Welcome To Today's Game

Good evening and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Westbury United.

A special warm welcome to all of the management players, committee members and supporters from Westbury who have made the journey from South Wiltshire for this league game.

Tonight sees us play Westbury in a league game for the first time since February 1981 when the two sides were in Division Two of the Wiltshire County League. Westbury moved across from the Western League in the summer as part of the FA's restructuring of the National League System and have made a decent start to life in the Uhlsport Hellenic League. They currently sit in ninth spot in the league table having won six of their opening eleven league fixtures. Full details of their results so far this season are included elsewhere in tonight's programme.

Whilst it is over 40 years since we last met in a league fixture the two sides have met 81 times in competitive fixtures over the years, with the most recent games having taken place in the Wiltshire FA's county cup competitions and the FA Cup. Details of all the results over the years are included in tonight's programme unfortunately for Royal Wootton Bassett Town supporters it does not make pleasant reading. Westbury have beaten us 53 times in those 81 games, with us winning just 19 times, with nine draws over the years. Some of those defeats were also by big scores. As well as our overall record against Westbury not being too pretty nor is our recent record with us having lost all of our last four meetings. Hopefully Sam and the lads can build on Saturday's excellent 4-0 win over Downton in the FA Vase and start to make an improvement in that record against tonight's opponents. At the time of writing these notes our second round opponents in the Vase are not known but

by the time you read these notes all will have been revealed on social media. Hopefully it is someone from another league but not Mousehole away!

Development Team

Saturday saw the Development team return to winning ways after last week's first defeat of the season against Pewsey Vale. Once again the evergreen Matty Bennett led the way scoring twice, both goals coming with his head, with Dale Richards completing a hat-trick of headed goals with the third in our 3-1 win. The victory left the Development side three points behind Pewsey with a game in hand and with a much better goal difference courtesy of that big win against Purton. Next up for Steve Yeardley's side is a home against struggling Ludgershall Sports here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground this coming Saturday.

Youth Section Round-up - 24th October

Half term meant just two of Royal Wootton Bassett Town's youth section sides played competitive fixtures this weekend.

And the Under 13 Yellows took full advantage of being in action as they triumphed 4-1 at home against Kingsdown Lions Tigers.



Thomas Hyde gave Bassett an early lead before William Moreton and Fynn Crone extended their advantage further. Billy Robinson did pull a goal back for the visitors but Moreton eventually put the game to bed with his ninth goal of the season.

The result moves Bassett to within three points of North Wilts League Divison Four leaders FC Abbey Meads Youth Blue and Blunsdon Youth.

While the Under 13 Yellows celebrated victory, it was a frustrating afternoon for the Under 15 Blues who Malmesbury Youth defeated by the odd goal in three at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground.

Parker Fisher netted his seventh goal of the campaign for Bassett.

Youth Section Round-up - 17th October

Aleksander Goralczyk had already scored four goals in a single game for Royal Wootton Bassett Town Under 12 Yellow this season. Against South Cerney he went one better, netting five times as Bassett came out on top 7-6 in an unbelievable thirteen goal thriller.

Helping seal the win – the Yellows' third in their opening four North Wilts League Division Five games – was a brace from Stanley Lockley.

Also maintaining their fine starts to the 2021-22 season were Bassett's two Under 13 sides. In Division One, the Blues returned to the top of the table with a 5-1 home win against FC Calne Youth - the side who started the day at the summit. Goals from Liam Lve-Owens (2). Phanuel Asenso, Karol Czekanski and William earned Bassett deserved. convincing triumph as the side responded brilliantly to their first defeat of the season in their previous outing. While not top of the table, the Under 13 Yellows are sitting in a healthy third place in Division Four. Like their Under 12 equivalents, they have three wins from their first four games after beating South Cerney 8-1. William Moreton led the way with a hat trick, Fynn Crone and Jack McGeoch both netted braces, while William Pegler also scored.

