Welcome To Tonight's Game

Good evening and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League fixture against our near neighbours Calne Town for what our Press Officer described as the "Route 55 derby". Despite just being down the road, the game at Calne a few weeks back, was the first meeting between the two sides in a league game since 30th November 1985 when both clubs were in the Wilts County League. At the end of that season Calne were promoted to the Western League whilst two years later we were promoted to the Hellenic League and the two sides remained in their new leagues until Calne moved across to the Hellenic this summer as part of the FA's reorganisation of the National League System.

A special warm welcome to all of the management, players, committee members and supporters from Calne Town who have made the short journey along the A3102. In particular special greetings to former Youth team player Clive McDaid who is part of the management team at Calne and former Bassett player George Ford who looks like he has been promoted back to the first team after playing for Calne Town Reserves against the Development Team a few weeks back.

After two good, albeit curtailed, seasons in the Western League, which ultimately saw Calne promoted from Step 6, they have found the going a lot tougher at the higher level. They currently sit second from bottom in the table with five wins and four draws from their 35 fixtures. They need to win tonight and also in their final two games, hope that Chipping Sodbury Town lose their final game, and also improve their goal difference by a material amount in the process to avoid relegation. In reality it looks like they are already down. Whether that relegation would be to Hellenic League Division One or the Western League is anyone's guess but the FA will opine on this once all the leagues are complete and promotion play-offs held. Despite their tough season, as was the case at Calne, we know we will be in for a tough game here tonight as is always the case when local pride is also at stake.

Hamworthy Progress to Last Four in Vase

It could still be the case that our excellent run in the Vase was ended by the eventual winners. Hamworthy United progressed to the semi-finals on Saturday with a penalty shootout win over Southall after it had finished 1-1 at the end of 90 minutes. Also through to the last four are the

side of the university I attended, Loughborough Students, who progressed after a 2-0 win over Wythenshawe. Joining these two in the semi-finals are Littlehampton and Newport Pagnell, with the semi-finals for once having a "southern" feel to them.

Development Team

The Development Team kept their title challenge on track on Saturday but only just against a well organised young Odd Down Reserves side. The Dev Team fielded a strong side with both Jon Beeden and Sam Ockwell playing, but in the end had another penalty save from Simon Notman to thank for securing all three points. The windy conditions did not help in what was a game of limited clear cut chances decided by an early Matt Bennett goal.

Ladies Team

The Ladies side ended their season on a disappointing note when they were beaten by second from bottom Middlezoy 4-1 on Sunday. After a great first half of the season, it has gone downhill since the turn of the year with just one win in the nine games played in 2022, that win coming against bottom side Bideford. Hopefully the Ladies can regroup over the summer and come back more competitive in Season 2022-23.

Veterans' County Cup Final

Our Veterans' side went close to lifting the prestigious Wiltshire FA Veterans' County Cup on Friday night, eventually losing a penalty shootout after it had finished 3-3 at the end of normal time. Former first team player Jeremy Newton scored a superb hat-trick but was then unfortunately one of our players to miss a penalty in the shootout. It was a fantastic match against Bradford Town and the old guys did the club proud. The only blemish on the night for me was that, due to a kit clash, we were forced to make a change, and the team played in training shirts without numbers on the back. I found this a bit embarrassing for a County Cup Final. I have expressed my irritation about this to the Chairman and Club Secretary and hopefully the upshot will be a new change kit for the Veterans' for next season.

After tonight we have a one month break to our final two league fixtures but hopefully will have a few cup games to fill the gap. Enjoy the game.

