GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Bluefin Insurance Cup Third Round fixture against Thornbury Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey along the M4 from Bristol, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening, and we wish you a safe journey home.

This is the third time we have met Thornbury Town this season with both our two league games with them completed by the end of September. The first meeting here at the Sustain Stadium saw us win 4-1 but it was a bit closer in the return down in Bristol where an early Alfie Presley goal saw us secure a narrow 1-0 win. Not only have we won the two games this season but we also defeated Thornbury Town three times last season saw we currently have a 100% winning record against tonight's opponents.

Whilst we are looking on course to achieve our best ever finish at Step 5 level it would also be great if we could make a cup final as it is a long time since we lifted any silverware. This is the last competition we have a realistic chance of winning this season and win tonight and with a bit of luck in the draw who knows. just two points behind fifth placed Roman Glass St George with a game in hand. Hopefully we can continue that fine form of late here this evening in the cup.

WOMEN'S COUNTY CUP FINAL

Unfortunately our Women's side fell to a 3-0 defeat in the Wiltshire FA County Cup Final. In what has been a very difficult season it is still a major achievement to have made a cup final and well done to all involved with the Women's side. Hopefully now they can take what has been decent cup form all season into the remaining league games as they look to move away from the bottom of the table.

DEVELOPMENT SIDE

After defeating Melksham Town Reserves twice this season there was no treble on Saturday as the Development side put in one of their worst performances of the season to lose 3-0 at the Oakfield Stadium against the side bottom of the table. It was the side's penultimate away league fixture due to the high number of home games that the first team have had on a Saturday this season. The Development side have nine of their remaining ten league fixtures at home and hopefully they will use home advantage to avoid getting involved in a relegation battle between now and the end of the season.

UNDER 18 FLOODLIGHT SIDE

Nick Warren's Under 18 side have on a number of occasions come from behind to claim victory this season. Still unbeaten in the league and top of the table they also progressed in the League Cup last Thursday with a late winner against a determined Warminster Town side. Next up in the quarter final is Bishops Cannings with the winner then away to Calne Town in the semi.

Enjoy the game this evening and hopefully progress into the last eight of this cup competition.

Opponents History

THORNBURY TOWN



The exact date of the formation of the club is uncertain, but there are records of football being played in the late 1800s, with the first mention of "Thornbury Town" in 1898.

Before the outbreak of World War I, Thornbury played in the Dursley & Wotton League, with records of games against Chipping Sodbury Town, Wickwar and Westbury Park. During this time Dr. E. M. Grace, elder brother of W G Grace, played for the team.

After the war, the club re-formed and joined the Bristol and Suburban League. The club played in what is now the upper end of The Castle School Sixth Form Playing Field, on a pitch surrounded by an iron fence. They used changing rooms at a social club on the High Street which is now the Thornbury branch of HSBC. In 1933, multiple clubs in the area merged to form Thornbury Sports, later becoming Thornbury A.F.C., and later, Thornbury Town A.F.C.

At the end of World War II, the club moved to its current home at the Mundy Playing Fields. After using various establishments for changing room facilities, a pavilion at the playing fields was built in 1964. After playing in the Bristol and District League, they became founding members of the Bristol Premier Combination, winning the league in the 1956–57 season.

In the 1968-69 season, the club became founding members of the Gloucestershire County League and in the following season recorded attendances in excess of 500 spectators. In 1971, the club was accepted into the Western Football League after finishing third in the County League. However, the Mundy Playing Fields didn't meet the requirements, therefore, the club remained in the County until their relegation to the Bristol Premier Combination in 1977.

The club returned to the Gloucestershire County League in 2002 after many steady, but unsuccessful, seasons in the Bristol Premier Combination, finally winning the title by 13 points. The club finally won their first County League title in 2009-10, but history repeated itself with the club unable to make the step up to a higher level due to lack of facilities at the Mundys. That summer, the local youth football team, Thornbury Falcons, merged with Thornbury Town in a bid to cement the long term tradition of developing local youth talent.

After the title winning season in 2009–10,

Thornbury Town struggled to repeat the success and went through multiple changes of management in the following seasons. Under the stewardship of Andy Davies, the club won the Les James League Cup for the first time beating league winners, Cheltenham Civil Service 1–0. That season the club also finished in a respectable 4th place, which they repeated for the next two seasons.

