The Wiltshire FA have re-introduced the Wiltshire Premier Shield for Season 2019-20 after a break of 7 seasons. Whilst previously the competition involved just the 4 sides playing at Step 4 and above, the re-introduced Shield will now include the clubs playing at Step 5. This means there will be 10 teams entering this season's Shield and we will be one of the lowest level teams in the cup competition. The 10 teams will be Swindon Town, Chippenham Town, Salisbury, Swindon Supermarine, Melksham Town, Highworth Town, Westbury United, Bradford Town, Amesbury and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The one and only season we have played in this competition before was Season 2001-2 when we defeated Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the First Round 1-0 before knocking out Swindon Supermarine 2-0 in the Second Round. We eventually went out at the Semi-Final stage losing 2-0 to Swindon Town.

## Welcome to Flackwell Heath

Good afternoon and welcome to this UHlsport Hellenic League fixture against Flackwell Heath. We hope all from Flackwell who have made the journey along the M4 enjoy their short stay with us this afternoon and wish them a safe journey home. Flackwell are one of the most hospitable clubs in the UHlsport Hellenic Premier Division and I would like to congratulate them on their excellent FA Cup run which saw them win through three rounds before eventually going out at the hands of higher league opponents Slough Town in front of an impressive crowd of 484. This FA Cup run plus having played three games in the FA Vase means that Flackwell are little bit behind with their league fixtures so do not be deceived by their current 13th place league position, they will almost certainly be one of the top six sides by the end of the season. They have not finished in the bottom half of the table in any of their last ten seasons in the Hellenic Premier and I cannot see this season being any different under the astute management of Marcus Richardson.

Westfields continue to set the pace in the Hellenic Premier, with pre-season tipped sides Brackley Town Saints, Bishops Cleeve and Binfield all up there as well. The two local based sides, Fairford and Shrivenham, continue to surprise many but look like they are in the promotion race for the duration. On the Tony Kempster forum the individuals who spend a lot of time speculating what next season's leagues will look like currently have both Westfields and Fairford being promoted to Step 4. This is as a result of Fairford's record being one of the better ones of second placed sides across the country which, if they maintain the points per game record to the end of the season but still finish behind title favourites Westfields, would almost certainly be good enough to see them promoted.

## Fairford on Tuesday

Another home game and another defeat in what is turning out to be a miserable season. Fairford in contrast, as noted above, are having a superb season with a good team spirit in a team that includes a number of players we have lost or discarded in recent seasons. They are certainly showing us what can be done when you have a good team spirit and everyone working in the same direction. However, just like the recent 1-0 defeat to one of the other top sides in the decision, it is narrow margins deciding these games but we always seem to be on the wrong end of those and we have now lost five games in a row. Sometimes no matter how good your players look on paper you can get into a losing rut that is very hard to get out of and we seem to have that problem. We desperately need a win from somewhere, especially at home, else we are certainly in danger of possible relegation. Hopefully the management and players now realise they are definitely in a relegation battle whereas expectation at the start of the season was that we would be at the other end of the table. We should look to take inspiration from what Shrivenham did last season and see if we can emulate what they achieved after a similar poor start last season. Fingers crossed.

## Richards stunner proves the difference in tense derby

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's derby disappointment goes on as Sam Collier's team suffered a 1-0 home loss against Fairford Town.

Bassett have now gone winless in six straight games against the Reds and Shrivenham - losing five in a row - with the last win against local rivals coming at the start of last season. Connor Thompson's second half goal proved decisive as the diminutive forward collected Kallum Thomas' cross, turned in the box and fired into the top corner beyond 'keeper Matt Bulman.

The game itself was one of limited chances - particularly for the hosts who again appeared to lack the imagination required to snatch a win and kickstart a season that worryingly has failed to get going.

While playing a Fairford side currently flying high in second place, the fact that the visitors made hard work of their victory suggests that there is scope for Bassett to climb the table. But that's going to require a quick change in confidence and form. And having played ten of the fourteen league games so far at home - with two more up next against Flackwell Heath and Holmer Green - it's going to take a huge effort from Bassett to accumulate points on their travels.



