Welcome To Today's Game

Good afternoon (just) and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this final UHlsport Hellenic League fixture against Corsham Town, the first time I believe we have ever played a first team league game on Easter Sunday. In the old days Easter Sunday used to be a protected date when games could not be played but times have moved on and we welcome you all to this Bank Holiday fixture.

A particular warm welcome to our visitors and friends from Corsham Town who are with us today having made the short journey across the county. It will be good to hopefully catch up with the likes of John Cuthbertson (one of the best non-league football photographers in the area and the author of Corsham Town's fantastic club history books), Jacob Price (one of the best club media officers at this level), Chris Perry (the sponsor of the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League that our Development Team play in) and John Gingell (the Chairman of that league).

This game was always likely to attract a sizeable crowd and the fact it is being played over a Bank Holiday weekend and as part of the Hellenic League Ground Hop we are almost certainly guaranteed our largest league attendance of the season, although I suspect the attendance we had for the Torpoint game in the FA Vase will remain our biggest crowd of the season.

Corsham have had a fantastic first season results wise in the UHlsport Hellenic League and, at the time of writing these notes, sit in sixth spot with a chance of achieving fifth place depending on today's result and how Bradford Town got on in their final game against Westbury United on Friday. With the Bank Holiday and this game coming so soon after Friday unfortunately for once the statistics and league tables will not be up to date across all of the leagues we play in. As is usual the first programme of next season will have all the final information in it.

Ground Hop

Today sees us involved in a Ground Hop event for the first time since Season 2004-05 when we attracted a gate of 268 for a league game against Pewsey Vale over the August Bank Holiday weekend. That game ended all square at 1-1. The club would like to extend a warm welcome to all our visiting ground hoppers and trust that you have been entertained in the early games in the "Hellenic Hop" over this weekend. We hope you enjoy your short stay with us here today and we

wish you a safe journey as you continue with the other games over the weekend. Just to clarify one thing though, regarding the advertising material put out for the weekend's Hop, the Hellenic Division Two's are not at Step 7 (National Feeder League Level).

Development Team

Once again with the programme having to go to the printers a day earlier than would normally be the case, and with this being a Sunday fixture, it is not possible to report in the programme on the latest position with the Development Team. By the time you read these notes the Development Team may well have won their game in midweek against Stratton Juniors and also their tough looking fixture against Trowbridge Town yesterday and still be on course to win the title of the Step 7 league in which they play.

Veteran's Team

Royal Wootton Bassett Town will be hosting the fourth edition of its Veterans Super Sunday event at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on Sunday 1 May, with two fixtures scheduled against the RAF FA Veterans. Moving back to its usual May slot having been held in August last year, the event will again be raising money for the Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund and will feature games involving Bassett's and the RAF's Over 35s and Over 50s Veterans sides. The Over 50s will square off first on Super Sunday, with kick off for their Brian Johnson Memorial Shield match being 11.30am. That will be followed by the Over 35s fixture at 2pm. Food and drink will then follow in the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground clubhouse.

#HerGameToo

Today's fixture has been designated a #HerGameToo fixture. HerGameToo, are a group of female supporters who are passionate about football and working to eradicate sexism in the football industry. They want women and girls of all ages to feel confident and safe sharing their opinion about football both online and in real life without fear of sexist abuse. There is more detail on the organisation elsewhere in today's programme. Congratulations to Holly Drinkwater and Alisa Allan of Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Under 10 Girls team for winning the club's anti-discrimination banner competition and they were given their prizes at Friday's game. These posters will be printed and displayed on a promotional board around the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground stadium pitch.

Club Volunteers In Focus

Whilst former chairman Paul Harrison has a suite named after him for all his efforts for both the Football Club and the Sports Association, if there was another room to name in the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground clubhouse, there would only be candidate to receive such an honour. That person would be Pete Yeardley who has done just about every role for both organisations over the years. Pete's long involvement with the Football Club began at the start of the new Millennium when he was joint-Reserve Team manager. Focussing on promoting youth and working alongside Paul Burke, Pete and Paul's young side won the Hellenic League Reserve Division Two championship in 2000-01, their 2nd season in charge. Most impressively, the team went the whole league campaign unbeaten as they won 16 of their 22 games and drew the other six to finish 11 points clear at the top.

