Welcome To Today's Game

Good afternoon and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for our second home game of the 2021-22 Season with our visitors here this afternoon **Chipping Sodbury Town**.

A warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Chipping Sodbury who have made the journey along the M4 to be with us today. We hope they enjoy their short stay with us this afternoon and we wish them a safe journey home.

There will be some familiar faces on the opposition bench this afternoon as it is a warm welcome back to the management team of Jeff Roberts and Andrew Youngsam. Jeff has already visited the GBSG twice this season and has also managed a few of the players in our side so he will know a lot about our strengths and weaknesses going into today's game. To counter that our coach Tom Jones was Jeff's coach at Highworth Town and will no doubt have briefed Sam and Bully as to what we can expect from Jeff's side this afternoon.

After going so well in cup competitions last season but having our league campaign stalling last season, Tuesday night's result was certainly not what Sam and the lads had hoped for. After two excellent performances on our travels in our opening two games no one will be hurting more than Sam after Tuesday's disappointing result. Sam described the performance to Your Sport Swindon as a "sloppy" one and no doubt he and the lads will be keen to put it right against Chipping Sodbury Town here this afternoon.

Chipping Sodbury are currently on something of a torrid run not having won a competitive match since the 2019-20 Season. Last season they did not win any of their 12 league games, losing 10 and drawing the other two and also went out of both the FA Cup and the FA Vase at the first time of asking. They have also started life in the UHlsport Hellenic League losing their FA Cup game 2-1 at home against Harefield United, having lost 4-1 away at Fairford Town in midweek. Despite this run of results we should not under estimate our

visitors today who certainly have some quality in their forward line with the likes of Sol Pryce and former Highworth Town player Aysa Corrick.

We are back here again here next Saturday when Ardley United are the visitors to the Gerrard Buxton Sports Round in the next round of the FA Cup. Ardley are familiar opponents for us having been in the Hellenic League from 1993 until the end of last season, but are now in the Spartan South Midlands League following the FA's reorganisation of the National League System. Before that though we travel across the Severn Bridge in midweek to play Lydney Town who got their league campaign off to a flying start with a 3-2 win over much-fancied Bradford Town thanks to a hat-trick from our former player Lewis Thompson.

In the other national FA competition we have drawn Woking based side Knaphill in the First Qualifying Round who play in the Combined Counties Premier South Division. Knaphill's ground is about a mile and a half up the road from where I live so I have told Sam I will try and have a look at them ahead of our game on September 11th. They won their FA Cup replay in midweek, going through on penalties but lost their opening league game but based on previous seasons I expect them to be tough opponents.

Before next Saturday's FA Cup encounter the Development Team will be in action here at the GBSG in midweek when our former player Ben Jarrett brings his young Wroughton side for a Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League fixture.

We have a busy end to the month with three first team home fixtures and the Vets Super Sunday (see advert in tonight's programme) so there is certainly plenty of action here in the coming weeks.

Enjoy the game and hopefully a first home game league win for Sam and the boys after Tuesday night's disappointment.

Hellenic Premier Division 21-22

Midweek, Week 1 – 3rd/4th August 2021

The early leaders in the UHlsport Hellenic League after an impressive 4-0 away win at Hallen are Corsham Town. Goals from Gary Higdon, Jaiden Pearce, Luke Ballinger and substitute Lewis Powell did the damage for Corsham. Also scoring four were Fairford Town who inflicted an opening day defeat on today's opponents Chipping Sodbury Town to maintain their miserable winless run that goes back before our last meeting. Ross Langworthy bagged a brace and there were further goals from Danny Gudger and new signing George Peare. Brismcombe & Thrupp made a good start to their season hitting three unanswered goals past Longlevens, Sam Foulkes scoring twice and Harlie Price with the other goal.

Calne Town edged a close game at Shrivenham winning by the odd goal in five. Former Bassett youngster George Ford scored the Calne opening and there were further goals for Harvey Flippance and Dan Watts. The other three winners in the opening round of games were Cribbs, Lydney Town and Thornbury Town. A solitary goal deep in injury time from George Kellow was all that separated the two sides. Another former Bassett player amongst the goals was Lewis Thompson who hit a hat-trick to down much fancied Bradford Town, 3-2 the final score. On target for Bradford were George Box and Charlie Walton. Newly promoted Thornbury Town were 2-1 winners at home against Tuffley Rovers.

