The Wiltshire FA have re-introduced the Wiltshire Premier Shield for Season 2019-20 after a break of 7 seasons. Whilst previously the competition involved just the 4 sides playing at Step 4 and above, the re-introduced Shield will now include the clubs playing at Step 5. This means there will be 10 teams entering this season's Shield and we will be one of the lowest level teams in the cup competition. The 10 teams will be Swindon Town, Chippenham Town, Salisbury, Swindon Supermarine, Melksham Town, Highworth Town, Westbury United, Bradford Town, Amesbury and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The one and only season we have played in this competition before was Season 2001-2 when we defeated Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the First Round 1-0 before knocking out Swindon Supermarine 2-0 in the Second Round. We eventually went out at the Semi-Final stage losing 2-0 to Swindon Town.

### **Editorial**

### Looking Forward to A Better New Year

As the year of 2019 draws to a close, many at Royal Wootton Bassett Town will not be disappointed to see its passing as far as the First Team is concerned and hopefully 2020 will be the start of better times for Sam and the lads. To say 2019 has been something on an annus horribilis for the First Team would be an understatement. Of the 36 games played just ten have been won, and we have lost on twenty-one occasions prior to today's encounter. The final month of the season has then also seen the horrific assault on Brad Pagliaroli, for which, adding insult to injury, he received a three game ban having been head-butted and had his head stamped on. With the ramifications from the game still being dealt with by the football authorities and, given the matter could yet still result in other action on our part, it is not appropriate to expand on matters at this stage in today's programme.

### Welcome to Brimscombe & Thrupp

A warm welcome to today's visitors Brimscombe & Thrupp who have made the short trip from Gloucestershire for this last Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture of 2019. Like ourselves Brimscombe have also had a tough start to the current season having begun the season as one of the favourites for promotion. With many of last season's successful squad still at the club you should not read too much into their low league position and they now appear to be turning their season around having gone unbeaten in their last four, winning the last two. Not too long ago Sam was still predicting them to turn their season around completely and to feature in the top part of the table so we should be under no illusion that we are in for a tough game here this afternoon. That said our record against Brimscombe has been pretty good since they came into the Hellenic with us averaging 1.5 points per game in our sixteen league games to date. Hopefully we can continue our good record here today.

### **Holmer Green**

The last First Team game here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground saw us share ten goals with visitors Holmer Green. After a going a goal behind we quickly got back on level terms and after we went in front there was only going to be one winner. Going forward we looked excellent but those frailties at the back were once again in evidence as we conceded another three goals to a side that have only scored fifteen goals in eighteen games all season, with six of those goals coming in the two games against Royal Wootton Bassett Town. In reality we could and should have had a lot more than the seven we did score. One has to feel a little bit sorry for Holmer Green given their enforced transfer from the Spartan South Midland League against their wishes and the loss of players at the start of this season having completed one season in the Hellenic. Hopefully for them next season will see them playing in a league more suited to their geographic position and that they remain playing at Step 5/6 next season. With Wiltshire side Pewsey Vale having pulled out of the Wessex

However, the wind was soon taken out of their sails as, shortly after the hour mark, the Waters stole possession in midfield and a neat one-two between Lorezno Di Felice and Josh Dillon led to the former calmly slotting beneath Declan Lehmann to restore his team's two goal lead. Momentum was now back firmly with Virginia Water and they controlled the remainder of the game. Dillon came close to adding a goal when his shot on the turn flashed narrowly wide of the post. He found his range with guarter of an hour remaining though, drilling a loose ball into the bottom corner after Bassett failed to clear from danger posed by Di Felice. Lehmann then denied a powerful low strike from Bocarro. But the keeper was beaten for a fifth time in the closing stages as neither Tony Joyce nor Aaron Oakley took opportunities to clear from Dale Wright's low cross and Baker took full advantage, slotting home his second. Already facing an emphatic defeat, to wrap up a sorry afternoon Bassett were even denied a late consolation as Oakley's stabbed volley from a Bradbury cross was tipped away by Jones. Thus, after the promise of the previous weeks, Bassett reverted to type with their defensive woes resurfacing. They have now conceded three or more goals ten times in eighteen league contests thus far -a dire record that goes a long way to explaining why they remain mired in the lower reaches of the table.

