The game was never stopped until after we had scored resulting in the tie going to the dreaded penalty kicks and we missed three on the day and went out. So I was a little disappointed that initially we were not allocated three officials for today's game.

However, the good news is that, since I started writing these notes on Tuesday evening, we have now been allocated three officials for today's semi final and there can now only be honest and impartial views if there are to be any mistakes.

Enjoy the game today and hopefully a win to take us to a final. See you in the bar!



DURRINGTON FC LADIES



We have not been able to find out much about the history of Durrington FC but their club badge indicates that they were formed in 1976.

The current Ladies Team was established in the Wiltshire County League in Season 2021-22 and had a successful first season finishing in third place in the table, losing just 3 of their 18 league matches. In the end they finished just four points below champions FC Chippenham and three points behind Melksham Town Ladies. That successful season saw manager Jeff Smith feature in the Wiltshire FA's end of season awards, receiving a Highly Commended Award in the Adult Coach of the Year category.

They have carried that good form last season into the current season and at the time of writing sit second in the table with eight wins from their opening ten league games, losing just two games, one to leaders Purton who we defeated in the last round, and one to fellow semi-finalist Swindon Supermarine.

Durrington have made it through to the last four of the competition after defeating Marlborough Town 7-1 in the First Round and then Westbury Youth 5-0 away in the last round.

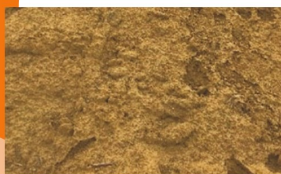

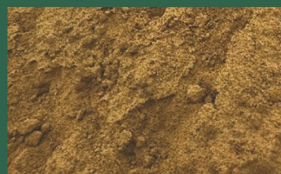

Royal Wootton Bassett Town overcame a spirited fight from underdogs Purton to advance to the semi finals of the Wiltshire County Women's Cup with a 3-1 win thanks to goals from Hannah Gulliver and Libby Davies.

Having endured a rough start to their league campaign, the County Cup offered a chance for Simon Harrison's side to get some welcome respite and restore a degree of confidence.

But, while facing lower level opposition, the short trip to quarter final opponents Purton - who sit undefeated at the top of the Wiltshire County Women's League - represented a potential banana skin, with Bassett knowing that they would need to be at their best if they were to advance. And Purton proved tricky opponents, pushing Bassett for the majority of the match.

Any nerves Bassett felt were initially settled when they took the lead through Gulliver. In her position on the right wing, Gulliver received a switch of play from Caily Morse. There, she masterfully turned inside the full back and struck a left-footed shot from the edge of the area that proved just too powerful for Purton 'keeper, who was unable to prevent the ball from finding its way into the bottom corner.

However, Purton struck back before half time to level. Bassett had three good opportunities to clear, but were unable to do so - and Emma Skinner took full advantage, jumping onto the loose ball and lifting over the onrushing Nia Davies in the Bassett goal.

Bassett would ensure there was to be no upset though, with Libby Davies scoring two unanswered goals after the restart.

Davies' first came as she beat the Purton 'keeper to the ball to get on the end of Ellie O'Nions' excellent low cross from the left corner with a delicate first time finish.

Bassett's leading scorer then produced a trademark solo effort to make it 3-1, firing beneath the home 'keeper from twenty yards after a surging run at the Purton defence.
