Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Worcester Raiders. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made what is a very long journey for a midweek fixture, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening and wish you a safe journey home.

This is only our fourth ever meeting with Worcester Raiders, with the three games so far seeing one win apiece and one game drawn. Our one win came this season in the reverse fixture at Worcester's impressive Warriors Stadium and a report from that game is included in today's programme along with one from the only time we have met at the Sustain Stadium which finished in a 2-2 draw last season.

Worcester Raiders, who started the season as one of the fancied sides, have not had such a good season as last season when they finished in fourth place. currently sit in ninth spot having played 34 games already, more than anyone else in the division. They would need to win all of their remaining games, including tonight's fixture, to have any chance of reaching the play-offs but even that would almost certainly not be good enough given the points they have dropped already. After tonight they have just three games left and we are still in February! Currently, assuming no postponements, they are scheduled to finish their season on Saturday 9th March, which is very early indeed. If their players wish to continue playing into April they will all need to find sides to sign on for in leagues below Step 6 in and around the Worcester area, with most leagues outside the National League System have a registration cut off of 31 March.

Last Tuesday's game away against Cinderford Town was postponed due to a waterlogged pitch and we still await details of the rearranged date at the time of writing these programme notes. On Saturday we visited Mangotsfield for the second time this season, having lost to them in the FA Cup

right at the start of the season. In another close game on this occasion we made sure we did not concede to return with a valuable point in our quest for the play-offs, extending our current unbeaten run to three games. Hopefully we can make that four here tonight.

Looking at our other sides, the Development Team are having a tough time of it of late. On Saturday they went down 1-0 away at Larkhall Athletic Development in what by all accounts was an entertaining game, having also lost 2-0 away at Shrivenham the previous week. That is now four straight defeats in a row, all of which have been away from home for Mark Simpkins side. They are back on home 3G on Saturday and will be hoping they can bring that losing streak to an end when they entertain Calne Town Reserves.

On Sunday, the title hopes of our Women's side were ended when they could only draw 1-1 with Bath City, the point coming courtesy of an injury time equaliser from Natalie Goodright. Whilst disappointing that any chance of the title has finally come to an end the ladies should be proud of the season after last they have had season's disappointing one that had ended in relegation. Adam Wood has certainly done a great job rebuilding the side and generating a good team spirit. The point gained against Bath guaranteed the Women's side of runners-up spot. They will now look to win both their two remaining league games to finish as close as possible to champions Poole who should be congratulated at bouncing back at the first attempt after their own relegation last season. The Women's side will be up against Bath City for the second consecutive week at the Sustain Stadium when Bath visit in the League Cup.

Enjoy the game and hopefully three more points in our quest to make the end of season play-offs.

Worcester Raiders Beware - the Return of Dan Warre



Opponents History Worcester Raiders



Worcester Raiders were formed in 2001 as a youth club, joining the Worcester & District Football League in 2010 upon the formation of a senior side. In 2013, Worcester Raiders joined the West Midlands (Regional) League Division Two, gaining promotion in their first season in the National League System. In 2019, Worcester Raiders won Division One, gaining promotion to the Premier Division. Worcester Raiders entered the FA Vase for the first time in 2020–21. At the end of the 2020–21 season the club were transferred to Division One of the Hellenic League as part of the FA's restructuring of the National League System.

In the 2021–22 season, Worcester Raiders finished second behind Studley F.C. in Division 1 of the uhlsport Hellenic League. Despite a 3-0 loss to Hereford Pegasus F.C. in the playoff final, Worcester Raiders were promoted to the Premier Division of the Hellenic League following the closure of Walton Casuals F.C. in the Southern League Premier South, leading to the reprieve for Merthyr Town and Cinderford Town A.F.C. The result was Worcester were promoted to the Hellenic Premier as runner-up in that play-off.

Worcester Raiders initially played at Claines Lane. On 29 July 2020, English Premiership rugby union club Worcester Warriors confirmed Worcester Raiders would move into Sixways Stadium, with Worcester Warriors' co-owners Colin Goldring and Jason Whittingham becoming joint majority owners of Worcester Raiders in the process. In September 2022 the future of the club was left uncertain after the gates to their ground were locked, as a result of Worcester Warriors' financial problems. This effectively left Worcester Raiders homeless nowhere to play their home matches. However, it was later confirmed that the Raiders had reached an agreement with the administrators to Warriors' Sixways.

Worcester Raiders had a successful first season in the UHIsport Hellenic League Premier Division securing a fourth place finish sandwiched between two Wiltshire Clubs Corsham Town and Royal Wootton Bassett Town.

Saturday 5 November 2022 Resilient Bassett rattle Raiders late to claim point

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Worcester Raiders 2

Time and again this season, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's resilience has stood out as the team's defining characteristic. Unlike in previous years, so far this campaign there has never been a time when Sam Collier's side have been out of a game - even when they have fallen behind.

And that strength was again on show in Bassett's first ever meeting with Worcester Raiders.

