Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON

welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Wantage Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey along the M4 from Wantage, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon.

As you will read elsewhere in the programme, our record against Wantage Town is not a good one and the last time (and only time) we defeated Wantage here in a game at Bassett was at the start of the millennium when the Head of Senior Section and the two oldest members of the Bassett Ultras were playing for the First Team. Our record against them under Sam has seen an improvement with two wins in the last three meetings but we still only have that one home win against Wantage and it is about time we improved that record.

By their own high standards Wantage are having a very difficult season and could well suffer their second relegation in three seasons having been relegated from the Southern League at the end of Season 2021-22. They currently sit bottom of the table with just ten points from their opening 27 games. Their only wins this season have come against Lydney Town (twice) and Westfields. They are seven points adrift of second from bottom Lydney Town and a further five points behind Thornbury Town who sit third from bottom. With just eleven games to play, including games against Worcester City, Corsham Town, Slimbridge and Roman Glass St George, as well as this game here this afternoon against a side sat third in the table, Wantage have some difficult fixtures to come and it is going to be hard to beat the drop. That said, we cannot take a win for granted here this afternoon, especially given our poor home record against them. We will need to make sure we are at our best this afternoon to make sure that they have to get the points for safety against the other sides challenging for promotion.

For us there are now just nine games to go in our quest for the play-offs, six of which are at home where our record continues to be very good, with just two defeats in the 13 league games played to date. As noted on Tuesday night, there are also some difficult fixtures to

come for us with Worcester City, Corsham Town and Fairford Town yet to visit the Sustain Stadium, but we just need to focus one game at a time and accumulate as many points as possible. Near neighbours Fairford Town are looking strong contenders now for the play-offs and it could be very interesting (and good for gates) if the four teams in the play-offs end up being ourselves, Corsham Town, Highworth Town and Fairford Town.

I was reading my Non-League Paper last Sunday and nearly choked on my cup of coffee when I saw that there was a contribution in there from Pete Yeardley on sin-bins and the latest innovation of a blue-card (see next page for extract from the paper). I must say I had to agree with Pete's analysis on sin-bins, which in my view need to be used in the Premier League and EFL down if they are to really have the desired impact in eradicating dissent. The addition of cynical fouls to what can lead to a sin-bin offence just gives another matter that would be widely open to interpretation and cause more issues than it would solve.

Looking at our other sides, the Development Team will look to return to winning ways today when they make the short trip to Shrivenham a side who last season were playing in the Hellenic Premier Division. Having won at home, Mark Simpkins side will be looking to complete a league double. The Women's side are back here at the Sustain Stadium when they entertain Stockwood Wanderers, a side they have beaten twice already this season. Now that the pressure of having to win every game and by lots of goals has effectively been lifted hopefully the ladies can relax and enjoy themselves more in their remaining games. As noted in Tuesday night's programme, it does seem a little harsh that just one promotion place is available from the division when both Poole and ourselves had been relegated from the Premier Division at the end of last season.

Enjoy the game and hopefully three more points in our quest to make the end of season play-offs and a further improvement in that record against Wantage Town under Sam Collier.

Opponents History Wantage Town



Wantage Town FC (the 'Freds') can trace its roots back to 1877, but the established date of 1892 has long been given as the first time the club affiliated to the Berks & Bucks FA. between the Reading flitted Temperance, Swindon & District, North Berks and Reading & District Leagues prior to the First World War, and the first silverware came in 1903-04 with winning the Swindon Advertiser Cup, a feat repeated in 1907-08 as well as becoming Swindon League Champions and the League Cup winners.

After the 1st World War, the Freds briefly played in the North Berks League, winning the North Berks Cup in 1920 and 1921 and the Championship in 1921-22. After a brief period playing in the Reading & District League with no success they then re-entered the Swindon & District League, winning the Division 2 title in 1931-32, and Division 1 in 1933-34. The Fifties was the most successful period for the Club, winning the S&DL Division 1 in 1952-53 (without losing a game) and the Premier Division in 1955-56, while in 1954-55, the Fred's won no fewer than five cup competitions, including the Berks & Bucks Intermediate Cup.

Since joining the Hellenic League in 1956, the Fred's have spent most of their seasons in the Premier Division, winning promotion from Division 1 on six occasions - as runners -up in 1969-70, 1987-88, 1991-92 (where they set a club record of 32 games unbeaten) and 1995-96, and as Champions in 1980-81 and 2003-4. The Reading Senior Cup was won for the first time in 1982-83.