Whilst we were drawing 2-2 away at Bishops Cleeve, there were also draws at Roman Glass St George where visitors Westbury left with a point after a 1-1 draw. It was a similar score at Westfields where a 50th minute strike from Joseph Davies cancelled out a 15th minute opener for Malvern from Harry Clark.

Saturday 7 August 2021 – FA Cup

All the UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division sides were in FA Cup Extra Preliminary Round action with the only all Hellenic tie being our own game against Thornbury Town which saw us win comfortably by four goals to nil thanks to goals from Dave Bampton, Alan Griffin, Tommy Ouldrige and substitute Tom Moore. Nine other Premier Division sides join us in the Preliminary Round. Biggest winners were Wiltshire side Bradford Town who won 7-1 away at Hythe & Dibden, George Box firing a hat-trick for the visitors.

Fellow Wiltshire sides Westbury United and Corsham Town are also safely through. Westbury won 4-2 at home against Christchurch whilst Corsham won 3-2 away at Hamble Club. The other Wiltshire based side Calne Town were held to a 1-1 draw at Bremhill View by Wessex League side Bashley and then went down 2-1 in the replay.

Two other Premier Division sides also went out after replays. Shrivenham drew with former Hellenic League side Burnham on Saturday but then were well beaten in the replay, Burnham hitting four unanswered goals. Hereford Lads Club were held 0-0 at home by Haughmond and in another tight game lost by a single goal in the replay. Brimscombe & Thrupp shared six goals with Western League side Brislington in the first encounter on Saturday but made no mistake in the replay winning 3-1 to make it through to the next round.

Tuffley Rovers saw off former Hellenic side Windsor winning a "home" game at Stag Meadow 3-2. Fellow Gloucestershire side Longlevens join them in the next round with a hard-fought win at Aylesbury Dynamos, Joey Haswell with the only goal of the game. Fairford did not do so well against the other Aylesbury side, Aylesbury United, losing 2-0 to exit the competition. Our opponents in the opening league game of the season Bishops Cleeve had an emphatic 6-1 win in their tie against Western League side Clevedon Town, Jake Rhodes and Jack Watts both scoring twice for Cleeve in this one. The two other Hellenic sides to progress to the Preliminary Round were Westfields, 3-0 winners over Heather St Johns and Roman Glass St George who defeated former Hellenic League side Holmer Green 2-1.

Today's opponents Chipping Sodbury Town crashed out of the competition at the first hurdle for a second season running, losing 2-1 at home to Harefield United. The four other remaining ties involving Hellenic sides saw all four go out, Cribbs were beaten 4-1 by Broadfields United, Malvern Town went down 3-1 at Highgate United, whilst Hallen and Lydney Town both lost to former Hellenic League sides, Hallen losing 3-1 at Combined Counties side Reading City and Lydney going down to the only goal of the game at Risborough Rangers, now of the Spartan South Midlands League.

Opponents History

In the summer of 1959 Cliff Phelps brought football back to Chipping Sodbury after a 6-year absence. In the initial 59/60 Season they entered a senior team into the Dursley & Wotton League. The following season they joined the Bristol & District League and throughout the 1960s remained in Division 3.

The 1970s began with relegation after finishing bottom of Div 3 and the slump continued in 71/72 when finishing bottom of Div 4. Season 76/77 promotion back to Div 4 after finishing 3rd. Season 78/79 saw them go one better as they finished second in Div 4. To finish the decade off and celebrate 20 years of the club's rebirth, they won the Div 3 title.

The good form continued in the 1980s, a 4th place saw promotion to the Bristol & District League Div 1 and by the end of Season 80/81, they had gained promotion to the Senior Division. The first Senior season saw a mid-table finish, bettered the following year by a 3rd place finish. Unfortunately, in 85/86 they were relegated back to Div 1, where they remained until finishing second in 88/89.

The 1990s kicked off with a 3rd place finish and promotion to the Bristol Premier Combination Div 1. The early 90s saw a new clubhouse and changing rooms built with help from players and committee members. A 4th place finish in 92/93, and the winning of the Premier Cup, was the clubs best season so far. They were to remain in Div 1 until the end of the 1990s, when they were promoted to the Premier Division.

After 3 seasons in the Premier, they were relegated at the end of 2001/02 but 05/06 saw them win the Division 1 title and promotion back to the Premier Division. 2007/08 was another successful season, when they won the Premier Division title and promotion to the Glos. County League. The first season in the County League unfortunately saw the team finish bottom but they escaped relegation.

