The Wiltshire FA have re-introduced the Wiltshire Premier Shield for Season 2019-20 after a break of 7 seasons. Whilst previously the competition involved just the 4 sides playing at Step 4 and above, the re-introduced Shield will now include the clubs playing at Step 5. This means there will be 10 teams entering this season's Shield and we will be one of the lowest level teams in the cup competition. The 10 teams will be Swindon Town, Chippenham Town, Salisbury, Swindon Supermarine, Melksham Town, Highworth Town, Westbury United, Bradford Town, Amesbury and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The one and only season we have played in this competition before was Season 2001-2 when we defeated Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the First Round 1-0 before knocking out Swindon Supermarine 2-0 in the Second Round. We eventually went out at the Semi-Final stage losing 2-0 to Swindon Town.

## Welcome to Holmer Green

Good afternoon and welcome to this UHlsport Hellenic League fixture against Holmer Green and our fifth consecutive home fixture. We hope all from Holmer Green who have made the journey along the M4 enjoy their short stay with us this afternoon and we wish them a safe journey home. Since the two sides met on the opening day of the season, when the two teams shared six goals, both have gone on to struggle this season. Both currently sit in the bottom three, although we are now seven points clear of the bottom two now after last week's win. Holmer Green are currently bottom of the table and come into today's game on the back of 14 straight defeats in all competitions. However, of their first 15 league games played to date, it is interesting to note that just six have been at home and they will be hoping the run of home games, when they finally arrive, will help see them climb the league table. For us this is our 12th home game in 16 league matches and we have a long winter on an extended road trip about to take place. Today is an important game for both sides and, with the re-structuring of leagues at the end of the season, irrespective where both sides finish, this could be the last ever league meeting between the two sides.

## Flackwell Heath

At last that first home win of the season at the 14th attempt and what a good performance from the side last week. Right from the start there was a high tempo to our game and it is no coincidence that this occurred with younger legs in the side. It was great to see a side that closed down their opponents from front to back throughout the game and gave them little time on the ball. It has been a while since I have seen that from us. Across the whole side there was some great performances, no more so than captain Gio Wrona who led by example on the pitch with a battling display. The two youngsters George Ford and Dan Warre both had fantastic First Team debuts and it is pleasing to see more youngsters who have progressed from the Youth Section doing so well in the First Team. With Charlie McCuish, Kai Robinson and Landon Golding also coming on as substitutes it meant we continued to have that energy and work rate right to the end. Hopefully going forward there will be more faith in the youngsters and they will all be given an extended run in the team as we embark on that December and January road trip.

It was interesting to see the Chippenham Town Academy write-up about all the players they have out "on loan" at the moment, especially the bit about the three they have "loaned" us. A bit galling when they have actually played more competitive games for this club than they have ever played at Chippenham. It also noted that they did not know if Landon had come on as it was not mentioned in our match report. A quick look at FA Full Time would confirm that he did, as would a quick chat with the player, not difficult to do. Felt like an unnecessary dig at us on Twitter. With Bassett having drawn Chippenham Town in the County Youth Cup I am hoping Shane's side can beat them handsomely when they meet.

On the hour the lead was almost doubled. Bohane slipped through Francis but the forward was denied by another good save from Watkins when played through one-on-one.

The visiting 'keeper was appearing to be a source of frustration for Bassett, his two fine stops having helped keep his side in the match. But he was soon to be beaten for a second time, though again did his best to help prevent a goal that was gifted to the hosts. An attempted Mansfield backpass when straight to Francis, whose shot was saved well. However, the rebound fell to the forward and he squared to man of the match Gio Wrona, who fired in to the net.

With twenty-five minutes remaining, there was still plenty of time for Flackwell to launch a comeback. And Bassett had to be on their guard to prevent that.

Flackwell felt they should have had a penalty when Muhamadou Ceesay, having breached the defence, was pulled back, but the referee waved play on. Ceesay was eventually able to get a shot off and looked as though he was going to score. However, a great save by Bulman denied the forward.

Ceesay did eventually get the better of Bulman, pulling a goal back in stoppage time – the only dampener on an otherwise fine afternoon for the hosts.

However, there was no time for the Heathens to push for an equaliser as Bassett finally got off the mark at home.

# Match Report v Flackwell Heath (H)

## Quality victory ends home hex

**Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Flackwell Heath 1**

Gerard Buxton Sports Ground

At the fourteenth time of asking this season, Royal Wootton Bassett Town finally won a competitive home fixture as they triumphed 2-1 against Flackwell Heath.

