The Wiltshire FA have re-introduced the Wiltshire Premier Shield for Season 2019-20 after a break of 7 seasons. Whilst previously the competition involved just the 4 sides playing at Step 4 and above, the re-introduced Shield will now include the clubs playing at Step 5. This means there will be 10 teams entering this season's Shield and we will be one of the lowest level teams in the cup competition. The 10 teams will be Swindon Town, Chippenham Town, Salisbury, Swindon Supermarine, Melksham Town, Highworth Town, Westbury United, Bradford Town, Amesbury and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The one and only season we have played in this competition before was Season 2001-2 when we defeated Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the First Round 1-0 before knocking out Swindon Supermarine 2-0 in the Second Round. We eventually went out at the Semi-Final stage losing 2-0 to Swindon Town.

## **Editorial & Club News**

### **Welcome to Ardley United**

Good afternoon and welcome to this Uhlsport Hellenic League fixture against Ardley United. Today is our 1,100th league game since joining the Hellenic League. We hope all from Ardley who have made the journey enjoy their short stay with us this afternoon and we wish them a safe journey home. When the two sides met at Ardley earlier in the season we ran out 3-1 winners thanks to two goals from Callum Parsons and one from Jonny Davoile, two players who are both no longer with us. Ardley United have also had some changes since that last meeting between the two sides, manager Craig Adey stepping down having been in charge since 2017. Ardley currently sit second from bottom in the league table, 13 points above bottom side Holmer Green. Unless there is a dramatic improvement in form from Holmer Green, Ardley like ourselves should be safe from any relegation concerns but both sides will be keen to pick up the three points this afternoon just in case Holmer Green go on an extended winning run. No doubt the Ardley side here this afternoon will also be looking to impress the new management team so another tough game is in prospect this afternoon.

## Is This Still As Enjoyable?

Tuesday evening 15 players and coaches left work early to make a 130-mile round-trip to Windsor to play a league fixture at Step 5. In addition, about 8 or 9 officials and spectators made the same journey all because they love the game of football and are prepared to invest their time and money in following the club. The game started well with both sides creating good chances and we took the lead through a well taken goal from Bradley Pagliaroli on 11 minutes. It had all the hallmarks of being a really entertaining game. The game remained a tight well contested affair but then that all changed on the half hour mark. A Windsor player fired in a shot which came back of the post falling to another Windsor player who fired in a shot which hit Michael Miller in the midriff area prompting howls of appeals for a penalty from the Windsor fans behind the goal. The referee hesitated but then blew and pointed to the spot for handball. Despite the protestations from Miller that the ball had hit him in his midriff, pointing to the ball mark on his shirt, the referee then sent Miller off having given the penalty.

Now the beloved IFAB continually tinker with the laws of the game as they go down the route of turning the beautiful game into something akin to a non-contact sport, with players picking up cards for the slightest of fouls (each and every one costing the player £10 and eventually the club in an accumulated respect points fine, money which some volunteer has to raise or the player pay for the privilege of playing the game). In the summer the IFAB amended the laws relating to handball but even with their latest incarnation of the laws regarding handball my understanding is that it still has to be the case that the player deliberately touches the ball with their hand/arm, including moving the hand/arm towards the ball, with an offence applying even if the ball touches a player's hand/arm directly from the head or body (including the foot) of another player who is close by.

Much credit should be given to the Bassett defence that this was the case. Rather than play through the middle, Cleeve sought to utilise the dangerous Lucas Price and Stephen Davies out on the wing. But they were contained by impressive young full backs George Ford and Alfie Presley, while sharpshooting forward Jack Watts and his strike partner Leun Crowe were kept under wraps by centre halves Jon Beeden and Carl Evans.

Bassett's solidity at the back stood in stark contrast to that shown by Cleeve following the restart. The hosts almost found the opener ten minutes into the period when Ford clipped a fine through ball for Rhys Talmash in the right channel, but Francis could on scuff his effort from the wide man's cut back. Two minutes later though he found the net. A slice of fortune finally fell Bassett's way in the build-up as Thwaite and 'keeper Matuesz Wieczorek misjudged a long ball forward. After the ball bounced off the head of the former, it fell to Francis who steered a finely judged left-foot lob over the stranded Wieczorek and into the net from the best part of 25-yards.

