Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Tonight's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League game against Tuffley Rovers. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Gloucester for the game, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening.

After last season's relegation battle, which was ultimately successful, Tuffley Rovers are having a much better season this time round and currently sit in 15th place and have no relegation worries this season with Wantage Town and Lydney Town somewhat cut adrift at the bottom of the table. Tuffley have won seven of their 24 league fixtures so far this season. We were 2-1 winners when the two sides met at Tuffley back in September and, having done the double over Tuffley last season, we now have the better record in games between the two sides, with 12 wins to our account, 11 for Tuffley and nine drawn games. We are also on a healthy winning run against tonight's opponents having won all five of the last five meetings between the two sides. Hopefully that run will continue as we look to maintain our push for the play-offs.

Since the last programme notes we have had three first team games with one win, one draw and one defeat. The drawn game came in our last home game against Cinderford Town where a late equaliser from Ben Dodd gave us a share of the points. This was followed by a narrow 3-2 defeat in the Wiltshire Premier higher level Swindon Shield away at Supermarine. I understand it was a good performance with Alfie Presley getting our two goals but once again that cup final proves elusive. We have one more chance this season in the Floodlit Cup and it is to be hoped that we field another strong side as it is certainly a winnable cup. The final game of the three was Saturday's league encounter away to Worcester Raiders where another good performance saw us come away with all three points following a 2-1 win that saw us open up a seven point gap over Roman Glass St George.

It is congratulations to both near neighbours Highworth Town and Worcester City, who both won through to the last 16 of the prestigious national FA Vase competition on Saturday to give the Hellenic league 12.5% of the last 16. Änother were winner our conquerors Bridgwater United who inflicted the first defeat this season by a Step 5 side on Farnham Town of the Combined Counties League. Until Saturday Farnham's only defeat had come against Southern League Premier Division leaders Chesham United. Having taken Bridgwater to a penalty shootout we could well find we went out to the eventual winners as Farnham were a lot of people's favourites for the cup.

On the subject of congratulations, it is well done to Chris Taylor on joining the "100 Club) with his appearance against Swindon Supermarine in the Wiltshire Premier League.

The Development Team had an impressive win on Saturday inflicting an 8-0 defeat on the side who had knocked us out of the League Cup, Ludgershall Sports. The win consolidated the Development sides fourth placed position in the table.

Since the last programme the Women's side have played twice winning both games to move second in the table behind Poole. A 5-1 away win at Frome Town was followed by a narrow 2-1 win against Shaftesbury, Maddy Elliott scoring with a late winner to keep the promotion ambition on track. The only downside is that Poole keep winning and winning big. They already had a much better goal difference and when they keep racking up such big scores they are making themselves hard to catch. With three games to go we with them dropping somewhere, perhaps our neighbours Purton can do us a favour and complete a league double over Poole.

The U18 team crashed out of the League Cup in midweek losing to Kingsdown for the second time this season.

Enjoy the match and hopefully we will be celebrating three vital points to maintain our push for the play-offs and to keep us in touch with the top two in the table.

Opponents History Tuffley Rovers

Tuffley Rovers • Club History

The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior X Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions



Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.

After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11th, 3rd, 6th and 3rd in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17th. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10th placed finishes, before a 15th place finish in 2018/19. Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17th place).

Since the resumption of full-playing activities, Mustoe has had one full campaign, with the club finishing in 18th place and narrowly avoiding relegation from the Hellenic League Premier Division.

Within ten minutes Bassett were on level terms as a handball in the box earned a penalty, which Matt Jones squeezed past Merchant who guessed correctly.

Bassett then upped the ante, but a second was not forthcoming, while Tuffley posed a threat on the break.

The visitors thus seemed on course to claim a point - until Spalding's strength, composure and attacking instincts sealed victory for Bassett.





LAST WEEK, four clubs flew the flag for the Non-League game in the third round of the FA Cup – and each one of them played their part in an occasion that will live on in history.

Big upsets, ten-man triumphs, last-gasp heartache, and record-breaking crowds, our last-standing quartet were involved in it all.

It embodied what the FA Cup is all about.

But, sadly, if you are a fan of a certain age or if you can't wait up 'til near midnight to watch the highlights on Match of the Day, the chances are the achievements of our fab four may have passed you by.

Of the 32 matches over the weekend, six were broadcast live on TV and a further two on BBC iPlayer and the Red Button.

Sadly, none of these six matches involved our Non-League clubs – in fact Wigan Athletic were the only team not in the top two divisions to feature with their visit of Manchester United taking the Monday night slot.

Along with Chesterfield and Eastleigh, National League South Maidstone United – the lowest-ranked side left in the competition - were handed the graveyard 3pm Saturday slot and only three cameras were at the Gallagher Stadium to witness George Elokobi's men produce the shock of the round in beating League One Stevenage 1-0, sparking a joyous pitch invasion afterwards.

Aldershot Town's trip to West Bromwich Albion was put back to 2pm on Sunday and was shown live by various broadcasters in 39 different countries worldwide. Incredibly, the UK was not one of them.

As well as fans around the country being denied the opportunity watch the FA Cup magic unfold, the clubs cruelly missed out too with each of the 12 teams selected for live coverage receiving a tidy £85,000 on top of their prize money – lifechanging sums for the majority of clubs at our level but pocket change to the Premier League elite.

"Most people are amazed the cameras are not here," said Maidstone co-owner Oliver Ash. "I get that more people support Everton and Crystal Palace so the TV companies think they will get more viewers than Maidstone.

"But it is a shame because the competition is all about games like ours - the lowest-ranked club in the competition against a side that could well be in the Championship next year.

"It would have been wonderful TV. It is all about the magic of the FA Cup - it is so wonderful for the spirit of the club, the community and the town.

"Definitely this is the biggest result in the club's history. We are not going to win it, but more and more the FA Cup is something magic for clubs like ours.

"It may have lost its magic for the top clubs but it has gained its magic for us."

Interestingly, the BBC felt the need to respond immediately to the widespread criticism levied at the two main terrestrial channels by revealing (and even boasting) that the FA Cup third round smashed viewing records over the course of the weekend.

A peak audience of 7.6 million tuned in for Arsenal v Liverpool on Saturday teatime (no surprise there), while the crunch north-east derby between Sunderland and Newcastle United shown on ITV at lunchtime will have attracted similar numbers.

But I would have loved to have seen, however, the audience figures for Crystal Palace v Everton on Thursday night (what's that about?) or even Tottenham Hotspur v Burnley 24 hours later – two dire games of football which had no place heading the line-up on third round weekend.


As I write this, the TV slots haven't yet been selected for the fourth round, but I suspect the TV companies will attempt to appease the disgruntled Maidstone fans by featuring their trip to Championship high-fliers Ipswich Town in some form or another.

For Eastleigh, the sky's the limit if they can beat Newport County in Tuesday night's replay with a blockbuster home tie against 12-time holders Manchester United awaiting the winners.

Whoever comes out on top in that now colossal tie at the Silverlake this week must surely earn top billing for fourth round weekend on January 27-28. Won't they?

Great play from Hemsley then failed to find its reward as she was denied by Stranger.

Bassett thus seemed on course for a draw. That was Jefferies played a one-two with Gulliver and delivered a superb cross to Morse. Morse's shot was rather tame but Stranger could only parry and Elliott was on hand to gladly stroke home.

There was to be one late scare when Poppy Failes found herself one-on-one with Powell but, superbly, the Bassett 'keeper foiled her.

That was the last chance of note and, despite not being near their best, Bassett had got the job done.