### **Ruthless Waters expose Bassett's frailties**

#### Stag Meadow, 14th December 2019

Virginia Water 5 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1

A clinical attacking display from Virginia Water brought Royal Wootton Bassett Town's three game winning streak to an abrupt end as Sam Collier's side suffered a 5-1 thrashing against a team who began the day two places below them in the Hellenic League Premier Division table. Any momentum gained from that modest run of victories against Flackwell Heath, Holmer Green and Reading City was washed away as Bassett's defensive frailties were exposed early and often.

Bassett may look back on a fifteen minute spell at the start of the second half in which they were firmly in the ascendancy and wonder what could have been. That period began with Landon Golding, halving a 2-0 half time deficit and also saw penalty appeals waved away following a seemingly clear foul on TJ Bohane. But in truth, Bassett were well-beaten – and deservedly so. Demonstrating their ruthlessness in front of goal, of Virginia Water's six shots on target during the game, five found the back of the net. The first arrived on eleven minutes. Play was switched out to Josh Hill on the right side and, allowed to advance forwards unopposed after his run had not been tracked, the full back eventually delivered a cross to the far post, which an unmarked Casey Bocarro guided into the bottom right corner with a precise header. Jake Baker then doubled Virginia Water's lead on 26 minutes. A ball over the top caught out the Bassett defence and a pass was threaded through to Baker, who fired in low at the near post from the edge of the area. Bassett now faced an uphill battle, but they were not helping themselves by playing too direct against a team who enjoyed an aerial advantage in defence. Only once did the visitors threaten during the opening period, coming when Bohane saw a far post header from a dangerous Caine Bradbury set piece delivery tipped wide by Matt Jones.

But following the restart, Bassett initially looked a different team. They began in energetic, fluent fashion and were rewarded on 48 minutes. Bassett's pressing forced a poor clearance, which Gio Wrona seized upon. He fizzed in a low cross from the left, which Jones could only parry, the loose ball falling straight into the lap of youngster Golding, who made no mistake with a simple finish. Minutes later, Bassett came close to equalising when Bohane deftly headed a Dan Warre delivery towards the bottom corner, but Jones was able to save on the dive. The hosts appeared to be struggling with the visitors. And that was no more apparent than when a well-worked move saw play worked to Bohane inside the Virginia Water penalty area, where he was clumsily caught from behind by Finn Kelly-Lewis. Much to Bassett's frustration, however, their appeals for a what seemed to most a nailed-on penalty were turned down. Still, Bassett remained on top and their confident start to the second half gave reason for hope.

League following another enforced transfer at the end of last season the FA cannot afford to lose too many more sides from the National League System and as has been said previously hopefully valuable lessons have been learned when it comes to anymore lateral moves.

### **December's Road Trip**

After the big win on the Saturday against Holmer Green, we then started what should have been a run of four away games, starting with that trip to Fairford. The following Saturday we had a much more enjoyable trip to Reading City, coming away with our first clean sheet in the league and all three points following a 2-0 win thanks to goals from youngster Charlie McCuish and Brad Pagliaroli. A good all round performance, particularly from a defensive perspective, and three vital points ahead of the trip to Stagg Meadow to play Virginia Water.

It was a very young side that we took to Stagg Meadow and unfortunately we were unable to replicate that clean sheet as we went down 5-1 to what is quickly becoming one of our bogey sides. However, whilst we fielded a young side against Virginia Water, it was not the youngsters who let us down on the day, they were the better players on what turned out to be a defensive horror show for some of our more experienced players. The final scheduled away game at Bishops Cleeve became another victim of the awful wet weather the country has experienced over the last month. In the end, what should have been a four game run of away games turned out to be just two, with one win and one defeat to show for our efforts.

### **Other Senior Sides**

The Ladies have played one game since the last programme, defeating Middlezoy Rovers 3-2 to go top of the league, a position they still hold going into the New Year. This is the second season running they have gone into the New Year at the head of the table so well done to James, Jonny and the Ladies for a great 2019, a complete contrast to the men's First Team! The Development Team also had a 3-2 win in their only game in December and currently sit in 7th spot in the Premier Division of the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League.