## Pewsey Vale

The big news in local football within Wiltshire this week came out from Pewsey when on Tuesday they announced they were pulling their First Team out of the Sydenhams Wessex League. I knew they were having problems as both their First Team and Dev Team managers had left in recent weeks and they were struggling to fulfil two fixtures a weekend. The issues all stem back to the summer when the FA Leagues Committee somewhat bizarrely transferred them out of the Hellenic League with one of their lateral transfers into the Wessex League. With Pewsey having previously been in the Wessex League as a result of their geography there was an element of logic but it looked bizarre from the point of view that the Hellenic was desperately short of numbers. What the decision also failed to appreciate was that a large number of the Pewsey players were Swindon based and, whilst happy to make journeys along the M4 and into Gloucestershire, they were less inclined to travel to the Isle of Wight and other difficult journeys to the South Coast. My understanding is that Pewsey appealed this decision but the appeal unfortunately fell on deaf ears and was unsuccessful. It is such a shame for the club who worked so hard to originally achieve Step 6 status when they won the Wiltshire County League back in Season 1992-93, initially joining the Western League before then having spells in both the Wessex League and then the Hellenic League. They will now look to rebuild in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League with their Dev Team now being the only adult Saturday side at the club, with the Dev title having been dropped from their name. In our former player Craig Wall, who is the club chairman, and Nikki Jeffery, the club secretary, they have some good people at the helm and I am sure they will come back stronger in the long run after this experience. Hopefully lessons will be learnt by the FA National Leagues Committee from what has happened here when making their proposed changes at the end of this season with a lot more transparency and consultation in their dealings.

## Vets Sides

The Blue Vets side finally got their league campaign underway this week with a 3-1 away win against Swindon Rovers thanks to goals from Paul Davis, Nick Warren and Pete Wilson. The Yellow's get their season started this coming Monday when they play Trowbridge Tigers here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, this game being played straight after the Blues have played Marlborough Town in the same division. The first game kicks-off at 7.30PM the second at 8.35PM.

## Next Up At The Gerard Buxton Sports Ground

Next up here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground are those two Vets games on Monday. Then next Saturday we have a real relegation battle "six-pointer" against Holmer Green. Enjoy the game and see you in the bar after the match hopefully celebrating that first home win of the season.

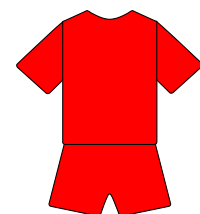
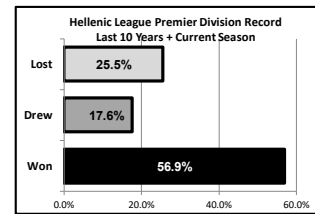

# Opponents History

## Flackwell Heath • Club History



Flackwell Heath FC was founded in 1907 and the club joined the High Wycombe and District League for its inaugural season. The Heathens proved to be a major force in local football, having won twelve Wycombe League championship titles and fourteen High Wycombe Senior Challenge Cup finals.

In the 1950's Flackwell joined the Great Western Combination League and won this league twice before returning to the Wycombe League. In 1956 the club moved to its current home, the new ground being donated by the Wilks family.

Through the 60s and 70's the club continued their success on and off field and the new clubhouse was built in 1974 as the first stage of their rise into senior football. In 1975 The Heathens won the Berks and Bucks Intermediate Cup and the Reading Senior Cup. In 1977 the club achieved Senior status and moved up into the Hellenic League Division One. Promotion to the Premier Division was achieved at the first attempt. After five seasons in this league, during which time floodlights were installed at Wilks Park, Flackwell were elected into the Athenian League. In 1984 they joined the expanding Isthmian League. The clubs first season in this competition saw them playing in Division Two (North) and against some tough opposition they finished in a respectable eighth position. The following season Flackwell was switched to Division Two (South) where life turned out to be even tougher. At the end of season 1990-91, after finishing below mid-table, The Heathens found themselves placed in the newly formed Ryman League Division Three.

At this stage the club installed a 150 seater stand to stay in senior football, and new home changing rooms were built to comply with new ground gradings. For the next 10 years the club carried out further ground improvements and they established themselves in senior football.

In 2002/03 for the first time in their history Flackwell reached the 4th qualifying round of the FA Cup losing 4-1 at home against Crawley and finished third in the newly formed Ryman League Division Two, the highest position achieved to date.

In 2003/04 Flackwell won The High Wycombe Senior Challenge Cup for the twelfth time. In season 2004/05 The Heathens reached the 4th Qualifying Round of the FA Cup for the second time in three years, this time losing 3-0 at Ryman Premier Division Billericay Town and were runners-up in the Ryman League Associate Members Cup, losing 2-1 after extra time to Division Two champions Ilford on their own ground. The Veterans team won the FA Umbro Sunday Cup, lead by Byron Walton a feat which was repeated in 2006 and 2007. After winning the National final the lads went to The Bernabeu Stadium and played against Real Madrid veterans for the European Cup and lost by 3-1.

