Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON

welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Slimbridge. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Gloucestershire, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

Today's encounter should have been our third league fixture of the season but frustratingly it is now our season opener due to circumstances beyond our and the League's control. Our scheduled opener against Thornbury Town was postponed due to health and safety reasons with building work at the ground not completed in time. The second fixture, which was scheduled to be here at the Gerard Buxton Ground last Tuesday night, was postponed due to scheduled opponents Roman Glass St George requiring a replay in their FA Cup tie with Lydney Town.

Looking at today's game, the last time that we played Slimbridge was way back in 2010-11. The big gap is due to Slimbridge moving across to play in the Toolstation Western League in Season 2013-14 from where they were then promoted to the Southern League. This season sees them return to the Hellenic League after a ten season absence having been relegated from the Southern League at the end of last season.

For those who take note of our previous records against our opponents we go into today's game with an element of trepidation as our record against Slimbridge is frankly abysmal with just one win and eleven defeats in the previous 12 encounters between the two sides. If we are looking for positive omens the winner in our one and only win over Slimbridge was scored by a certain Sam Collier in a 2-1 win back in 2009-10.

Slimbridge like ourselves exited the FA Cup last Saturday, losing 3-2 at home to Combined Counties side Reading City. Their one league game so far saw them draw 0-0 with our near neighbours Highworth Town. Like ourselves Slimbridge saw their scheduled midweek fixture postponed due to a FA Cup replay.

Last Saturday's defeat away at Mangotsfield United was a disappointing result but I thought we were the better side on the day and just lacked that crucial potency in the final third. We certainly bossed the second half and could easily have taken the game to a replay but that second goal in injury time certainly gave something of a flattering Mangotsfield. scoreline for Young goalkeeper Harry Pickering, signed from Melksham Town, had an excellent game throughout on his debut and young Jowan Partridge was outstanding at centre half. Hopefully some of the key missing players last Saturday will be back today to provide more potency in our attack. With the FA prize money gone we will now be looking to achieve an extended run in the FA Vase to make up for such an early exit in the most prestigious of FA competitions.

Today sees the first "double-header" of the season with the Development side also at home on the AGP against Shrewton United in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League. The playing of two home game at the facility has been done at the request of the club as it allows the club to provide both sets of teams with the same hot meal and will free up a few more weekends to allow some of the Committee to travel to more First Team away fixtures.

It is a busy start for both Men's sides with midweek games coming thick and fast in both leagues, with the Development side now in a division of 18 teams. This will lead to a busy first two months of the season for everyone.

Enjoy the game and hopefully we will be celebrating a rare win over Slimbridge and our first three points of the season in the bar after the game.

Ellis Parker - Goalkeeper Good young prospect that has returned to the club after a year away at Conderford Town. Came through the Under 18s and reserve sides and now looking to establish himself as the club's number 1.

Ben Hands - Defence A strong lad at the heart of the defence also plays in a defensive midfield role and capable of chipping in a few goals returning for his third season with the Swans. Previous clubs include Lowlevens and Cinderford Town.



Nathan Dennis - Defence Has made a huge impact in the central defence in the last two seasons, big old school style defender who puts himself about at both ends of the pitch.



Charlie Hitchings - Defence With over 400 games behind him at Southern and Western League level, will bring a huge amount of experience in the centre of defence.

Myron Turner - Midfield Brings a calmness and solid feel to the midfield, very popular and dependable member of the squad and among the supporters here at Thornhill Park. In his seventh season with the Swam having previously played for Longlevens

Marley Thomas - Midfield

In his third spell with the Swans having made over 180 appearances with the club. The pacy winger is another fans favourite and looking to continue his goal scoring touch after spells away at Evesham United and Conderford Town.

Another product of last year's successful U/185 team who broke through into the first team towards the end of the season. Going to play an important part in this season's team.

Dale Evans - Midfield

Combative midfielder with bags of Southern League experience who joined the Swans towards the end of last season. Previous clubs include Larkhall, Mellebam and Paulton Rovers

Edjija Mbunga - Forward Pacey striker who can be a real handful in and around the penalty area.