## **Hellenic Premier Round-up**

#### Saturday 21st December 2019

Just two games in the Premier Division on Saturday survived the latest round of heavy downpours and if this wet weather continues for much longer there is going to be a massive fixture backlog. Whilst we are not doing too bad in terms of games played some sides, such as Binfield, are six games short of being half way through their league fixtures by Christmas, a measure which is a good guide for whether a side is going to have a fixture headache in the New Year. The poor old Fixture Secretary cannot win. Many sides last year, including ourselves, moaned about the heavy front loading of fixtures. Having been listened to last season, a much kinder programme of games this season is now suffering as a result of the unprecedented incessant wet weather than seems to have gone on for months now. Hopefully there will be some respite in the New Year. The good news is that the cup competitions are all well advanced and by waiting to re-arrange the long list of postponed games, those involving an element of long distance travel can be re-scheduled for a free Saturday and the shorter distance games for midweek.

The two games that did take place saw important wins for today's visitors Brimscombe & Thrupp and Burnham. **Burnham** defeated visitors **Holmer Green** 3-0 as they picked up their fifth home win of the season. Joey Gritt gave Burnham the lead in the sixth minute, but Burnham had to wait to increase their margin of victory over the bottom side until the hour mark when Matthew Ayres netted. Ayres then added a third in the final minute of the game with an angled header. The win lifted Burnham up into fourth place in the table but they had played three more games than the top two sides Westfields and Fairford Town.

Jack Smith scored both goals for **Brimscombe & Thrupp** in their 2-0 win at **Lydney Town**, the goals coming in the 27th and 60th minutes as Smith took his goal tally for the season into double figures.

With this programme having been sent to the printers before Christmas there is no roundup of the seven games that were scheduled for Boxing Day. Hopefully the wet weather wil have relented allowing the games to go ahead on a day that is normally really good for attendances at games. As we approach the turn of the year **Westfields** are looking a safe bet for promotion to the Southern League. **Fairford Town** continue to surprise with the players at their disposal and could yet remain in the promotion picture come the season end. **Shrivenham** have a much better squad on paper than their local neighbours and should continue to have a big say in the promotion picture. However, most pundits expect **Binfield** and **Bishops Cleeve** to be the main challengers to Westfields for the title once they have played catch-up with their fixtures.



## U18 Floodlit Team

#### Brimscombe & Thrupp • Club History



Brimscombe A.F.C. was founded in 1886 – the same year as the Gloucestershire Football / Association!

The G.F.A. friendlies were played until the competitive league was formed in 1890. In 1902 the Stroud League was founded and Brimscombe were its first winners. Just after the First World War the Northern Senior League appeared. Its first season was 1922 and once again Brimscombe were the very first champions. Football was interrupted during the Second World War (1939–1945) but the game continued at 'The Meadow' where matches between the Army, Navy, Air Force and a team called 'Brimscombe Wanderers' took place.

When the Gloucestershire County League was first formed in 1968/9, Brimscombe – affectionately known as "The Lilywhites", were again founder members, along with other local sides Forest Green Rovers and Stonehouse Town. In 1973/4 The Lilywhites, amid some confroversy, found themselves back in the Senior League, just failing by one vote to secure a place in the Helienic League. It was at this time the Club experienced a difficult period and in the late 1970's Brimscombe and Thrupp amaigamated to secure both Club's futures. The Club hit a purple patch in the 1980's and won the Senior League Division One and Two and the County Cup all in the space of three seasons, eventually being promoted back to the County League and finishing 4th in 1987. There then followed many years of varying fortunes for the club including relegation to the lower leagues. However, in 2008 there were major changes to the Club Committee and the Football Management which immediately brought a successful period for the club.

In season 2008/9 the First Eleven managed by Phil Baker were Runners-up to Longlevens and were promoted once again into the County League for the third time in its History. In 2011 Brinscombe & Thrupp F.C. won the Gioucestershire County League for the first time and gained promotion to the Hellenic League under Phil Baker. Since promotion major redevelopments of the ground have taken place including an extension to the clubhouse and the installation of floodlights. Season 2012/13 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. win the uhisport Hellenic League Division 1 West and gain acceptance into the Premier League. More ground improvements were undertaken which included a new 100 standing/100 seating stand and further walkways around the pitch. Season 2013/14 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. playing in the highest league in the club's history, the ground improvements were complete with the new stand finished and other improvements made. The club experienced its first ever F.A. Vase football and were guite successful reaching the first round proper. The season was also made memorable with the First XI winning three cup finals – those being the Stroud & District Charity Cup, the Helienic League Flying Press Floodilt Cup and the Helienic League Supplementary Cup.

