Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin

Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Brimscombe & Thrupp. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Gloucestershire, we hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this afternoon and wish you a safe journey home.

Brimscombe & Thrupp are one of a number of sides in the division who still have a lot of games to play. In fact they have the most of any side in the division with 12 games still to play and it is certainly going to be a busy end to the season for them, playing up to three games a week some weeks. Their squad is not that large, with just 31 players being used so far this season, so it is going to be a tough period for them between now and the end of the season. Whilst these play-offs are an exciting end to the season, the need to have games finished by an early date in April is taking away a period when the pitches are normally in good condition and fitting more into a period when pitches are notoriously bad, and some teams are suffering the combined effect of this truncated season and the bad weather, Brimscombe being one such side.

Last Friday night's win over Fairford Town was a very important result after those defeats to Worcester Raiders and Corsham Town. If we can record another victory here this afternoon it will put us in a strong position in terms of those play-offs. It is not going to be easy though as in recent times Brimscombe have become something of a bogey side for us. That said we did win at Brimscombe back in November to record our tenth victory over Brimscombe to their 13 victories with four games having been drawn. Brimscombe themselves still have an outside chance of making the play-offs but would

need to win all their games in hand to put themselves into a position to realistically challenge for a play-off spot.

Last weekend the Development Team saw their short trip down the road to Malmesbury Victoria Development postponed due to ongoing issues with the Malmesbury pitch, caused by this winter's wet weather. The Development Team now have just six games to play with five of them being away from home and have played the second highest number of games in the division, showing the advantages of the 3G pitch. They are next back in action next Saturday when they take on Calne Town Reserves who they beat 2-0 in their last outing a fortnight ago.

On Sunday the Women's side certainly enjoyed their trip to the seaside, returning from Weymouth with all three points following a hard fought win. They are without a league game this coming weekend and are back in league action a week tomorrow when they entertain Shaftesbury in their final league game of the season. A win would see them finish just two points behind champions Poole.

The First Team are next in action here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground a week on Tuesday when Worcester City will be our visitors. We are expecting the champions elect to bring a large crowd with them that evening which should help boost further our average league date this season which is already higher than last season's average boosted by the recent crowds for the two games against Corsham Town and Fairford Town.

Enjoy the game and hopefully three more points in our quest to make the end of season play-offs.

Brimscombe have always been somewhat of a bogey-team for us but hopefully we will be able to claim a rare double over them today.

Today is an important fixture in our endeavour to reach the play-offs and confidence should be high following our derby victory over Fairford last Friday. Although the performance was not a classic, the result was with Bassett looking the only team wanting the victory. That result was even more important following the cruel defeat in the dying minutes by Corsham and the under-whelming performance against Worcester Raiders.

With Worcester City's inevitable march towards the title, positions in the play-offs are getting tight. Ourselves, Corsham, Highworth, Cinderford and Slimbridge currently looked best placed to take one of the 4 places but with the number of games remaining Brimscombe can still claim a spot but will be playing every few days if they are to get there.

After today we finish our home fixtures with the visit of Worcester City, no doubt a large

crowd can be expected, especially if they have the opportunity to win the league that evening. We then finish the regular season with tricky away games against Slimbridge and Cinderford before hopefully embarking on our play-off adventure.

The women's team, having secured runners-up spot will be looking to end the season with some silverware having reached the ¼ final of the league cup having beaten Bath in the previous round.

The Dev were without a game last week following the inevitable postponement of their game at Malmesbury.

The U18 floodlight team's season is drawing to an end with one game remaining. Although top of the table after their victory at Radstock last week, a backlog of fixtures for other teams will ultimately mean they finish out of contention.

Off the pitch, the order has now been placed for the new stand to be positioned behind the goal at the kiosk end with construction hopefully finishing by the end of May. Other projects are still under consideration

Play-Off Picture After Last Week's Win Over Fairford Town

After last week's round of fixtures, Royal Wootton Bassett Town remain in third in the Hellenic League Premier Division - with their playoff hopes very much strengthened.

Last Friday's important 1-0 derby victory against fourth place Fairford Town, combined with draws for Slimbridge (1-1 against new leaders Corsham Town) and Cinderford Town (1-1 against Worcester Raiders) as well as defeat for Roman Glass St George (0-1 away at Highworth Town) means Sam Collier and his side have extended their advantage over four of the teams chasing them.

Indeed only Highworth were able to maintain pace with Bassett on what could prove a decisive round of matches.

Highworth are eight points behind and, with five games in hand, are well placed to climb

above Bassett into third place (a position that comes with the guarantee of a home playoff).

The Worthians still have to win most of the games in hand they possess though - which will be a tough challenge in a highly competitive division.