Opponent's History Slimbridge

The Gloucestershire village of Slimbridge is world renowned for its Bird Sanctuary, but much hard work has gone into making Slimbridge better known in football circles.

The Club's history can be traced back to the 1899/1900 season, when the team were playing in local football at various venues in and around the village. A gap in the records suggests there may have been a couple of seasons when no games were played, and thus, officially, the Club's centenary was celebrated in 2002/03.

For the next forty-odd years the Club were predominantly members of the Stroud and District League with varying degrees of success and failure, except for a period between 1960 and 1968 when they were in the Gloucester Northern Senior League.

It was not until 1951 that the current ground at Wisloe Road (Now renamed as Thornhill Park) became the club's home, and it subsequently became the legal property of the club after former player, and ex-Chairman of the club, Evi Thornhill, bequeathed the land to the Club in his Will, with the Club becoming legal owners in 1960. It was to prove an incredibly valuable treasure in future years.

By 1988, the club had fallen on hard times, but fortunately, a handful of committee members led by Gordon King and Gordon Tudor kept the Club afloat. The following season local businessman Paul Chappell arrived. The Club was stabilised and construction of new changing facilities, to County League standard, were completed. Paul Chappell was to remain a vital part of the club until his retirement from his duties in 2020.

As playing standards improved, 2000 saw the completion of the building of a long-awaited Social Club in an area of the ground that in Its old life had housed a cowshed. John Mack, a successful local entrepreneur, joined the club as Chairman, and he remains a committed supporter of the club to this day as Club President. In the summer of 2001, Doug Gray was appointed Manager, and the club began a period of upward momentum.

The team achieved a Runners-up spot in their first season in the Gloucester County League, and were accepted into the Hellenic League. Hellenic Division One West was won by an Eleven Point margin in 2002/03. A creditable fourth place finish was achieved in the Hellenic Premier League in 2003/04. In a marvellous season the club also claimed the Hellenic 'Norman Matthews' Floodlit Cup and the G.F.A. Challenge Trophy.

Floodlights arrived at the ground in the summer of 2003. A pre-season visit from Conference side Forest

Green Rovers on 22nd July, produced a then ground record attendance of 427 to witness the inaugural game under lights at Wisloe Road.

A few weeks later on Sunday 24th August, that ground attendance record was beaten at a Bank Holiday Hellenic Premier Division fixture that was part of the 2003/04 annual 'Ground Hop' weekend. Local rivals Shortwood United provided the opposition in front of a crowd of 525.

Season 2004/05 again saw a fourth-Place finish in the Hellenic Premier. The club also made their first appearance in the F.A. Vase, which resulted in a run to the third round proper before a 2-1 extra time defeat at Western League side Backwell United.

In February 2005, Gray stood down after nearly four seasons at the helm of the club.

The club started season 2005/06 under newly appointed Manager Doug Foxwell. A first entry into the F.A. Cup saw a visit from Wessex League side Wimborne Town. A 1-0 defeat did not dampen the sense of occasion on the first day of the season. A second successful run in the F.A. Vase came to an end in the Third Round Proper, with a 3-1 defeat at South Midland Premier, Welwyn Garden City.

After a record-breaking 64 game season, the team achieved a Fifth-Place finish in the Hellenic Premier, and the club also won the Hellenic 'Norman Matthews' Floodlit Cup and the GFA Challenge Trophy, both for the second time in three seasons.

Season 2006/07 proved to be the most successful in the Club's history to date, with both the First Team and Reserve side recording League and Cup doubles, with the bonus of record-breaking F.A. Cup and Vase runs for the senior side.

In the F.A. Cup, a Five Match run from the Extra-Preliminary Round finished at Merthyr Tydfil in the Third Qualifying Round. Along the way there were memorable wins against two other Southern Premier sides, 2-1 at Yate Town and 3-1 at home to Chippenham Town. It was six matches in the F.A. Vase before defeat was tasted, the run ending in the Fifth Round Proper at home to the eventual winners, Truro City.