Flackwell finished fourth in Ryman League Division Two in 2005/06, narrowly missing out on promotion. After the end of 2006/07 the FA reorganised the non-league pyramid and we were due to be relegated into the South Midlands Spartan League until Barking and East Ham United went out of business and we were given the opportunity to take their place in the Ryman Division One (North). Unfortunately we finished bottom of the league and were relegated into the Hellenic Premier Division for season 2008/09.

In 2007/08 season we held our centenary game against Wycombe Wanderers with a crowd of 1300 watching Peter Taylors's first game in charge at Wycombe.

In our first season in the Hellenic League we finished in 9th position and lost 2-1 to Chalfont Wasps in the final of the High Wycombe Senior Challenge Cup at Adams Park. In 2010/11 we got to two cup finals but both were lost on penalty shoot-outs, The Berks & Bucks Trophy to Newport Pagnell and the Reading Senior Cup to Newbury Town.

The 2014/15 season saw us gain promotion into the Southern League Division 1. However, a late move by the Southern League of us from the Central Division into the South West Division meant FHFC were unable to accept promotion and we stayed in the Hellenic League Premier Division for season 2015-16. 2014-15 also saw us with places in the final of the Berks & Bucks Trophy (losing to Windsor FC) and the High Wycombe Senior Challenge Cup (winning against Penn & Tylers Green FC). Earlier that season we reached the fourth qualifying round of the FA Cup losing to Conference side Weston Supermare 4-1. For the first time in club history we also reached the last sixteen of the FA Vase losing 3-2 to Shaw Lane Aquaforce. 2015/16 season under the continued management of Graham Malcolm assisted by Paul Shore saw us finish 3rd in the Hellenic League also winning 3 cup finals – the Berks & Bucks Senior Trophy (against Newport Pagnell FC), the UHSport Challenge Cup (against Brackley Town Saints) and the Wycombe Senior Cup (against Pitstone and Ivinghoe FC).

The last few seasons have seen a change of management at Wilks Park, with Marcus Richardson our current manager. He and his players finished 8th in season 2018-19.

With a number of sides in Wiltshire Senior Cup action the league match most impacted the top of the table was at the Gerard Buxton Ground where second placed Corsham Town Reserves were Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development's visitors. Just like the first game between the sides, that had seen Royal Wootton Bassett win by a solitary goal, it was another tight encounter between two well organised sides. The visitors Corsham went close to breaking the deadlock on 16 minutes when leading scorer Dan Lardner almost got on the end of a cross at the far post. In the second half, shortly after Kai Robinson had gone close to equalising for the home side, they wasted another great chance when Langford was put clean through but slipped just as he was about to get his shot away and Corsham cleared. Both sides pushed for goals and the keepers at both ends of the pitch were called into action. Corsham's Ryan Withers, returning to his former club, went close when he got on the end of a corner, but his header was well saved by Adam House in the Bassett goal. At the other end a couple of minutes later it was the turn of Corsham's Dave Cardus to deny a goal when he saved brilliantly from a Nick Mason header. Ten minutes from time Cardus was at it again when this time he denied Danny Langford with another great save. Corsham's well organised back four comfortably saw out the final ten minutes to secure the vital three points that took them to within a point of league leaders Wroughton at the top of the table. They now remain unbeaten on the road so far this season after nine away league games.

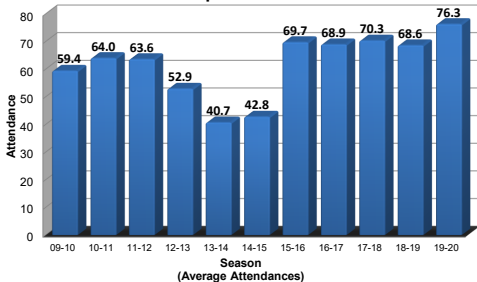

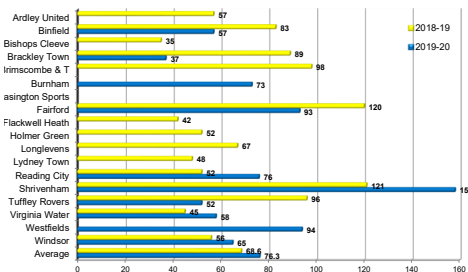

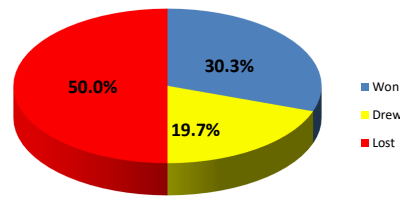

# Player Profile - Dale Richards

# Hellenic Record - Head to Head



A product of Bassett's youth system, Richards finished as Bassett's second top scorer in season 2016-17 as he enjoyed a fine season primarily spent playing in an attacking midfielder role.

