Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Tonight's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Tuffley Rovers. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Gloucester, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening and we wish you a safe journey home.

Tuffley currently sit 19th in the table having won just three of their opening 16 league games. The three wins have come against Lydney Town, Thornbury Town and Wantage Town, with two of those wins coming on the road.

Our record against Tuffley has improved in recent seasons, the lats time we lost to them in the league was back in December 2017. The last time we lost to them at home was way back in 2005. However, overall Tuffley still have the better record in matches between the two sides with 11 wins to our nine, with nine games ending in a draw. Hopefully we will continue our good recent record against Tuffley here tonight.

Tonight we will be looking to bounce back from our narrow defeat at Hereford Lads Club on Saturday, when we went down to a goal two minutes from time. So many of this season's games have seen late goals, and whilst a number have gone our way, Saturday was not one of them. A brief match report from the game is included in tonight's programme. Hopefully we will have more luck here tonight as a win will see us climb one place in the table to seventh spot.

Tonight's game is having to be played on a Wednesday night due to the World Cup and hopefully by the time you read these notes England will have progressed to the Round of 16 as winners of the group. If England have ended up as runners-up it means there will be a big impact on our FA Vase fixture this coming Saturday. The FA Vase game is scheduled to kick-off at 3PM, the same time as the World Cup game that will involve the runner-up in England's group. Attempts were

made to switch the game to the Friday night to avoid any clash but it would have meant moving tonight's game (which I still do not understand why it was inserted in FA Vase week in the first place). We sought to move tonight's match but were thwarted in our efforts. No doubt if we win on Saturday comments about flying the flag for the Hellenic in the last 32 of the national competition will be all over social media. As a QPR fan I know a song about flags which would be appropriate in these circumstances.

The Development Team bounced back from last week's defeat with a comfortable 5-1 home win over Ludgershall Sports in the Fountain Trophies Cup on Saturday. A brief summary of the game is included in tonight's programme. They will be home again in the next round with Melksham Town Reserves scheduled to visit the Sustain Stadium next month. The impact of the Hellenic League fixture scheduling and the multiple home cup draws for the First Team means that 11 of the Development Team's remaining 15 fixtures (possibly more if they progress further in the cup) will be at home!

The Women's side were winners against Purton in their last game in the Wiltshire County Cup and managed to avoid Swindon Town in the semi-final draw and will be home to Durrington with the game scheduled for 15th January. They now need to start turning their cup form into league points as they seek to climb away from the bottom of the table.

Last week saw the Under 18 side produce a much improved second half performance to beat AFC Aldermaston 4-2. Hopefully by the time you read these notes they will have continued their unbeaten start to the season and progressed to the Second Round of the League Cup.

Enjoy tonight's game and hopefully we will be celebrating a win against our Gloucestershire rivals from Tuffley.

ISUZU FA VASE THIRD ROUND: BASSETT TO HOST CORSHAM IN WILTSHIRE DERBY

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have been handed a mouth-watering home derby fixture against Wiltshire and Hellenic League Premier Division rivals Corsham Town in the Isuzu FA Vase third round

The tie is currently scheduled to take place at the Sustain Stadium next Saturday 3 December.

On top of being a derby encounter, there will be extra spice added to the match given that both teams will be aiming to write club history, with neither Bassett nor Corsham having ever advanced beyond the Vase third round before.

Indeed, for both clubs this season is only the second occasion in which they have reached this stage.

For Bassett, it will be a welcome first home fixture in the competition after wins on the road against Bridport (5-3) and then Wellington (2-2, 5-4 on penalties).

While Sam Collier's side enjoyed an exemption to the first round, Corsham have already faced four fixtures in the Vase this season, recording three wins away from home during their impressive run.

After a 3-1 home triumph against Cove in the first qualifying round, the Quarrymen triumphed 6-5 on penalties following a 2-2 second qualifying round draw away at Brislington. They then saw off a second Western League side, thumping Keynsham Town 4-0 in the first round. On Saturday, Kieran Baggs' men were 3-1 winners in their second round fixture against fellow Hellenic Premier outfit Roman Glass St George.

Corsham last made it to the third round in 2006-07, recording wins against Harefield United and Amesbury Town before a loss away at Bideford. Since losing in the first round in 2007-08 and prior to this season, Corsham fell into a Vase rut, going beyond the qualifying round stages just twice (where they were eliminated in the first round) in 14 Vase participations.