Elsewhere the Under 18 Yellows were the only other youth section side in action to claim a positive result. They drew 1-1 away against Kingsdown Lions Blue thanks to a Harvey Watkinson goal. The Under 18 Blues slipped to a narrow 1-0 home loss against Lambourn Juniors, who grabbed all three points with a goal scored on the break. The Under 14 Yellows scored four times, but fell to a defeat against heavy 13-4 Ferndale Rodbourne YCFC. And the Under 12 Girls were beaten 8-0 by unbeaten Marlborough Youth Tigers in the Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League.

Opponents History

The club started in 1920 with the amalgamation of two local sides. Westbury Old Comrades FC had just won promotion to the First Division of the Wiltshire County League and to strengthen the side they joined forces with a local junior side, Westbury Great Western Railway XI. Together they became Westbury United Football Club.

In its first season the club finished third from bottom of the county league and after struggling throughout the 1920s, went on to great success in the 1930s.

In the 1930s Westbury won everything possible in Wiltshire football and in 1936 also reached the first-round proper of the FA Cup. They were led by a magnificent player called Billy Pearce, who captained the Wiltshire county side throughout the decade. Also in the side at the time was a prolific goalscorer called Bill Butler, who scored more than eighty senior goals in one season (including thirty in a month!).

The club then purchased and moved to its present ground in Meadow Lane, at a cost of £475 for the four-acre site. The very first game played on what was then the Jubilee Playing Field was against Bristol City and a crowd of around 4000 attended.

In recent years the Club has, with the help of the Football Stadia Improvement Fund, been able to replace the drainage system on the pitch as well as erect fencing around the ground and a wall around the pitch. Following several seasons in the 2000s where the aim of promotion to the Toolstation Premier League wasn't achieved, long standing manager Paul Brickley stood down and there were six seasons of struggle from 2010/11 till 2015/16 under various managers, with the team finishing in the bottom three every time.

Matthew Bright took over as Chairman in November 2014, installing Shaun Gardner as 1st team manager. Bright aimed to make the club more family orientated and make Westbury United the centre of the local community. The club now have a strong link with the local youth football club, Westbury Youth FC, which provides a pathway for youth footballers. Gardner's team finished the 2014/2015 season bottom of the league table but avoided relegation. In September 2015. resigned as first team manager. His assistant manager, James Goddard, was appointed as his

successor after three games in temporary charge. Westbury finished the 2015/16 season in 20th position.

Season 2016/17 started with them winning half of their games up until the middle of November, followed by a run of nine games with only one win and one draw. Morale amongst the players was low and the officers of the club were concerned Westbury would be involved in another relegation battle: the decision was made to relieve James Goddard from his duties at the club after a home defeat by Chippenham Park. at that time a relegation rival. Westbury's reserve manager, Marc Lanfear, stepped in to lead the first team whilst a new manager was sought. He was assisted for those two matches by Nathan Hallett-Young; they won both of their games against two of the top three teams in the division.

Father and son, Neil and Joe Kirkpatrick, were appointment joint managers on 1 February 2017. They suffered defeat in their first three league games in charge, but after that they oversaw a five-league game winning streak, the first time Westbury United achieved this since 2009.


The Kirkpatrick's had attracted a strong group of players and Westbury started the season amongst the favourites to be promoted. They started the season well, staying unbeaten for the first 13 league games, winning 8 and drawing 5. Chairman Matt Bright stepped down in early October to spend more time with his family, and Secretary Greg Coulson was elected to become Chairman at a Special General Meeting in early November. The club won the First Division and secured promotion to the Premier Division. They managed to score more points (95, previous best 91), score more goals (97, previous best 95) and concede the least goals (29, previous best 39) in the club's history.

Their first season in the Premier Division saw Westbury, fired by the goals of youngster Callum Demkiv who they had attracted across from Melksham Town, finish in the top five, a tremendous achievement in their first season at Step 5. The following season they sat mid-table when Covid-19 brought the season to a premature end and were 6th in the table when the same thing happened last season. During the summer they moved across to the Uhlsport Hellenic League as part of the restructuring of the National League System.

From The Archives - 1959-60

The Wiltshire County Premier Football League came into existence in 1956 and Wootton Bassett Town were to spend nine seasons in the league from Season 1959-60 before the Wiltshire Combination replaced the Premier Division as the top league in the county in 1968. Wootton Bassett's best season in the Premier Football League was their first season of 1959-60 after the club had achieved promotion from the old Wiltshire Football League at the end of Season 1958-59.

