Welcome To Today's Game

Good evening and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Lydney Town.

A special warm welcome to all of the management players, committee members and supporters from Lydney who have made the journey from the Forest of Dean for this league game. As to why we are playing this game tonight when neither side appears to have a game this coming Saturday you will have to ask the powers that be at the Hellenic League. We certainly do not have a game on Saturday and I could not see a County Cup or other game that Lydney were playing.

Before considering tonight's game it is appropriate to first of all congratulate First Team Manager Sam Collier and his partner Megan on the birth of their son Fred Patrick Kenneth Collier on Saturday. Congratulations to you both as you embark on the exciting adventure of parenthood from all at Royal Wootton Bassett Town. I am sure Sam and the Lads will be celebrating the new arrival in the bar, if not tonight, in the not too distant future.

Back to tonight's game and opponents Lydney currently sit second from bottom in the table having lost nine of their opening eleven league games, winning the other two. One of those defeats was against ourselves, as we returned over the Severn Bridge with all three points following a 3-1 win back in August. We should not read too much into their number of defeats, apart from the game against leaders Malvern they have all been close affairs, and their two victories includes an opening day victory over a Bradford Town side who, as we saw when they came to the Gerard Buxton Ground, are a very useful side.

In the Lydney Town line up is a player who will be familiar to our supporters, Lewis Thompson having played for us back in Season 2016-17 when on loan from Swindon Supermarine. Lewis is certainly the dangerman to watch out for tonight having scored ten of Lydney's 21 goals so far this season.

It was disappointing to fall to our second defeat in a week against Westfields on Saturday but they are certainly going to be there or thereabouts come the season end.

We were once again missing a lot of players on Saturday due to injury and other reasons and it was something of a blessing that Melksham Town called off our Development game as it allowed us to have a full complement on the bench against Westfields. Hopefully a number of the missing players will be returning tonight. With Sam otherwise engaged Bully and Tom have taken the team in the last two games and we thank them for covering for Sam. They will no doubt have hoped for better results in the two games but both opponents were decent sides and as this league often shows if you are not at the top of your game you get punished in this league.

Despite their fixture being postponed the Development Team remain top of the table as Pewsey Vale blew a 4-1 lead to draw 4-4 away at Trowbridge, dropping two points ahead of our game against them later this month. Before that the Development Team travel to Stratton Juniors who hae just appointed a new manager with Neil Lee moving across from Swindon & District League side Redhouse. No doubt a number of players will have followed him so Steve Yeardley's side can expect to face an improved Stratton side on Saturday.

Sunday saw the Ladies team in FA Cup action but, as was the case last season, the Ladies have exited the competition at the first stage, going down 5-4 in a nine goal thriller. As well as the defeat the Ladies lost the influential Hannah Gulliver to injury and she will be sorely missed in the coming weeks. The match report from the FA Cup game is included in tonight's programme. The Ladies are back in league action on Sunday when Bishops Lydeard visit the Gerard Buxton Ground.

Enjoy the game and hopefully a return to winning ways for Sam and the lads.

Club News



First Team FA Vase Draw

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have been handed a home tie against Downton in the Buildbase FA Vase first round. The tie is due to take place at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on Saturday 23 October.

Victories against Knaphill and Portishead Town have seen Bassett progress through the competition's qualifying rounds for the first time ever in consecutive seasons. And now Sam Collier's side have their eyes on (at the very least) equalling the club's record Vase run, which a win over Downton will achieve. However, to reach the second round – the stage at which they were eliminated last year – Bassett will have to again avoid being the victims of an upset against Step Six opposition.

Downton, who ply their trade in Wessex League Division One, reached the first round courtesy of a 2-1 away win against league rivals Ringwood Town. They previously had a bye in the first qualifying round.

So far, they have enjoyed a solid start to their season on all fronts. In the league they have registered four wins, two draws and two defeats from their opening eight fixtures, while, in addition to their Vase success, they have made it through to the Wiltshire Senior Cup quarter finals and the Wessex League Cup last sixteen.

