Youth Section Round-up 3rd October

The inclement weather may have limited the number of youth section games that were able to take place. But three of Royal Wootton Bassett Town's teams took full advantage of being able to play as the Under 12 Girls, Under 16 Yellow and Under 18 Yellow teams all recorded their first wins of the season.

For the Under 12 Girls it was a particularly special occasion as their triumph away against Allstarz Girls Electra was their first win in competitive football. They won in style too, coming from 2-0 down to win 5-2 thanks to a Daisy Bundy hat trick and Robyn-Jayne Spencer double.

In North Wilts League Division Three, the Under 16 Yellows got off the mark with a fine 4-3 home victory against Wroughton Youth Jaguars. Bouncing back from their cup loss last weekend, Patrick Otto-Mensah (2), Ewan Painter and Lewis Taylor were on target to help their side claim all three points.

The Under 18 Yellows also registered their first win of their Division Three campaign as they defeated South Cerney Youth 3-1. All the goals came in the second half, with Morgan Bridgman, Charlie Hudson and Jacob Rendell -Haines netting for Bassett.

Elsewhere, four Bassett sides were in cup action. The Under 13 Blues advanced to the North Wilts League Cup second round with a clinical 3-0 win away against Chiseldon Youth thanks to goals from Sonny Parmaku and William Smith. They will host FC Calne Youth in the second round in November.

The Under 13 Yellows were unable to join them as they lost 10-0 to Division One opponents Ramsbury Youth. Also heading for the exit door were the Under 15 Blues and Under 14 Blues.

In round one of the Wiltshire County Cup, the Under 15 Blues were beaten by the odd goal in three by Croft Junior Blue. Parker Fisher was Bassett's scorer. Meanwhile, Brandon Jack's goal was not enough to prevent a 5-1 loss for the Under 14 Blues against Lydiard Millicent Juniors in the North Wilts League Cup round one.

Whilst we were drawing with Lydney (see report elsewhere) in tonight's programme, **Cribbs** went to within two points of Malvern at the top of the league, a solitary goal from Ross McErlain giving them a narrow 1-0 win over **Fairford Town**, with leaders **Malvern** being held the same night to a 3-3 draw at home to **Tuffley Rovers**. Malvern led 3-0 at the break thanks to goals from Joe Bates, David Reynolds and Matt Turner but a storming second half saw Tuffley pull it back, Joe Shutt and Jamal Lawrence amongst the goals for Tuffley .

Westbury United followed up their 6-0 win over Hallen with another big win in the Wiltshire derby with **Calne Town**, smashing five unanswered goals. **Thornbury Town** held **Bishops Cleeve** to a 1-1 draw both goals coming in the opening ten minutes. It was the same score in the game down the bottom end of the table between **Hallen** and **Chipping Sodbury**.

The following night tonight's visitors **Brimscombe & Thrupp** were surprisingly beaten 2-1 by **Hereford Lads Club**, this after Brimscombe led 1-0 at the break. The same night a solitary goal from Matthew Swann on six minutes gave **Corsham Town** all three points away at **Roman Glass St George**.

Friday 8th & Sat. 9th October 2021

The weekend action started on Friday night and saw **Cribbs** go top of the table thanks to a 3-2 home win over **Hallen**. George Kellow, Ross McErlain and a winner from Nick Jones after Tommy Blackwell had given the visitors an early lead and James Burford had scored a second. On Saturday, **Hereford Lads Club** crushed visitors **Tuffley Rovers** 9-1 with sub Kiea Cowley-Hair coming on and firing a hat-trick, Levi Ellis and Cameron

Peters both bagging a brace. **Bishops Cleeve** pulled level on points with Cribbs when they beat visitors **Longlevens** with goals from Jordan Annear and Jack Watts. Harlie Price hit a hat-trick after Jack Bartman's opener as **Brimscombe & Thrupp** came from 3-1 down at **Chipping Sodbury Town** to win 4-3. A 92nd minute goal from Ollie Woodhouse earned **Roman Glass St George** a 2-1 win at **Calne Town** while goals from Ross Lye, George Box and Charlie Walton saw **Bradford Town** win 3-0 at **Corsham Town**. Opponents History



Brimscombe A.F.C. was founded in 1886 – the same year as the Gloucestershire Football Association!

The G.F.A. friendlies were played until the competitive league was formed in 1890. In 1902 the Stroud League was founded and Brimscombe were its first winners. Just after the First World War the Northern Senior League appeared. Its first season was 1922 and once again Brimscombe were the very first champions. Football was interrupted during the Second World War (1939–1945) but the game continued at 'The Meadow' where matches between the Army, Navy, Air Force and a team called 'Brimscombe Wanderers' took place.

When the Gloucestershire County League was first formed in 1968/9, Brimscombe – affectionately known as "The Lilywhites", were again founder members, along with other local sides Forest Green Rovers and Stonehouse Town. In 1973/4 The Lilywhites, amid some controversy, found themselves back in the Senior League, just failing by one vote to secure a place in the Hellenic League.