In the Hellenic Premier Division, bad weather, which led to a record number of postponements during the subsequently extended season, led to half a Seasons fixture being played in the final two months. A tremendous effort saw the Club Bring the Championship Shield to Wisloe Road, the winning margin being three points over second placed North Leigh.

Opponent's History



Slimbridge

There was a rousing performance in the G.F.A. Trophy Final against Almondsbury Town. A 3-1 victory not only retained the Trophy, but recorded a third success in four seasons in that competition.

The Reserve side had an early success in the Gloucester Northern Senior League Cup with a 2-0 win against Division One Tuffley Rovers. This saw confidence rise and they went on to break a Gloucestershire Northern Senior League record in winning Division Two with a Played 30, Won 30 record.

As a result of winning the league after an inspiring final day victory, and the upgrade to the ground facilities at Wisloe Road, the club were promoted into the BGB Southern League Division One Midlands for Season 2007/08, however, there was a twist to come in the tale.

On July 10th 2007 the club decided not to take up the promotion, and effectively, the first team took over the position in the pyramid occupied by the reserve team, which was disbanded.

The First Team reverted to the Gloucester Northern Senior League. This meant a severe upheaval in the club both on and off the field with the manager Doug Foxwell and several senior players moving on the pastures new.

However, a loyal band of players stayed on including James Cole, who over as player manager with assistance from long term club captain Leon Sterling to begin the next stage of the club's journey.

Four promotions followed as the club regained their previous status. James Cole handed over to Leon Sterling, who moved into the Manager's role, with Leon joined as Assistant Manager by long time Slimbridge stalwart Freddy Ward. The two guided the side to three top six finishes in their first three seasons back in the Hellenic Premier.

After the completion of the 2012-13 season, the Swans applied for a transfer to the Toolstation Western Premier League to reduce prohibitive travelling costs, a move which was approved by the FA in the Summer of 2013.

After two seasons in the Toolstation Western Premier League, a third-place finish at the end of the 2014/15 season gave the Swans a second opportunity to return to the Southern Football League. This time the club accepted the offer and took their place in the South and West Division, finishing a credible 18th in their first season, the highest level the club had ever achieved at that time in their history. Prior to the commencement of that campaign, John Mack had stepped back from Chairman duties and his position was taken up by Barry Gay. At the start of the 2016-17 season, and prior to our pre--season friendly fixture with neighbours Forest Green Rovers, the football ground in Wisloe Road was formally renamed to Thornhill Park in recognition of the marvellous gift we received from Evil Thornhill 46 years earlier.

Evi's son, Tony and his late wife Margaret were on hand to cut the ceremonial ribbon, and Tony made a short heartfelt speech about how much the renaming meant to him and the entire Thornhill family, and how honoured they were that the football club had recognised their father in this way.

A difficult two seasons of struggle at a higher level saw the eventual departure of Leon Sterling as Manager, with Freddy Ward stepping up to the plate, assisted by local footballing legend Lee Driver-Dickerson. With Freddy then stepping aside to concentrate of his last few years of playing having steadied the Swans' ship, 'Drive' took over the reins as Manager of the first team.

The Club's previous ground attendance record was smashed on 4th February 2017, when 898 fans saw the side suffer a 3-0 defeat to Hereford FC, who were working their way back up the league pyramid following their reformation after the collapse of Hereford United

The last 2 years have seen an incredible expansion of the football club— the establishment of a thriving Youth setup at Under 18 level, and the resurrection of the Reserve side has seen Slimbridge AFC make great strides as a club.

Prior to the Covid suspension of football in March 2020, the Under 18s and the Reserves were top of their respective leagues, while the first team were sitting in 12th place in the Southern League Division One South, the highest placing in the history of the football club. Although the FA has made the season's results null and void, they have been officially added to club statistics and all appearances and goals will stand in our records as a permanent tribute to all who represented the club in a fantastic season in the strangest of all campaigns

The Club has gained a great local reputation both on and off the pitch for looking after players and developing them in their careers - Already some of those previously with the club in the last 2 seasons have moved to Conference South level to ply their trade.