In 2017–18, the club finally improved on their three consecutive fourth-place finishes, winning the league for a second time. The club also completed the double by winning the Les James League Cup for a second time, beating Frampton United 1–0. Work behind the scenes by committee members, meant the club were also in a position to apply for promotion to Step 6 of the Non-League System after receiving planning permission for a 50-seater stand, floodlights and perimeter fencing. The club's application was successful and they were placed in the Hellenic Football League Division One West for the 2018-19 season. The improvements to the Mundy Playing Fields were officially opened by the Mayor of Thornbury, Shirley Holloway on Tuesday 23 October 2018 before Thornbury Town's Hellenic League Subsidiary Cup game against local rivals Tytherington Rocks, which they won 6-0. After staying in the race for the top spot until the final weeks, the club finished in a respectable 3rd place behind Easington Sports and Cheltenham Saracens. Thornbury also finished the season winning the league's Supplementary Cup, beating Wallingford Town 2-1 at the ASM Stadium in Thame.

Ahead of the 2019-20 season, manager Andy Davies announced he was stepping aside as first team manager to take a break from football management, ending Thornbury Town's most successful era. Former player Jason Rees and ex-Gloucester City player Gary Kemp were announced as the new management team.

On 12 July 2019, it was announced that the club would take part in the FA Cup and FA Vase for the first time in the club's history, falling at the first hurdle against Leighton Town in the FA Cup, whilst reaching the second round in the FA Vase. In Season 2020-21 Thornbury sat second in the table in Division One West when the season was curtailed and that was sufficient to enable them to be promoted to the Hellenic Premier for the first time. Their first season saw them finish 14th in the Premier and they will be looking to improve on that this season.

There have been five meetings between Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Thornbury Town, all of which have taken place in this and last season.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town currently have a 100% winning record against tonight's opponents from Bristol. The first meeting last season was in the FA Cup at the very start of the season. A rampant first half performance saw Bassett establish a 3-0 lead after 25 minutes. And it was smooth sailing from there onwards, with a final goal late in the match time meaning Bassett matched their biggest margin of victory in the FA Cup (the club's only previous win by four goals coming in a 5-1 triumph against Dilton Rovers in the 1946-47 Extra Preliminary round). Tommy Ouldrige set Bassett on their way after quarter of an hour, scoring with a fine finish with the outside of his left foot from the edge of the area that sailed in over Thornbury 'keeper McKenzie Welsh. The lead was doubled three minutes later when Gio Wrona whipped in a free kick from the left side and veteran Alan Griffin headed home. Dave Bampton then made it 3-0 as he fizzed a low drive from 25 yards into the bottom left corner. With four minutes remaining, Tom Moore cut in from the left hand side and struck a right-footed shot to make it 4-0.

Less than a month later the sides met in the league for the first time at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. Two goals from Alan Griffin

secured the points for Bassett. His first came from the penalty spot six minutes before half time as he coolly tucked the ball away into the bottom left corner, out of reach of Thornbury 'keeper Kurtis Parkin who did manage to guess correctly. Griffin's second arrived a matter of minutes later. Having rattled the crossbar, he spun and finished decisively to give his side a commanding half time lead that they would not relinquish.

The third meeting last season was in early February. Overcoming the elements on a wet and windy afternoon, as well as opponents who had won three in a row in the league, Bassett climbed a place to 13th in the Hellenic League Premier Division courtesy of a dominant second half display. A solitary goal from Sam Packer saw Bassett lead at the break by the slenderest of margins. It was a different story second half. Bailey Gallagher fired in from the edge of the box to make it 2-0 before Sam Packer and John Mills combined to provide each other with a goal to make it 4-0, this after Thornbury had been reduced to ten men. The result was rounded off by a fifth scored by Alfe Presley who was set up by a defence splitting pass from Chris Taylor.

This season saw us win 4-1 at home in August and then 1-0 away in September. Match reports from both games are included elsewhere in tonight's programme.

Up to this point it had been all Bassett, but a lapse shortly after scoring almost allowed Thornbury to reduce their arrears with Matt Crowther forced to pay close attention to a shot that went narrowly wide.

After Bennett had been thwarted by Welsh after a jinking run, the veterans marksman eventually got the goal his performance deserved as he started and finished a swift move. Bennett sprayed a crossfield pass to Gallagher whose fine cross was met by Bennett at the far post to make a third headed goal of the night for Bassett.

