Welcome To Today's Game



Good Afternoon & Welcome

to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this South West Regional League fixture. Today's visitors Liskeard Athletic have travelled up from Cornwall, not a short journey with an estimated

travel time of two hours and 53mins. We ourselves have already made that journey to Liskeard earlier in the season back in October. It was my first ever visit to Liskeard having shared the mini bus driving duties with Gareth. The actual game now seems such a long time ago.

The game finished 6-3 to Liskeard with us taking a two goal lead, but Liskeard were able to turn the game around before half time, scoring six goals before Libby scored with a late consolation to complete her hatrick. A disappointing result, but what it did highlight was an ongoing problem from last season where players were not available for the away trips and were only available for home games. I thanked the players for travelling and showing the commitment needed to compete in this division, and that sticking together is important to avoid relegation this season. After the Liskeard away game we had four players leave and in December along with Libby dual signing at Step 3 Cheltenham Town. With these events occurring it was important for Simon to recruit before Christmas to bolster the squad. Simon

was able to sign Megan Young on loan from Cheltenham and Neve Johnson from Swindon Town, both adding to our squad depth and it gives us more options and competition for places.

Cup final Disappointment

Last Sunday's county cup final at Melksham Town ended in disappointment for us and to lose 3-0 was painful but a fair reflection on the game. In the game we were unable to put Warminster under any sustainable pressure with their back four coping well with our attacks and limiting us to a couple of shots at goal from distance. You have to give Warminster credit on playing to their strengths by getting the ball forward quickly and being very direct alongside making sure the game was played in our half of the pitch. We struggled to get a foot hold in the game and were not able to pass or move the ball quickly enough to beat their high press. We did compete / battle to the final whistle but was never able to break down the Warminster defence.

We now have to move quickly on from last week defeat and focus on this next important game.

Let's hope for a good performance and our first three points this season, and I hope to see you all in the bar afterwards. .










Today's Opponents

LISKEARD ATHLETIC

The original Liskeard Athletic men's side were regular finalists in the Cornwall Senior Cup; after finishing on the losing side in 1893–94, 1895–96, 1901–02 and 1903–04, they won the trophy in 1904–05 with a 1–0 win over Penzance. The club folded in 1935 due to financial problems.

The modern club was established in 1946. In 1966 they joined the South Western League. The club were runners-up in 1975–76 and went on to win the league the following season. After finishing as runners-up again in 1977–78, they won the league for a second time the following season and moved up to Division One of the Western League. A third-place finish in their first season in the division resulted in promotion to the Premier Division. They went on to win the Cornwall Senior Cup in 1983–84 and 1984–85.

In 1985–86 Liskeard were Premier Division runners-up and won the Senior Cup for a third consecutive season. They were Western League champions in 1987–88 and won the Senior Cup again in 1988–89. The club finished as runners-up in the Premier Division again in 1989–90, also retaining the Senior Cup. However, in 1995 they dropped back into the South Western League. The club won the Senior Cup in 2002–03 and were runners-up in the South Western League in 2006–07. At the end of the season the league merged with the Devon County League to form the South West Peninsula League, with Liskeard placed in the Premier Division.

The 2013–14 season saw Liskeard finish

bottom of the Premier Division, resulting in relegation to Division One West. Following league reorganisation at the end of the 2018–19 season, the club were elevated to the Premier Division Wes0 where they have been ever since, finishing as runners-up in Season 2021-22.

The club have played at Lux Park since their establishment in 1946. The ground had been used for football and cricket since the early 20th century and was sold by Viscount Clifton for £300 in 1912 for use as a sports ground. An adjacent field was purchased for £500 in 1922 and used for football, with the first match on 9 September that year against Woodland Villa. Although the football club folded in 1935, the ground continued to be used for rugby and then by Moorswater Football Club for the 1945–46 season.

After Liskeard Athletic started playing at Lux Park, dressing rooms were built in 1961 and a standing area erected in the late 1980s. A seated stand was built in 1989 to replace an older structure. The standing area was replaced by a new stand after being destroyed by high winds in January 1990.

The women's team at Liskeard Athletic is a fairly recent addition to the club but they have been very successful winning the South West Regional Women's League Western Division last season to achieve promotion to the Premier Division. They currently sit in sixth place in the table with three wins from their opening eight games.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town remained winless in the South West Regional Women's Football League after a 6-3 loss away against Liskeard Athletic.

Adding to the feeling was the fact that, for the second time this season, Bassett surrendered a two goal lead.

Libby Davies struck twice within the opening

quarter of an hour as her side got off to a perfect start.

But that would be as good as it got for the visitors.

Chloe Williams pulled a goal for the hosts before Sam Metters headed in from Charlotte Bond's cross to draw level midway through the half.

Another Metters header then gave Liskeard their first lead. And the Cornish outfit were fully in charge just before the interval courtesy of a fine Bond free kick.

After the restart, Metters completed her hat trick to 5-2, while Ollie Ramsey got in on the act to make it a home half dozen.

There was time for Davies to complete her hat trick shortly before the end but that was a mere consolation.

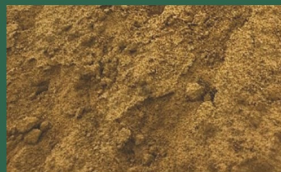

Royal Wootton Bassett Town fell short in their quest to win a second Wiltshire County Women's Cup crown as Simon Harrison's side were well beaten in a 3-0 final defeat against Warminster Town.