In the Vase, Downton will now be aiming to reach the second round for the first time since 2012-13. That season the Robins advanced to the third round – their best performance in the competition, having also reached the second round in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Although notionally county rivals, there have been very few previous competitive

meetings between Bassett and Downton. Indeed, the teams have met just twice before in the Wiltshire Senior Cup.

The first encounter was in 1973-74 when Bassett triumphed 3-0 in the Senior Cup opening round before Downton prevailed 1-0 in a second round tie in 1992-93. The teams should also have faced each other in the 1963-64 county competition. However, Bassett were unable to raise a side for that away fixture.

There will be no such issues this time around though as Bassett and Downton face off in a national competition. And it's set to be an entertaining Vase tie, which both clubs are looking forward to.

Opponents History



Although Lydney is one of the main towns of the Forest area the Severnsiders have always led a very nomadic existence. With the town very much a Rugby stronghold the football

club has always found it difficult to exist and although the club can trace its roots back to 1911 it never has had a sound base. The club competed in the local leagues until 1952 when they were elected to the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League. In 1969 the club folded due to lack of committee. In 1971 the soccer lovers of the town pulled together and the club reformed and in 1974 the appointment of Harold Elliott as player/coach saw many players from Lydney Juniors introduced with the resulting effect of promotion to Senior League Division One in 1976. During this period the club switched from Bathurst Park onto the Recreation Ground using the changing facilities at neighbouring Cricket Club.

In 1979-80 after twice finishing Runners-Up they finally lifted the Senior League Division One Championship. Applications to the County League were unfruitful so the club turned to the Hellenic League, where the club held its own, but after 4 seasons the huge financial burden of the League forced the club to return to the Senior League. A dispute with the Cricket Club saw the club move back onto Bathurst Park and following this Secretary Roger Sansom, who had been elected in 1975 and who is still secretary to this day. investigated the possibility of building a clubhouse on the Recreation Ground. Unfortunately on the pitch the downward spiral continued and the club found itself back in the NGL. The players thankfully stayed together and they bounced back into the Senior League the following season.

Ambitious plans to have our own clubhouse were still in the pipeline and a clubhouse was opened on Lydney Recreation Trust in 1990. In 1995 the club did the double by

winning Division Two and the Forest Green Supporters Trophy, a feat they repeated in 1996-97.

In 2003-04 Manager Peter Elliott, who along with Roger Sansom are the longest serving members of the club with 40 plus years service, guided the club to the Final of the League Cup and the Senior Amateur Cup but in 2004 due to work commitments Peter decided to step down. The club turned to Stuart Liddington to take the helm and with Peter being persuaded to assist him they forged a very successful partnership. The addition of Pete Macklin from Cinderford Town, Danny Clarke ex-Oxford United, Matthew Timmins from Whitecroft and the return of Mark Saunders from Australia gave the club a real boost. Pete. Danny and 'Matty' provided the missing link in goalscoring department scoring over 70 goals between them, Danny leading the way with 32 goals. The Senior League title was secured with 4 games to go and they did the double by lifting the Senior Amateur Cup. The season was complete with the news of acceptance into the County League a prize denied to them some 25 years ago.

The clubs County League campaign started in unconvincing fashion with only 4 points from 3 home games but a 20 game unbeaten run saw the club take over as league leaders at the start of 2006, a position they held for the remainder of the season. Scoring goals was very much the key to winning as 87 goals proved, 'Matty' Timmins finishing the leagues leading goal scorer with 28 goals. This success was beyond the clubs wildest dreams and gave the club the opportunity of a return to the Hellenic League after 22 years.

A steady start saw the club 12 points behind the leaders in October but a 6 game winning streak at the end of the year saw the club take over as leaders at the start of January.

Opponents History continued....

The critical game came in mid-April with fellow title contenders Trowbridge Town visiting 'The Rec'. In front of a crowd of 305 goals from Danny Clarke and Mark Crabbe secured victory and a 5 point cushion. With 3 games to go the Title was won at Malmesbury when Danny Bishop came off the subs bench to score 2 late goals and give the club an unprece-dented 3rd title in as many seasons. The squad had certainly exceeded all expectations and can quite easily be classed as the best in the clubs history. Ambitious plans for the required improvements to gain promotion were put forward and accepted by the League allowing the club to play at the highest level in its history.