Despite Corsham going to the top of the table, they remain likely to finish as runners-up behind Worcester City. The Quarrymen are now just a win away from guaranteeing at least a playoff finish though.

Behind them it seems like Bassett are one of six teams fighting for the other three spots. Collier and co are very much well placed - and a win at home against Brimscombe and Thrupp today will only strengthen their credentials even further.



Opponents History

Brimscombe & Thrupp



Brimscombe A.F.C. was founded in 1886 – the same year as the Gloucestershire Football Association!

The G.F.A. friendlies were played until the competitive league was formed in 1890. In 1902 the Stroud League was founded and Brimscombe were its first winners. Just after the First World War the Northern Senior League appeared. Its first season was 1922 and once again Brimscombe were the very first champions. Football was interrupted during the Second World War (1939–1945) but the game continued at 'The Meadow' where matches between the Army, Navy, Air Force and a team called 'Brimscombe Wanderers' took place.

When the Gloucestershire County League was first formed in 1968/9, Brimscombe – affectionately known as "The Lilywhites", were again founder members, along with other local sides Forest Green Rovers and Stonehouse Town. In 1973/4 The Lilywhites, amid some controversy, found themselves back in the Senior League, just failing by one vote to secure a place in the Hellenic League.

It was at this time the Club experienced a difficult period and in the late 1970's Brimscombe and Thrupp amalgamated to secure both Club's futures. The Club hit a purple patch in the 1980's and won the Senior League Division One and Two and the County Cup all in the space of three seasons, eventually being promoted back to the County League and finishing 4th in 1987. There then followed many years of varying fortunes for the club including relegation to the lower leagues.

However, in 2008 there were major changes to the Club Committee and the Football Management which immediately brought a successful period for the club. In season 2008/9 the First Eleven managed by Phil Baker were Runners-up to Longlevens and were promoted once again into the County League for the third time in its History.

In 2011 Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. won the Gloucestershire County League for the first time and gained promotion to the Hellenic League under Phil Baker. Since promotion major redevelopments of the ground have taken place including an extension to the clubhouse and the installation of floodlights.

Season 2012/13 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. win the UHlsport Hellenic League Division 1 West and gain acceptance into the Premier League. More ground improvements were undertaken which included a new 100 standing/100 seating stand and further walkways around the pitch.

Season 2013/14 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp F.C. playing in the highest league in the clubs history, the ground improvements were complete with the new stand finished and other improvements made. The club experienced its first ever F.A. Vase football and were quite successful reaching the first round proper. The season was also made memorable with the First XI winning three cup finals – those being the Stroud & District Charity Cup, the Hellenic League Flying Press Floodlit Cup and the Hellenic League Supplementary Cup.

Season 2014/15 was another historic occasion with the side playing in the F.A. Cup for the first time in its history. The club continued to go from strength to strength during season 2015/16 and saw the team end in fifth position, its highest league finish in its history. The upgrade of the club continues with works being carried out as required by Step 5 football. 2016/17 was another great season for the club when we appeared in three cup semi finals and saw the club have their best FA cup to date, eventually losing in the third qualifying round at Weymouth.

Season 2017/18 saw Brimscombe & Thrupp win the GFA Trophy for the first time in its history and finish sixth place in the League.

Season 2018/19 saw us reach our highest league position in the clubs history, however, second place was not enough to see us gain promotion.

Season 2019/20 was virtually wiped out by the Covid pandemic which affected all levels of football throughout the country this continued into season 2020/21 which also had restrictions put on us. Season 2021/22 gave us a season with Covid restrictions which in most cases were lifted, it was in this season we once again made the GFA Cup final, however, disappointingly lost, but once again we finished the season in a creditable ninth place. Season 2022/23 again saw us finish in 9th place.

Bassett suffer at hands of bogey side Brimscombe

For Bad days at the office have, thankfully, been few and far between for Royal Wootton Bassett Town this season – but this was perhaps the worst yet.

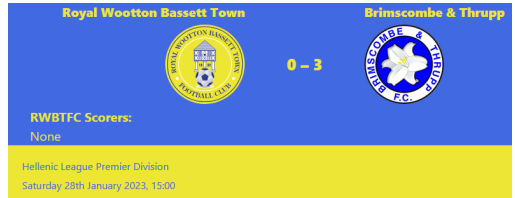
A miserable first half in which visitors Brimscombe and Thrupp scored three times and Bassett were reduced to ten men, as well as a generally disjointed performance, condemned Sam Collier's side to their heaviest league loss of the current campaign. The 3-0 defeat doesn't do Bassett any favours as they fight for their highest ever finish while in the Hellenic League Premier Division. With their victory, Brimscombe – although three places below in eleventh – were able to close the gap between the teams to five points, with the Gloucestershire side still with a game in hand to play.