A contest that pitted South West Regional Women's Football Premier Division rivals against each other, the showpiece promised to be an evenly-contested match.

But although Bassett weren't blown away, a sub-par performance allowed Warminster to claim a relatively comfortable win as they went one better than last year when they finished as runners-up.

Warminster scored at key moments early and late in the first half, with Shannon Redhouse netting twice to put her side in command at the interval.

Warminster made a fast start, and almost went ahead in the third minute as Bassett 'keeper Millie Powell tipped Millie Spratt's curling free kick onto the bar. Powell then did well to save low from Maddy Brown's 20 yard drive a couple of minutes later.

But Warminster didn't have to wait too much longer for the opening goal, which came just after the quarter hour mark. However, it arrived in somewhat controversial circumstances.

From the halfway line, Spratt sprayed a pass

forward for Brown to run onto. Arriving to the loose ball at the same time as Powell, the Warminster forward appeared to commit a foul on the Bassett 'keeper. However, no free kick was given, and Redhouse reacted quickest, being on hand to place into an empty net from the edge of the area.

Warminster remained on top for the remainder of the half, and ultimately doubled their advantage on the stroke of half time.

This time Bassett could have no complaints. Brown dispossessed Ellie O'Nions inside the Bassett half to launch a counter before squaring inside for Redhouse, who took one touch and then arrowed a powerful effort into the back of the net from the edge of the box.

While Bassett came close with a Laura Jefferies free kick early in the second half, it was soon 3-0 as Brooke Cheal-Ferris scored with a towering thirty yard, left-footed strike that sailed into the top corner.

That was game, set and match with still over half an hour to play.

No consolation was forthcoming either with Bassett unable to muster anything of note in front of goal.

Instead, Warminster pressed to extend their lead further, with Mia Blazey coming close to turning the ball in from close range and Powell in the Bassett goal having to be frequently alert to keep Warminster at bay.

While not the performance or result that Bassett hoped for, the team can nonetheless be happy to have gotten to the final for the fourth time in club history. In what has been a very difficult season results-wise, that achievement is at least something to look back on with pride.

Bassett Leave It Late Again

Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Warminster Town finally got to play their Wiltshire League Floodlit Cup first round game at the fourth attempt - and Nick Warren's side edged a tight game 2-1 courtesy of Joe Beavis' late winner.

Two postponements due to pitch conditions, with fog having also caused another postponement, meant under the cup rules the venue was switched from Warminster to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. And, although it was to prove a tight affair all evening with both team playing a passing game building up from the back, Bassett ultimately benefited from having home advantage.

Whilst Bassett Town had more of the possession, they rarely opened up an organised Warminster back line and the first real chance of the night fell the way of the visitors on 22 minutes when a ball played into the edge of the Bassett box was headed by defender Sonny James in the wrong direction and over the head of his goalkeeper Finlay Cranswick-Coates. Luckily for the home keeper, the ball hit his post and then rebounded back across his goal line and was cleared.

Ten minutes later the home side had their best chance of the half up to that point when they finally opened up the Warminster defence but Spencer Bowen saw his shot tipped over the bar by keeper Thomas Jones.

The deadlock was finally broken two minutes before half time and, given the lack of clear cut chances in the game, it was no surprise that it came from a dead-ball situation.

Warminster were awarded a free kick for a foul right on the edge of the 18-yard box with the attacking player ending up in the box; on another night, it could have seen a penalty awarded. The free kick was in a very central position but Lennon Burden fired a powerful well placed shot around the wall and into the net past Cranwick-Coates to make it 1-0 to

the visitors.

The lead did not last long though as straight from the kick-off Bassett went down the other end and a ball into the box saw Flynn Walters clear of the defence and when he was brought down the referee pointed to the spot giving the home side an immediate chance to bounce back. Leading scorer Jacob Rendell-Haines made no mistake from the spot as the two sides went into the half-time break all square.

The second half continued in a similar fashion to the first with lots of possession football but limited chances being created.

With the possibility of extra time looming, the final 15 minutes finally saw things opening up as both teams tried to find a winner.

Cooper Brooks went close to finding the net for Warminster before Bassett created their best chance of the night in open play, Euan Spackman getting to a ball into the box before visiting keeper Jones and set up Flynn Walters on the edge of the box with the keeper stranded. However, Walters' powerful shot was brilliantly blocked on the line by Cole Parmley and cleared to safety.

Walters then went close three minutes later but saw his shot turned away by keeper Jones for a corner.

There was to be a late winner though when, following another attack from the home side, the ball fell to substitute Beavis on the edge of the box and his powerful shot gave keeper Jones no chance to make it 2-1 to the home side.

Bassett had the ball in the net again moments later and again it was Beavis who fired home after a free kick from Bowen came back off the bar, but the goal was ruled out by an assistant's flag for offside.

The final whistle went shortly after and it is the home side and league leaders who progress to the next round. But, has been the case in recent league games, they had left it late to get the better of a determined and well organised opponent showing there is very little between all the sides in this Under 18 Division this season.

Bassett will now meet Bishops Cannings in the quarter final with the winner of that tie then away to Calne Town in the semi-final.