Winning for the first time at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground since a 4-2 victory against Holmer Green in March, Sam Collier's side earned a vital three points courtesy of a high-quality display.

Handing full debuts to youngsters George Ford and Dan Warre, the Bassett boss was taking something of a risk. But they repaid his faith in their manager and showed that they can perform at this level, putting in performances at full back and winger respectively.

And Collier was rewarded by the rest of his side too, who played with a high tempo, a feature of their missing for the most part so far this campaign, throughout the game.

Bassett sought to show positive intent from the start and came close to taking a third minute lead when TJ Bohane headed narrowly wide.

The visitors then also produced an early opportunity as a neat move involving Lewis Sinclair and James Mansfield led to the ball being fed through for Ashley Howell whose shot was just off target.

Shortly after Marcus Richardson's flick picked out Sinclair, but he could only strike straight at Matt Bulman.

The best chance of the half fell to the hosts midway through the period. Bassett were able to get in behind the Flackwell defence and with Mark Francis one-on-one with Aaron Watkins looked destined to take the lead. However, the Heathens' keeper saved expertly with his legs to preserve parity.

At the other end the veteran Richardson fired over the bar after a square pass from Mansfield, an even first half eventually ending goalless.

Just as they had done in the opening period, Bassett fashioned an early chance after the restart. And this time they took it, Bohane netting for the fifth time this season with a neat left-foot finish.

It will be interesting to see how many of the "loan" players are asked not to play on Saturday 7th December with the County Cup game the next day. Playing in a Senior fixture should take priority. The argument that education establishments take priority doesn't work on a Sunday (Mr Tanner tried that with Andy Ferguson and I 40 years ago and we were able to play for Wootton Bassett Town rather than in a school volleyball tournament even if it meant we had extra ballroom dancing in PE rather than football for a few weeks after).

## Development Side

The Development side under Steve Yeardley put in a good performance last weekend at one of the top sides Shrewton United, but eventually went down by the odd goal in three. Despite the defeat that was our best result ever at Shrewton which has not been a happy hunting ground in recent seasons and another game where our young Development side have pushed one of the top sides all the way. With the First Team now away for most of December and January, one advantage is that the Development side can get some more home games under their belt, having played nine of their fourteen league games to date away from home. With the games at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground likely to go ahead even in wet weather, hopefully the Dev team can start to put a little run together and also make progress in the league cup, where they meet Ludgershall Sports in the First Round.

## Next Up At The Gerard Buxton Sports Ground

Despite the lack of First Team home games, December is a busy month for games here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. Tomorrow the Ladies entertain Somerset side Middlezoy Rovers in the South West Regional Women's League and then next Thursday the abandoned game with Chippenham Town is re-staged in the U18 Floodlight League. The same teams then do battle three days later in the County Cup but at the time of writing I am not sure which pitch will be used for that game. The Dev Team are then home on two consecutive Saturdays with Malmesbury Victoria Development and Stratton Juniors the visitors. In between the two Vets sides play each other in the Vets Division of the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League. # From The Governor - To The Adver

ROYAL Wootton Bassett Town recorded their first home win of the season on Saturday when downing Flackwell Heath 2-1 at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground.

Second half strikes by Terence Bohane and Giogio Wrona earned Sam Collier's underperforming side their third Hellenic League Premier Division win of the season. Frustratingly, three points were never going to lift Bassett up the 19-team table – though they are now seven points clear of bottom sides Brimscombe & Thrupp and Holmer Green. Bassett play Holmer Green at home next Saturday, so a chance for Collier to record what would be Bassett's second back-to-back win of the season has unquestionably presented itself.

He said: "We've massively underachieved this season, without a shadow of a doubt. "We added a lot of quality to the squad during the summer, but we've lacked a bit of endeavour. But we saw that endeavour on Saturday in abundance from one to 15. "There were some great performances. Credit to the ground staff too. Our pitch is second to none in this league. "I'm delighted with the surface we are able to play on."

Collier asked for a little more endeavour from his players in the build up to Saturday's game, and he praised his entire squad for the way in which they reacted to his calls. Defensively, Bassett held off a number of openings for Flackwell, while up front Bohane and Wrona's strikes confirmed what proved to be a deserved victory. Collier added: "We made a couple of changes, we brought in a couple of teenagers – one 16 the other 17. "We asked for a little bit more from everybody, that's myself included. If everyone can give that extra 10 per cent then we hoped that we'd be able to get something out of the game.