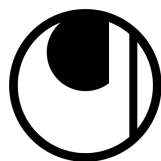

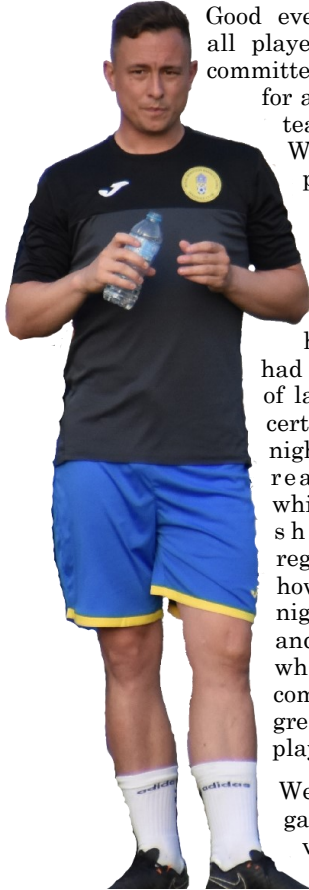

Opponents History

The club was established in 1886, and in 1894 they were founder members of the Wiltshire League. They finished bottom of the table in 1901–02 and 1902–03, and when the league gained a second division in 1903, the club were excluded from Division One. However, they were Division Two champions in 1906–07, earning promotion to Division One. Despite finishing bottom of Division One for the next two seasons, the club avoided relegation to Division Two. They left the league in 1912, but went on to win the Wiltshire Senior Cup in the 1912–13 season, beating Trowbridge in the final. The club returned to the Wiltshire League in 1919, and after merging with Harris Football Club in 1920, they became Calne & Harris United.

After World War II Calne did not re-join the Wiltshire League for the 1945–46 season, but returned the following year. They finished bottom of the league again in 1961–62 and after being renamed Calne Town in 1963, they finished last every season from 1963–64 until 1966–67. When the Wiltshire League merged with the Wiltshire Combination to form the Wiltshire County League in 1976, Calne were placed in Division One. The club won the Wiltshire Senior Cup again in 1984–85, beating Swindon Supermarine in the final.

In 1985–86 Calne finished third in Division One, and were accepted into Division One of the Western League. They were Division One runners-up in 1992–93, earning promotion to the Premier Division. The club remained in the Premier Division until the end of the 1998–99 season, when they finished bottom of the table and were relegated back to Division One. The club were Division One runners-up in 2004–05 and were promoted back to the Premier Division.

Although they won the Wiltshire Senior Cup again in 2009–10, the club also finishing bottom of the Premier Division and were relegated back to Division One.

Calne won the Wiltshire Senior Cup for a fourth time in 2011–12, beating Bemerton Heath Harlequins in the final.

in 2012 Simon Gardner took over the reigns as first team manager after a successful period managing the reserves to a league and cup double most players from the reserves followed Gardner up to the first team and finished in a respectable mid table finish 2 seasons on the bounce.

Neurin Jones was appointed first team manager in 2014 and led the club to mid table finishes for 2 successive years. In 2016, Jones left his role as a manger and ex Chippenham Park manager Dave Ferris took over in December, but left the club after finishing 21/22. The club avoided relegation due to being reprieved.

in 2017 Ben Redford & Clive McDaid were appointed as joint managers and finished in 17th in their first season in charge, followed by an 8th placed finished the following year.

McDaid stepped down from the first team and the experienced Trevor Rawlings became joint manager. In the 2019-20 season the side spent most of the season top of the table, but the season was cut short and declared null and void due to the Coronavirus Pandemic in early March with the side sitting 3 points clear.

Calne started this season with Rawlings still at the helm but he resigned in September after an indifferent start to the season. Clive McDaid returned to the management seat as joint manager with Ben Redford.

Last Meeting at GBSG Rylands Way

Wootton Bassett Town 4 Calne Town 2 FA Cup Preliminary Round

Wootton Bassett Town's name will never be engraved on the grand old trophy, but they ensured a place in FA Cup history with a pulsating 4-2 victory against local rivals Calne Town, becoming the first team to record a win in the 132nd edition of the competition.