A pair of good saves from Wieczorek then kept his side in the game. The first was simply stunning as at full stretch he tipped a curling Francis strike, which had taken a deflection, onto the crossbar. His second save from Francis, this time from a header following a Ford cross, was more routine but still forced him to stoop low on the dive. There was little he could to deny Odhiambo though with twelve minutes remaining. Another pass over the top caught out the Cleeve defence, and Odhiambo raced onto the loose ball before delicately lifting a shot over an onrushing Wieczorek and into the roof of the net. The veteran's goal seemed to settle any potential jitters Bassett were experiencing as they were now able to play with the comfort of a two-goal lead.

And that was extended further – in stunning style – with eight minutes to go. Patient build-up involving Francis, Harrison Lea and Kai Robinson eventually created space in the middle for Warre and the youngster produced a sublime long-range effort that a despairing Wieczorek could do little about as his shot sailed into the top left corner. With the win in the bag and a clean sheet to boot, it was shaping up to be a perfect day for Bassett. There would be one dampener though as Talmash, playing his first game for Bassett since September, received a needless red card for his aggressive retaliation to a foul by Harry Burns. But that aside it was a hugely impressive afternoon for Bassett, who after not winning a home league game until November have now recorded five on the bounce.

Man of the Match: Jon Beeden – led the defensive line impressively at centre half, ensuring that Hellenic League Premier Division top scorer Jack Watts had a very quiet afternoon.

## **Match Report v Bishops Cleeve (H)**

## Bassett storm past Cleeve with Impressive second half treble Royal Wootton Bassett Town 3 Bishops Cleeve 0

Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, 8th February 2020

A trio of excellent second half goals and a resolute defensive display saw Royal Wootton Bassett Town end their two-game losing streak as they recorded a convincing 3-0 victory at home against Bishops Cleeve.

In contrast to last week's losing effort away against Lydney Town, Bassett made the better of the difficult conditions at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground than their opponents. With the early stages of Storm Ciara brewing, a stiff breeze was present throughout the match.

But, with the wind behind them in the opening period, the visitors failed to take advantage, creating just one chance of note from open play despite putting the hosts under significant pressure.

The second half then belonged to Bassett. Cleeve defended anxiously throughout. And after an error presented Mark Francis with the chance to score a well-taken opener, Bassett slowly but surely twisted the knife, with Anaclet Odhiambo and Dan Warre ensuring an emphatic final score line.

Such an outcome would not necessarily have been expected at half time with the score still deadlocked.

The visitors had appeared the better of the two teams. However, that was aided by the advantages offered by the conditions. Further, despite enjoying much of the play they only posed any real danger from set pieces.

Leun Crowe headed a Luke Payne free kick into the side netting on nineteen minutes before Bassett should have been ahead when Carl Evans contrived to miss from close range after a mishit Alfie Presley free kick found the centre half unmarked at the near post.

Bishops Cleeve then had their lone opportunity from open play but debutant 'keeper Eddie Cavanagh was equal to Lucas Price's well struck shot on the turn.

Two further chances came their way from set plays before the break, Lee Llewelyn whipping a left wing free kick across the face of goal and narrowly wide before Richard Thwaite headed just outside the far post from a towering Adam Mace free kick delivery.

The game therefore entered the interval knotted up at 0-0.