It is a tribute to the committed and very talented team of coaches and managers in place at all levels of the club, that the future is very bright indeed for the Swans...

Elementary mistakes have been the downfall for Wootton Bassett Town more often than not when they have lost this season, the lack of thrashings during the course of their campaign attesting to that. And once again they played a role in their 2-1 defeat to promotion chasers Slimbridge, with both of the visitors' goals being very much avoidable.

But the Swans' three points were also influenced by some extremely questionable officiating, which left much to be desired.

The game's main flashpoint came six minutes before the half time whistle when Bassett were denied a stonewall penalty, while Slimbridge escaped not only having to face a spot kick but also playing the rest of the game at a numerical disadvantage.

Expert skill from Sam Packer allowed him to fly past right back Fred Ward with ease, putting the hosts in a three-on-two situation. After advancing down the wing, he slipped a pass inside to Tom Dingle, who was under the close attention of defender Tom Speers. Dingle confidently rolled his marker ten yards from goal, but while he prepared to fire at goal, the defender went to the floor and reached out to block the ball with his hands.

The handball was clear to the majority of the Rylands Way crowd, yet neither the referee nor his assistant managed to spot the blatant infraction, which denied Dave Turner's an obvious goal scoring opportunity.

The incident came at a crucial juncture of the match. Bassett had just survived a quarter hour long Slimbridge onslaught that had seen two efforts cleared off the line.

Still disgusted about the officials' mistake, Bassett lost their composure and found themselves behind in the 43rd minute. Controversy surrounded the goal too, with it appearing as though Ross Langworthy, who got the final touch, was offside. However, a home defence at sixes and sevens played a crucial role too.

Allowing the burly Marvyn Roberts the freedom to latch onto a routine ball over the top left †keeper Stewart Thompson exposed, and the home custodian was duly lobbed. Langworthy then slid in at the left upright to ensure the ball nestled in the back of the net.

The early stages of the first half had been a tentative affair, but the visitors began to assert their dominance, with their first clear chance coming when Ben Wood looped a header just over after a corner had only been half cleared. In the 21st minute, Langworthy had Thompson beaten after shrugging off the attentions of Mark McMeeking, but an acrobatic clearance from Shaun Carter preserved parity.

Craig Bowden was next to dash the visitors' hopes when he scrambled the ball away off the line from a close range Roberts effort, after Thompson could only parry a stinging Langworthy drive.

The defensive heroics continued following the restart too. Rob Hine beat Thompson to Paul Carter's whipped in free kick, delivering a towering header which seemed destined to hit the roof of the net. But a despairing McMeeking headed clear before the loose ball was bundled away, Roberts once again having failed with the rebound.

A fantastic goal fashioned out of nothing then made it 1-1 on 56 minutes. Bowden clipped a clearance down the right wing. Although played more out of defensive necessity rather than an attempt to initiate an attack, it fell perfectly for Dingle, whose intuitive diagonal run allowed him to lose the attention of his marker. Then, after bringing the ball down, he blazed an unstoppable drive from the right edge of the box past Dave Evans at his near post.

Slimbridge appeared rocked with Wood lunging in dangerously on Matt Boucher moments after the goal was scored. It was reckless and two-footed, but somehow he escaped with just a yellow card as punishment.

Soon after, Bassett were punished for lax discipline. A ball over the top split the defence, and Langworthy took full advantage, driving past McMeeking before sending a firm strike from 18 yards past Thompson.

Although once again rattled, Turner's side did not give up the ghost and came close to an equaliser ten minutes from time when Packer weaved his way through the Swans' defence only for his touch to elude him ten yards from goal. His weak effort was deflected by Speers and collected easily by Evans.

Compounding a frustrating afternoon for Bassett was Witney United's convincing win away against Fairford Town. It therefore means the Blanketmen's visit to Rylands Way on Tuesday is of huge importance. There is no better time to break a six game winless league streak.