"We started really brightly before Flackwell Heath got back into it. What we haven't done in recent weeks is stay in the game when other teams have enjoyed spells of possession. "But we did that on Saturday. We defended fantastically well and scored two good goals in the second half. "I was disappointed we conceded at the end, more so because the lads deserved a clean sheet. "But, more importantly, we got three points."






Royal Wootton Bassett Town recovered from a 3-1 deficit to claim a point against Holmer Green with a pair of goals in the final ten minutes. But while Sam Collier and his team may be satisfied with the point they earned against a side who are typically strong at home, they will know that there is plenty that can be improved upon following a disappointing opening day display. After Callum Parsons had put Bassett ahead from the spot, avoidable errors helped put Holmer Green in a commanding position after an hour of play. And though Bassett dominated possession in the second half as the hosts flagged, their play in the final third was over elaborate, especially on a bobbly, dry pitch. Neat, intricate short passing may be effective at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground and on the league's other better surfaces, but Bassett need to learnt to adapt their style to suit the conditions. Holmer Green did have the ball in the net first, but Ben Booker's header was ruled out for a push. A minute later, offside should have been given when Tom Cole's ball forward picked out Parsons, who was stood a good few yards beyond the last home defender. But, to everyone's surprise, no flag was forthcoming and Parsons was brought down by 'keeper Phill Pykett after attempting to round him. After dusting himself down, Parsons coolly slotted the resulting penalty into the bottom left corner. Chances then fell for Brad Pagliaroli and Mani Roper to double that advantage, but the former saw his snap shot on the turn repelled by a smart save from Pykett before the latter shot straight at the 'keeper when played through in the left channel by Rhys Talmash's pass. Holmer Green were soon on level terms though as one ball out from the back caught out the Bassett defence. That opened up room for the hosts and, after latching onto Ollie Lynch's backheel on the edge of the box, Alex Rice was scythed down in the box by Tinashe Gwavava. Lynch stepped up to take the penalty, sending Lehmann the wrong way. The game was by this point very even, but the home side would go into the break ahead. Talmash had spurned a chance at the other end to put Bassett back ahead, seeing Pykett save his low drive with his feet. But sloppy play at the other end saw them present Holmer Green with a set piece that led to the second as captain Gio Wrona, playing at left back, was caught dwelling on the ball and confounded things by committing a foul. Martin Lancaster whipped in a free kick from the right and an unmarked Ryan Parsons made no mistake, heading in from 12 yards.

Their lead was then doubled ten minutes after the restart, catching Bassett out down their right side. The ball was worked into Harrison Holbrook in the left side of the box and he played a cute pass to an overlapping Rice, who poked home at the near post from an angle. That goal forced Collier into action as the Bassett boss made a double substitution, introducing Danny Langford up front and Harrison Lea into the heart of a midfield. And both players made a difference, injecting life into a performance that had gone flat. Bassett began to exert dominance too as Holmer Green, who had been forced into making a pair of changes during the opening period, tired on an energy-sapping, humid afternoon. But the visitors initially failed to make the most of the possession they were enjoying. Defender Tyron Leigh failed to connect properly with a Wrona free kick when unmarked, flicking his header wide, while Parsons shot straight at Pykett from close range. They then had the woodwork to thank that they didn't fall further behind as Adam Riley's curling effort from the edge of the area clipped the crossbar. Eventually though, with ten minutes remaining, Bassett snatched a lifeline as Parsons rather scruffily swept in from a Wrona cut back. Pagliaroli then fired into the side netting before finding his range to grab the equaliser in the final minute. He initially played a low ball into the danger area from the right side, which bounced around the box before falling into the feet of Parsons. He played a return pass to Pagliaroli, who drove towards the by-line and squeezed a side foot effort into the opposite bottom corner from an acute angle. Having got back on terms, Bassett did almost throw the game away as they switched off at the back allowing Holmer Green in. A square ball was played to a wide-open Holbrook just yards from goal. But a fabulous save from Lehmann, diving back to claw the ball away prevented what would have been a certain goal.

# Opponents History

## Holmer Green • Club History

Originally founded in 1908, Holmer played initially in The Chesham and District League. Matches were played at Campbell's Meadow, (now the Rosetti Estate), close to a tennis racket factory. Sometime before 1934 the Club moved to Holmer Green Common and set up headquarters in The Bat and Ball. In 1934 the Club switched to The Wycombe Combination League. The first trophy won by Holmer Green was The Chesham Charity Cup in 1939, the first of 28 Cups and Championships won thus far by the 1st XI.