Season 2014/15 was another historic occasion with the side playing in the F.A. Cup for the first time in its history. The club continued to go from strength to strength during season 2015/16 and saw the team end in fifth position, its highest league finish in its history. The upgrade of the club continues with works being carried out as required by Step 5 football. 2016/17 was another great season for the club when we appeared in three cup semi finals and saw the club have their best FA cup to date, eventually losing in the third qualifying round at Weymouth. Season 2017/18 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp win the GFA Trophy for the first time in its history and finish sixth place in the League.

Season 2018/19 saw us reach our highest league position in the club's history, however, second place was not enough to see us gain promotion.

Well, where did that decade go? It's quite amazing when you look back ten years and see how much has changed in that time. Or, for that matter, how little has changed. The same argument for three-up from Non-League's top tier continues, clubs fall into financial crisis, others rocket up through the leagues and our executive editor Jon Couch still hasn't made a tea round!

No matter what ups and downs your team has had since 2010, we still all turn out each week to enjoy a game of Non-League football. Lots has changed. We've seen new divisions added at Step 3 and 4, the FA Trophy and FA Vase finals are now on the same day for Non-League Finals Day. We've seen the likes of Jamie Vardy go onto play for his country and win the Premier League, where Chris Wilder is now managing. In 2010 he took Oxford United back into the Football League. The rise of twitter has changed the way we interact with the game, clubs, players and even managers. I'll let you decide whether that's for better or worse. But there is no denying, much of social media has been used for positive by Non-League clubs. Whether that's driving awareness of games or simple post-match interviews, good clubs do such great work to engage with their community. We've never had so much information at our finger tips. Just think, someone could score a screamer in 2010 and you may never see it. Today, you can view it before the game has even finished.

In last Sunday's NLP we looked at moments of the decade and over the next couple of weeks we will look back at some of the other talking points. It's already apparent we've taken on an impossible task as different moments in time can be very personal. From my own view, you can bet I never imagined covering a Non-League team in an FA Cup quarter -final as I did with Lincoln City when they took on Arsenal - not long after Sutton United had player the Gunners. Then there have been other moments like Whitley Bay winning the Vase for a third season in a row, seeing the ever growing list of Non-League players making it higher up the ladder and the humbling afternoon England C spent with refugees in Jordan.



Barnes made a fantastic impression in his one season with the club, earning Hellenic League Division One West Player of the Year in 2012-13 with 32 goal in 36 games, while helping Bassett to earn promotion and reach the FA Cup second qualifying round. Meanwhile, Bohane has shone for Bassett at the end of the decade, finishing as last season's top scorer with twenty goals, while continuing to deliver the goods this year.

While he never achieved twenty goals in a season for Bassett, after joining in 2009-10 veteran forward Alex Green also proved a reliable goal scorer when available over the course of three injury-affected campaigns.

## Hellenic Record - Head to Head

Centre midfield: Matt Bown - Bown, who played for Bassett for three and a half seasons from 2009 to 2013, was the archetypal box-to-box midfielder. Full of energy and not afraid to make a tackle, Bown had an eye for goal too, scoring 18 times as he finished as Bassett's top scorer in 2011-12 – the year in which he collected both Manager's and Players' Player of the Year awards. He then registered nine times in the promotion winning campaign a season later.



Honourable mentions: While the biggest strengths of the two central midfielders selected were their ability to contribute when going forward, Bassett have also boasted a group of high-quality defensive midfielders during the decade – Richie Carter, James Turner, Matt Cheetham and Gio Wrona – all of whom have provided lengthy service to the club. Out wide, Ryan Banks' contributions at the start of the decade were hugely important, while in more recent years Harvey Scholes stood out for the creative spark he provided.

