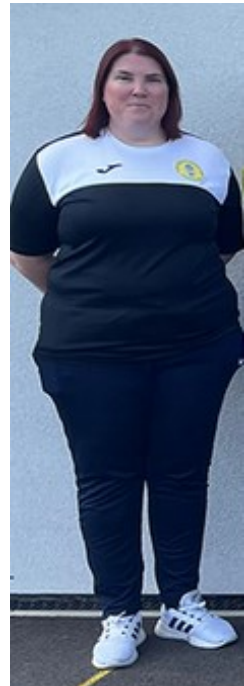
Five U18's played in the game, all starting to establish themselves as confident step-5 players. The future is certainly bright with many talented young players on the team. I

Today's Opponents

WARMINSTER TOWN

Warminster Town FC was founded in 1878 but it seems to have been firmly established in 1885. In those early days they played in the Wiltshire County League until the 1929-30 season and the following season they joined the Western League.

After the Second World War, Warminster Town FC went back into the Wiltshire County League. They remained there for quite some time, in fact, it was the 1983-84 season that they were once again playing in the Western League. Following the 2005-06 season relegation saw them back in the Wiltshire County League. This was not for long as the club applied to join the Wessex League for

the 2008-09 season before joining the Western League for for the 2012-13 season where they still play today.

The club ground is in Weymouth Street, Warminster and they originally played at Holly Lodge, Boreham Road, Warminster.

Like a lot of clubs the Women's side at Warminster is a fairly recently established side and their most successful season by far was last season when they won the South West Regional Women's League Eastern Division title and also made the final of the Wiltshire FA County Cup, but lost 2-11 to Swindon Town in the final.

Second half comeback in vain as Warminster upset Bassett on penalties

(Warminster won 3-2 on pens)

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies fell to an upset defeat away against Warminster Town in their Wiltshire County Women's Cup quarter final. After the two sides had shared four goals during the 90 minutes, Warminster kept their nerve to triumph 3-2 on penalties.

Facing opposition from the South West Regional Women's Football League Eastern Division - a step below Bassett, Graham Fletcher's side entered the contest as favourites to progress to the semi finals of the competition.

But a strong first half performance from Warminster meant Bassett were playing catch up. And despite coming from 2-0 down to draw level, the visitors were unable to find a winner before falling short when the game went to penalties.

Warminster had star striker Shannon Redhouse to thank for their healthy half time lead.

Her first - struck sweetly into the top corner - came after a strong Lydia Shirley challenge won possession back for her team deep in Bassett territory on 18 minutes.

Redhouse then grabbed her second with one minute to go until the interval, slotting home

after good set up play from Mia Blazey.

Bassett struck back five minutes after the restart through leading scorer Libby Davies before captain Laura Jefferies equalised quarter of an hour later.

There were no further goals - although Davies had what would have been the match winner controversially disallowed with five minutes remaining. That meant the game went to penalties.

Despite two excellent saves from young 'keeper Millie Powell (pictured below), only Davies and Hayley Huckin were able to convert their penalties for Bassett, allowing for Warminster to claim a 3-2 shootout win and march on to the last four.

The result means Bassett pass up the chance to retain a title they won in 2018-19.

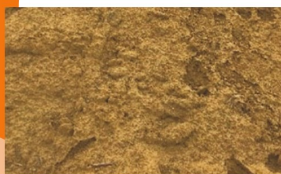

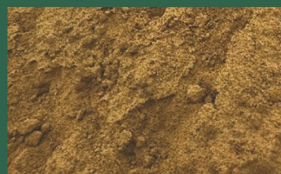



Royal Wootton Bassett Town overcame a spirited fight from underdogs Purton to advance to the semi finals of the Wiltshire County Women's Cup with a 3-1 win thanks to goals from Hannah Gulliver and Libby Davies.

Having endured a rough start to their league campaign, the County Cup offered a chance for Simon Harrison's side to get some welcome respite and restore a degree of confidence.

But, while facing lower level opposition, the short trip to quarter final opponents Purton - who sit undefeated at the top of the Wiltshire County Women's League - represented a potential banana skin, with Bassett knowing that they would need to be at their best if they were to advance. And Purton proved tricky opponents, pushing Bassett for the majority of the match.

Any nerves Bassett felt were initially settled

when they took the lead through Gulliver. In her position on the right wing, Gulliver received a switch of play from Caily Morse. There, she masterfully turned inside the full back and struck a left-footed shot from the edge of the area that proved just too powerful for Purton 'keeper, who was unable to prevent the ball from finding its way into the bottom corner.

However, Purton struck back before half time to level. Bassett had three good opportunities to clear, but were unable to do so - and Emma Skinner took full advantage, jumping onto the loose ball and lifting over the onrushing Nia Davies in the Bassett goal.

Bassett would ensure there was to be no upset though, with Libby Davies scoring two unanswered goals after the restart.

Davies' first came as she beat the Purton 'keeper to the ball to get on the end of Ellie O'Nions' excellent low cross from the left corner with a delicate first time finish.

Bassett's leading scorer then produced a trademark solo effort to make it 3-1, firing beneath the home 'keeper from twenty yards after a surging run at the Purton defence.