However, after the impressive – but perhaps unexpected – home draw with leaders Malvern Town and win away at Westfields earlier in the month, finishing January with four points is probably in line with expectations. It's just it would have been preferable to have increased that haul by taking something from a game that, on paper, was certainly winnable.

Brimscombe have been Bassett's bogey side of late though. Heading into the match, Bassett had won just two of their most recent twelve league meetings. And that dismal run continued with this disappointing loss. The decisive moment of the match came half an hour in when Jon Beeden was dismissed for an off the ball incident with Adam Price in the penalty area. By this point, Brimscombe already led 1-0 courtesy of a fierce 25-yard strike from 'Oliver Barnes' that the forward conjured out of nothing just twelve minutes in.

The last thing Bassett therefore needed was to gift their visitors a chance to double their lead while at the same time putting themselves at a numerical disadvantage. But that's what the experienced Beeden's rash, needless outburst achieved, with Barnes coolly sending Matt Crowther the wrong way from the spot after the dust had settled. The incident sucked the life out of Bassett too. Although they had trailed, Bassett were well in a game that produced chances at both ends. It was a contest that lacked proper quality, but had nonetheless been relatively entertaining as neither midfield took a firm grip on the game.

Bassett had been fortunate not to have trailed after just eight minutes when Price somehow skewed wide with an open goal at his mercy after Crowther spilled a Barnes shot. Moments before



Brimscombe's opener, the visitors were fortunate that Bailey Gallagher's shot from a dangerous area was deflected.

Then between Brimscombe's first and second goals, there was a flurry of openings. A last-ditch block from Adam Corcoran foiled Barnes after he had blocked Beeden's attempted clearance and charged towards goal. At the other end, a firm Matt Bennett drive was batted away by Dan Brabham. Brimscombe were next to go close with Jonty Welch forcing Crowther to save on the dive. The visitors soon survived a let off when an incisive move involving Louis Spalding and Bennett created space for Alfie Presley to shoot, but he could only drag wide.

But the sending off and penalty abruptly changed things. Although Bassett felt they had a good shout for a penalty of their own shortly after when Scott Chilcott was bundled over by Price, Brimscombe soon took advantage of their extra man. And their third goal came in some style with Price feeding Tom Black, whose fine turn on the edge of the box fooled his marker, allowing the gangly forward a one-on-one with Crowther from which he made no mistake.

Holding such a commanding lead gave Brimscombe margin for some error after the restart. But they still sought to turn the screw on Bassett even further, passing up four good chances before the hour mark. First, an unmarked Barnes hurried a shot that Crowther was able to hold on the dive. Welch narrowly missed the target with a thirty-yard drive before Dean Turner skewed wide of an open goal after a twisting run from Barnes. Black then stabbed wide at the left post from a Sam Folkes cross. Bassett did step up a gear in the final half hour. And during that time it certainly wasn't obvious that one team was playing a man short. Bassett's best chance came when Gio Wrona's precise pass in between three defenders picked out Bennett at the far post, but his first-time effort from close range rattled the bar.

Later on, Matt Jones forced an awkward save from Brabham with a 25-yard free kick, while Kai Robinson headed narrowly over from a Jones corner. Ultimately though, a consolation was not forthcoming, a disappointing, forgettable afternoon finishing with Bassett pointless and goalless.

Case settles derby as Bassett clinch vital victory

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Fairford Town 0

Oliver Case scored the only goal of the game as Royal Wootton Bassett Town earned a crucial Friday night derby victory against fellow Hellenic League Premier Division playoff contenders Fairford Town. With both teams having dropped points in recent weeks and entering their final five games of the season, their meeting at the Sustain Stadium was one neither team could afford to lose.

A high stakes encounter, the pressure was therefore on – and it was Bassett, much to the relief of manager Sam Collier, who were able, just, to deliver the goods. As was perhaps to be expected given what was seemingly at stake for both teams, it was a nervy contest devoid – at least in the opening period – of much real quality. And it was no real surprise that the first half finished goalless. For Bassett, Kyle Tooze drove a long range effort over after a driving run forward from midfield, while captain Adam Corcoran skewed a header off target from Tommy Ouldridge's free kick delivery.

