Welcome To Today's Game

Good evening and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Cribbs.

A special warm welcome to all of the management players, committee members and supporters from Cribbs who have made the journey along the M4 from Bristol for this league game.

Cribbs moved across from the Western League in the summer as part of the FA's restructuring of the National League System and I believe tonight will be the first ever meeting between the two sides.

We come into tonight's game on the back of consecutive league wins and just as important two clean sheets. Hopefully we can continue that sequence tonight but Cribbs have made a good start to life in the Uhlsport Hellenic League and currently sit third in the table with eleven wins from their opening seventeen games. That said they have hit a bit of a bad spell of late and after losing 3-2 to Lydney Town on Saturday are now without a win in their last five games.

Our win against Hallen on Saturday came courtesy of a solitary goal from Matt Bennett who continues to terrorise defences with his pace even though in theory he is eligible now for our veterans' side! He is the top scorer for the Development side this season with 21 goals and when called up to the first team this season has shown that he is more than capable of still playing at Hellenic level. Saturday's game saw him make his 190th appearance for the first team and I wouldn't bet against him joining Corcs in the 200 club before the end of the season

Saturday's game saw manager Sam Collier also reach a milestone with his 100th game in charge and it was fitting that he was able to celebrate the occasion with a win.

Development Team

Saturday saw the Development team's scheduled game against Devizes Town Reserves postponed, this time due to a lack of match officials. With hindsight if scheduled opponents Devizes had gone with our Secretary Ian Thomas' suggestion of waiting until 10.30am on Saturday to make the final call on the game, rather than 6pm on Friday, the game would have gone ahead as another game was postponed after the 6pm deadline and the officials could have been moved across. In the end they were moved to other games previously there was just one assistant referee such is the shortage this season with no recruitment going on during the two Covid impacted seasons to replace referees that had retired. Bassett dropped a place in the table with Corsham Town Development winning but if Bassett win their games in hand we can go level with league leaders Pewsev Vale. Steve Yeardley's side are back in action on Saturday when Shrewton United visit the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. When the sides met back in September Bassett won 4 -1 and will be hoping to complete a league double over Shrewton.

Ladies Team

The Ladies finally got to play a competitive game on Sunday after close to a month of inactivity due to cup games and waterlogged pitches. They certainly took their frustration of being without a game for so long out on visitors Bideford, hitting fourteen unanswered goals to move up to fourth place in the table. Bassett are five points behind the leaders with two games in hand. Win them and Graham Fletcher's side would be top of the table. A brief report on Sunday's game is included in tonight's programme.

Enjoy the game tonight and hopefully a hat -trick of league wins for Sam and the lads.

Club News

FA Vase Second Round Proper

Royal Wootton Bassett Town will have the benefit of being at home in the Buildbase FA Vase second round. However, they will face an extremely tough test having been paired with Cornish-side Torpoint Athletic in a tie that is due to take place at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on Saturday 20 November.

Bassett have already recorded home wins against Knaphill (1-0) and Downton (4-0) - as well an away victory against Portishead Town (3-1) - on their journey to the second round of this year's competition. And Sam Collier's side - who will make club history if they are able to advance to the third round - will no doubt be pleased that it is Torpoint having to travel to Wiltshire rather than Bassett having to make the journey to the Cornwall coast.

Yet there is no doubt that the second round draw represents the toughest challenge Bassett have faced in the Vase so far this season. At present Torpoint sit fifth in the South West Peninsula League Premier Division East. However, that is something of a false position given that the Windmills have at least five games in hand over three of the teams above them. Most impressively, they are still unbeaten in the league, having won eight and drawn one of the nine fixtures they have played so far.

Torpoint's eyes are no doubt set on gaining promotion to the Western League at the end of the campaign. But they will also be equally intent on a deep run in the Vase, which their early season form suggests they are more than capable of. Their current Vase exploits have seen them play all three of their ties so far on home soil. They began with a narrow 1-0 first qualifying round win against Callington Town before a much more straightforward 6-1 triumph against Stoke Gabriel and Torbay Police in the second qualifying round. The first round then saw Torpoint

granted their first encounter with a side outside of the South West Peninsula League - and they were more than up to that test as they impressively beat Bassett's Hellenic League Premier Division rivals Chipping Sodbury Town 4-1.

Torpoint have plenty of Vase pedigree too. They first entered the competition in 1991-92 and two seasons later advanced to the fourth round before going a stage further in 1995-96. While not competing in the Vase between the 1997-98 and 2009-10 seasons, the past decade has seen them advance beyond the second round on two further occasions. Torpoint reached the quarter final stage in 2010-11, where they were narrowly beaten by Poole Town, and advanced to the third round in 2016-17 before losing at Bradford Town.

Despite that rich history in the competition though, their visit to face Bassett will only be their third ever Vase encounter against a Hellenic side. In addition to their recent win against Chipping Sodbury, Torpoint visited Brimscombe and Thrupp in the 2015-16 second round and were beaten 3-2. It will be an equally unique experience for their hosts too as Bassett have only ever faced South West Peninsula League opponents twice before in the Vase. And - like Torpoint against Hellenic League sides -Bassett hold a 1-1 record, having lost 2-0 to St Blazev in 2001-02 before beating Camelford 4-0 last season. The impending contest - a rare, challenging matchup that would not happen outside of a national cup competition - therefore represents what would be widely considered an ideal Vase tie. Bassett will also be hoping that it is a fixture in which they are able to make club history. Regardless of the outcome though. it will be an afternoon to look forward to at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground.

Opponents History

Cribbs FC are currently in their 64th season since they were founded back in London in 1958 as 'Sun Life Assurance'.