Scoop's Man of the Match: Tom Dingle – took his goal brilliantly and his intelligent play gave the Slimbridge defence trouble. This was most notable when his hold up play forced Slimbridge defender Tom Speers to take such drastic action and handle the ball. Unfortunately this was not punished..

For the first time in four years, Royal Wootton Bassett Town exited the Emirates FA Cup at the extra preliminary round stage following a 2-0 defeat in a closely fought tie away against Mangotsfield United.

A first half penalty and stoppage time suckerpunch were enough for Mangotsfield to book their place in the preliminary round as, despite a positive performance, Sam Collier's side were unable to make any kind of breakthrough.

It was just the final, crucial end product that the visitors were missing. For large parts of the game Bassett were the better team, but the inability to put away their chances proved costly.

Indeed there was a portent of what was to come after just two minutes when Tom Moore broke through in behind the home defence only to be denied by Mangotsfield custodian Nick Croucher.

It seemed a soft, harsh penalty award, though Walters later admitted it was a definite foul. Either way, Mangotsfield were not complaining and Jadyn Crosbie just about managed to squeeze his spot kick beneath debutant 'keeper Harry Pickering to open the scoring.

It was then close to being 2-0 shortly before half time but Pickering kept out Owen Ridler's effort.



Bassett again had the opening chance of the second half. An almost carbon copy of his earlier opportunity, Moore was able to get in behind the Mangotsfield defence as he latched onto a great through ball but could not find a way past Croucher.

At the other end, Dave Bampton's late, assured challenge was enough to knock Crosbie off his stride and prevent a potential second for the hosts.

Midway through the half substitute Alan Griffin then headed narrowly over from a Louis Spalding cross.

By now Bassett were pushing forward for an equaliser, leaving space for Mangotsfield to threaten on the break and Marcus Kelly almost was able to capitalise from a counter but fired wide.

Kelly went one better in injury time though, steering in a rebound after Pickering had initially made a decent save.

It's therefore Mangotsfield who will go onto visit either Ardley United or Ascot United who drew their tie.

For Bassett it will be an even longer wait to get their league campaign started after Roman Glass St George's contest at Lydney Town ended all square. Bassett's league opener will now be Saturday 12 August at home against Slimbridge.

Last season was an unmitigated success for Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Men's First Team.

In fifteen previous Hellenic League Premier Division campaigns, Bassett had either battled relegation or done little more than make up the numbers, failing to achieve a top half finish.

However 2022-23 was different. Not only did Bassett break their top half duck, but Sam Collier's side proved how competitive they could be in the division, ultimately claiming a fifth place finish. Adding further gloss to the campaign, Bassett matched their record run in the FA Vase, advanced two rounds in the FA Cup and reached the Bluefin Sports Challenge Cup semi finals.

Now, with the slate wiped clean, comes the tricky challenge of aiming to repeat that success.

An already competitive division may be even tougher, while Bassett may have seen a couple of important departures from last season's side.

But given the quality that remains in the squad, there's no reason why Bassett can't seek to replicate last year's achievements - and push for a potential playoff place that a top five finish would yield this time round.

In terms of the competition Bassett will face, even more quality has been added to the mix. Relegated sides Cinderford Town, Slimbridge and Highworth Town arrive hungry to reclaim their Southern League status. Pershore Town come into the Premier Division on the back of an emphatic Division One title winning campaign. Meanwhile fallen giants Worcester City eyeing up a battle with their city rival Raiders - will likely be strong. But having taken points off all but two teams (Corsham Town and Brimscombe and Thrupp) last season, that should not put Bassett off. This is a team that knows they can compete against all opponents they face.

And that confidence can be generated from the strength of the squad Collier has at his disposal. Goalkeeper Matt Crowther (Milton United), attacking midfielder Alfie Presley (Corsham) and forward Matt Bennett (Purton) have moved on.

But the rest of last season's crop have been retained, with the Bassett boss fighting off others to keep the likes of Matt Jones and Louis Spalding who contributed so much to last season's success. Quality has been added with the return of cultured midfielder Sam Packer too.