Corsham have more than made up for that recent dearth of Vase success this season though with a record-equalling run – and they'll

no doubt be aiming to extend it further when they make the short trip to Bassett.

Like their visitors to be, Bassett have only found themselves in the third round once before too – that coming last season when the team were beaten 3-1 at home by Hamworthy United.

With club history again on the line, Collier and his side will be hoping to avoid a similar fate this time. Meanwhile, Bassett will be hoping to reverse a recent run that has seen Corsham win all three league meetings played between the teams since the Quarrymen joined the Hellenic League last season.

A win for Bassett will be their first against Corsham since a 2-1 triumph in the 2008-09 Wiltshire Senior Cup.

It promises to be a cracking tie – we look forward to hosting Corsham and hope to see a good crowd at the Sustain Stadium.

The Gaffer on



Fairford Town manager Jamie Reid lamented his team's attitude as his side fell to a heavy 4-1 defeat to Thornbury Town in the Hellenic Premier Division on Tuesday night, writes George Nash.

Reid's side were convincingly beaten in Gloucestershire on a miserable evening where the Fairford boss brought into question the application of his players.

"The lads on Tuesday just didn't turn up at all," said Reid.

"It was cold, it was wet, there was no atmosphere and I just didn't feel like any of them wanted to be there.

"When you go into games like that, you need to match their desire and their effort. It's the old clichés of earning the right to play and we just didn't do that at all.

"There was zero effort and zero quality from my players and we got what we deserved."

The loss brings an end to a good recent run of results for Reid's men, after an impressive 3-0 win over Bradford Town was backed up with a 2-2 stalemate against local rivals Royal Wootton Bassett Town last Friday.

Reid's side put themselves in a commanding position at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground as Danny Gudger and Robbie James put them two goals to the good at the break.

But Bassett, who have made a habit of coming from behind in recent weeks, fought back with a brace from substitute Matt Bennett earning Sam Collier's men a share of the spoils.

And Reid was quick to offer an honest assessment of the game, admitting that a draw was an accurate reflection of the contest.

"I thought we were quite lucky to get the two goals but it was great to go into half-time 2-0 up. "In fairness I felt they did deserve to get something out of the game. If we'd had got that third goal early in the second half it might have been a different story but we didn't.

"They had their spell and they scored at the right time. And I think a draw was a fair result in the end."

The Bassett boss, however, was buoyed by his team's ability to come from behind and

believes they could have nicked all three points at the death.

"We started really well but then got sloppy with it," said Collier. "We knew the way they were going to cause us problems from set pieces and that's exactly what happened.

"Words were said at half-time and we knew we had to be better. We made some changes and got back into the game at 2-2. I think if we'd played another five minutes we probably would have won it."

Speaking about the importance of having players who can come off the bench and positively impact the game, Collier added: "It's absolutely massive.

"We spoke after the game about the importance of having a squad. If you want to be in the top six of this league then you've got to have

Opponents History TUFFLEY ROVERS

The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.



After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11th, 3rd, 6th and 3rd in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17th. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10th placed finishes, before a 15th place finish in 2018/19.

Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17th place).

Bennett brace salvages derby draw

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Fairford Town 2

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's habit of coming from behind to earn a result continued as, courtesy of a Matt Bennett brace, Sam Collier's side overcame a 2-0 half time deficit to claim a point in an entertaining Friday night derby at home against Fairford Town.

In four of their last five games - and in their three most recent Hellenic League Premier Division fixtures, Bassett have fallen behind before reeling off impressive comebacks that have allowed the side to maintain their positive run of form

However, while Bassett found themselves facing single goal deficits against Westfields, Worcester Raiders and Wellington, the comeback pulled off against Fairford was arguably more impressive as Collier and his team found themselves two goals down and facing the prospect of a third straight home loss against the Reds.

But a half time overhaul - which saw the Bassett boss gamble by brining on three substitutes, including Bennett - did the trick and ultimately earned a share of the spoils.

A draw was arguably a fair outcome - and reflective of the fact that this was the proverbial game of two halves.

Having soaked up early Bassett pressure that failed to translate into any meaningful chances, Fairford took the lead when unmarked defender Robbie James was on hand to steer in after a dangerous Tom Chamberlain free kick delivery had been redirected back across the face of goal by Olly Whelan.

The visitors soon doubled their advantage as half time neared. Adam Corcoran was unable to head clear from 'keeper Joe Wright's long pass forward and Danny Gudger took full advantage, beating Matt Crowther to the loose ball before rounding the 'keeper and steering in from an angle.

