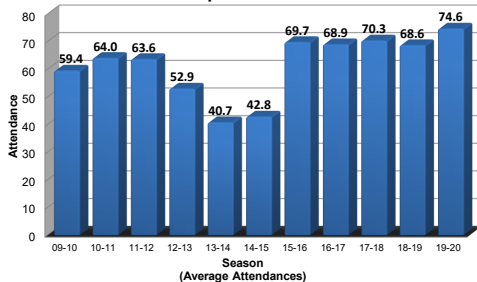

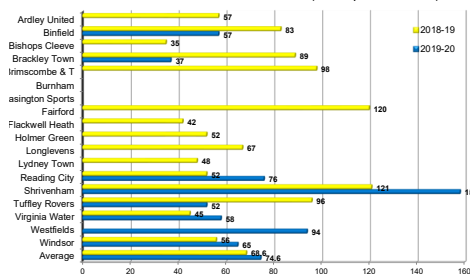

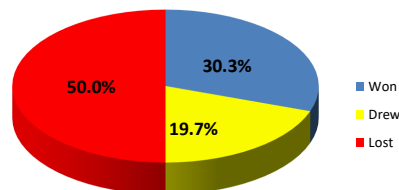

# Cover Guy Profile - TJ Bohane



Bohane is a prolific forward who has established himself as one of the most feared opponents in the Hellenic League Premier Division. Strong in the air as well as possessing two good feet, the forward re-joined Bassett from Southern League Highworth Town who he went back to in the summer after spending last season with Bassett. TJ had joined Bassett last season from Bracknell Town, who he helped to consecutive runners-up finishes in the Hellenic League Premier Division over the previous two seasons, while scoring 78 times. Prior to his time with the Robins,

Bohane had spent the majority of his career in senior football with Highworth Town. Between 2013 and 2016, he scored 79 league goals for the Worthians, while during the course of the 2014-15 campaign he netted 41 times in 50 appearances as Highworth made the FA Vase semi-finals and lifted the Wiltshire Senior Cup. Bohane was previously a member of Bassett's Under 18 Floodlit League side, playing for that team during the 2004-05 season. He began the following season at Swindon Supermarine, appearing once, before moving to The Elms, where he netted four times in 37 games. A switch to Shrivenham followed ahead of the 2006-07 campaign, and there Bohane formed a dangerous strike partnership with veteran Alex Green, scoring twelve goals in his first season at The Rec. He finished as their leading scorer a year later with 25 goals in all competitions as he helped Shrivenham reach the FA Vase fourth round. Following the departure of Pete Horwat and Alan Dyton, Bohane switched back to Highworth in the summer of 2008. After six goals in 2008-09, he bagged 14 in 2009-10 as part of a strike force featuring Steve Robertson and Matt Bennett. 2010-11 was his best season yet, as he struck 43 goals in all competitions, including a league-leading 37 – 8 more than closest Golden Boot rival Richie Claydon. That year he struck a hat-trick in a 5-1 thrashing of Bassett as Highworth finished the season fourth.

The summer of 2011 saw a switch to Supermarine, where he had a brief spell before transferring back to The Elms. However, after eight games he made the move to Shortwood United, and bagged thirteen goals as the Nailsworth side finished runners-up in the Hellenic Premier Division and secured promotion to the Southern League. The forward again split the following campaign between Supermarine, Highworth and Shortwood before committing to The Elms for 2013-14. The move paid off as he struck 40 times in 45 games and was the Hellenic Premier Division's second top scorer. Bohane bettered that tally by one a year later and played an instrumental role in Highworth's run to the Vase final four. Against Windsor in the first round proper he netted a hat trick, while goals followed in each subsequent round against Bridport, Blackfield & Langley – where his strike was the only goal of the game, Tunbridge Wells, Bradford Town and Tadcaster Albion. Bohane then scored 25 goals in 2015-16, his 23 league strikes good enough for third best in the division. The start of the 2016-17 campaign began with Bohane playing for Bassett, though after three appearances and a single goal he was snapped up by Bracknell Town. And he proved an instant hit at Larges Lane, firing 46 times in 42 appearances as the Robins finished second, being denied the title only by virtue of a final day defeat. He started the following season with Supermarine, netting once in five matches before returning to Bracknell, where he scored 31 times in 33 games. Bohane enjoyed another excellent run in the Vase too, helping Bracknell reach the quarter finals with three goals in the early rounds against Buckingham Athletic and Cricklewood as well as in both last sixteen matches against Blackfield and Langley. Last season he was back at Bassett and finished the season as our top scorer with 20 goals in 33 appearances and it is great that he has returned after starting the season with Highworth Town.

## Patient Bassett bide their time to beat Bideford

While controlling the game for long periods, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies were forced to be patient before sealing what was a deserved 2-1 triumph at home against Bideford. Bassett went behind before Lauren Kayll levelled on the half hour mark. An attacking second half display then helped seal the win as Hayley Huckin struck the decisive goal on 58 minutes. The hosts enjoyed the better of the opening exchanges, but a goal was not forthcoming. On six minutes an outstanding Laura Jefferies corner was headed onto the bar before, five minutes later, Huckin had an effort blocked following good build up play between Hannah Gulliver and Lily Withers. Bideford then found the back of the net with their first opportunity as Kate McKane's firm 20-yard strike proved too powerful for Alice Farnell. Ten minutes later it could have been two for the visitors but Rebecca McMullin fired wide. Bassett soon got back on the front front and Kayll should have equalised when a defensive slip put her through but she placed over. However she made no mistake a couple of minutes later, combining well with strike partner Huckin before finding the bottom corner. Bassett subsequently had the better opportunities prior to the interval but were unable to go ahead, Huckin having the best opportunity when she headed over.