At the other end Fairford's best openings fell to leading scorer Jamal Lawrence. But on both occasions he miscued. His first chance came when a short corner caught Bassett off guard. Harrison Edwards fizzed a low ball into the box which struck Lawrence, lurking on the edge of the six yard box, and fortunately ricocheted safely out of play. He then raced between Corcoran and Case to latch onto a through ball in behind the defence but could only drag a poor effort off target from 18 yards. Both Bassett 'keeper Rob Brown and Fairford shotstopper Ben Mitchell were therefore spectators in the opening half. And while Brown would continue to play such a role after the restart, Mitchell became busier as Bassett upped their game. And three corners in quick succession almost yielded an opening goal.

The latter of that trio saw Ouldridge play short into the feet of Tooze. And, after easily rolling Ellis McSharry, his low ball across the face of goal caused panic. Will Davidson initially blocked on the line from Case's snap shot. But the ball went out only as far as Ouldridge, who had ghosted into the

area, and his powerful left foot strike from 15 yards was headed over by the same player to keep the ball from flying into the top corner.

Debutant Elliot Dugan then clipped narrowly over after racing onto Sam Packer's defence splitting pass as the hosts continued to seem most likely to score. Bassett's pressure eventually paid off with just over twenty minutes remaining. Ouldridge swung a fine corner into the heart of a crowded six-yard box and Case got in front of Mitchell to head home from close range. It could soon have been two as Dugan squared for an unmarked Tooze, but Mitchell acrobatically tipped over the bar. Mitchell then had to be alert to save from Ouldridge after he had been set up by Dugan.

Despite having to chase the game, Fairford were unable to really threaten Bassett. And frustration crept into the visitors' game, which eventually boiled over when substitute Tom Chamberlain received his marching orders for contesting the referee's initial decision to send him to the sin bin.

The Fairford man would quickly embarrass himself as, despite the referee's instructions to leave via the other side of the pitch, he opted to take the long way round before taking a swipe at the pitch side barrier and the corner flag.

All that needless drama emerged after Chamberlain had contested the initial decision of the assistant referee to award a free kick against him for a soft foul deep in Bassett territory. Having to face ten men certainly benefited Bassett. And for the remainder of the game, Collier's team kept their discipline and focus, seeing time out to clinch not only a season double over their rivals but also what could be a hugely vital three points. While only four games now remain, there is still much work for Bassett to do. Realistically, Collier and his team need at least another four points to maximise their chances of qualifying for the playoffs. Yet, they will need to dig deep to get the points they need in the fixtures they have left.

Brimscombe and Thrupp are next up. The Lilywhites may be mired in the bottom half of the table. But they have been a bogey side for Bassett in recent seasons and were comfortable winners on their last visit to the Sustain Stadium. Title favourites Worcester City follow in the final home fixture of the season before testing visits to Slimbridge and Cinderford Town – who are both also hunting for a top five finish. The Fairford victory may have settled some nerves. But the pressure is still on.

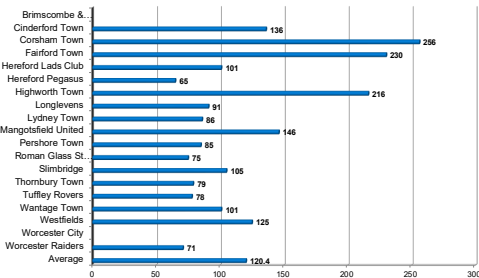

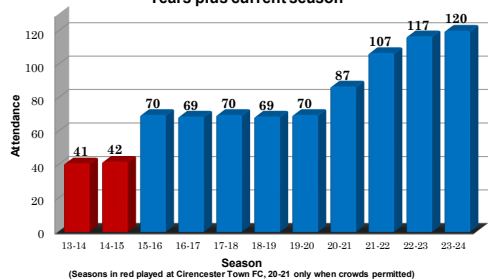

NON-LEAGUE talent will be showcased not once but twice to the nation in the next week – and it sets us up nicely for what promises to be an exhilarating finale to the domestic season. Next Saturday, March 23, sees the return of Non-League Day, where the international break gives our clubs the chance to take centre stage and promote the importance of affordable volunteer-led community football.

Before that, though, it's the turn of England C to take their pride of place when they head down to Llanelli Town's Stebonheath Park on Tuesday for their now annual fixture with Cymru C.

This year marks the 22nd year that former Barnet and Stevenage boss Paul Fairclough takes the Three Lions helm – and the 74-year-old has carefully selected a highly competitive 16-man squad for the fixture, plus a 10-man contingency squad.

Mindful of the stage of the season and club commitments, Fairclough has adopted a one-player-per-club policy and has been able to select an open-age group.

Chesterfield captain Jamie Grimes has been picked for the first time at the age of 33, as has the National League's top goalscorer, Eastleigh goal machine Paul McCallum, at 30.