Season 1959-60 was also an exceptionally good season for tonight's visitors Westbury United who won the new Premier Football League for the second time having also won the title in the inaugural season of 1956-57. Westbury were to lose just three times in Season 1959-60 as they finished ten points clear of second placed Melksham Town. Wootton Bassett Town were back in sixth spot, the highest position the club would achieve in that nine-year spell in the new league. That season Wootton Bassett Town won half of their 28 league games, drawing six and suffering defeat on eight occasions. Those defeats included two against today's visitors, Westbury winning 4-1 at Rylands Way at the end of November, Ray Young with our consolation goal, and then completing a league double with a narrow 2-1 win in the return game at the end of March, Mick Jefferies with our goal that day.

Westbury had a more successful time in the Wiltshire Senior Cup that season although both sides went out of the competition at the hands of the same team, Swindon British Railways. Victories over Downton and Melksham Town saw Westbury progress to the Third Round, before a narrow 2-1 defeat at the hands of Swindon BR ended their cup run. Wootton Bassett Town did not get past the First Round, also losing narrowly to Swindon BR by a 1-0 score line.

That season the league ran a league cup competition which was a bit like the old European Cup competitions, with games played over two legs. In this competition it was Wootton Bassett Town who did the better of today's two sides. 

THERE'S no greater buzz among Non-League supporters than experiencing the magic of the FA Cup.

That thrill of seeing your hometown club pitched against the elite in the world's greatest cup competition. There's simply nothing like it.

Sadly, though, the FA Cup gods can't shine down on everyone and it takes a sprinkling of dust from Lady Luck herself at times in order to keep the dream alive

Take Horsham FC for example. After celebrating a famous win over Woking – two levels their superior – in the fourth qualifying round last Saturday, Hornets fans would be have forgiven for getting carried away while glued to the televised first-round draw on Sunday lunchtime.

Their reward...a trip to Carlisle United – a round trip of 682 miles for a game which wouldn't really over-excite the TV companies ready to potentially place them in the nation's spotlight.

Understandably, the Hornets would have looked on in awe at fellow Isthmian Leaguers AFC Sudbury, whose reward for becoming the first team to beat National League South leaders Dartford this season was a mouth-watering home clash against League Two neighbours Colchester United — a tie which will almost certainly whet the appetite of those either side of the Suffolk/Essex border.

My message to Horsham, however, is fear not. The magic of the FA Cup has not passed you by just yet.

As local sports editor, I remember covering Farnborough Town's path to the fourth round of the cup back in 2002-03. After a handsome first-round victory over Harrogate, the town was filled with anticipation until they were handed a rather underwhelming trip to Southport in round two.

Still, the run went on, however, as Boro came through 3-0 against the 10-man Sandgrounders to book their place in the third round for the first time in the club's history.

Premier League and Championship big guns lay in wait but Farnborough's reward was a depressing 540-mile round trip to League Two Darlington in the snow! Talk about a damp squib!

Incredibly, Graham Westley's side came through that too, winning 3-2 in arctic conditions to make the hat for round four. Third time lucky, Premier League champions Arsenal were their just rewards and despite a 5-1 defeat to Arsene Wenger's star-studded Gunners side in a tie eventually switched to Highbury, the club enjoyed their finest hour – a day that could never be taken away from a support base starved of success for so long.

The same could also be said for Lincoln City. Non-League football's best ever FA Cup run to the last eight in 2016-17 saw the National League Imps come through low-profile trips to Championship duo Ipswich Town and Brighton & Hove Albion to take their place in the fifth round.

Again, the giants of English football lie in wait but Lincoln were instead paired with a trip to Burnley where their run was expected to end with a whimper and without the fanfare it thoroughly deserved.

Not so, as Sean Raggett's 89th-minute header earned Danny Cowley's side the most famous win in their history and an eventual quarter-final clash with Arsenal at the Emirates. The rest, as they say, is history, as far as Lincoln are concerned.