Season 2003/2004 was one of the Fred's most successful. The First Team won Division One East to regain its position in the Premier Division of the Hellenic, and the Reserves finished top of their league, also winning promotion. In 2010-11, the Fred's won the Premier division title, but they were not promoted to the Southern League due to

ground grading criteria not being achieved. In the 2012-2013 season, the club achieved the Southern League Ground grading, but finished runners-up to a very strong Marlow side, and again missed out on promotion.

In 2013-2014, the Fred's won the uhlsport Hellenic Premier title again, and this time with the appropriate ground grading in place, saw promotion to Division One (South and West) of the Southern League. The Fred's remained in the Southern League for 3 years, before seeing relegation back to the Hellenic League at the end of the 2016-17 season. In 2018-19, the Fred's won the uhlsport Hellenic Premier title for the third time and regained their place in the Southern League, this time in the Division 1 Central section. The Reading Senior Cup was won for a further two times, in 2017-18 and 2018-19.

The following two seasons at the higher level were not completed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but they finished bottom at the end of 2021-22 and were relegated back to the Hellenic.

Throughout the years the Club has worked to upgrade the facilities at Alfredian Park. Purchased outright for the princely sum of £500 in 1922; floodlights were introduced in 1996 and new stands in 2012. The club merged with the junior section to become one entity in 2020, and re-introduced a Women's team in 2015, meaning football is now offered from U7s through to adults for players of both genders. The club has a long lease on St Mary's field behind the club, use of the adjacent school field, and another site at Tugwell to accommodate the growing number of teams.

Wantage Wins

Our record against today's visitors does not make pretty reading with just six wins in 27 previous games between the two sides. Somewhat surprisingly there has never been a single drawn game in those previous 27 meetings. Whilst overall our record is not very good, Sam did finally end our miserable run of ten straight defeats against Wantage with a win just before Christmas last season. Prior to that our last win had come wayback in September 2010! We also won the away game at the beginning of this season, winning 4-0 at Wantage to make it two wins in a row.

Whilst we have won two of the last three meetings and Wantage's league position would have us down as favourites here today we should not take anything for granted. We have only ever won just the one time at home against Wantage Town and that win came way back in January 2001 when goals from the current Head of the Senior Section Paul Davis and Lee Stoddart secured a 2-0 win. Also in the squad that day were two of the Bassett Ultras who will this afternoon spend much of the night behind the two goals we are attacking, Simon Green being in the starting line up for that last (and only) home win with Simon Jones on the bench as an unused substitute.

Whilst for Royal Wootton Bassett Town as a whole we cannot look back at games against Wantage Town with any fondness, at least manager Sam Collier can be excluded from that, as the current manager scored both goals in a 2-1 success over Wantage Town back in Season 2010-11 and managed the side to those two away league wins this and last season.

Hopefully we can continue this improvement in fortunes against Wantage under Sam here this afternoon.

This time Luke Softley rose to connect with the midfield talisman's delivery and the centre half's close range header left visiting 'keeper Harvey Moroney with no chance.

Longlevens were lucky too that their margin of defeat was not any higher. Bailey Gallagher had the misfortune of hitting the bar three times in the second half - once with a curling free kick from the right side, once with a powerful left foot drive from the edge of the area and once with a header. A few inches lower and he would have wrestled sole possession as Bassett's second leading scorer for the season. Instead, Hobson-McVeigh and Connor Waldon currently share that position.

Bassett now turn their attentions to the visit of basement side Wantage Town on Saturday. Win that - as they should be expected to do - and Collier's team will have reached the sixty point mark.

65 was enough for fifth place last year. And with the race for the remaining playoff places behind Bassett a tight one featuring multiple teams, a similar total may be enough to secure a postseason spot this time round.





THE role of Non-League football club chairman is an unforgiving one at the best of times.

Making sure the manager is happy, the fans are satisfied and the hard-working staff or volunteers have got all they need, it's all about keeping the ship sailing on the right course. Well, for Oldham Athletic chairman Frank Rothwell that has quite literally been the case.

By the time you read this, the 73-year-old – yes SEVENTY THREE – should have completed his epic row across the Atlantic Ocean from the Canary Islands to Antigua. It's all to raise money for Alzheimer's Research UK – as he told The NLP last week, while stranded 400 miles off the Antigua cost waiting for change in the weather!

"We've had terrible conditions for ocean rowing," Rothwell reported back.

"Three years ago, I completed this journey in 56 days. This time I expected to finish in 49 days but we're now on day 51 and I've still got 400 miles to go!

"I'm going backwards now because the wind has changed direction and is blowing me the wrong way. I'm in a big current which is very contrary to the direction I was going, which is a bit of a pain."