#### Strikers

**Striker: Steve Robertson** – registering 73 goals in 98 appearances over the course of four different seasons, Robertson was the most prolific forward to wear Bassett colours in the last decade. Possessing a wicked left foot and a danger from set pieces, he proved capable of scoring all types of goal. Robertson first made his mark in 2012-13, scoring four goals in five games including a hat trick in the final first team game played at Rylands Way. He



returned part way through the 2014-15 campaign, netting twelve times in sixteen appearances before notching 30 times in 38 matches on his way to picking up the Players' Player of the Year award a season later. 27 goals in 39 matches followed in 2016-17. Robertson has continued to be a thorn since leaving for Wantage Town and Shrivenham.

Striker: Sam Collier - originally joining Bassett as a left back in 2009-10, Collier's switch to centre forward proved transformational for his career and Bassett's fortunes. 22 goals that season, including stunning winners against Slimbridge and, then, on the final day of the season at Easington Sports, helped seal runners-up spot in Hellenic League Division One West and promotion for Bassett. He subsequently scored 26 times in 51 appearances a year later in the Premier Division. Brief stints with Bassett in 2011-12 and 2013-14 saw Collier continue to find the net on a regular basis, while he was again at the top of the scoring charts in 2017-18, finding the net eleven times.



Honourable mentions: In the first decade of the new Millennium, Bassett had strikers score twenty or more times in a season just twice (Lee Stoddart in 2000-01 and Shaun Terry in 2008-09). Over the last ten years, however, that has happened on six occasions, with Mark Barnes and TJ Bohane achieving that feat alongside Robertson and Collier.

### Match Report v Holmer Green (H)

#### Seven up as Bassett finally double up Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, 30th November 2019 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 7 Holmer Green 3

An outstanding attacking display saw Royal Wootton Bassett Town romp to victory against Hellenic League Premier Division basement dwellers Holmer Green – and record back-toback league wins for the first time this season. Despite a nightmare start, Sam Collier's side recovered to lead 5-2 at half time before ultimately triumphing 7-3 as five different players registered on the scoresheet.

A defensive error from Aaron Oakley had gifted Holmer Green a first minute lead Lewis Workman took full advantage for the visitors. But within quarter of an hour Bassett had recovered and enjoyed a healthy lead. Mark Francis equalised on six minutes before producing a fine finish from just inside the area a minute later. Defender Carl Evans then headed the home side's third after thirteen minutes. Evans struck again midway through the period, heading in from a Gio Wrona free kick to make it 4-1. Francis could have made it five – and completed a hat-trick – on the half hour mark but he was cruelly denied by the post with a chipped effort. And shortly after the visitors reduced Bassett's lead, as Oakley was caught out again, this time enabling Pawel Kotwica to score. But the three-goal lead was restored seven minutes before the interval as TJ Bohane was fouled in the box, dusted himself off and confidently dispatched the penalty. It should even have been 6-2 before half time, but Wrona contrived to miss an open goal after an Alfie Presley shot had been pushed out to the Bassett skipper.

Brad Pagliaroli eventually added another six minutes after the restart, scoring his fifth of the season following excellent set up play from Dan Warre, the Bassett youth section product impressing again in his second start. The home side had been imperious in attack. But defensive weaknesses were still apparent, which enabled Holmer Green to net a third with twenty minutes to go. Sloppily, Bassett turned over possession when in attack, and the visitors broke down the right wing before a switch of play to an unmarked Kai Morgan who fired past Declan Lehmann. But Bassett would not allow the visitors to have the final say in the game, Caine Bradbury netting a seventh. The goal was somewhat fortuitous, his mishit cross, intended for Bohane at the far post, instead looping over the 'keeper. Yet it had followed great build up play.

Goals certainly have not been Bassett's problem this season so far. Instead, generosity at the other end of the pitch has heavily influenced what has been a rather disappointing opening four months of the campaign. However, the convincing victory against Holmer Green sees Bassett regain touch with the tightly bunched middle pack of teams in the division. They remain 17th but are now only four points off tenth place Flackwell Heath (albeit having played four games more). That gives the team every chance of extricating themselves from the lower reaches of the table. But it will require this modest winning streak not to be another false dawn.

**Centre back: Liam Edmondson** - making over 200 appearances for Bassett after initially joining the club in 2008, Edmondson played a key role in both promotion winning campaigns during the decade. Commanding in the air and an excellent man-marker, he netted both Manager's and Players' Player of the Year awards in Bassett's 2010-11 Hellenic League Premier Division campaign.