You see, Horsham may well be cursing their luck right now and wondering if the FA Cup gods will ever shine on their plush new Camping World Community Stadium in West Sussex. Hope, though, as Farnborough and Lincoln proved, is still on the horizon and but there's still time for the magic of the cup to be conjured.

As Del Boy would say in Only Fools and Horses..."He who dares, wins!".

First Team Match Report

Saturday 23rd October 2021 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 4 Downton 0

FA Vase, 1st Round Proper

A near faultless performance, a clean sheet, a John Mills hat trick and a place in the hat for the Buildbase FA Vase second round: it was pretty much a perfect afternoon for Royal Wootton Bassett Town as they brushed aside Wessex League Division One outfit Downton with a 4-0 victory.

With the run of league form they have endured, there hasn't been much for Bassett to celebrate in recent weeks. While Bassett's position in the league does still need to be addressed, Sam Collier's side deserve a great deal of credit for how they emphatically saw off Downton and earned a place in the Vase for the second round for a second consecutive year - and only the fourth time in club history.

Bassett's second half display was particularly impressive as they turned the screw on their opponents, notching three goals while not offering Downton even a sniff of a consolation.

At half time, the tie did seem to hang in the balance. Bassett were a goal ahead thanks to Mills 35th minute opener, but Downton were by no means second best. They gave the impression of being a well drilled side capable of playing some good football. Yet they lacked the cutting edge to cause any major threat.

Indeed they only really created two half chance in the opening period. The first saw left back Sam Howe drag wide after being invited to advance forward. Marcel Laptas then found the side netting after a quick counter.

Bassett grew into the game and an enforced early substitution helped spark the hosts into life as Joe Selman replaced Dave Bampton who pulled up with an injury sustained in an early challenge.

It was not a like-for-like swap by any means. Bampton was playing at centre half, while Selman operates as a winger. But it allowed Bassett to shuffle things around and introduced a player whose movement would prove difficult for the Downton defence to deal with

And Selman would be involved in Bassett's opener, playing a return pass to Mills, who coolly picked out the bottom corner after Chris Taylor had initially won the ball deep in Downton territory.

It could even have been two before the break, but Selman snatched at a shot after Alan Griffin had redirected a Gio Wrona back across goal.

Leading 1-0 meant that there was still much work to be done after the restart. But from the resumption until the final whistle Bassett made sure they were in firm control of proceedings.

Mills initially squandered a one-on-one opportunity, shooting straight at Matty Fredericks, after Selman had stole possession from James Clark, while Will Davidson steered into the side netting from a dangerous Wrona corner.

But a second soon arrived as Bassett's pressure paid off. Davidson saw an attempted cross blocked, with the loose ball falling to Tommy Ouldridge. He squared inside to Mills, who needed just one touch to roll his marker before slotting home.

Mills' hat trick should have arrived two minutes later but he somehow contrived to skew over from close range after Ouldridge had cushioned a header from Khedive McIntosh's cross into the forward's path.

But from the way Bassett were playing, further goals seemed an inevitability.

Wrona eventually grabbed Bassett's third, the midfielder tapping in after Fredericks could only weakly parry a Taylor effort.

Taylor then fired over from close range, while Mills and McIntosh both saw shots saved.

The scoring would be completed in the final minute though. The impressive Davidson forced another turnover of play inside Downton's half and the ball broke for Mills who advanced towards goal unopposed before calmly picking out the bottom corner.

It was a goal Bassett deserved and the final margin of victory was a fair, rather than flattering, reflection of the game.

Tougher tests await Bassett - both in the next round of the Vase as well as in the league. But the result and the performance that earned it will hopefully inspire the necessary confidence to rise to these challenges.

Man of the match: John Mills - the experienced forward earns the award for a well-taken hat trick - a haul that on another day could have been four or five.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development were looking to bounce back from last week's first defeat of the season and reclaim second spot in the table having been overtaken by Corsham with that win in midweek when they visited Odd Down Reserves. The two sides have met just once previously on the opening day of last season when an injury time goal from Bailey Gallagher secured all three points for Royal Wootton Bassett Town in a seven-goal thriller. 