That left Bassett with a huge amount to do to get themselves back into the game. And while Collier resorted to shuffling his pack, bringing on Bennett, Bailey Gallagher and Sam Packer, his side were lucky that they didn't face an even greater deficit when Fairford forward George Peare, with the goal at his mercy, struck wide of the mark with a first time effort from close range early in the second half.

Having survived that scare, Bassett quickly got themselves back into the match. Moments later with the ball at the other end, Jack Hobson-McVeigh whipped in an inswinging corner, and Bennett, shaking off his marker, flicked in a header at the near post to make it 2-1.

It didn't take long for the scores to be levelled and for Bennett to grab his second. While under pressure from the forward, Fairford 'keeper Wright failed to hold on when coming out to catch a bouncing ball - and Bennett seized upon the error, slotting into the bottom corner from ten yards out.

With the scores back level, that set up the game for an exciting finish. And both sides would have chances to snatch a winner late on.

The error-prone Wright almost fumbled a Hobson-McVeigh corner into his own net but was saved by Whelan's goalline clearance.

For Fairford, Gudger came close as he saw a shot of his from the edge of the area catch a deflction and go narrowly over.

Bassett then had arguably the best opportunity to claim the points when Alfie Presley got on the end of Bennett's fine low cross to steer towards goal but, fortunately for the visitors, his shot from eight yards out was straight at the 'keeper.

Bassett thus finish their run of four home league games unbeaten, with a win against Bradford Town and three consecutive draws. Those against Westfields and Worcester Raiders were certainly impressive, though Bassett would perhaps have wanted more from this fixture against Fairford.

Nevertheless, the team avoided defeat - and again showed their character to complete another comeback job.

Bassett Suffer Late Lads Club Loss

Royal Wootton Bassett Town slipped to eighth in the Hellenic League Premier Division after suffering a 3-2 defeat away at Hereford Lads Club.

Lads Club twice came from behind before snatching a winner two minutes before the end of normal time courtesy of a well taken Adam Hockey goal.

The loss is Bassett' first in five league matches and Sam Collier will be frustrated that his side failed to hold on for what would have been a fourth consecutive draw.

There will also be frustration that Bassett failed to hold on to two leads. In recent weeks, Bassett have been the experts at coming from behind to salvage a result. This time though they got a taste of their own medicine.

Bassett initially went 1-0 up midway through the opening period as Sam Packer rose to head home from a corner.

But Lads Club were on terms eight minutes before half time as they took advantage of a set piece, James Hancocks heading from a teasing free kick played in from the right edge of the area.

The game therefore seemed set to head into half time with the score 1-1. But Bassett produced a fine goal to go into the break in front. Rhys Talmash played a one-two with Alfie Presley on the halfway line and left home defender Henry Dyde staring at his heels as he raced clear on goal. Forced wide by 'keeper Steve Bell, there was still work for the forward to do, but he kept his nerve to slot in from an acute angle.

The advantage the visitors held didn't last for long though.

Six minutes into the second half the hosts were awarded a soft seeming penalty and Brandon Jennings squeezed a left-footed effort into the bottom corner, just out of the reach of Matt Crowther who guessed correctly.

It remained 2-2 until late on, with Bassett unable to see out the game for what would have been a handy draw.

Lads Club caught Bassett on the break and substitute Adam Hockey swivelled on the edge of the area before arrowing a low drive into the bottom right corner.

ESSENTIAL READING FOR FOLLOWERS OF THE NATIONAL GAME

THERE would have been a lot of smiling faces at Boreham Wood on Monday night when Sorba Thomas came off the Wales bench to make his World Cup debut. It's the latest chapter in a remarkable rise for the former National League attacker, who is now starring in the Championship for Huddersfield Town.

It wasn't all that long ago the 23-year-old was one of Wood's most important players having come through their academy - he regularly returns to give talks to the next generation of hopeful young footballers.

"I genuinely think there is a fine line between arrogance and confidence," Garrard told me last week. "If you're an elite athlete you've got to walk along that line. Sorba does that. He has the confidence in his ability and the arrogance to deliver on it. You see that in his game. That's why he's got his call-up for Wales.

"He's got Premier League pace. We've always spoken about that. And he's added to his game, hugely. With us he was always developing. We got him on the coaching side of things so his off-the-field stuff - the tough conversations dropping players in the U19s, people knocking on his door because they're not playing on a Wednesday, these are things he grew off the pitch which definitely helped him grow on the pitch.