The shot on Tuesday evening was definitely from close range but even if the ball had hit the hand/arm (which our player didn't think was the case and the mark on the shirt would seem to validate) his hands were down by his side and his hand/arm had not made his body unnaturally bigger and was most definitely not above/beyond their shoulder level, all factors that my reading of the latest draft of the law on handball say have to apply for it to be a handball offence. Unfortunately, having given the penalty I guess the sending off had to strictly follow under the laws as drafted these days, the referee not being empowered to show any leniency, but the impact on the game was massive as we now had to play 60 minutes with 10 men. A second soft penalty moments later and we knew it was once again not going to be our night. I must congratulate the players with how they dealt with the injustice of another harsh sending-off, both in terms of the reaction to the incident itself and the way they then performed for the rest of the game. Even with the numerical disadvantage we remained in the game and had some decent chances to equalise late in the second half. It took Windsor until five minutes from time to finally finish us off, a well taken shot from Danny Horscroft after a mishit cross from the left found its way to him in space just outside the box. Yet another injustice in what feels like a season of injustices and I wonder how many of those who made the long journey on Tuesday night and probably got back sometime after 11.30PM are thinking is this really enjoyable any more? I am certainly starting to think that. Whilst we at least do not have VAR at grass roots level, all these rule changes and the FA's training and coaching of referees seemingly outlawing the ability for referees to apply common sense to situations these days, the more and more I fall out of love with the game that has been massive part of my life. Unfortunately I can't see anything getting better any time soon although at least I know the FA now have a programme that I can fall back should I get too depressed with it all.

### **Development Side**

Since the last home programme the Development Side have lost away at Marlborough Town, the young side coming up against a physical side on a heavy pitch. Whilst the defeat was disappointing I am sure both the players and management have learnt a lot from the game. The Dev side are without a game today with Purton the next opponents here at the Gerard Buxton Ground next Saturday.

### **Ladies Side**

The Ladies have not played since the last programme but, weather permitting, are scheduled to be away to Portishead tomorrow.

Finally I hope all enjoy the game this afternoon, hopefully the match will end with 11 players on both sides for the full 90 minutes and with the crowd thoroughly entertained, but it would be nice if we could end the day with the three points.



# **Hellenic Premier Round-up**

### Saturday 15<sup>th</sup>February 2020

All the scheduled games in the Premier Division on Saturday 15th February fell victim to Storm Dennis.

#### Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2020

Three of the scheduled six games on Tuesday night kicked-off but only our game at Windsor went the full duration. Two penalties from Luke Brooks-Smith and a late Danny Horscroft goal secured all three points for Windsor as they ran out 3-1 winners, this after Brad Pagliaroli had put us in front on 18-minutes. The games between Falckwell Heath and Burnham and Holmer Green and Reading City were both abandoned following heavy downpours.

#### **Hellenic Premier Next Season**

The FA recently issued some guidance regarding what next season could look like at Steps 5 and 6 as part of the restructuring that is scheduled to take place in the Summer. The FA are to be applauded for there transparency in doing this, providing maps of what the various leagues and divisions could look like based on league tables as at 31 December 2019. After last season's late lateral movements, providing early warning of what some of the moves could look like is a positive step by the FA, allowing for clubs to flag up early whether they are likely to appeal. Whilst we are now in February things have moved on a bit but the FA will provide another update in March. In the meantime the guys on the Non-League Matters Forum keep an unofficial version which will be pretty accurate as to what the final outcome may look like. The Premier Division of the Uhlsport Hellenic League will revert to 20 teams and the latest projected list on the Forum at the time of writing, based on current league tables, is as follows:

Abingdon United, Bishops Cleeve, Brimscombe & Thrupp, Calne Town, Cheltenham Saracens, Chipping Sodbury Town, Clevedon Town, Cribbs, Fairford Town, Hallen, Hereford Pegasus, Longlevens AFC, Lydney Town, Malvern Town, Roman Glass St George, **Royal Wootton Bassett Town**, Shrivenham, Thornbury Town, Tuffley Rovers and Wantage Town.





# **Opponents History**

#### Ardley United . Club History

Ardiey United were formed in 1945 just after the end of the Second World War. In the early years, the club piled its trade in the Lord Jersey FA and played on a pitch which was situated close to the railway line on the Oxford Road. The 1950's and 190's were successful for the club as they won both league titles and cups; most notably the Oxfordshire Junior Shield on three occasions as well as many other trophies.

The acquisition of the current Praying Field site in the mid-60's enabled the club to move into the heart of the village, and a number of voluntieers led by life-long supporter. Doug Hodges built modest changing rooms. Ardiey continued to compete in the Jersey League throughout the 70's and early 80's without much success but this was to change in the mid-80's with the arrival of Norman Stacey as chairman — a position that he graces to this day, in 1988 the club were promoted to the Oxforoshire Senior League and won the Division One title at the first attempt, following this up with the Premier Division title the following season.