It was at this time the Club experienced a difficult period and in the late 1970's Brimscombe and Thrupp amalgamated to secure both Club's futures. The Club hit a purple patch in the 1980's and won the Senior League Division One and Two and the County Cup all in the space of three seasons, eventually being promoted back to the County League and finishing 4th in 1987. There then followed many years of varying fortunes for the club including relegation to the lower leagues. However, in 2008 there were major changes to the Club Committee and the Football Management which immediately brought a successful period for the club.

In season 2008/9 the First Eleven managed by Phil Baker were Runners-up to Longlevens and were promoted once again into the County League for the third time in its History.

In 2011 Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. won the

Gloucestershire County League for the first time and gained promotion to the Hellenic League under Phil Baker. Since promotion major redevelopments of the ground have taken place including an extension to the clubhouse and the installation of floodlights.

Season 2012/13 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. win the UHlsport Hellenic League Division 1 West and gain acceptance into the Premier League. More ground improvements were undertaken which included a new 100 standing/100 seating stand and further walkways around the pitch.

Season 2013/14 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. playing in the highest league in the clubs history, the ground improvements were complete with the new stand finished and other improvements made. The club experienced its first ever F.A. Vase football and were quite successful reaching the first round proper. The season was also made memorable with the First XI winning three cup finals – those being the Stroud & District Charity Cup, the Hellenic League Flying Press Floodlit Cup and the Hellenic League Supplementary Cup.

Season 2014/15 was another historic occasion with the side playing in the F.A. Cup for the first time in its history.

The club continued to go from strength to strength during season 2015/16 and saw the team end in fifth position, its highest league finish in its history. The upgrade of the club continues with works being carried out as required by Step 5 football.

2016/17 was another great season for the club when we appeared in three cup semi finals and saw the club have their best FA cup to date, eventually losing in the third qualifying round at Weymouth.

Season 2017/18 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp win the GFA Trophy for the first time in its history and finish sixth place in the League.

Season 2018/19 saw us reach our highest league position in the clubs history, however, second place was not enough to see us gain promotion.

Knockout stages within sight after Bassett see off Brimscombe

Royal Wootton Bassett Town moved to the top of Group Two of the Bluefin Sports Hellenic League Challenge Cup and, more importantly, are within touching distance of booking their place in the competition's knockout stages following a well deserved 3-1 home victory against Brimscombe and Thrupp.

The win moves Bassett onto seven points from their opening three games, a point ahead of Brimscombe who had triumphed in their opening two encounters. The teams will meet again in Gloucestershire on Saturday - and should Sam Collier's side triumph they will be all but guaranteed of a place in the last sixteen.

Playing a first competitive home fixture since early November, Bassett took charge of the contest and were three goals to the good before the hour mark.

The hosts went ahead on 19 minutes after a smart set piece move caught the visitors out. TJ Bohane won a free kick midway into Brimscombe territory, which Sam Ockwell played short to an unmarked Rhys

Wells in the right channel. Wells' cross after he had beat his man was flicked on by Matt Berry-Hargreaves and, ever the poacher, Bohane dove low in a crowded six yard box to head past 'keeper Adam Clatworthy.

Another set piece allowed Bassett to double their lead five minutes into the second half. From just inside the Brimscombe half, Ockwell floated an inch perfect delivery over the top of the visitors' defence and from an acute angle Dave Bampton arrowed a stunning volley into the top left corner which Clatworthy was helpless to do anything about.

Five minutes later it was 3-0. Bohane's deep cross from the right picked out Gio Wrona at the left post. This drew the attention of Clatworthy, allowing Wrona to cut back to an unmarked Wells who provided a simple finish from close range.

Brimcombe finally fired into life, although the deficit they were in was always going to be difficult to overcome.

Nevertheless, they put the hosts under a great deal of pressure in the final twenty minutes. And Oli Barnes made things a little more interesting with quarter of an hour remaining, firing home with a first time left foot shot after a crossfield pass had stretched the Bassett defence.

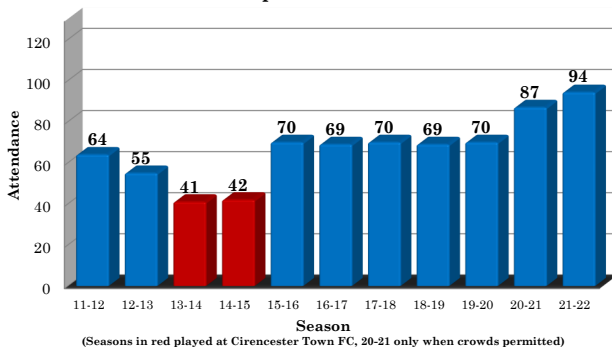

ESSENTIAL READING FOR FOLLOWERS OF THE NATIONAL GAME

RECREATION Ground, Aldershot. Circa 2001-02 season. I had made my way pitchside, waiting for Aldershot Town manager George Borg to emerge back from the tunnel for post-match interviews.