He initially broke into the club's first team as a defender and made the left back spot his on during his 2014-15 debut campaign. That year, he made 45 appearances, scoring twice. His first, a header away against Brimscombe and Thrupp, levelled the scores in a game Bassett went on to win, while his second helped put his team two goals to the good against Oxford City Nomads.

Richards continued at left back three seasons ago, scoring once – a goal in a draw away at Brackley Town Saints – in 35 games.

Combining athleticism, strength in the air, and a fine left foot, Richards has always enjoyed getting forward. And his shift to a more advanced position came in season 2016-17, with his conversion being a successful one. He scored his first of that season in a fine 3-1 away win at Thatcham Town before scoring in three straight games against Lydney Town, Oxford City Nomads and Burnham. Away at Ascot United, his well taken strike restored parity in a game which Bassett went on to win 3-1, while he also netted the opener in a hard-fought 2-0 win at Highmoor Ibis. Last season due to a time spent travelling he missed a few games but still made 29 appearances, scoring twice, again featuring both at the back and up front at times. Richards joined the club as an 11-year-old, featuring in a successful youth side, which won a number of North Wilts League and Cup titles.

His development was further enhanced while at Cirencester Academy, with that experience helping turn him into a player who showed no fear in his first exposure to adult football despite being just 18 years old.

Over the past two years, his appearances have been limited by a spell travelling and the need for heart surgery, but he has still featured 45 times, scoring four times.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies' hopes of retaining their Wiltshire County Women's Cup title remain alive as they cruised into the semi-finals of the competition with a routine 13-0 home win against Melksham Town. Seven different scorers found the net as Bassett cruised against opponents from the Wiltshire County League – two divisions below the South West Women's Regional Football League Premier Division, who they saw off 15-0 at the same stage of the competition last season. Grace Eagles gave the hosts an early fourth minute lead, firing past Tory Swinney from range after Melksham were unable to fully clear from a Laura Jefferies corner. Hayley Huckin beat the offside trap before rounding Swinney and tapping in to make it two before scoring an almost carbon copy ten minutes later to further extend Bassett's advantage. Hannah Gulliver then got in on the act with a long distance strike. Two further goals arrived before the break. After receiving an Eagles cross, Lily Withers was afforded too much time in the box and comfortably slotted home before Huckin crossed for an unmarked Aly Lyons to steer into the net.

Comfortably ahead, Bassett rung the changes at the break. That did not slow them down after the restart though. On 52 minutes, Rosie Kirk strode forward before squaring to Lyons, whose shot was parried. However, Gulliver was on hand to put away the rebound. A minute later, Sophie Smith raced onto Amber Egerton's through ball and beat Swinney from distance. Lyons then scored a third goal in the space of five minutes, tapping in after a Smith shot came back off the bar. The tenth arrived on the hour mark as Smith got her second from outside the box. A simple finish from Beth Kelloway made it eleven with twenty minutes to go as she finished off a move from Smith's unselfish pass. It was a fantastic result, surely one of the best this season's competition will throw up. Expect everyone to be talking about Jerome Slew in the coming weeks – he's scored 22 goals this season already! Now Wayne Brown's side will welcome Newport County or Grimsby Town (depending on Tuesday's replay) to their Essex home next Friday with the TV cameras in attendance. The makings of an upset? You bet!

DID you hear the a-moo-sing excuse for missing training that Atherton Collieries boss Michael Clegg received last week? Striker Tom Bentham is a butcher by day and had a unique reason for not being at training on Thursday night. So he sent his gaffer a message. Bentham said: "Cleggs – I think I'm going to be working till like 11 tonight mate. Got a full cow to do on a farm and it needs doing today after work." Clegg responded: "Have a night off because that's the best excuse I've ever had!"

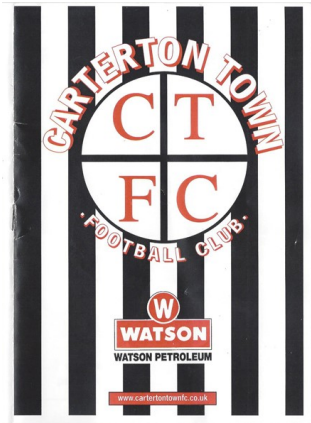
# On This Date