After last week's clash with Westfields, this was another tough engagement with the Raiders opening the afternoon in third.

But Bassett - without centre halves Adam Corcoran and Dave Bampton through suspension as well as Matt Bennett, Scott Chilcott, Jack Hobson-McVeigh and Chris Taylor - dug deep, producing another solid display to earn a point.

They did so the hard way too, twice coming from behind in an entertaining 2-2 draw.

Bassett should arguably have been ahead though as Gio Wrona managed to rattle the bar with the goal at his mercy early on after great interplay between Tommy Ouldridge and Matt Jones.

Worcester soon capitalised on that miss, taking the lead through Jordan Murphy who slotted home



from Jade Ferron's fizzing low cross.

While plugging away at the Worcester back line and dealing with what the dangerous Raiders threw at them, it took until midway through the second half for Bassett to draw level for the first time. After Ouldridge won a free kick inside the visitors' half, Jones teased in a delivery which Landon Golding, having lost his marker, met with a glancing header into the corner of the net.

Raiders then made it 2-1 as Joe Billingham was on hand to tap in after Matt Crowther could only parry from Murphy's shot on the turn.

That meant Bassett were again forced to dig deep.

But, with time winding down, they snatched the equaliser and point they deserved in some style.

Veteran Alan Griffin drew a foul around 30 yards from goal, and Jones stepped over the ball. Catching Raiders 'keeper Ryan Young off guard, the left footer steered a delightful low curler around the wall and into the bottom left corner.

It was a fine strike - and one that earned another important, valuable result against one of the division's fancied sides.

Saturday 13 January 2024 Comeback scuttles Raiders

Worcester Raiders 1 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2

Royal Wootton Bassett Town reached the half century mark as a dramatic late comeback earned Sam Collier's side a hugely impressive 2-1 victory away at Worcester Raiders.

A lively fixture whose outcome was always in the balance with both teams pushing the other hard ultimately fell Bassett's way after Alfie Presley converted a somewhat contentious penalty with seven minutes remaining.

While Raiders - whose eighth loss in nine games leaves their Hellenic League Premier Division playoff chances hanging by a thread - felt hard done by the decision, Bassett will care little as their march to the playoffs continued apace.

Collier's team now sit on 51 points, with a healthy ten point cushion separating them from Fairford Town - the team currently occupying sixth and the first team on the outside looking in of a playoff spot.

Even more impressively, third place Bassett - who, if the season finished today would be guaranteed a home playoff semi final - are now seven points clear of Roman Glass St George in fourth. Like most of their 16 league wins to date this season, Bassett's latest triumph was of the hard fought variety.

The visitors started the brighter of the two teams, though Raiders were probing too. And it would be the hosts who found themselves in front when Kyri Kourouyiann rose highest to head home a free kick on 25 minutes.



Raiders took their advantage into the break and held onto it for a healthy part of the second half.

But Tommy Ouldridge eventually equalised on 67 minutes, blasting in after home 'keeper Jack Oxenham could only bay away Bailey Gallagher's low cross into the box.

That set up a tense, exciting finish. Both teams were desperate to find a winner - Raiders to try and keep their season alive, Bassett to further solidify their top five status.

The second half had already been a physical battle and both teams continued to push.

The hosts thought they had the lead with quarter of an hour to go but Jordan Wilkins' effort whistled just past the post.

Soon after they were behind with Bassett awarded a penalty and leading scorer Presley keeping his nerve to ultimately settle the contest.

Bassett now return to the Sustain Stadium for an exciting three game homestand, starting with Tuesday's fixture against Tuffley Rovers and ending with the return match against Westfields on 27 January. Title favourites Worcester City visit next Saturday too for a top of the table clash. That a fixture Bassett are involved in at this stage of the season can be described as such shows just how well the team have been performing. Long may that continue as the campaign nears its closing stages.

Rare goalless draw another step in the right direction


Mangotsfield United 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 0

Royal Wootton Bassett Town edged another point closer to securing a Hellenic League Premier Division playoff place after a 0-0 draw away against Mangotsfield United.

The game may not live long in the memory with both sides cancelling the other out courtesy of strong defensive efforts. But it moved Bassett a step closer towards achieving their goal, while also inching the gap to current fourth place occupiers Fairford Town another point higher following the Reds' heavy Friday night loss at Highworth Town.

The result does represent a first for manager Collier, who prior to the afternoon had never overseen a goalless draw in the league. At the 188th time of asking though that has now happened. Indeed it's a first 0-0 league draw for just over seven years - Bassett's last being at home against Ascot United on 4 February 2017. Collier has been in charge of four cup fixtures that finished deadlocked after 90 minutes. And the most recent was in the Floodlit Cup last season - against Mangotsfield.





IN THE week where the sporting world stood still for the Taylor Swift show (aka, the Super Bowl), our very own live TV showcase was entering the spotlight.