The game was not yet over though. Thornbury grabbed a lifeline through a Luke Franklin stunner. And that seemed to unsettle Bassett for a period. However, any nerves were eventually settled when Kai Robinson wrested back possession with a strong tackle. He then passed to Gallagher whose through ball split the Thornbury defence, allowing Ouldrige - who had timed his run perfectly - to latch on and coolly slot past Welsh.

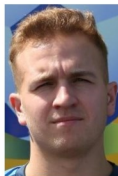

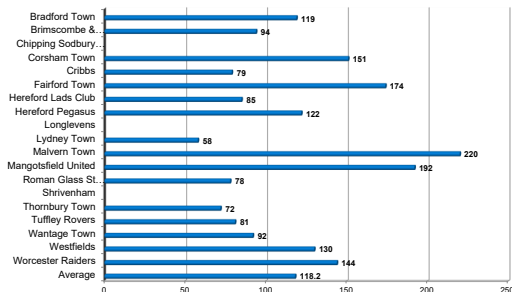

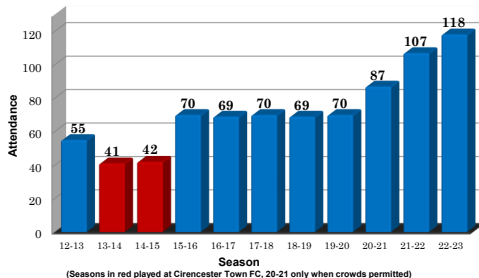

‘BIG GAME’ PERIOD

WE are now, officially, in the ‘Big Game’ period of the 2022-23 season.

Glance through any fixture list of upcoming matches and you will see them everywhere.

It’s that stage of a campaign where teams still have it all to gain – and all to lose. Be it at the top of the bottom, every point really matters from here on out.

How teams deal with tricky Tuesday night away matches, fixture pile-ups (don’t tell Klopp), injuries and suspensions will go a long way to decided the outcome of their season.

It will be the difference between titles and play-offs, missing out on top five – or seven in the National League – finishes or relegation and survival.

glory, they welcome Altrincham while FC Halifax Town are also former winners and travel to Aldershot Town – the Shots still haven’t played at Wembley.

You’d be hard pressed to find a more interesting and exciting competition than the FA Vase. The finals tend to be among the most absorbing games of the season, a unique factor being it’s so often two teams pitted against each other who are from different regions of the country and know very little about each other.

Holders Newport Pagnell Town are certainly putting up a strong defence of their title they won last season by beating Littlehampton Town.

They got past Jersey Bulls in round five to set-up another home date, this time with Atherstone Town.

There is an all-North West Counties League tie between Congleton Town and Bury AFC. Funnily enough, the pair played in the league just a day after being drawn together in the quarters on Monday and shared a 1-1 draw.

West Didsbury & Chorlton are also NWCFL representatives and they host Ascot United next. Ascot play in the shadow of the grandstand at the famous racecourse – look out for it next time the racing is on the tv.

Completing the sixth round are Peacehaven & Telscombe, who will face Corsham Town.

All these ties will be played on Saturday, March 11 as the 16 clubs look to make another step towards Wembley. Big Games!

Bassett Leave It Late Again

Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Warminster Town finally got to play their Wiltshire League Floodlit Cup first round game at the fourth attempt - and Nick Warren's side edged a tight game 2-1 courtesy of Joe Beavis' late winner.

Two postponements due to pitch conditions, with fog having also caused another postponement, meant under the cup rules the venue was switched from Warminster to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. The lead did not last long though as straight from the kick-off Bassett went down the other end and a ball into the box saw Flynn Walters clear of the defence and when he was brought down the referee pointed to the spot giving the home side an immediate chance to bounce back. Leading scorer Jacob Rendell-Haines made no mistake from the spot as the two sides went into the half-time break all square.

The second half continued in a similar fashion to the first with lots of possession football but limited chances being created.

Walters then went close three minutes later but saw his shot turned away by keeper Jones for a corner.

There was to be a late winner though when, following another attack from the home side, the ball fell to substitute Beavis on the edge of the box and his powerful shot gave keeper Jones no chance to make it 2-1 to the home side.

Bassett had the ball in the net again moments later and again it was Beavis who fired home after a free kick from Bowen came back off the bar, but the goal was ruled out by an assistant's flag for offside.

The final whistle went shortly after and it is the home side and league leaders who progress to the next round. But, has been the case in recent league games, they had left it late to get the better of a determined and well organised opponent showing there is very little between all the sides in this Under 18 Division this season.