The Bristol team was established in 1976 when Sun Life first relocated to Bristol. Initially they ran two teams in the Bristol and Avon League, playing at Dundridge However. when the Causeway Sports Ground (now The Lawns Sports Ground) was opened in 1978, the 1st team were promoted straight to the Avon Premier Combination League where they stayed for 20 years until they eventually won promotion Gloucestershire County League by winning the Bristol Premier Combination League in 2000.

The club adopted the name of AXA Sun Life FC at the end of the nineties following the merger of the AXA Equity & Law and Sun Life Assurance Society, and became AXA FC in 2002. At the end of the 2010/11 season, following the acquisition and merger of AXA Sun Life & Friends Provident, Cribbs Friends Life was born. As the insurance company and the club parted ways, the club officially became Cribbs Football Club.

The 2011–12 season was Cribbs' most successful season to date as the club claimed its first Gloucestershire County

League title on its way to an unprecedented League and Cup double, with the team later adding the Les James League Cup to the League Championship, in the process becoming the first and only side to achieve this feat.

As well as winning the double, the club finally earned promotion to the Western League Division One for the 2012–13 season as a result of being crowned champions. The season turned out to be a successful one for the club in general as the Reserve and 'A' sides also gained promotion.

Cribbs first season in the Western League Premier Division saw them finish in 15th place. Two eighth place finished in two of the three following seasons saw Cribbs continue to improve as they established themselves in the Step 5 Premier Division. They were having a less successful season in the first of the two Covid impacted seasons but in Season 2020-21 they sat in 5th place in the table when Covid once again brought the season to a premature end.

The club moved over to the Hellenic League from the Western League in the summer of 2021 as part of the FA's restructuring of the National League System.



YOU HAVE to wonder what Hollywood actors Ryan Reynolds and Rob McElhenney really made of their first experience of Non-League football.

In case you hadn't heard, the actors who bought Wrexham turned up at Maidenhead United to see their first Red Dragons in the flesh last week

For people who roll in some pretty high-profile and glamorous circles, walking in to be greeted with some heckling must have been an eye-opening experience. I doubt that happens on the red carpet.

The depth of the National League System on full show with more than 1,600 turning out on a dark night to watch 90 minutes of the Beautiful Game, Fantastic.

I imagine they returned home with an even greater sense of how vital all these clubs are to their communities, not to mention how much it means to the supporters of the club they now own.

Of course, as is the way with these things, their team lost 3-2 before conceding a late equaliser against Torquay United on Saturday to draw 1-1.

The documentary covering their take-over will be titled Welcome to Wrexham. Last week was also a Welcome to Football. Where it rarely goes to plan.

After Tuesday's defeat, Deadpool star Reynolds – a seriously successful businessman to boot – described his feelings on an instagram post.

"Football is a staggering, heartbreaking, gorgeous, tommy-gun of soul-deadening, evil and beauty and I'm never sleeping again ever, ever."

Whether you are interested in their takeover or are indifferent, we can probably all relate, in some form, to that summary.

Whoever you support, there must have been times when you think: Why do I do this? I know I have

There are millions of people in this country who have no interest in this mad game. Who don't spend their Saturdays – or midweek evenings – standing in the cold, or glued to websites and social media to see how their team and rivals

have got on.

And sometimes, after those last-minute goals, you do wonder if it would be easier to not bother.

But that's the thing with football. It hooks you in. It refuses to let go. Conceding stoppage-time goals is equalled out by those stoppage-time winners. Or at least the hope of one.

And there's something bizarrely magical about being out in the freezing cold watching a drab draw.

Especially in Non-League. Where you're so close to the action and feel so much a part of it. I think we've seen that this season with some of the attendances across all levels — a combination of people just happy to be out at games again, mixed with an apathy of the higher reaches of the game.

Because, yes, football can be a real pain at times. There are issues at all levels that really grate and things in Non-League that could be better.

But it also provides more drama and moments than any Hollywood script. Hopefully the Wrexham duo saw that for themselves.

The second half was then a trickier affair for Bassett.

Hallen were fastest out of the blocks but, at least in the opening exchanges, unable to fashion anything other than a pair of half changes.

Bailey Gallagher then came close to doubling Bassett's lead but was unable to find a way past Thomas-Barker who parried away.

That chance for Bassett came somewhat against the run of play and Hallen were close to equalising when Jake Jackson shot on the turn and found the post with twenty minutes remaining.

The final stages of the match then proved to be hectic as both sides pushed for what would have been a second, decisive goal of the match.

Tommy Ouldridge volleyed wide, Mills shot across the face of goal and Bennett struck over for Bassett. For the visitors Dawid Regula failed narrowly to find the target after a swift counter, while Martin Stowell headed straight at Eddie Cavanagh from a last minute corner.

One goal was all the game would produce though - and, much to Bassett's delight, it was a Bennett strike that delivered the three points.

Royal W. Bassett Town 14 Bideford 0

Returning to league action for the first time in a month, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies showed few signs of rust as they recorded a comfortable 14-0 win at home against Bideford.

Libby Davies was once again the star of the show for Bassett as she found the net eight times. But it was also a fine afternoon for youngsters Jorja Halden and Poppy Wannell as they both scored twice and in the process registered their first goals in competitive senior football for Bassett. Experienced campaigners Laura Jefferies and Maddy Elliott rounded off the scoring.

Facing the side currently occupying bottom spot in the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division, Bassett entered the game as favourites. And with Bideford only able to field nine players for the fixture, a one-sided contest was a clear possibility.

To their credit, Bideford battled to the end. But the numerical disadvantage they faced across the 90 minutes meant they endured a long afternoon.

First though, Bassett will be hoping to maintain the pressure on the sides above and, crucially, aim to take points off them when they eventually meet.