"I went and watched him in the play-off final last year. I was sat with his friends and family. I don't think I've been as nervous as that for a game I've been involved in, let alone someone else. Because it was like watching someone you've brought up. Now he's going to the World Cup."

He's not the only former Boreham Wood youngster out in Qatar. Sheffield United's Iliman Ndiaye is in the Senegal squad and his rise also has Garrard beaming.

"We went to the PGMOL tournament three

years ago where they were using VAR prior to rolling it out, and he scored a goal like Maradona," Garrard says.

"We knew he had a special talent. Obviously he's gone off to Sheffield United and he's with Senegal now.

"It's very similar routes (to Sorba). We were fortunate he landed on our lap but the minute he came in it was, 'No, no - this one is special'."


Of course there are plenty of other former Non-League players at this World Cup. Thomas' team-mate Kieffer Moore turned the game in Wales' favour when he came off the bench. The striker, now in the Premier League, played for Truro City and Dorchester Town before other spells at Forest Green and Torquay United on loan. He also represented England C in an International Challenge Trophy game against Estonia.

There are players in the Wales squad who have played Non-League like Joe Morrell (Sutton and Margate) and Town Lockyer, who won promotion with Bristol Rovers. In the full England squad, Nick Pope began at Isthmian League Bury Town. Jordan Pickford had loan spells at Alfreton Town and Darlington, while Callum Wilson turned out for Tamworth and Kettering Town. Ghana striker Antoine Semenyo played on loan for Bath City in 2018.

In recent years we've seen many more examples of players learning their trade in Non-League and landing on world football's biggest stages. There is more than one route to the top. As Garrard adds: "Iliman was at Marseille as a kid, didn't really make it, and was trying to find somewhere to go before he came to us. Sorba was released by West Ham. There are success stories."

Royal W. Bassett Town 4 AFC Aldermaston 2

Just one game survived the wet weather in the Under 18 Floodlight Division this week, that game being the match at the Sustain Stadium between second in the table Royal Wootton Bassett Town and bottom side Aldermaston who had won just one of their opening seven games, losing the other six. The form book would have suggested a comfortable night for the home side, but it was anything but for Nick Warren's side in an entertaining game. Right from the start AFC Aldermaston matched the home side stride for stride and were much the better side in the opening half. They went 1-0 up just after the half hour mark when Freddie Stewart pounced on an error in the six-yard box by Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Charlie Stammers, Stammers failing to clear the ball enabling Stewart to fire Aldermaston in front. They went close to extending their lead a minute before half-time, Oscar Kirby firing in a powerful shot which was well saved with his feet by Jack Rae in the Royal Wootton Bassett Town goal and it remained just the one goal at the break.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town upped their game in the second half and went close to getting back on level terms ten minutes into the second half when Flynn Walters saw his shot deflected onto the post and out for a corner. They eventually did get themselves back in the game on the hour mark, a misplaced shot from Rhys Westlake fell to Euan Spackman who put it away for 1-1. The home side then went in front for the first time ten minutes later, a dangerous cross from the right by Charlie Stammers to the

far post saw Flynn Walters stretch to get on the end of it, which he succeeded in doing, keeping the ball in play putting it into the six-yard box, where Jacob Rendell-Haines had a simple tap in for 2-1.

They did not hold the lead for long though. Aldermaston were awarded a free kick 25-yards out in a central position and Oscar Kirby smashed the free kick into the top corner of the net to make it 2-2 with 15 minutes to go. Royal Wootton Bassett Town knew they could not really afford to drop many more points in their quest for the title and immediately sought to respond, Euan Spackman firing a shot just over the bar within a minute of Aldermaston's goal. As the game went into its final ten minutes it looked like the sides would have to settle for a point apiece, but Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Rhys Westlake had other ideas. With seven minutes to go the ball was fed into his feet on the edge of the Aldermaston box and he turned defender and slotted the ball past Aldermaston's keeper into the far bottom corner of the net for 3-2. Aldermaston once again sought to get back on level terms but in pushing caught plavers forward were on counterattack just two minutes after falling behind. A ball out of defence saw Flynn Walters pick the ball up on the halfway line and run past a couple of defenders with Westlake joining him to make it two-against one as the Aldermaston keeper came out, Walters unselfishly slid the ball across to Westlake who had an open goal in front of him and put it away for 4-2 and secure all three points for the home side. Royal Wootton Bassett certainly knew they had been involved in a tough game and if Aldermaston continue to play like they did that second win of the season cannot be too far away.