Indeed, it's been far from an easy ride for the Latics chief, who has lost personal items at sea, capsized no fewer than three times and suffered both nausea and motion sickness. However, for a man who left school aged 14 to repair tractors, then built a multi-million-pound business, has overcome prostate cancer and rescued his hometown club Oldham from bankruptcy after their relegation from the Football League in July 2022, he will not let these problems deter him.

"It's hard on the body, and really hard on the mind, particularly when you start going backwards," he adds. "The boat has rolled over three times! Hopefully the wind will change, but at the moment I'm 400 miles from Antigua sat here on an anchor.

"I throw a parachute and 100m of rope in the sea that holds the boat in this position against the sea."

It's in those moments Rothwell can think of the difference he is making in undertaking his

mission. Rothwell is raising money for Alzheimer's Research UK in their bid to fund research to combat dementia. It's a cause close to Rothwell's heart having lost his best friend, brother-in-law, and several close friends and relatives to dementia in recent years.

Last year, he raised £1.1 million and has so far collected £220,000 of his £1 million target with the football club backing his bid from the confines of Boundary Park.

"Dementia is becoming far more prevalent as we're becoming older nations," Rothwell explained.

"I'm 73 and rowing an ocean solo at an age where our parents' generation died, so more people are living to old age and catching dementia.

"My best friend Phil died of Alzheimer's, my brother-in-law Roger died when I was at sea last time, there's five people in the last four years who are friends or relatives who have died from it.

"There's more people dying of dementia than of any other disease in the UK, we all want to do some good if we can do for a cause.

"I've found a cause that I'm attached to and people are supporting me and donating very heavily."

Rothwell helped save his hometown National League club from the brink of extinction in 2022 and the fanbase, in turn, have rallied behind his charitable work.

Players wore Alzheimer Research UK's logos during Oldham's recent victory against Hartlepool United with the club also raising £12,000 through a kit auction.


And on February 24, the Latics are opening their doors for just £1 a ticket for their game against Kidderminster Harriers in order to give Rothwell a hero's welcome.

"I can't wait to come and meet all the fans and have a pint in the bar, and say hello to everyone," he smiles. "One thing I'm missing is my wife's dinner, all my family, and all of the supporters, and I can't wait to see you all again, give you a wave and shake hands."

And with Poole Town winning 3-0 at home against Stockwood Wanderers in their penultimate match, that means that the Dolphins will be confirmed as champions if they triumph when they face Purton next week. Given their massive advantage on goal difference, a draw should probably suffice for the Dolphins too.

Knowing they had to win, Bassett started the game with intent but, despite knocking on the door, were unable to fashion any early clear cut chances.

A dangerous Emma Sykes delivery did force visiting 'keeper Issy Heybourne to make an alert save. But it was the visitors who had the first shot on goal as Millie Powell denied Bianca Osborne.

Osborne and teammate Bianca Redding shot straight at Powell again as the visitors posed a threat.

But the better chances were falling Bassett's way as Hannah Gulliver turned her marker, firing just wide from the edge of the area.

Eventually Bassett got their noses in front ten minutes before the interval as a fine turn from Libby Davies opened up space for her to produce an exquisite shot into the top corner.

It was a lead Basset took into the break - and both sides came out after half time with the aim to grab the all-important second goal.

A lively opening ten minutes saw Annie Redding stride into the Bassett box but she could only shoot into Powell's arms. At the other end, a last ditch tackle denied Davies when seemingly through on goal before Powell did brilliantly to parry from Kaydee Thornicroft, whose rebound effort was placed wide.

The game eventually settled down though and Bassett were the team again looking most dangerous. Holly Baker twice came close from a pair of Laura Jefferies deliveries. Davies then narrowly struck over.

The failure to convert those chances then proved costly as Weymouth equalised with twenty minutes to go. Unable to clear a corner at the first attempt, the ball dropped for Emily Screen who swivelled and arrowed a low drive into the corner of the net.

Bassett responded to the equaliser and piled on the pressure in the closing stages. Alas, the hosts ran out of time. Caily Morse's dangerous ball into the box flashed across the face of goal when all it seemingly needed was a touch. Davies steered wide from a Jefferies free kick. Then in the dying moments a corner caused chaos in the Weymouth box but somehow the visitors were able to survive.

For Bassett it's a case of what if following only the third league game all season in which they have dropped points. With just nine teams in the division and one side guaranteed promotion, fine margins were always going to prove vital though - and so they have proven, potentially to Bassett's detriment as they sought to bounce back to tier five at the earliest opportunity.