Accepting a place in the Helleric League for the 1993/4 season, Ardiey spent six seasons in the fold Division One winning it in both 1996/7 and 97/8 as well as winning the Division 1 Cup for a record four consecutive seasons before it was merged with the Premiler Division Cup to become the Challenge Cup that we know today.

The manager during these years was ex-Oxford United leading scorer Peter Foley and he was to be the first in a line of managers

to keep Ardiey at the forefront who include Paul Spittle, Paul Berry, Dan Still and Kevin Brock among their

Major change was to come in the early 2000's as, along with the Ardiey Playing Field Committee, Ardiey United oversaw the construction of dedicated facilities along with a separate village hall which enabled the club to be Independent of community activities. The new clubhouse, which had been awarded the Non-League Paper's Hungerford Cup for most-improved facilities, allowed the club to be promoted to the Helienic Premier Division and so began the club's most successful years to date. Kevin Brock took the reins for seven seasons which saw Ardiey win several cups including the Oxfordshire Senior Cup in 2013/14, a season during which they narrowly lost out on the Premier Division title by just two points. Following Brock's departure, Paul Davis took over as manager for nearly two seasons until the resignation of long-time chairman Norman Stacey in June 2017 for personal reasons.

Ian Feaver took over the role of Chairman and appointed Craig Adey as First Team Manager. A decision to be voluntarily relegated to uhisport Hellenic League Division One West gave everyone some breathing space to adjust to the new regime. Craig brought with nim a talented squad of players and they won the Division title gaining promotion back to the Premier Division at the first time of asking.

The 2018/2019 season had its ups and downs but the team finished on a high winning the Hellenic League Floodilt Cup.

# Harsh Penalty & Sending Off as Bassett Go Down Fighting

## Windsor 3 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1

Stagg Meadow, 18th February 2020

Trips to Stagg Meadow normally involve plenty of goals, the occasional sending off and invariably end in defeat for Royal Wootton Bassett Town and the latest trip to Windsor was to prove no different. The game was a very even affair in the first 10 minutes with both sides creating chances with the game played at a high tempo. Royal Wootton Bassett Town took the lead on 11 minutes when Brad Pagliaroli scored on his return from suspension, firing into the corner of the net with a low powerful shot, a goal we have seen many a time from Brad in the last two seasons. On 18 minutes the home side went close to equalising when they hit the Bassett cross bar with a powerful shot from the edge of the area but Bassett held onto their lead until the half hour mark when the game took a dramatic twist. A Windsor player fired in a shot which came back of the post falling to another Windsor player who fired in a shot which hit Michael Miller in the midriff area prompting howls of appeals for a penalty from the Windsor fans behind the goal. The referee hesitated but then blew and pointed to the spot for handball. Despite the protestations from Miller that the ball had hit him in his midriff, pointing to the ball mark on his shirt, the referee then sent Miller off having given the penalty. A harsh penalty, an even harsher sending off. The penalty from Luke Brooks-Smith was fired into the top corner of the net giving Bassett keeper Edward Cavanagh no chance, as Windsor restored parity. It then went from bad to worse for Bassett moments later when a Windsor player went down in the box under a challenge from Jon Beeden and the referee again pointed to the spot. Beeden was sent to the sin-bin for disputing the decision and once again Luke Brooks-Smith stepped up to take the kick, this time firing low into the bottom corner of the net to make it 2-1 to Windsor. Bassett managed the sin-bin period well and prevented any further damage but the sacrifice of Dan Warre for a defender denied the Bassett side an outlet which, with hindsight, was badly missed in the second half.

Despite being at a numerical disadvantage Bassett remained very much in the game and as the game moved into its final 20 minutes it was the visitors, despite not seeing much of the ball, who were looking the more dangerous thanks to some great deliveries from set-pieces into the box from Caine Bradbury. First Carl Evans went close to restoring parity with a header from a free kick before fellow centre back Jon Beeden headed narrowly wide from another Bradbury set piece. The visitors were made to pay for those missed chances when five minutes from time a mis-hit cross from the right found Danny Horscroft in space on the edge of the 18 yard box and he fired in powerfully into the corner of the net to finish off any hope Bassett had of taking something out of the game. In the end the two penalties in that five minute spell on the half-hour mark proved costly as the side from the Royal town once again left the Royal park empty handed.