A steady start was overshadowed by events off the pitch when despite gaining planning permission for erection of floodlights the club became embroiled in a sea of red tape with their landlords. To continue playing in the Premier Division an agreement was reached to use Cinderford Town and Harrow Hill for home games. Despite these off the pitch issues an unbeaten league run of 11 games placed them in the top half of the table. Despite finishing in 10th position the club were unable to satisfy the April deadline imposed by the league and were forced to be relegated back into Division One (West).

With relegation came the inevitable loss of players who wished to play at a higher level of football and the club decided to pin its future hopes on the youth of the town. Mark Lee, who had joined the club from County League side Ellwood, took on the role of Player/Manager. In 2014-15 they finished runners up to Tytherington Rocks but despite finishing in a promotion position ground development had not been completed by the March 31st deadline and a further season in Division One followed. Determined that such a situation would not happen again further development work followed to ensure the necessary G grading but disappointingly after all the

clubs efforts the club finished in third spot which would not necessarily ensure promotion. As luck would have it circumstances led to the club being offered a place in the Premier Division which they readily accepted but this again meant further development was needed to obtain an F Grading and this was attained in 2016 with the installation of a 2nd stand.

In 2016-17 silverware came the clubs way via the Floodlit Trophy beating Flackwell Heath on penalties after the game finished 3-3. Last season the club finished in 11th position but Manager Mark Lee decided to step down after 8 years in charge and the clubs search for a new manager started.

The club turned to ex-Town forward Richard Kear. Lydney born Richard joined Cheltenham Town as a youth player but on his release he played on the Non League circuit. In 2013-14 he rejoined the club from Westfields. Unfortunately family commitments saw Richard step down at the end of last season. To replace Richard the club has been fortunate to regain the services of Stuart Liddington who as previously recorded was the clubs most successful manager guiding Lydney into the Hellenic League in 2006 and it is hoped that he will once more bring success to the club.

A sensational second half performance from Royal Wootton Bassett Town blew away Lydney Town as Sam Collier's side recovered from being 2-0 down after less than twenty minutes to triumph by the odd goal in five on another dramatic evening of football involving these two teams.



On a blustery night, all five goals were scored at the same end. However, it was ultimately the hosts who took better advantage of having the wind behind their backs

They looked in store for a long evening at first though. After only eight minutes Sam Elliott gave Lydney the lead, as his header, while unmarked, crept in with 'keeper Charlie McGready thinking the ball was headed the other side of the post. The visitors then doubled their advantage when Bassett failed to deal with another free kick and Sam Wines nodded in from Lewis Halford's cross

Lydney were by far having the better of things and came close again through Wines. As the interval neared, Bassett finally went close when Rob Lincoln almost got on the end of a cross-cum-shot from Brad Pagliaroli at the far post. But Lydney then almost grabbed a third as Wines missed by a matter of inches.

Able to avoid being in an even deeper hole before the break, the home side came out flying once play resumed.

And they found the back of the net in the first minute of the second half as Dale Richards fired home a powerful effort from the edge of the area.

Confidence restored, Bassett were putting Lydney under a huge amount of pressure. Jon Beeden went close as his shot was deflected wide, while Lincoln forced a brilliant save from Ellis Boughton. Eventually, with twelve minutes to go they were level as Pagliaroli curled one in from eighteen yards. That was shortly followed by TJ Bohane heading narrowly over. Despite that miss, you could sense that a third was on its way for Bassett.

And that duly arrived through Pagliaroli, who produced another fine strike from the outer limit of the penalty area with seven minutes remaining.



There was still time for more twists and turns and, never a team to make it easy for themselves, the hosts' hard work was almost not rewarded by all three points. The dynamic Ross Gabriel first fizzed a volley over the bar from eighteen yards before the visitors forced a corner late on that wound up being placed narrowly wide of the post.

Victory was finally secured though, a stunning comeback being justly rewarded.