They suffered a scare shortly after the restart though when Gulliver was forced to clear off the line following Farnell's slight fumble. Bideford were claiming for a penalty, which the referee turned down. And Bassett broke to the other end where Huckin shot against the post. The hosts themselves had appeals for a spot kick waved away when Huckin headed a Kayll cross onto the arms of a defender. Bassett continued to create the better openings as Kayll shot straight at Zoe Stock and Withers found the side netting. The deserved breakthrough eventually arrived just before the hour. Amber Egerton took on her marker before fizzing in a low cross, which Huckin controlled before firing in on the turn. The latter stages then saw both sides trade blows. Farnell recovered well after initially seeing a cross squirm between her legs. Meanwhile, at the other end Egerton came close with two headers from set piece deliveries. Then with three minutes remaining Farnell saved from a free kick in a dangerous area.

In the end it was a deserved win for Bassett - their fourth in a row in the league and one which pulls them to within three points of leaders Callington Town with two games in hand to play. Their winning run will be tested next week, however, with the return fixture away at Bideford.

Is anyone else wondering who would be a club secretary in the wake of more clubs falling foul of the rules when it comes to ineligible players?

There seems to be so much red tape to jump over and areas where you can be tripped up that some may feel they don't need the hassle. Brighthouse Town joined Willand Rovers last week as the latest side to be kicked out of the FA Trophy. Both clubs fielded a player who didn't have international clearance, despite having played for other teams in the National League system before joining them, and were removed from the competition. It remains to be seen how far these cases will go – presumably they will have played in league and other competitions too. Both clubs felt they had followed the guidelines but that wasn't enough to prevent them slipping the wrong side. And then Bedfont Sports joined the ineligible party.

The Eagles won their initial FA Trophy preliminary round tie fixture at Grays Athletic 3-0 on October 12 but were charged by football's governing body for fielding a player without international clearance. It had been suggested that two of the Isthmian League South Central division's players didn't have the correct clearance to play, but Bedfont provided the appropriate documents that had been granted by The FA themselves. However, it was found that the previous club of one of the players – a team in Romania – had not applied to the Welsh FA in 2014 for clearance and therefore the chain was not complete prior to him signing for Bedfont. Consequently, his international clearance from the FA to Bedfont was cancelled when this was raised four days prior to their first round qualifying fixture at Hitchin Town. Having considered the evidence presented by the club, FA members, in accordance with FA Trophy Rule 16(c), accepted the club did not know and could not have known, even had they made every reasonable enquiry, that the player was ineligible and should not be removed from the competition. However, they were still subject to any other penalty such as being ordered to replay the tie, which took place on Wednesday (November 6).

The feedback we often get is that clubs are finding it harder and harder to attract people to putting their hand up for the vital jobs that keep Non-League clubs going – and issues like these aren't helping. Volunteers need all the help and encouragement they can get. The game needs to get together and find some real solutions.

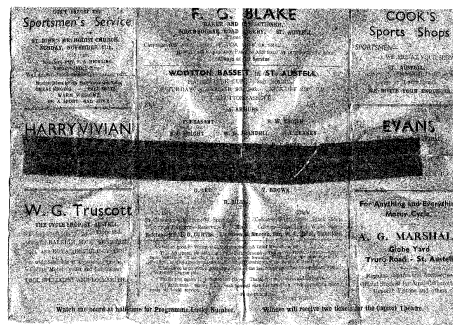
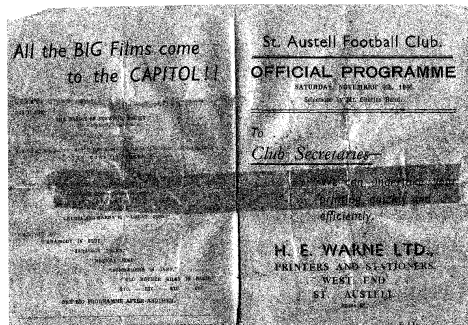

# On This Date

Looking back over the history of the club we appear to have played only 12 times on this date, **9 November**. Interestingly no games have been traced on this date before the Second World War. We have won four games, drawn twice and lost six times on this date.

The first four matches played on this date failed to see us win, with the first ever game being in the FA Amateur Cup against St Austell in 1946. Mary Harrison who followed the side as a young girl and went to the game in Cornwall has provided us with a programme from that first game that she retained for a game that was played over 70 years ago (see pictures below). Unfortunately there was no happy ending in this one as we lost 9-0.



Things started to get better in the 1980's when we lost just one of five games from 1985 through to 2001. However, this date is not a good one to play North Leigh FC as we have lost 4-0 on the two occasions we have played them on this date. The last time we played on this date was back in 2016 when we secured a 5-1 home win over Sandhurst Town in a Floodlit game that included goals for current players Dale Richards and Adam Corcoran.