Admittedly Bassett will have to share the distinction with Ascot United and Thrapston Town, who also triumphed on a balmy summer's evening. However – for a small club – most would forgive the Rylands Way outfit for boasting about such an accolade in future years.

There could be no challenges to the claim that their all-Wiltshire tie was a barnstormer, however. All 248 souls undoubtedly went home happy in the knowledge that they got their money's worth and more.

Drama, controversy, outstanding play. The game had it all as the home side came back from a goal down, benefited from Calne missing a penalty and powered to glory with a strong second half showing.

The game's tone was set from the off. Although signs of nervousness could be detected from both sides, chances were immediately created at both ends of the pitch. Seven minutes in Calne's Dan Lardner beat an onrushing keeper James Domm to the ball but could only place his looping header wide of the post. Seconds later, now at the opposite end of the pitch, an unmarked Steve Yeardeley snatched an effort with his weaker left foot onto the post following Shaun Terry's perfectly floated cross.

With both teams coming agonisingly close in the early stages, goals always appeared

as though they would be forthcoming. And Calne eventually gained the ascendancy in the 19th minute, albeit in contentious circumstances. Rory Sproule capitalised on Bassett's inability to head clear a troublesome cross, rifling a 15 yard thunderbolt onto the crossbar. The ball darted downwards, falling behind the goalline according to the assistant referee, before shooting back up onto the bar. Domm protested animatedly that the whole ball failed to cross the line – in fairness it was the only thing he could do to have any chance of keeping out such a powerful strike. It was to no avail though and his team found themselves behind.

Yet, the visitors' lead lasted all of two minutes, Bassett hitting back in an instant. Finding the back of the net was the veteran Shaun Terry, who clearly demonstrated that while that yard of pace may desert you in your advancing years, those predatory instincts are permanent. Wide man Matt Bown, taking a pass from Craig Bowden, cut in from the left and arrowed a low drive towards the far post. There, having slipped his man and avoided the offside trap, Terry stuck out his leg, diverting the ball past a wrong-footed Jamie Bartlett into the opposite corner. Vintage stuff from the self-anointed 'fox in the box'.

Obviously disappointed to lose their lead, Calne stepped their game up for the remainder of the half, their midfield helping control proceedings as Bassett's front pair of Terry and Barnes became somewhat isolated.

With attention focused primarily on the Bassett half of the pitch, it appeared as though the Lilywhites would snatch a half time advantage, Sproule forcing an uncomfortable save from Domm on 22 minutes.

On the half hour mark they were offered the perfect chance to seize control of the tie

when they were awarded a penalty in seemingly farcical circumstances. Only at half time did the full story emerge to the crowd as it was revealed that Shaun Carter had been punished for needlessly kicking out at an opponent off the ball after the danger had been averted from a corner. The enigmatic Sproule stepped confidently up to the spot, but somehow ballooned his effort into the trees behind Domm's goal; the forward's effort was nowhere close to the target.

Calne continued to apply the pressure though, Lardner striking inches wide with a first time shot before an outstretched Domm was forced to glove Sproule's glancing header behind.

It would be no exaggeration to say that half time came as something of a relief for Bassett. Manager Dave Turner did not rest on his laurels, however, gambling early by replacing Carter – on a yellow card – with youngster Aaron Dainton, who slotted in at full-back, allowing Adam Corcoran to shift inside where he is more comfortable. Despite some early nervy moments, the change seemed to pay off with the pressure on the Bassett goal easing.

With Calne now no longer in control of proceedings, the home side were able to break forward and delivered a warning shot on the hour when Terry's clever through ball set Bown free. The midfielder was prevented from scoring when Bartlett saved at his feet before Barnes saw his follow up shot hooked away from danger thanks to some last ditch defending. Nevertheless a signal had been sent to Calne to tighten up at the back.

Yet they failed to take notice. Sixty three minutes in Barnes broke free only to be wrestled down on the edge of the box. Outnumbering their opposition, the clever-thinking Yeardeley pulled a masterstroke, squaring a quick free kick to Barners, who cut inside his out of position marker and

slotted home at the near post.