The 2010s have been the most successful period in the club's history although it did not look that way as the decade started. After a 3rd place finish in the County League in 10/11, two disappointing bottom place finishes followed. However, the appointment of Karl Reese as manager for 14/15 sent the club on an upward trajectory. In his first season a 3rd place finish saw them promoted to the Western League, a league they had last graced in 1952. They then won the Western League Div 1 title at the first attempt. A 13th place finish in 16/17, their first season in the Western Premier, also saw a first venture in the FA Vase. Reese had left prior to the start of the 17/18 Season club along with a number of key players but the club achieved another 13th place finish and a first venture in the FA Cup which saw them defeat Brackley Town Saints before losing to Bishops Cleeve. Season 18/19 saw another good run in the FA Cup as they overcame two Hellenic sides before being knocked out by Bristol Manor Farm. A 10th place finish was their highest ever finish in the pyramid. An eventual summer of 2019 saw the club successfully appeal a sideways move to the Hellenic League, although they are expected to eventually become part of the Hellenic once the NLS restructuring is implemented. 2019-20 saw them remain in the Western Premier but the uncertainty of which league they would be playing in, unsettled the players and several departed along with the manager. At the time that Covid-19 struck and brought the season to a premature end they sat 4th from bottom with just 6 wins from their 28 games. Season 20/21 saw a familiar face in the Chipping Sodbury Town dugout as former Royal Wootton Bassett Town manager takes over the reins at Chipping Sodbury. It was to be a tough inaugural season for Roberts at his new club and his side sat bottom of the table at the time the season was brought to a premature end. He will be hoping to get off to a much better start this season with his side now in the Hellenic League.

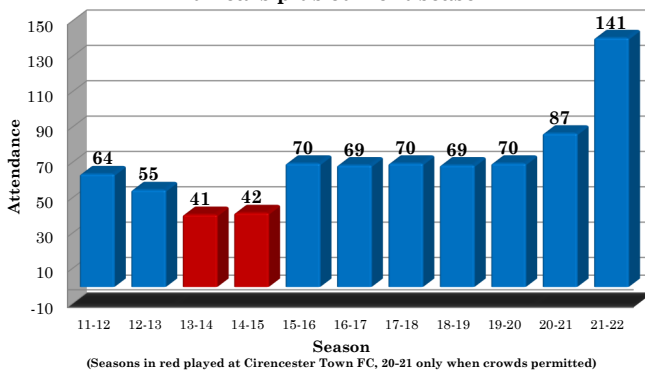

ESSENTIAL READING FOR FOLLOWERS OF THE NATIONAL GAME

THE NLP office has been an odd place to be on a Saturday night these past 18 or so months.

Usually, between about 4.45pm and 9.30pm, it's a hive of activity – and a little stress – as results, reports and pictures roll in from across the country.

From Workington to Ramsgate and everywhere in between, the spread of the National League System never ceases to amaze. And that's what makes it such an undertaking to coordinate and squeeze as much into our pages as we possibly can in time for the print deadline before the lorries deliver to paper to all those towns by sunrise.

There will be times in the coming weeks where I will, tongue in cheek, regret saying this, but we've missed that feeling of a looming deadline. It's great to have it back. As you (hopefully) know, the paper has still been out every week since Covid interrupted our lives back in early 2020.

We've had some football since then, with the National League's top division playing all the way through, plus the FA Cup and some others, which has kept us busy – the only shame being the fact the majority of games were played out in front of empty stadiums. But since March 2020 when everything first shutdown, there has been just five or six weeks where everyone from Steps 1-6 were playing. And even then, we were wrestling with late Covid call-offs, meaning late page redraws and rejigs. At least you can play for bad weather!

Glass shatter positive start

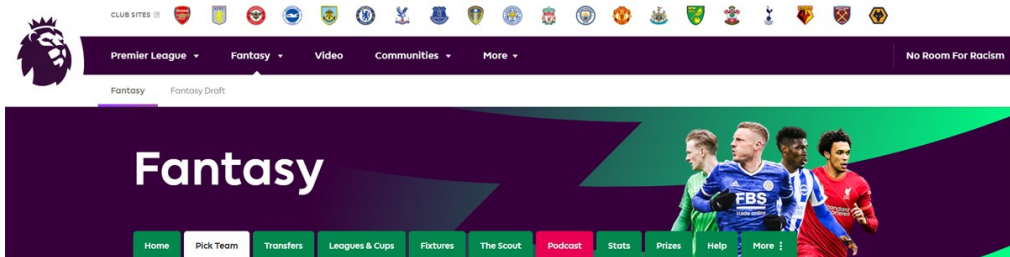