**Centre back: Shaun Carter** - a player in the same mould as Edmondson, Carter was another double Player of the Year award winner, claiming both prizes in 2012-13 as Bassett earned promotion from Division One West with a runners-up finish. Carter was another long-serving player during the decade and made close to 200 appearances for Bassett across five seasons. It is only fitting that Bassett's best centre half pairing over the past ten years are together in the team of the decade.

Honourable mentions: George Drewitt – yet another double Player of the Year award winner, this time in 2014-15 – deserves mention for his excellent performances over the course of three seasons after making a belated step up from Bassett's reserves. Club stalwarts Steve Yeardley and Adam Corcoran also had a strong case for consideration, with both offering versatility to play either at centre half and full back. Having been a dependable, strong performer over the course of four and a half seasons – during which he helped secure two promotions, Craig Bowden is a little unfortunate not to have made the starting eleven at right back.

#### Midfielders

**Left midfield: Brad Pagliaroli** – in his season and a half so far with Bassett, Pagliaroli has been a shining light. While capable of playing through the middle, with his speed and great skill he has proven most effective playing out wide, in particular when cutting in onto his favoured left foot. Pagliaroli scored eighteen times in 40 appearances last season – including an impressive winner away against Leighton Town in the FA Cup – and is well on his way towards comfortably reaching double figures again this term.

**Right midfield: Dan Bailey** – a creative, hard-working midfielder with an eye for producing a spectacular goal, Bailey netted 33 times for Bassett in 142 appearances between 2014 and 2017. At times with Bassett, he was perhaps a little underappreciated by his managers. However, he could always be relied upon to not only give his all, but also to come up with a vital assist or goal. Bailey was Bassett's leading appearance maker in 2014-15 and 2016-17 and also finished as top scorer in that first season, registering nineteen times. Now back with Fairford Town, he continues to be a reliable performer.

**Centre midfield: Sam Packer** - If an award was to be given for Bassett's Player of the Decade, Packer would be the frontrunner. The cultured midfielder dazzled across seven seasons with Bassett, scoring 26 goals in 145 appearances while creating countless other goals. After initially joining in January 2011, Packer quickly established himself as a starter under Dave Turner. Combining clever movement with superb distribution and a willingness to also get stuck in, He was a player capable of transforming any game and, when at his best, was a joy to watch as he tormented opposing defences.







### Media Officer's Team of the Decade

As the decade ends Press and Media Officer Stuart Smedley selects his team of the decade.

On reflection, the past decade has been a tumultuous one for Royal Wootton Bassett Town. During those ten years the club's first team have experienced three changes of division – including one cruel demotion. Bassett have played at three home grounds – including two years in exile at Cirencester Town (whose generosity and support are not forgotten) after saying goodbye to Rylands Way in 2013, before finally moving to the New Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. Meanwhile, five different first team managers have served in that period.

Nevertheless, the past ten years have brought notable on-field successes. Silverware may have proven elusive. But the two promotions from Hellenic League Division One West (in 2009-10 and 2012-13) earned under Dave Turner's stewardship helped turn Bassett's on-field fortunes around. Bassett also went on a record run in the FA Cup, Turner's team reaching the second qualifying round in 2012-13, before matching their best ever FA Vase performance in 2017-18 when Rich Hunter's side made it to the second round.

Which players though have stood out the most and proven worthy of selection for Royal Wootton Bassett Town's 'Team of the Decade'? Comprising players who have featured in seasons stretching from 2009-10 to the current campaign, here is the author's selection of those who have excelled most in blue and yellow over the last ten years:

**Goalkeeper: Stewart Thompson** – for the majority of the decade, Bassett have cycled through goalkeepers. However, at its start Thompson was a fixture in Dave Turner's successful sides. Making close to 150 appearances between 2008 and 2013, the outstanding shot stopper played a key role in delivering promotion in 2009-10 and performed excellently the following season in the Hellenic League Premier Division. Injuries would unfortunately limit Thompson's appearances over the next two seasons, though he still performed at a high level when available.



Honourable mention: Curtis Meare made 78 appearances as his time as Bassett's undisputed number one during the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons, earning Players' Player of the Year in the latter campaign. He has since gone on to win the Hellenic League Premier Division with Wantage Town.