When First Team Manager Barry Giles stepped down at the end of the same season, there was only really one name in the frame for the First Team role and Pete took on the position ahead of Bassett starting only their second ever season in the Hellenic League Premier Division. Paul Burke remained with the Reserve Team whilst Pete made the shrewd move of bringing in probably the best coach in the county in Mick Byrne to be his First Team assistant. Not only was Mick an outstanding coach, but his RAF connections also meant we were able to tap into the service personnel player pool from the likes of RAF Lyneham and RAF Brize Norton and some real quality players were brought into the club during Pete and Mick's tenure. The team also had probably the highest levels of fitness ever seen at the club at any time in its history.

The Hellenic Premier Division was arguably a much stronger affair in those days with a number of clubs who are now at Step 4, and in some cases higher, playing in the league, such as Brackley Town, Didcot Town, Highworth Town, North Leigh and Yate Town, and Pete and Mick did a good job keeping Bassett in the division for three seasons. A 15th place finish in 2002-03 was the best finish achieved, before Pete and Mick ultimately stepped down part way through the 2004-05 campaign with Chris Jones taking over to finish the season which

would eventually see Bassett relegated to Division One West.

Despite stepping down from management, Pete remained actively involved in the running of the club. 2008-09 saw Pete take on the then newly established Head of Youth Section role, a position he would hold for nine seasons, overseeing a rapid expansion of the Youth Section during that period. In 2012 he was then appointed a Life Member of the club. 2017-18 saw him switch to being Head of the Senior Section. Having managed both the First and Reserve teams, there was again no-one better placed to take on this important role, and he and Chairman Andy Walduck appointed Sam Collier as manager during Pete's first season in this position after Richard Hunter's departure. The start of the 2019-20 season saw Pete take over as Vice Chairman of the club, a role he continues to hold to this day, with his son Steve in charge of the Development team and eldest grandson Ryan also playing for the Under 8s.

As well as the official positions held, some of the key initiatives over the years have been driven by Pete. Having long worked as a coach alongside Chris Kirkland, Pete was the main driver for the Football Club taking over the running of Community Soccer, which fed our youth sides. He also persuaded Chris to allow the club to take over the five-a-side tournaments that Chris ran at Ballards Ash, which evolved into our own successful six-a-side tournament and - the best initiative of the lot - to bring the fabulous Holland Tours into the club, taking over from what Chris had started through the school.

In addition to all of the official roles and initiatives, Pete has been one of the most important members of the Royal Wootton Bassett Sports Association throughout his time with the Football Club. And it is again hard to think of a role or job that Pete has not done during this period for the Association.

Pete is one of a number of key volunteers gracing our club. However, if the title of Mr Royal Wootton Bassett Town Volunteer was to be bestowed on anyone it would almost certainly be Pete.

Opponents History

The earliest record found of Corsham Football Club is 1878 with the club becoming affiliated to the Football Association in 1893. Over the years, the team has often been referred to as the Quarrymen due to the high level of quarrying in and around Corsham.

In March 1894, the first Wiltshire Football League was formed with the original member clubs being Bradford, Calne, Chippenham, Corsham, Southbroom (Devizes), Melksham, Trowbridge Town, and W a r m i n s t e r . At the end of the 1894/95 season Corsham would be the inaugural champions, winning the league on goal average over Southbroom, helped by an emphatic 17 - 1 win over Calne in their final game.

Promotion was achieved to the Western League at the end of the 1997/98 season after winning the county league by goal difference from Devizes Town Reserves.

Ground improvements continued under the chairmanship of Colin Hudd, floodlights were installed in 2001, a 112 spectator stand erected and hard standing laid around the pitch perimeter.

2006/07 season saw Corsham Town winning the Western League Premier

Division, which was hotly contested by many teams, including Bridgwater Town and Frome Town. The club also added a third successive Wiltshire Senior Cup victory, again over local rivals Melksham Town.

Due to the Covid pandemic the 2019/20 season was declared null and void by the Football Association on 26th March 2020.

Justin Flowers and his backroom staff parted with the club at the end of the null and void 2019/20 season and moved across to Malmesbury Victoria.

The 2020/21 season saw Keiran Baggs becoming the new manager with Gary Higdon as his assistant. Unfortunately, after 10 league games the 2020/21 was curtailed by the FA due to the Covid pandemic.