While the pop superstar took centre stage during the most-watched sporting event across the Atlantic, the Football Association here were finalising terms for a four-year, multi-million pound deal with TNT Sports to show the FA Cup from the 2025-26 season.

As part of the agreement, TNT Sports, who have won many plaudits this season for their coverage of the National League and even North and South, will share the rights with a free-to-air broadcaster.

As part of the deal, all games from the third round onwards outside of 3pm kick-offs will be broadcast live, while the Wembley final will be shown on both TNT Sports and free-to-air.

At present, and for the past four seasons, the BBC and ITV currently share rights for the FA Cup and details of the extent of the involvement of free-to-air channels covering FA Cup games will be announced in due course.

TNT Sports, however, insist the deal, reportedly worth £66million-per-year - an increase of 15 per cent on the current deal – "will ensure that the world's longest-running national knockout football competition continues to be as broadly available as possible across the UK".

"Selected matches from every round will be available free-to-air, and highlights of every game will be made available," they said in a statement.

In his NLP column this week, Matt Badcock outlined the pros and cons of the new deal amidst a rather mixed social media reaction with critics suggesting having fewer FA Cup games shown live on free-to-air television hammers another nail in the world's most famous cup competition.

But, as Matt rightly pointed out, FA Cup ties being played behind a 'paywall' is nothing new. Sky Sports, Setanta, ESPN and BT Sport have all had deals in the past with another channel showing games free.

And, let's not forget, games will be free-to-air under this deal too. We just we don't yet know by who.

Suggestions are at least two games per round will be free to view – as well as one semi-final and the final – but, clearly, having stumped up the big bucks, TNT will dictate what they have.

From a Non-League point of view, that won't be such a bad thing if they put National League teams on the games. As mentioned earlier, their coverage of the National League this season has been exemplary.

Far from some of the patronising coverage Non-League often has to put up with in the past, the TNT commentary team led by Adam Summerton and including the likes of very own Adam Virgo and Aaron McLean tell the National League story with knowledge and passion, capturing some of the division's biggest moments as if it were a Champions League final.

Crucially, Matt also points out that while opinion is shared on the deal, the real focus should be on the extra revenue and what it can do.

FA Cup TV money is a key revenue stream for the FA to invest back into the game. A lot of good can be done with it and there are good people at Wembley who know that.


The fall-out from Covid saw the prize pot slashed. Having seen it doubled from previous years, it had to be trimmed back again with the Women's FA Cup – quite rightly – benefitting as a result.

It's vital for the Non-League and lower league game that the FA Cup fund is topped up again - especially in the early rounds where so many clubs have a chance at bringing in money on sporting merit rather than status alone.

We believe Non-League football deserves as many eyes on it as possible. And, of course, some more cash in the kitty.

A Libby Davies hat trick helped Royal Wootton Bassett Town to a 4-2 home victory against Stockwood Wanderers - a result that moves Bassett to within touching distance of securing a top two finish in the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern.

Now though three wins will see Bassett match Poole's points total albeit with a goal difference deficit that would appear insurmountable.

For the third time against Stockwood this season, there were plenty of goals, though Bassett will be a little frustrated that their margin of victory was not as big as it had been in their two previous encounters.

Bassett led as early as the eighth minute. Hannah Gulliver had already had a chance to open the scoring, firing over from an Honor Fraser cross. But Davies was the one to break the deadlock, coolly skipping past the last defender before slotting beyond Katie Whitmarsh in the Stockwood goal.

The home side were dominant the early exchanges but were unable to make the most of the pressure they were exerting.

And Stockwood soon equalised when Lauren Phillips teed up Grace Phillips, whose fine 25 yard effort had the better of Millie Powell and flew into the top corner.

Parity didn't last long though as Davies beat the offside trap and shot off the post and into the net.

She almost had a hat trick within the opening quarter of the game, heading Laura Jefferies' corner onto the post. The rebound fell for Gulliver who couldn't put the ball away from close range with Natalie Goodright also failing to convert when presented with a third bite of the cherry.

The Stockwood goal continued to live a charmed life as a double chance for Davies and Gulliver produced only a corner from which Amber Egerton shot just wide. Jefferies then hit the bar before the offside flag denied Gulliver after she raced onto a Davies through ball and had the ball in the net.

It was a similar story in the second half with more Bassett opportunities, yet no further goals, with Davies hitting the woodwork twice more.

Boasting the slenderest of leads, Bassett had to be on their guard - and Powell did well to save from Jodi May Hall before the home 'keeper tipped a Toni Blenkinsopp shot onto the bar.

Finally though the hosts made it 3-1 just after the hour as Davies head in from a Jefferies corner.

That goal stirred Stockwood into action and Jefferies had to be alert to clear off the line following a corner.

The visitors then reduced the deficit to just one goal again on 73 minutes as Sophie Morgan swung in a cross and Blenkinsopp deftly guided home at the near post.

That set up a potentially nervy ending. But Elliott gave Bassett breathing space, riding Libby Winstone's attempted challenge before tucking away.