#### Defenders

Left back: Dale Richards – a product of Bassett's youth system, Richards has amassed more than 175 appearances since making his debut at the start of the 2014-15 campaign. He quickly established himself as first choice left back that year, though has also proven effective in a more advanced role, as evidenced by the eleven goals he scored in 2016-17. Travel and health issues (including heart surgery) have limited his appearances over the past couple of seasons, but he remains a dependable player thanks to his pace and energy.



**Right back: Dan Comer** – making his debut in senior football with Bassett in the 2015-16 season, Comer was a consistent quality performer at right back. Calm on the ball, solid in the tackle and demonstrating a maturity in his play, it was little surprise that Comer picked up the Manager's Player of the Year award in 2016-17. He has since gone on to win the Hellenic League Premier Division with Wantage Town and is currently plying his trade in the Southern League with Highworth Town.



#### Defence make their case in complete performance Rivermoor, 7th December 2019

#### Reading City 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2

Stingy in defence, sensible in possession and clinical when it mattered most in front of goal, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's performance in their 2-0 triumph away against Reading City was arguably their most complete of the season so far. Victory was ultimately earned by two goals in a five minute second half spell as Charlie McCuish seized on a defensive error before Brad Pagliaroli struck a trademark left-footed drive into the bottom corner. Those goals sealed a deserved three points in a game which saw 'keeper Declan Lehmann - a busy man for much of the season so far - fail to have to record a single save. And that was thanks to a rock solid defensive display. Only once in the game did the Bassett back four in any way get exposed, and that was in the second minute when the ball was switched to Ben Lambourne on the left wing and his dangerous cross fizzed across the six yard box, just out of the reach of Fergus Burton and Samuel Bell. After that scare, Bassett did not look like conceding for the remainder of the afternoon. At the other end, the visitors had chances before the break. Pagliaroli curled over with his weaker right foot on twenty minutes before TJ Bohane flicked his cross on for Mark Francis, whose firm snap shot was well held by Charlie York. Then on the half hour mark, Bohane had York beaten with a curling free kick from just outside the box only to see his effort go inches wide of the post.

Although a tight contest. Bassett continued to be the only side capable of creating chances after the restart. Caine Bradbury went close with a free kick before Pagliaroli struck straight at York from outside the box. The best chance of the game so far then fell to Bohane, whose glancing header from a Pagliaroli delivery was brilliantly Palmer away by York low to the 'keeper's left. Eventually Bassett's pressure paid off, though their opener was a huge gift from the hosts. Reading defender Michael Butcher, who had a second half to forget, attempted a header back to York that fell straight into the lap of Charlie McCuish. The young forward, brought on as a first half substitute after an injury to Francis, had a free run at goal, rounded York and steered in from an angle to open his first team account. Pagliaroli almost doubled Bassett's lead three minutes later, but York was able to steer his effort around the post after a precise Gio Wrona through ball set the winger free. There was little York could do moments later though. Taking control on the edge of the area, Pagliaroli weaved his way past right back Marco de Sousa before firing low into the bottom corner from a tight angle. While 2-0 in front there was still plenty of time for Reading to mount a comeback - and they must have fancied their chances against a Bassett defence that has shipped a number of goals so far this season. But centre halves Aaron Oakley and Carl Evans were in commanding form, while young full backs George Ford and Alfie Presley dealt calmly with any threat, neither seeming to lose a tackle or get beaten. And that allowed Bassett to continue to attack their hosts. They were denied a third when Butcher cynically brought down the tireless Kai Robinson just outside the box as the Bassett midfielder raced towards goal. The Citizens' centre back was lucky to escape with just a yellow card from that, though he earned a second caution in injury time for a foul on Wrona. While it may not have been the prettiest display, Sam Collier's side showed grit and determination throughout to record their third Hellenic League Premier Division win in a row and, importantly, climb two places to 15th in the table. A crucial test awaits next week away against Virginia Water - with that game presenting another opportunity to edge closer towards the mid-table positions.

Man of the Match: George Ford - since making his debut last month, the youngster - a product of Bassett's youth section - has played without fault or fear at full back. He was excellent again at Reading, producing a mature display in which he - alongside left back Alfie Presley - kept the home side's wingers firmly in check. 23