Another moment of brilliance from Domm then preserved the lead. Lee Stevens whipped in a cross from the deep, an unmarked Sproule headed powerfully towards goal from six yards, but the 'keeper stooped low, holding onto to make a fine point blank save. The Calne forward had become the tormented tormentor – a thorn in Bassett's side yet, after his penalty miss, condemned not to add a second.

As he rued a golden opportunity gone begging, Bassett provided the game's turning point when an innocuous looking Barnes cross was allowed to drift into the bottom right corner, aided by a helping hand from a crossed-up Bartlett.

Calne went for broke by making a triple substitution. But Bassett's defensive wall limited their chances until the dying stages. They almost halved the deficit with five minutes remaining, but Domm again stooped low to prevent a close range header, this time from Greg Tindle. Alex Rigley finally clawed one back, driving a low twenty-yarder into the bottom corner during injury time.

Seconds later all hopes of forcing a replay were dead though when Yeardeley took an inside pass from Bown, danced past two defenders and tucked the ball away.

History, albeit just a small piece, had been written. The 132nd edition of the FA Cup had begun in style.

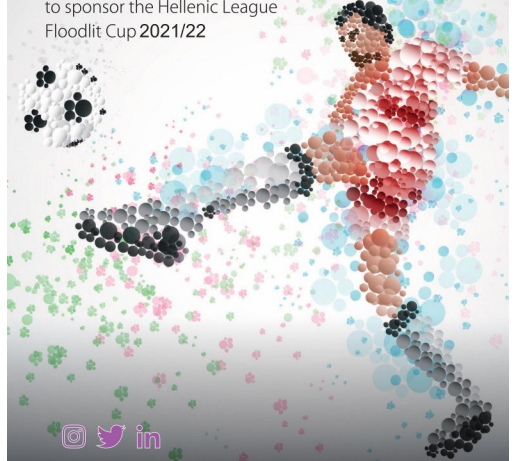

First Team Match Report

Saturday 5th March 2022

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 3

Tuffley Rovers 2

Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier

The game may have ended up being far closer than it should have been, but Royal Wootton Bassett Town made it two wins in a row as they saw off Tuffley Rovers 3-2 in an exciting, albeit nerve-racking Hellenic League Premier Division encounter. Bassett ultimately prevailed thanks to a lightning fast start that yielded two goals in the game's opening three minutes. Sam Collier's side should then have been out of sight by half time. But with Bassett failing to kill the game off, Tuffley came mightily close to rescuing a point after a brave fight back in the second half.

Throughout this season, Bassett have habitually made life difficult for themselves - and this was another of those occasions. But at least it makes for decent entertainment. This was a contest that certainly offered something for the neutral from the first minute through to the last. Sam Packer was first to strike, steering in a delicate side foot volley from John Mills' weighted free kick delivery with just over sixty seconds on the clock.

Mills then quickly made it two. Bassett stole possession straight from the restart and as Mills charged towards goal he was bundled to the ground just outside the area by visiting 'keeper Jack Copland. Copland was lucky only to see yellow, but the visitors were duly punished as Mills dusted himself off before picking out the top right corner with a sublime free kick.

Stunned to find themselves in such a hole so early on, Tuffley were well and truly on the ropes. And they were fortunate not to find themselves even further behind at the interval. However, wasteful finishing and some fine glovework from the fortunate Copland meant Bassett were unable to extend their advantage despite time and again causing problems for the visitors' defence.

On the quarter hour mark Bailey Gallagher cut inside from the left before flashing a form drive just wide of the left post. Minutes later neat interplay between Gallagher and Bennett saw the latter shoot narrowly wide from the edge of the box.

Twenty minutes in, Mills saw a delicate free kick acrobatically tipped over by an outstretched Copland before the forward failed to locate the target, dragging wide from 15 yards after a Bennett cross had bounced off a defender and into his path. A brief lull ensued as Tuffley finally established something of a foothold. But the final five minutes of the half again saw Bassett threaten. On 41 minutes the ball was worked from Bennet through

Mills to an unmarked Gallagher, but the winger's curling effort from 15 yards crashed back off the bar. The rebound eventually dropped for Kai Robinson, who forced a diving stop from Copland. Three minutes later, a Mills cross was cleared only as far as Gallagher on the edge of the area and his shot, squeezed between two defenders, was denied by another Copland save.

That profligacy in front of goal would then almost come back to bite Bassett. Sensing they still had a shot at taking something from the match, Tuffley played with intent from the opening whistle of the second half. And within ten minutes of the restart it was well and truly game on as Liam Smith made it 2-1 with a free kick from the left edge of the box that he struck into the opposite to corner.

Adam Corcoran did quickly restore Bassett's two goal lead, bundling home after Copland could only parry Macaulay Dodson's glancing header from Mills, set piece deliver . However, Tuffley's goal had injected the visitors with added confidence. And, helped by having a forceful wind behind them, they made Bassett sweat for the remainder of the match.

Gifted time and space to bring the ball forward, defender Liam Wright chances his arm from range on the hour mark and only narrowly missed the target with a powerful 30-yarder. Meanwhile, a pair of Smith corners resulted in shots being blocked. Eventually Rovers again reduced their deficit to a single goal. And they did so in style as substitute Yesh Lomotey fizzed a dipping 25 yard thunderbolt into the bottom corner. That goal set up a grandstand final ten minutes.

The pressure the visitors sought to apply did leave them vulnerable at the back though and Bassett had chances to add a fourth. The best opening fell to Alan Griffin, but his shot on the turn was batted away after a well-worked build up involving Bennett and James Johnson - who impressed with his willingness to run at the Tuffley defence in the short cameo he enjoyed.

But Tuffley, committing men forward, were the ones on the front foot as full time neared. And the hosts were forced to hold their breath at least once as Jon Beeden nearly diverted the ball into his own net after a diagonal ball had been headed back into the danger area.

Thankfully though that was the closest Tuffley would come to snatching a late point.

Man of the Match: John Mills - the forward enjoyed a very productive, impressive afternoon as he scored an outstanding free kick and served as the provider for Bassett's other two goals. His contributions were decisive in delivering Bassett the win.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town were unable to stop Westbury United's stunning charge towards a potential promotion place as Bassett were beaten 2-0 away in west Wiltshire.

In a closely fought game with limited chances at either end, Westbury triumphed courtesy of a pair of second half goals, with the hosts seeing out the final ten minutes with ten men.

What was a wide open battle for second spot behind leaders Bishops Cleeve in the Hellenic League Premier Division has, in recent weeks, seen Westbury claim status as clear favourites for that position.

Going into their contest with Bassett, they had lost just once in their previous 22 league fixtures, with just five points dropped from the last available thirty.

They were therefore favourites to win this clash - but Bassett put up a solid fight before two set piece plays determined the game's outcome.

Bassett could claim to have shaded things in the opening period, though Westbury did threaten with a direct style of play that forced the visiting defence to be on their toes.

Despite by no means being a pretty finish, given Westbury's promotion charge it was an important one.

And with twenty minutes left, they doubled their advantage as Ronnie Frost emphatically headed home from a corner.

That goal should have made certain of victory. But late pressure from Bassett as well as a red card for Dan Price for a second bookable offence made for some nervous moments as time wound down.

Substitute James Johnson, who enjoyed another impressive cameo, forced Westbury 'keeper Mark Bowden to be alert before the home shotstopper was forced to steer an Alan Griffin free kick around the post. Alfie Presley then came close, firing narrowly over after cutting in from the left.

Bassett were unable to find a way through though, allowing their Wiltshire rivals to hold on for the win and move within five points of guaranteeing themselves a top two finish with five games left to play.

For Bassett, the result keeps them 13th in the table, a point behind Hereford Lads Club having played the same number of games and five behind Fairford Town with one match in hand.

Sam Collier's side will therefore need a strong haul of points in their final four games of the season and for results elsewhere to go their way if they are to finish higher than their current placing.

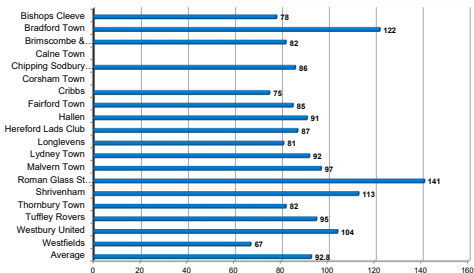

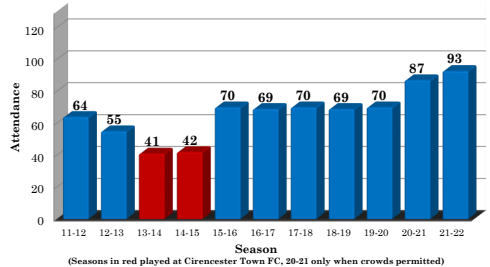

WHEN James Doe created Non-League Day in 2010, not even he could have imagined the beast he had unmasked.

What started off as a suggestion to help acknowledge the plight of Non-League football in the community has now become one of the biggest occasions in the

Non-League calendar, celebrating all aspects of the game outside of the Premier League and EFL.

Year-on-year, the turnstiles continued to click and Non-League Day got bigger and bigger until Covid brought the concept to an abrupt halt in 2020 and 2021.

Now, however, it's back for the first time in three years and Doe believes this year's event has the potential to be the best yet.

"I think it has the potential to be the biggest one yet," Doe said of the event, which takes place on Saturday March 26 this year. "We've had a couple of years off and the world of football has changed quite a bit.

"I think there's still a bit of reaction to the whole European Super League filtering down, I think a lot of people discovered Non-League during the pandemic because they were locked out of their big clubs. As we've seen, there are big crowds at lots of games this season that you wouldn't necessarily normally get.

"It feels extra special this year because of the gap. We've had a couple of false dawns where we thought we would go with it and then things flared up and new variants appeared.

Doe, a QPR fan, came up with the idea when watching his local side Harrow Borough.

And its legacy has already contributed to huge rises in attendances up and down the country

which was strangely enhanced by Covid and the government restrictions which went with it.

In the past, clubs have embraced Non-League Day with quirky events and traditions to get supporters through the gates. Bungay Town handed out mushrooms on the door and even paid each supporter 5p one year in order to hit the headlines.

At Great Yarmouth Town, you got a free fish sandwich and Grantham Town dished out gingerbread men, courtesy of the chairman.

Once again this year, Prostate Cancer UK are supporting the event – as they have done since 2014.

They are urging fans to be aware of their risk of the most common cancer in men by taking a 30-second test on their website, while Doe is promoting awareness by pulling on a PCUK jersey for his annual Non-League Day ground hop.

A match map, detailing which games are on, is now live on the Non-League Day website, and Premier League clubs have also got involved, promoting local games in their jurisdiction.

"It's always been a celebration, it's not a protest," Doe said. "We're trying to bring every element of the football community together. That's the idea and I think it largely has done.

"It will be good to get as many people involved as possible and be as positive as we can. It's supposed to be a bit of fun.

"I've been chatting to the guys at Harrow recently and they've got someone who has become an outreach officer. They did their first big promotion against Taunton where they invited loads of school kids and they pretty much all turned up.

"It doubled the crowd, from an incredibly diverse background with people who would have never stepped foot in a football ground before that and it could be really transformative.

"We'd love as many clubs as possible to get involved."