Behind me were two young boys, aged between four and seven I'd say, kicking a football between them on the pitch (don't tell the groundsman, I'm not sure they were allowed).

I knew at the time one of the lads (the younger one I think) to be the son of Stuart Cash, the Aldershot Town assistant manager. He had come along with his Mum to cheer on Dad from the directors' box – I'm guessing his first football memory.

That young boy is now, of course, Matty Cash, Aston Villa's talented young right-back, signed from Nottingham Forest for a cool £16 million just over 12 months ago.

These days, having helped Terry Brown guide AFC Wimbledon into the Football League, Stuart is enjoying the lap of luxury at Premier League grounds up and down the country following his son in a similarly proud show of family loyalty and support.

Matty's plight to the very top got me thinking about players who were brought up in the Non-League way. Yes, there's the Jamie Vardys, Andre Grays and Nick Popes of this world who earned big moves to the top, but how about those with a professional grounding but nurtured off-the-field from a grassroots background.

Indeed, Matty doesn't have to look far to see that he's in good company. His Aston Villa teammate Tyrone Mings is another taught the Non-League way from his father Adie, who

spent six years in charge at Chippenham Town.

It was there where Tyrone was spotted by then Ipswich Town boss Mick McCarthy, who spent £10,000 to bring him to the Championship. The rest, as they say, is history. Adie later followed his son into the Premier League and is now a scout at Chelsea.

And how about one of the top-flight's newest stars, Crystal Palace's Conor Gallagher? He is the youngest of four brothers with his siblings all having played at Non-League level.

Jake Gallagher, 28, enjoyed a solid career at the likes of Welling United, Aldershot Town and Dorking Wanderers, while twin brother Josh served a number of clubs at Steps 3 and 4, such as Staines Town, Met Police, Leatherhead and Farnborough. Third brother Dan, 24, is currently at Dorking Wanderers.

It's groundings such as these which have completely changed the perception of Non-League football from the upper echelons over the years.

No longer is life outside the professional game seen as a poor relation, a kick-and-rush fest played on a quagmire of a pitch, it's now a hotbed of playing and managerial talent with a refreshing purity about it.

And if it hadn't have been for the lure of Non-League and grassroots football then perhaps young Matty Cash might never have got his clear passion for the game.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town appeared on course for victory against Lydney Town courtesy of Alan Griffin's twelfth goal of the campaign. However, Brad Kear's stoppage time equaliser saw Sam Collier's side held to a 1-1 draw that prolonged their winless league run to six games.

Bassett's performance was an improved one compared to those which they have put in during their frustrating run of later. However, ultimately that did not prove enough to snap their streak against a Lydney outfit currently languishing in the lower reaches of the table.

In fairness to Lydney, who always prove to be difficult, frustrating opponents to play against, their league position is probably not a true reflection of the talent they have at their disposal. Lydney twice came close from set pieces before a Bailey Gallagher drive from the edge of the area was well held at the other end.

Lydney's Lewis Thompson saw a pair of firm efforts repelled by Eddie Cavanagh, the second a free kick from the edge of the box.

Bassett then twice hit the woodwork. Gio Wrona rattled the crossbar with a powerful shot from the after a Mills header dropped for

him on the edge of the box. Soon after Mills latched onto a Kai Robinson through ball, cut inside from the right and sought to curl a low shot into the bottom corner. However, he could only find the post.

Bassett finally found the net shortly after the restart. Wrona curled in a free kick from the left side, which Griffin met with a header that lacked direction. However, a shanked clearance meant the ball was still in a dangerous position and the veteran marksman was on hand to scramble home from a matter of yards.

However, chances to extend that lead were passed up. Griffin saw a shot cleared off the line after he had stole possession on the edge of the area following some questionable defending. Macauley Dodson was centimetres away from connecting with a low Wrona corner; had he got his head on the ball it would have been a certain goal. Gallagher also saw a low shot saved.

Having not taken those chances, the bar came to the rescue for them at the other end as a looping header from a Lydney corner found the woodwork. And the hosts were somewhat fortunate that Lydney weren't awarded a penalty late on as Adam Corcoran appeared to foul.

It seemed as though Bassett were going to hold out for victory. That was until a cross from deep on the left was swung in and Kear glanced a delicate header into the bottom corner.

In the aftermath of Kear scoring, the hosts had ex-Bassett player Lewis Thompson sent off as he had some choice words for Jon Beeden, against who Kear had won his aerial battle. His dismissal mattered little for his side though as Bassett's frustrating form continued.

Things don't get easier in the next couple of weeks either with fixtures against high-flyers Brimscombe and Thrupp and Malvern, the inform Westbury United and local rivals Fairford Town to come before the end of the month.
