**Good afternoon & Welcome** to the Sustain Stadium for today's big game against fellow strugglers Poole Town.

The game against Poole earlier in the season was a tough battle, with neither team willing to give up the points. We relied heavily on our goalkeeper, Millie Powell to keep us in the game during the first half. Poole scored first in that game, but it was another one of our young players, Caily Morse, that rescued our only point of the season so far. There are no easy games in this league, and with both teams desperate for points, we are expecting another tough challenge today.

But from my point of view, the players have lots to be encouraged by from recent performances. Firstly, Warminster were extremely fortunate to leave here with all three points. ## LIBBY MOVES ON

Cheltenham Town Ladies have completed their latest addition in the form of striker Libby Davies.

Davies, formerly of Royal Wootton Bassett Ladies has been in scorching form this season, finding the net 37 times in just 16 appearances. After bagging 13 goals in just five, she caught the eye of Cheltenham who offered for her a chance of football two divisions higher.

Davies, who has also previously represented Wiltshire, **told Jon Palmer of Gloucestershire Live:** "I am thrilled to have this opportunity as this will be the highest level of football I've ever played.



"Cheltenham contacted Simon (Harrison, Wootton Bassett manager) about signing me which was a complete shock.

"I was looking for a new challenge elsewhere so the timing of their approach was great."

Davies started playing football at five years old after watching her brother, and played at Calne FC Boys up until the age of 15, while also attending South West camps.

After completing her A-Levels this summer, Davies is now looking forward to taking on the challenges of Tier Three women's football with Cheltenham.

"This was the level I wanted to play at," Davies said. "I am now aiming to build my confidence and develop into a better and stronger striker. The staff and players have been very welcoming which has made the process of joining easier."

Outside of football, Davies works as a food and beverage supervisor in a hotel.








It may only be a single point, but Royal Wootton Bassett Town gained a significant confidence boost as they finally got off the mark in the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division courtesy of a hard fought 1-1 draw away against Poole Town.

With manager Simon Harrison having to rotate his squad due to unavailability - including last season's leading scorer Libby Davies, Bassett were up against it in their first competitive fixture against the Dorset side.

But Harrison's side dug deep and, in the end,

were worthy of getting something from a lively contest against the only other side in the division not to have registered a point in their opening two fixtures.

Poole had led after Sacha Paynter gave the Dolphins the lead. However, Bassett eventually levelled through Caily Morse, who - grabbing her first goal in senior football - turned the ball home after a shot from fellow youngster Ellie O'Nions struck the bar.

Although the game would ultimately end all square, Bassett did have to survive a late square when Poole struck the post.

Despite that, the visitors were deserving of a draw and can now proceed without having to worry about there being a zero in the points column.

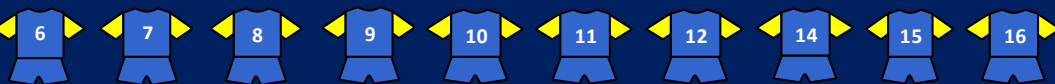