Tesults and performances during preseason may have been below par. After a comfortable win against Tredworth Tigers (9-2), Bassett lost consecutive games against Trowbridge Town (1-2) and Keynsham Town (1-3). Bassett bounced back to beat Pewsey Vale (2-0) before drawing with Kintbury Rangers (4-4). Two friendlies against Hellenic League Division One opponents followed, with a heavy loss at Devizes Town (0-3) and...

However, the time to deliver is not from July, but from August onwards. Bassett delivered last year - here's hoping Sam and his team can do it again.



It seems like only yesterday when FC Halifax Town's Jack Senior held aloft the FA Trophy at Wembley to signal the end of the 2022-23 season. And what a campaign it was!

At the very top of the pyramid, we'll probably never see of the like again; Wrexham and Notts County trading blows at the top of the National League table, both reaching well in excess of 100 points and scoring well in excess of 100 goals.

The Hollywood juggernaut stationed at the Racecourse Ground reached destination Football League first before the Magpies had to negotiate a few twists and turns in the play-offs before eventually joining them in dock.

Under Phil Parkison and Luke Williams, both sides were absolutely outstanding, raising the bar for the rest to follow.

But it wasn't just the National League which benefitted. A rippling effect from Step 1 all the way down took Non-League football to another level. All of a sudden, it wasn't just Wrexham A-listers Ryan Reynolds and Rob McElhenney getting all the attention, Non-League football had captured a wider audience – and for all the right reasons.

So, with Wrexham and Notts County now switching their focus towards their League Two campaigns – where they are expected to compete at the top end once again – the question is can Non-League football use that platform to push on and raise the bar even further?

Well, it's certainly made an encouraging start. With this week's FA Cup Extra Preliminary Round in mind, nine leagues at Step 5 kicked off the new campaign last Saturday, July 29, drawing in decent crowds up and down the country.

Undoubtedly, the biggest story of the day came at Bury FC, where almost 5,500 turned up to watch the newly-merged model of the old Bury FC and Bury AFC play their first ever league game at the town's spiritual Gigg Lane home for the first time in three years.

The biggest story of the summer, however, has centred around another famous old former Football League club – and sadly not for positive reasons.

At one point, long-suffering Southend United fans feared the club's proud 117-year history may grind to halt this summer amid debts of £2.5 million.

As fans protested outside the home of under-fire owner Ron Martin, the club were given extra time to clear a $\pounds 275,000$ tax debt and efforts to keep the Shrimpers in the National League were being made.

Despite boasting a squad of just 10 senior players at one point, manager Kevin Maher finally got the goahead to begin the club's pre-season preparations and thanks to the hard work of supporters in tidying up the run down Roots Hall ground last weekend, a safety certificate was issued ensuring Southend could at least host their opening day game against Oldham Athletic this afternoon.

Maher, of course, performed miracles in keeping Southend competitive in the top half of the National League last season amid impossible restrictions, but the Shrimpers will need to pull out all the stops once again if the Essex club are to challenge for honours again this time round.

That said, with last season's big two gone, Non-League's top-flight has a much more open look to it this time around with a number of former EFL big guns eyeing a route back into the top four tiers.

Chesterfield has spent well in the summer and will start as favourites, but cash injections at the likes of Oldham, York City and Eastleigh will certainly keep the Spireites on their toes.


Last seasons relegated clubs – Rochdale and Hartlepool United – the former competing in Non-League for the first time – have got their houses back in order and will be desperate for an immediate return, while National League North and South champions, AFC Fylde and Ebbsfleet respectively, have momentum and ambition on their side.

The North, too, is wide open with Scunthorpe United spending big in a bid to put right the wrongs of last season's relegation, similarly Torquay United, Maidstone United and Yeovil Town who make the South division as competitive as it has been in years.

So, in the blink of an eye, August 5th is upon us and battle can at last commence. At the NLP, we feel your anticipation and will be with you every step of the way, taking you through the thrills and spills, the highs and the lows.

It promises to be another cracker so let the games begin.