The early 70's saw the start of a very successful thirty years in the Club's history. Holmer Green moved to their present ground, Watchet Lane, in 1975 when the new Holmer Green Sports Association pavilion was fully ready. Holmer won The Berks & Bucks Intermediate Cup in 1976-77. Senior Status was thus achieved and since then the Club has striven to play at the highest level possible for a strictly amateur club.

The Club, through current President John Anderson, was heavily involved in the moves that set up The Chiltonian League in 1984. That League embraced clubs from no less than six different counties. Holmer had been very successful in the Chiltonian, and believed that a move to a better run league, where the clubs were encouraged to improve facilities, should be the next step. The Chiltonian were reluctant to lose their "flagship" club and tried to stop the move to the The South Midlands League. Not until August 1995 did Holmer Green through the FA's appeal system, successfully, switch Leagues.

This move gave Holmer Green the impetus to finally erect a Stand, now called The Don Want Stand in honour of their former long-serving groundsman who still helps out with his time and expertise, on a regular basis. In 2014 Don was presented with some mementos to mark his 50 years with the Football Club.

Premier Division status was achieved in 1999 after winning the Senior Division twice in four seasons, being 2nd and 4th in between. Floodlights were erected. Centenary events started with a visit from a full Wycombe Wanderers team in July 2007 when the ground record of over 800 was recorded.

In 2008 the Senior Club formally merged with Holmer Green Minors FC to become "One Club" and this occasion coincided with the new Club as a whole being named "Club of the Year 2008" by Bucks & Milton Keynes Sports Partnership.

Season 2008-09 was Holmer's 10th successive one in the Premier Division. After an unexpectedly long stay in the Premier Division, Holmer Green was demoted to Division One for season 2009-10, despite avoiding the two relegation positions.

Work immediately began to regain the "F" Grading required for Step 5 football to return to Watchet Lane. The 1st XI won the First Division by three points in 2009-10 losing only 3 of 40 games. The coveted "F" Grading was achieved again in 2011.

Manager Chris Allen, who was appointed in 2009, kept the regained Step 5 status for another incredible nine seasons before stepping down in May 2019, with Holmer having gained enough points by early March. Dave Lynch has been appointed in his place.







The court ruling that has seen Ossett United ordered to pay £135,000 will have given Non-League clubs plenty of food for thought about how they approach the issue of player-to-player insurance. The BetVictor Northern Premier League North West club have been sued by Rees Welsh, who broke his ankle in a tackle while playing for Radcliffe Borough against Ossett Town in April 2015. Just over £19,000 in damages were awarded to the full-back, making his debut, with the club also having to pay out £115,000 in costs and legal fees.

Ossett’s insurance, which included a public liability policy offered by the Northern Premier League and the minimum requirement as set out by the FA, did not cover player-to-player incidents and only covered their own legal fees should they lose a claim. The club is now considering selling their ground in order to pay off the hefty bill. NPL chairman Mark Harris told The NLP: “We make it clear within all the communications – and it’s in the third line of the first paragraph of the communication that goes out to clubs – that it does not include player-to-player cover.

“We will continue to recommend the policy we have for public liability and personal accident. If anything this is to remind clubs it doesn’t include player-to-player.”

Whether the ruling will spark a wave of cases remains to be seen. It remains true that these incidents are very hard to prove, but there is no doubting it will leave much of the Non-League game very uncomfortable. As it stands, the FA don’t have player-to-player insurance as mandatory. Clubs are – or at least should be – aware of what they are covered for and that there is a potential risk of what has happened to Ossett happening to them. Harris believes clubs don’t have an appetite for that level of cover to be mandatory and the FA say their rules are reflecting what the game wants. It is only right the authorities reflects on this case, takes the views of clubs and experts and then decides the best course of action.

Will this also put additional pressure on referees? As the sole independent party in these types of cases, a lot will be put on their reports and evidence. It is quite the position to be in. We must also not forget about Welsh. It can’t have been an easy route to go down and, however you feel about the ruling, he has suffered a major injury that will have affected not only his footballing career, but also his day-to-day life.

The impact of any injury to any player can’t be underestimated.

After that opening defeat we then won the next five games on this date on the bounce, including two against near neighbours Calne & Harris (who then became Calne Town). Ironically it was to be Calne Town that ended our run of wins on this date when they defeated us 2-0 in the Wilts County League back in 1985. Six years later we were on the wrong end of a cup upset in the Wiltshire Senior Cup losing to Wiltshire League Division 2 side Malmesbury Victoria. We ended the run of defeats with a draw against Pegasus Juniors with a 1-1 draw at Rylands Way and have won our last two fixtures on this date.
