# **RWBTFC Kit Sponsors**

### **Today's Visitors**

Welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this South West Regional Women's League Premier Division fixture against Middlezoy Rovers Ladies. A warm welcome to all the players, officials and spectators from Middlezoy who have made the journey from Somerset to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground this afternoon and we hope you enjoy your short stay with us and we wish you a safe return journey. Middlezoy currently sit in fourth place in the table with three wins and three defeats from their opening six league fixtures. All three league wins have come at home with the three defeats all coming on the road, a feature of their results also last season. The only sides they beat away from home last season were the bottom three sides, all the other seven games away from home resulted in defeats so it will be interesting to see how they get on in their first ever visit to the GBSG. Middlezoy are also on a run of three straight wins and are one of the form sides in the division. The sides are set to meet again here later in the season with Bassett having been drawn at home to Middlezoy in the Pat Sowden Cup, the date for that game has yet to be set by the league.

### **Melksham Town**

On the subject of cups it was a comfortable win for the Ladies last time out in the Wiltshire County Women's Cup as we ran out 13-0 winners over Melksham Town, and knocked Melksham out for the second season running in that competition. Judging by how well Melksham are going in the Wiltshire County League, with just one defeat and seven victories from their opening eight league games, the result highlighted the massive gulf in standard between the sides playing in the South West Regional League and those currently in the County League. A hat-trick for substitute Sophie Smith led the way for Bassett, highlighting the strength in depth that Jonny and James have assembled in the squad this season. The reward for the win is an away semi-final against Swindon Spitfires, with a likely final for whoever wins that tie against Swindon Town who have FC Chippenham in the other semi.

### **Next Week**

Next week the Ladies travel to deepest Cornwall to take on Callington looking to avenge that only league defeat of the season back in September. Since their victory over Bassett Callington have lost twice and were we to win today and pick up a win at Callington we would be in a great position at the top of the table with games in hand. However, we will need to be at our best both today and next week as these will be tough games as they generally all are in the Premier Division of this league. Hopefully last weeks enforced lay off due to the weather will not negatively impact our great run of form which has seen us win the last five games scoring 29 goals in the process. After the trip to Callington, the last game before Christmas sees the Ladies entertain Portishead, the only other side to defeat us this season, that defeat coming in the FA Cup when we left our goal scoring boots at home. With Portishead looking like one of the other sides who will be up at the top end of the table come the end of the season it means we end the year with three tough fixtures starting here today. Hope you all enjoy the game this afternoon.



Middlezoy started the season with a win away at Weston Super Mare in the FA Cup, thanks to two goals from Choe Snook in a 4-1 win, Georgia Coles and Chelsea Day the other scorers. They lost their first league game 2-0 away at Keynsham Town Dev but didn't have to wait long for their first points of the season, defeating MA Plymouth 1-0, Lucy Brown with the only goal of the game. Interest in the FA Cup was ended by Portishead, Middlezoy going down 3-1, Georgia Coles with the consolation goal. Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies' hopes of retaining their Wiltshire County Women's Cup title remain alive as they cruised into the semi-finals of the competition with a routine 13-0 home win against Melksham Town.

Seven different scorers found the net as Bassett cruised against opponents from the Wiltshire County League – two divisions below the South West Women's Regional Football League Premier Division, who they saw off 15-0 at the same stage of the competition last season.

Grace Eagles gave the hosts an early fourth minute lead, firing past Tory Swinney from range after Melksham were unable to fully clear from a Laura Jefferies corner.

Hayley Huckin beat the offside trap before rounding Swinney and tapping in to make it two before scoring an almost carbon copy ten minutes later to further extend Bassett's advantage. Hannah Gulliver then got in on the act with a long distance strike.

Two further goals arrived before the break. After receiving an Eagles cross, Lily Withers was afforded too much time in the box and comfortably slotted home before Huckin crossed for an unmarked Aly Lyons to steer into the net.

Comfortably ahead, Bassett rung the changes at the break. That did not slow them down after the restart though.

On 52 minutes, Rosie Kirk strode forward before squaring to Lyons, whose shot was parried. However, Gulliver was on hand to put away the rebound.

A minute later, Sophie Smith raced onto Amber Egerton's through ball and beat Swinney from distance.

Lyons then scored a third goal in the space of five minutes, tapping in after a Smith shot came back off the bar. The tenth arrived on the hour mark as Smith got her second from outside the box.

A simple finish from Beth Kelloway made it eleven with twenty minutes to go as she finished off a move from Smith's unselfish pass.

Eagles made it a dozen after shrugging off the attentions of a defender during a mazy run towards goal.

The rout was then completed as Smith, one of the half time substitutes, sealed her hat trick, guiding home a Gulliver cross.  $_{15}$

Like most club's Middlezoy Rovers Ladies is part of a larger club with an adults men's side that has been in existence longer than the Ladies side. Middlezoy Rovers were established in 1973 and appear to have started life in the Taunton & District Football League. It has not been possible to trace details of their early history but they were champions of Division 5 of the Taunton & District League in Season 2001-2. They continue to rise up through the divisions of that league and in Season 2011-12 were the Division One champions earning promotion to the Somerset County League. They adapted well to life at the higher level winning promotion out Division Two West at the first attempt as they finished as runners-up behind Congresbury. They once again adapted well to the higher level of football finishing 4th in Season 2013-14 in Division One and then going one better the following season finishing in 3rd place in the now regionalised Division One West. Season 2015-16 was to see another title won by the men's side as they were crowned Division One West champions and promoted to the Premier Division of the Somerset County League. After two fifth place finishes last season saw them go one better finishing in fourth spot. This season they have again started well and sit in second place in the league table. Their Reserves also now play in the Somerset County League.

Whilst the men's side were winning the Division One West County League title, Season 2015-16 saw their Ladies side start life in the Premier Division of the South West Regional Women's Football League. That first season saw them struggle at the wrong end of the table eventually finishing in seventh place in a division of eight teams with three wins from their fourteen league fixtures. The next two seasons saw the side improve. Whilst they again finished in seventh place in Season 2016-17, the division was now made up of ten sides and the following season they improved again finishing in fifth spot.

Last season they slipped back to seventh position but they were well clear of the bottom three sides in the division, winning nine of their twenty league games, drawing twice and losing nine. They performed well at home with six of those victories coming at home, as well as the two draws. It was on their travels that they struggled losing seven of their ten away games, only picking up victories against the bottom three sides. The travel sickness seems to have hit again this season. Whilst they have won all three home games played to date, they have also lost all three away games at Keynsham, Callington and Bideford.