THEY say age is just a number but in football it's one that can increasingly count against you – especially as it increases!

So let's show our appreciation for some Golden Oldies, who are doing their bit to show if you're good enough, you're young enough also rings true. After all, it was only a few years ago that Chris Swailes became the oldest scorer at Wembley when he notched for Morpeth Town in their 4-1 FA Vase final win over Hereford. Swailes was 45 years old when he turned the ball into the net to silence the mass of Hereford fans who had made the trip. Not bad for a defender who has had a long, career that took in plenty of stops in the Football League.

Non-League is always good for an evergreen footballer, particularly the strikers. Paul Brayson has been a regular scorer for Newcastle Benfield in recent years and he is still knocking them in aged 42. Perhaps it's something about those genuine goalscorers that, while the legs might not be as quick as they used to be, the minds is just as sharp. That gets them into the right goalscoring positions and then, when the ball is at their feet or the cross is in the right place, they just know how to stick the ball into the back of the net.

Jamie Cureton has scored at every level from the Premier League down. At 44 he isn't just on the back nine of his career, he's strolling up the 18th. But he's still one of the leading scorers in the Isthmian Premier Division and despite a surprise departure from Bishop's Stortford last week – the club couldn't guarantee his continuing role as player-manager next season – he has already found the net for new club Hornchurch. I caught up with his new manager, Mark Stimson, last week and he spoke to Cureton's desire to get in behind the back four burning as bright as ever. Stimson describes Cureton as a "clever" player and he's sure the youngsters in their squad will take plenty on board from the former Norwich City man. Cureton himself says it is all about diet and re-fuelling the right way after matches. When I spoke to Cureton last year as he reached his 1,000th game, he said he genuinely felt like he could do a job in the League still. And while you're feeling good, why not keep playing?

Back in the FA Vase, there was a familiar name on the scoresheet in Wroxham's win over Stowmarket Town. Grant Holt, another former Norwich striker, turns out regularly for the Thurlow Nunn Premier Division Yachtsmen. He hit a penalty in the 2-0 win that has put them in the last eight of the competition. A final hurrah at Wembley Stadium for Holt? Although aged 38, he could have far more opportunities yet. Just ask Swailes!

## On This Date

Looking back over the history of the club we appear to have played eleven times on this date, 22 February, the first fixture being in 1902 when we lost 1-0 at home against near neighbours and local rivals Purton in the Cirencester & District League.

Our first win on this date did not arrive until after the Second World War but when it did come it was a big win as we thrashed Calne Corinthians 9-1 at Rylands Way. Top scorer that season Geoff Simpkins helped himself to a hat-trick, Lou Nash, Stan Embling and Granville Taylor all bagged a brace as Bassett ran out 9-1 winners. Having also beaten Calne 7-1 at their place they were no doubt happy not to have to play Bassett again that season. A 2-1 win over Melksham Town in our next game on this date was followed five years later with a defeat at Bemerton. Our only game on this date in the 1970's was a good one for the club as we were comfortable 4-1 winners over Westbury, Benny Lehane, Phil Keep, John Parsons and Brian Ewan with our goals that day.

The date has not been a particularly lucky one for us since we moved up to the Hellenic League. In both 1992 and 2003 we suffered 5-0 defeats, firstly at the hands of Wallingford Town and then Didcot Town in the Supplementary Cup in 2003. Sandwiched between these two defeats was our last win on this date, a 4-0 home success over Headington Amateurs in 1997 at Rylands Way, Gary Ashford with two that day, Robbie Newnham and an own goal completing the scoring. In 2011 we picked up a 2-2 draw with Thame United in our first Hellenic Premier fixture on this date, Sam Collier and Alex Green scoring the goals for Bassett. Our last game on this date was back in 2014 when we went down 2-0 away at Oxford City Nomads. The summary of results and extracts from the Headington Amateurs game in 1997 are shown below:
