Welcome

Good afternoon and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Fairford Town. It is a warm welcome to manager Jody Bevan, his players and coaches and the Fairford supporters who have made the short journey across the border from Gloucestershire. We trust you will enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you all a safe journey home.

It is a special warm welcome back to former players Ben Mitchell, Dan Bailey and Mason Thompson who have all worn the blue and yellow in previous seasons.

Today will see us looking to complete a league double in this local derby having won 2-0 at Fairford back at the end of October. We won that day thanks to goals from Matt Bennett and Gio Wrona, this after Fairford had seen a player dismissed in controversial circumstances. We come into the game today on the back of a three game unbeaten run (four if you count the Shrivenham abandoned game) and hopefully we can continue that good form here this afternoon.

The win over Malvern Town in our last home game was one of our performances of the season, particularly from a defensive perspective. They were a very good side and we did not buckle under some sustained pressure, which might not have happened earlier in the season. We followed that up with our biggest league win of the season, a 5-0 away success over Thornbury United, our second win there this season. Last week's game at Hallen was the proverbial game of two halves, as we led 2-0 at the break but then conceded twice in the second half against the bottom side, who are a lot better than their league position would suggest. No doubt Sam will have been pleased to maintain unbeaten run ahead of today's game even though it could have been better if we had come away with all three points.

Development Side

The Development Side had a good 3-0 home win last week against Calne Town Reserves ahead of today's potential title showdown with Pewsey Vale. Calne certainly lost their discipline last week, picking up 9 disciplinary offences, and our lads took full advantage of the numerical advantage when the visitors went temporarily down to 9 men when they had a sin bin offence on top of the sending off, scoring twice in that period. Ironically there was only really one bad tackle in the game and that did not see a card being issued!

Veterans' Over 35s Side

The Veterans' side continues to head their division but can be overtaken by Priory Vale and Redhouse who have games in hand. There are still a couple of games between the various top sides to play so our Vets remain very much in the mix in the title race. Before that though they have the final of the Wiltshire Veterans' County Cup against Bradford Town on Friday 11th March to look forward to.

Ladies Side

The Ladies have had a tough run of away games which conclude tomorrow at Middlezoy, their 6th away game in a row. The run of away games has included long trips to St Austell, Bideford and Torquay and the Ladies have lost four of those five games played so far. Hopefully the trip to Middlezoy will see them return to winning ways.

Under 18 Side

Congratulations to Nick Warren and his players on securing runners-up spot in the Wiltshire Senior League U18 Division. They went close but in the end were pipped by a very good Devizes Town side. There is more detail on the climax of the U18 Division on the next page.

Enjoy the game this afternoon and hopefully three points for the Bassett.

Under 18s clinch runners-up in Wiltshire League Floodlit Division



Congratulations to Royal Wootton Bassett Town Under 18s who clinched runners-up spot in the Wiltshire League Floodlit Division! Bassett secured second place with a come-from-behind victory against Pewsey Vale in their final league game of the season at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground

Needing a win to make certain that they could not be caught by third place Melksham Town, Bassett endured a nervy opening 45 minutes. While the first half ended goalless, the tension was ratcheted up early in the second period when visitors Pewsey - who had held Nick Warren's side to a 3-3 draw when they met earlier in the season - took the lead, Thomas Holdstock firing in after good build up play down the left.

But Bassett produced the required response. Joey Warren hit a shot into the bottom corner of the net from the edge of the box to equalise. Warren then created what turned out to be the winning goal, his powerful run through midfield initiating a move that eventually saw the ball fall to Kevin Prouse on the edge of the six-yard box and the side's leading scorer steered home for his ninth of the season. The result ensured Bassett did not finish an excellent season empty-handed.

With their 2-0 victory against Radstock Town on Thursday, Devizes Town claimed top spot. And the title ultimately came down to Devizes' 4-0 triumph against Bassett at the end of January - a result that left Bassett needing to win out at the same time as hoping their rivals slipped up elsewhere if they were to finish in first.

Last week's narrow 2-1 defeat away against Calne Town in their penultimate fixture then as good as extinguished those hopes - and also endangered Bassett's chances of finishing second.

Victory against Pewsey was therefore required to ensure Melksham were unable to have the opportunity to pip them as the best of the rest. With the pressure on though, Bassett delivered.

In achieving runners-up spot, the team become the fifth Bassett side to claim Floodlit League honours. Alongside the 2010-11 champions, Bassett previously finished as runners-up in 2005-06, 2011-12 and 2015-16. Congratulations, again, to the team on an excellent season and outstanding achievement.

Experienced midfield player with an eye for goal who has now played over 200 times for Fairford. Joined Royal Wootton Bassett Town when Paul Braithwaite left Fairford to join Bassett in the summer of 2014. Remained at Royal Wootton Bassett Town after Braithwaite left and Rich Hunter took over, spending three and a bit seasons at Bassett making a total of 142 appearances in the blue and yellow scoring 33 goals.

Experienced goalkeeper who was another player who joined Royal Wootton Bassett Town when Paul Braithwaite left Fairford to join Bassett in the summer of 2014. Made 29 appearances for Bassett in Season 2014-15 when he was the regular No. 1 in Paul Braithwaite's side. Returned to Fairford during the 2015-16 season and was a regular during Fairford's Division One West title winning 2016-17 campaign. Previously also played for both Cricklade Town and Highworth Town.





A graduate of the Cirencester Academy, the winger's previous experience includes time with the University of Fraser Valley Cascades (Canada), Wantage Town, Cirencester Town and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. Mason made three starting appearances and four substitute appearances for Bassett in Season 2017-18.

Opponents History

Fairford Town Football Club is a football club based in Fairford, Gloucestershire, England. Affiliated to the Gloucestershire County Football Association, they are currently members of the Hellenic League Premier Division and play at Cinder Lane.

The club was established in 1891 and prior to World War II they played in the Cirencester and District League. After the war they switched to the Swindon & District League, going on to win the Premier Division title and Advertiser Cup double in both 1964-65 and 1968-69. In 1970 the club moved up to Division One of the Hellenic League. In their first season in the league, the club finished third, missing out on promotion on goal average, also losing in the Division One Cup final. The following season they were placed in Division One A as league expansion led to there being two Division Ones. The club went on to win the title and the Division One Challenge Shield, earning promotion to the Premier Division

At the end of the 1973–74 season Fairford were relegated to Division One. However, after finishing as Division One runners-up in 1975–76, they were promoted back to

the Premier Division. They finished as runners-up in 1978-79, also winning the Premier Division Cup. They were runnersup again the following season, which also win the Gloucestershire saw them Challenge Trophy. The club finished as Premier Division runners-up for a third 1990 - 91and in won Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy again in 1998-99. They remained in the Premier Division until finishing second-frombottom of the division in 2011-12 season. after which they were relegated to Division One West. In 2016-17 the club won Division One West, earning promotion back to the Premier Division.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town ended their winless run in the Hellenic League Premier Division with a well deserved 2-0 victory away against local rivals Fairford Town. Taking full advantage of the extra man they had following Danny Gudger's controversial red card five minutes before the break, secodn half goals from Gio Wrona and Matt Bennett proved enough to allow Sam Collier's side to register three points for the first time since September 4.

Fairford will argue - somewhat justifiably that the outcome hinged heavily on referee Havdn Lavender's decision to show Gudger red for what seemed to all to be an innocuous challenge. But Bassett will care little about their opponents' claimants. During their nine game winless streak, Bassett have frequently found themselves out of luck. This time though fortune was on their side. Up until Gudger's dismissal, the opening period had been a nondescript affair. In a game pitting underachieving sides against another, it was perhaps little surprise that play was cagey. While it was certainly a derby that both sides wanted to win, given their positions in the table it was also a contest that neither was interested in losing.

Action in front of goal was consequently limited. Indeed, the closest either team came to threatening to score was when Ross Langworthy headed narrowly over from Ian Herring's teasing free kick. The red card finally sparked things into life. It did seem rather harsh. Gudger misjudged the flight of the ball and, when adjusting to try and knock it past Wrona with a backheel, he caught the Bassett midfielder on the shin. Lavender saw malice in his actions though and sent Gudger off

Even though the score was still deadlocked, that decision meant it was advantage Bassett. And Collier's side proceeded to produce a professional second half performance in which they dominated

possession and, importantly, found the net twice. After producing a few shots that failed to find the target, the visitors eventually found their range. Bailey Gallagher threaded a pass into the left channel for John Mills who cut a pass back to Wrona on the edge of the area and he squeezed a side foot shot past Sam Ayres with the help of a slight deflection

After taking the lead, Bassett upped their control of the game. They felt they should have been awarded a penalty when Gallagher was upended on the left edge of the box, though Lavender proceeded to award a free kick, judging the offence not to have taken place inside. But a second soon arrived. Patient build up play saw the ball worked from the right side out to Mills on the left. The experienced forward then produced a feint that had Ant Brown fooled before weighting a delicate cross into the area, which Bennett headed past a wrong-footed Avres into the bottom left corner.

There was an opening for George Peare at the other end which he blazed over. But being a man down, Fairford produced little else. And if any side was going to add to the score further, it was to be Bassett. Bennett had three bites at the cherry. However he first sliced wide after a Tommy Ouldridge effort was deflected into his path before forcing a fine diving save from Ayres with a left foot curler. The Development side's leading scorer then raced onto a long ball over the top from 'keeper Eddie Cavanagh only to see Ayres snatch the ball at his feet when trying to round the Fairford shotstopper.

The best opportunity to extend Bassett's lead further fell to Mills. But he blazed over from the spot after Matty Shaun, believing he had been fouled by Scott Chilcott, fell on the ball and handled in the area.

While somewhat disappointing not to have added a third, an extra goal would have served only to add a little additional gloss to what for Bassett was a fine afternoon. A league win has been a long time coming. Here's hoping this derby triumph can serve as the start of a decent run that can help Bassett climb back into the top half.







Earlier in the season, we spoke to Terry Buss at Hanworth Villa as the one-club man celebrated 800 official appearances for the Step 5 outfit – although he wondered if it was even more than that.

The 35-year-old keeper made his debut when he was 16 – illustrating just how long it takes to rack up these numbers – and he was eyeing 1,000.

"I'll go as long as my body lets me, it's starting to ache now!" he told The NLP. "Now that the 800 is up, the magic 1,000 is in sight. It would be another three or four years without missing a game but I've not missed many over the last 19 years so, fingers crossed, I can have a good go.

"My son, Jimmy, is 12, I'm hoping when he gets to 16 he's good enough to come in and take over from me!"



First Team Match Report

Saturday 22nd January 2022 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Malvern Town 1

Royal Wootton Bassett Town recorded arguably their most impressive league win of the season as Sam Collier's side defeated promotion chasing Malvern Town 2-1. A far cry from the 5-2 reverse suffered at the hands of the Hillsiders in the teams' October meeting in Worcestershire, Bassett defended resolutely throughout against the Hellenic League Premier Division's leading scorers. That meant Chris Taylor's early penalty and Sam Packer's second half poacher's finish ultimately proved enough for Bassett to claim all three points.

Given Malvern's potent attack and with the visitors seeking to bring to an end a run of indifferent form that had seen them win just once in the previous six, Bassett knew that they would have to be at their best to take anything from the game. And Collier's troops duly delivered. The defence, unsurprisingly, was tested early and often. But they stood firm to frustrate Malvern. Meanwhile, in attack Bassett made the most of the opportunities they were able to create. Indeed, Bassett unsettled their opponents early, taking the lead after just seven minutes. Sam Morris was tripped as he broke into the box, and his central midfield partner Taylor coolly sent 'keeper Keiron Blackburn the wrong way from the spot.

After the teams exchanged chances, with Packer skewing wide for Bassett and Ben Hayes blazing over for Malvern, the visitors began to seize the upper hand. Controlling play, they sought to grind Bassett down in search of an equaliser. Try as they might though, Malvern's pressure appeared as though it was going to be in vain as half time neared. Their best chance fell to Dave Reynolds who squeezed a free kick narrowly wide of the post while Matt Turner had a shot from inside the area deflected over.

However, with less than three minutes to go until the interval, Malvern finally equalised. It was a rather cheap goal for Bassett to concede too. After a Lewis Platt header bounced off the bar, Cavanagh appeared to be in a good position to punch away the danger. But the 'keeper went for finesse over power in his attempt to clear and the ball dropped for Turner who stabbed in with a simple, giftwrapped finish.

Arriving on the verge of the half time, the equalising goal must have given Bassett a sense of déjà vu as last week's visit to Westfields — Malvern's fellow rivals for promotion — had seen Bassett go ahead early only to concede not long before the break. In that contest, Bassett were second best after the restart, going on to lose 3-1. There was to be no repeat this time though.

Malvern continued to threaten. Shortly after play resumed a Reynolds free kick deflected off the Bassett wall, with this redirecting the ball in the opposite direction and narrowly wide of the upright. The visitors then believed they should have had a penalty as Joe Bates went to ground as he sought to make a run to meet the resulting corner. Kyonn Evans also had a chance but was unable to shoot on target as the hosts remained resolute at the back.

Bassett then struck what proved to be the decisive blow on the hour mark. The tricky Packer drew a foul in the right corner and from the resulting free kick, which was fizzed across the face of the six-yard box by John Mills, he stole in at the far post, ghosting past his marker to guide home a fine first time finish. Behind again, Malvern failed to muster a response. Adam Sauntson saw two opportunities go begging, while, sandwiched between those, Evans had the ball in the net only for an offside flag to chalk it off.

After Reynolds failed to locate the target with ten minutes remaining, Bassett broke up the other end and almost sealed the match, only for Blackburn to deny substitute Alfie Presley. Still in the match thanks to that save, Malvern continued to exert pressure on Bassett. And with time winding down, they earned a free kick in a dangerous position, but Cavanagh produced an excellent save of his own to tip over from Joe Bullock's free kick and help preserve a fine victory.

First Team Match Report

Saturday 29th January 2022 Thornbury Town 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 5

A dominant second half display helped Royal Wootton Bassett Town to their biggest league victory of the season as Sam Collier's side thumped Thornbury Town 5-0.

Overcoming the elements on a wet and windy afternoon, as well as opponents who had won three in a row in the league, Bassett climbed a place to 13th in the Hellenic League Premier Division and - most importantly kept pace with Hereford Lads Club and Fairford Town, the two sides immediately above, who Bassett can overtake if they win the games in hand they hold over both.

Bassett started on the front foot against Thornbury and were rewarded with an early lead as Sam Packer mopped up the rebound after a flowing move involving Chris Taylor, Bailey Gallagher and John Mills had seen the latter's shot parried by McKenzie Welsh. The early pressure continued, with Tommy Ouldridge coming close to adding a second as he shot narrowly over.

Thornbury gradually grew into the contest though and the final twenty minutes of the opening period proved to be an even, albeit scrappy affair. During that time, the hosts had the best opportunity in front of goal as Marcus Wormwell struck narrowly over after a driving run. Come half time, it was still therefore anyone's game, with Bassett holding on to the slenderest of the advantages.

However, that state of affairs didn't last long after the restart as Bassett proceeded to dominate the second period. A hint of things to come, Ouldridge was unfortunate not to double his side's lead shortly after the restart as he was denied by a fingertip Welsh save. But the home 'keeper was helpless to deny Gallagher moments later as the winger cut inside, beat two defenders and fired home from the edge of the area.

That left Thornbury with a bigger hole to dig

themselves out of - and the home side's task was made even harder when Jack Sheppard-Cozens picked up a second yellow card, forcing the hosts to play the final half hour shorthanded. Bassett quickly took full advantage of the extra man as Mills whipped in a brilliant free kick that evaded all except Packer, who volleyed home at the far post for his second of the afternoon. The favour was then returned as Packer threaded a ball through to Mills, who coolly finished beyond Welsh to make it four.

By this stage, Bassett were all over Thornbury and it was a question as to how many goals Collier's side would rack up. Packer almost had a hat trick, but another Mills free kick was just out of reach as he attempted a diving header, while Mills sent another set piece narrowly over.

The inevitable fifth eventually arrived with ten minutes remaining. Man of the match Taylor - whose non-stop performance in the heart of midfield had set the tone throughout the match - wrestled away possession in the centre circle and split the defence with a perfectly placed pass that substitute Alfie Presley, making an arcing run, raced onto before beating defender Joe Guest and slotting into the bottom corner.

Thornbury should probably have had the opportunity to claim a late, undeserved consolation but, adding insult to injury, referee Andrew Bower decided against penalising Macauley Dodson for a late lunge in the box.

Bassett could even have added further to their margin of victory, but for the third time during the match Ouldridge narrowly missed out on adding his name to the scoresheet as he lifted a shot inches over after latching onto a delicate Mills pass.

Having made a flying start to February, the task now is to carry the momentum from this contest into the three remaining contests - all winnable on paper - that Bassett face this month. Achieve that, and come March and April Bassett could even find themselves in with a chance of sneaking into the top half come the season's end