Despite the last two seasons being affected by Covid, the FA went ahead with planned restructuring of the Non-League Pyramid. The results from 2019/20 & 2021/21 were combined and this meant that Corsham Town finished in a position for upward movement.

The club took this upward movement to Step 5 with a lateral movement in the Hellenic League Premier Division.

After the break Corsham once again had the better of the opening session, Fuller making several good saves in the Bassett goal. Ten minutes from time Wootton Bassett snatched the winner when a long throw was flicked on for Simon Green to score with a looping header over the Corsham keeper.

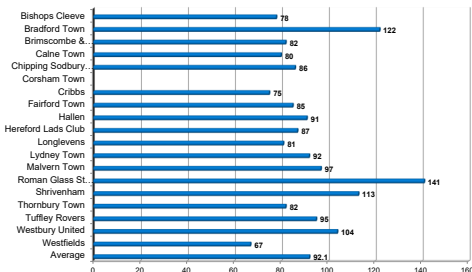

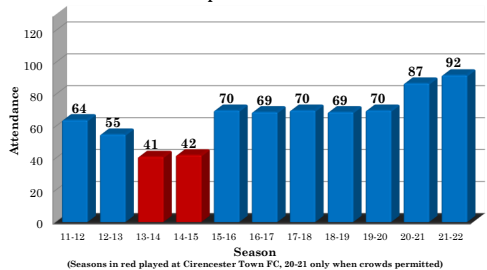

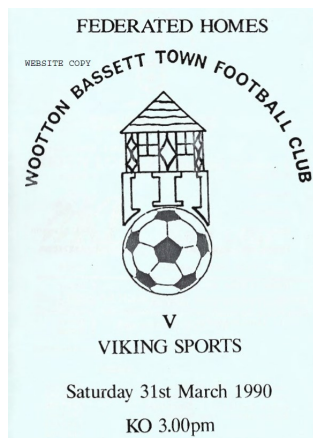

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development secured a dramatic late victory against Frome Collegians to head back to the top of the Wiltshire League table. Bassett now lead Pewsey Vale by two points and can go five clear with just three games to go with victory against Stratton Juniors on Wednesday. But Bassett will be relieved to be in such a position after a tough test against Frome, who Steve Yeardley's side had defeated back in September following an impressive second half showing that saw them emerge 5-0 winners.

It was a much closer affair in the return match at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. Whilst the home side had much of the possession in the first half, they found an organised Frome side very difficult to break down. Nick Mason's powerful shot from just outside the box was superbly turned onto the upright of the goal by Frome 'keeper Ben Forrester but, unfortunately for him, the ball rebounded to Dale Richards who bundled home for his 31st of the season to make it 2-0 at the break.

The home side thought they had extended the lead ten minutes into the second half when Jon Beeden headed powerfully into the net but a flag from the assistant referee saw the goal disallowed. Shortly after Dale Richards went close to getting his second of the match with his

powerful shot coming back off a post and the danger was cleared by the Frome defence.

Frome got themselves back into the game just after the hour mark, Barry Sandquest getting his head to a cross from the right, but the home 'keeper Simon Notman should have done better with the header, seeing the ball agonisingly go through his legs and into the net for 2-1. The goal lifted Frome who started to have more of the possession. But it was Bassett who went close to restoring their two goal lead, Matt Bennett seeing his powerful shot come back off the crossbar.

Frome continued to probe away and were rewarded with a second when another error from Notman saw Max Biddescombe level matters up twenty minutes from time. Frome were now in the ascendancy and captain Sandquest went close to giving them the lead for the first time in the match when his free kick from outside the box went inches wide of the near post. However, there was to be late drama at the other end. With the game deep into injury time, some great skill down the right-hand side by Matt Bennett saw him put a tantalising cross into the box that was met on the volley by Jon Beeden and his effort flew into the net for 3-2. There was still time for another great chance for Bassett to make it 4-2 when a ball over the top found Bennett clear of the defence but his fierce shot was well turned away by Forrester in the Frome goal to leave the final score 3-2.

Bassett had been pushed all the way by an organised Frome side who on another day could easily have left with a point. But now they have the chance to put some breathing room between themselves and Pewsey as a thrilling title race approaches its climax.


