# Today's Opponents History

## **SALISBURY FC WOMEN**



The current Salisbury FC is a phoenix club. The new club began in December 2014 when Salisbury FC Ltd was incorporated and created by a consortium of five – David Phillips, Ian Ridley, Jeremy Harwood, Graeme Mundy, and Steve Claridge, the latter also having the role of men's first team manager. After buying the remaining assets of predecessor club Salisbury City FC from the administrators, they started the huge task of creating a football club from scratch.

By early April 2015 a new lease had been obtained on the Raymond McEnhill Stadium which had been purpose-built in 1997 for the old club, enabling Salisbury FC to apply to the FA seeking a competitive league for the 2015-16 Season. The stadium had been locked and shuttered for a year, with the grass on the pitch extremely high, and much work was needed both on and off the pitch to bring it back into use. Supporters of the old club, desperate to see football back at the ground again, worked hard with other volunteers to get it all up and running in time for the first game in April 2015.

In May 2015, the FA placed the new club in the Sydenhams Wessex League Premier Division. For the loyal supporters and fans, 18 months of hurt and pain following the messy demise of Salisbury City was eased as they finally watched their new team line up for the first time. What a season the re-born club was to have as they took the Wessex Premier Division title in their first season, losing just three games all season to gain promotion to the Southern League. They also made the quarter-finals of the Sydenhams Wessex League Cup, were runners-up in the Wiltshire Senior Cup, and after an excellent campaign in the FA Vase went out in the semi-finals, just missing out on a trip to

Wembley that could have been that extra cherry on the icing on the cake in a superb inaugural season.

Salisbury FC men's first team remain in the Southern League currently playing in the Premier Division South (Step 3 of the National League System).

Salisbury appear to have re-established a second side in Season 2016-17, entering a side in the Hampshire Combination and Development League. That season saw them finish in a creditable fourth spot, but the following season was to be an incredibly successful one as they secured the Midweek Division title winning 15 of their 16 league games and finishing 13 points ahead of runners-up Poole Town.

Salisbury FC Women were formed in 2016 and quickly established themselves in Women and Girls football finishing in fifth place in their inaugural season in the Wiltshire League before following that up with an impressive second place in their second season in the County League. They did not fare so well in the first Covid impacted season but were in fourth spot in Season 2020-21 when the action was brought to an early end. They matched that fourth spot last season in what has now been re-branded the Premier Division of the Wiltshire County Women's League.

Salisbury have specifically stated on their website that their aim this season will be focusing on gaining promotion to the South West Regional Women's Football League, with a revamped management team and dedicated work towards team sponsorships.

Currently the team are based at Sarum Academy, Westwood Road, Salisbury.

## RWBT v FOREST GREEN ROVERS

### Rowlands & Randall Reap Rewards for Forest Green Rovers

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies fell to their Royal Wootton Bassett Town were unable to build on last weekend's Vitality Women's FA Cup victory as they returned to South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division action with a 3-0 home defeat against Forest Green Rovers.

Unable to find a way past a resolute Forest Green defence, Bassett ultimately succumbed after Charlie Rowlands scored a brace and Estelle Randall completed the scoring for Forest Green.

It did not help Bassett that they found themselves a goal down within three minutes of the opening whistle when good play between Nynka Rucker and Zoe Boyd allowed the latter to pick out Rowlands, who fired into the roof of the net

That was Rovers' second good chance of the

match - and they had a third inside the opening ten minutes when Hattie Jones shot from the edge of the area but Millie Powell was equal to her effort.

Bassett eventually settled into the match and the teams largely cancelled one another out for the remainder of the half.

There was therefore everything still to play for following the restart.

But Forest Green struck a decisive blow just before the hour when Rucker raced onto a ball over the top and squared for Rowlands to steer home and double her side's lead.

It was then soon 3-0 as Randall shrugged off the attention of Laura Jefferies and Sylvannah Winstone before rounding Powell and coolly slotting in.

That excellent individual effort signalled game over for Bassett, who were unable to conjure up a consolation.

Still without a league win after four games, the team are now due to get two weeks' respite with County Cup action against Salisbury next week before a visit to Torquay United in the Women's FA Cup.

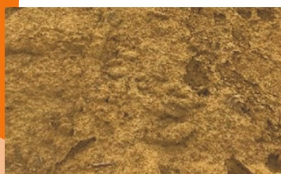

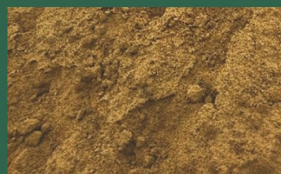

# The Non-League Paper

## ENOUGH IS ENOUGH



A few years ago, I took on the running of my son's youth football team to save it from potentially folding.

For three seasons, from Under 14s through to Under 16s, the team's coach and I gave the boys a platform to enjoy their football safe, controlled and friendly environment.

They were by no means world beaters but, win, lose or draw, they loved it, as did I, and we all look back on those years fondly with plenty of life skills, both on and off the field, learned.

Without doubt, the most difficult and time-consuming job I had in that time was booking referees. Even though I had a list of qualified referees locally as long as your arm, finding one to officiate our game on a Saturday morning was nigh-on impossible. I'm talking in excess of 50-100 emails per week sometimes until I could find someone available.

At the time, I remember questioning why it was so difficult. Especially for a teen, it kept them involved in the game, it was good exercise and the pay wasn't bad either. I didn't get it. Until kick-off that was.

Now, individually, and collectively as a team, we prided ourselves on our discipline and I can honestly say, hand on heart, I have never seen, first-hand, any incidents of abuse towards a referee. But, I have heard horrible reports of it happening and I can understand how it does happen. It has to stop.

A shortage of referees leads to a shortage of grass-roots football and, ultimately, in the Non-League game. In short, these young referees learning to officiate at grass-roots level are often promoted up the pyramid into the National League System.

Without them, it would not exist. I mean, would you take verbal, and occasionally physical abuse from players, coaches or spectators for a measly £30? No, neither would I.

With that in mind, I had mixed emotions I read proposals for referees to trial wear body

cameras in the adult grassroots game in the first half of next year.

It came following reports that a referee in Lancashire was left with a broken nose, four broken ribs, a dislocated shoulder, a broken collarbone, concussion and whiplash during an alleged attack during a game

In fact, according to Football Association data, there were 1.1 'serious cases' reported per 1,000 matches, covering assaults, physical contact or attempted physical contact with match officials and discrimination cases.

Last month, the FA have launched its 'Enough Is Enough' campaign to address behaviour within grassroots football, setting out that any unacceptable conduct will result in action being taken.

"The aim of the trial, the first globally of this nature, would be to explore whether the use of bodycams improves participant behaviour, while providing additional safety for match officials in the adult grassroots game," an FA spokesman said.

"We will be tracking the impact of the trial on behaviour and, if it's successful, will look to roll it out nationally and internationally."

Personally, I think it's very sad that football at grass-roots level has to go down this route but if a referee wearing body camera is to act as a deterrent and a means of their protection then the game owes it our whole-hearted support. The FA's hands have been tied.

It is understood, that even if the trial proves a success in improving behaviour and enhancing safety, the International Football Association Board [IFAB] will be determined to ensure that it is not deployed senior football.

But with reports of verbal abuse towards officials to us at NLP Towers still as rife as ever it's left the lawmakers with a decision to make.

No-one wants to see Big Brother watching Non-League football's every move and taking away its purity but unless we clean up our act from the bottom of our game up, then he may well have to. Respect our refs, weekends would be very boring without them.