Worthing hot-shot Ollie Pearce is one of two Step 2 players to be selected after scoring 33 goals in National League South this season. He joins Chester goalkeeper Wyll Stanway, whose sister Georgia is an England Lioness.

Competing with Stanway for the starting No.1 jersey is Bromley stopper Grant Smith, who returns having earned his first England C cap in the first fixture at Barry Town United in 2018 when Fejiri Okenabirhie smashed a hat-trick in a 3-2 thriller. There's also a return for Southend United defender Gus Scott-Morriss, who played in the 1-0 win over Mark Jones' side at Altrincham 12 months ago.

This will be the fifth instalment of the annual fixture but Fairclough's men will be looking to avenge their last visit across the Severn bridge, back in March 2022, when they were comprehensively beaten 4-0 in Caernarfon.

But Tuesday night's Cymru C game is not the only fixture on the Lions' calendar this year.

Fairclough's men will also be hosting a historic and groundbreaking international fixture against Nepal at Aldershot Town's EBB Stadium on Bank Holiday Monday May 6.

This prestigious event has been made possible

by a Tri-Party agreement signed by Aldershot Town FC, The FA and the All Nepal Football Association after the Shots helped raise funds of over £30,000 to help build two schools in Nepal following the devastating earthquake of 2015.

Laurence Jones, Head of National League System at The FA said: "We are delighted to be welcoming the All Nepal Football Association to England as part of our friendship visit in May.

"Football has the unique power to bring communities together and it will be fantastic to engage with the large Nepalese community that live in the area, as well as the Gurkha Regiments based at the Aldershot Garrison.

"We look forward to welcoming everyone to the community events and football matches, in what promises to be a great occasion for all."

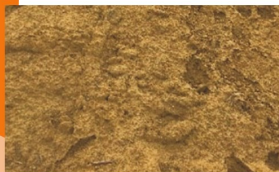

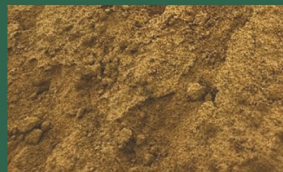

Morse has the code to topple Terras

Royal Caily Morse's early goal and a strong defensive effort guided Royal Wootton Bassett Town to victory away at Weymouth in the team's penultimate game of their South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern campaign.

With runners-up spot already secured, on paper Bassett had little to play for as they made the long trip down to the Dorset coast.

Despite that though, Adam Wood's side put in a strong performance that ultimately delivered victory - with the result meaning that Bassett will finish the season having beaten all but one of their league opponents. The lone side Bassett were unable to crack was Bath City - though Bassett can take solace from the fact they got the better of the Romans in their recent League Cup second round meeting.

The only goal of the game arrived after just three minutes. Libby Davies' through ball split open the Weymouth defence, with Maddy Elliott latching onto her past. Elliott's firm shot was parried by home 'keeper Issy Heybourne, but the rebound fell to Morse who pounced on the loose ball and coolly slotted home.

While there was to be no further scoring, the remaining 87 minutes were full of chances and intrigue with Bassett withstanding significant pressure - especially in the second half - as Weymouth were unable to get back on terms.

Bassett enjoyed a fast start and twice came close to extending their lead in the game's early stages. First, after getting in behind the Weymouth defence, Hannah Gulliver delivered a dangerous cross that Heybourne had to be alert to save. The Weymouth 'keeper then saved low from a left-footed Davies effort.

Bassett knew from their home encounter with Weymouth in February that the Terras would represent a big challenge though. And it wasn't long before the hosts were threatening. Lucy Roberts fired narrowly over from a free kick on the edge of the box after Lilia Slattery was forced into conceding a foul.

Millie Powell then had to save with her feet to deny Emily Screen, with the rebound just evading home captain Charlotte Wilson.

Screen soon had a double opportunity, with Powell dealing with the first before Darcy Cox got her body in the way to block the second.

Later in the half Screen found space to shoot but once again was denied by Powell.

Powell continued to be in inspired form as, three minutes before the interval, she was able to keep out another Roberts free kick that seemed destined for the top corner.

A slice of luck almost saw Weymouth equalise early in the second period when Bianca Osborne's flick on somehow evaded Briony Hurd and landed in the path of Kaydee Thornicroft but the Weymouth substitute could only drag wide.

There was some respite for the Bassett defence as play returned to the other end. 'Keeper Heybourne was bravely off her line to save at the feet of Elliott as the Bassett forward sought to latch onto Davies' pass. After seeing her ball in cleared only as far as her, Davies then scuffed wide after Weymouth failed to clear.

For the remainder of the game though the Bassett defence came under significant pressure.

Bassett did ride their luck midway through the half as Thornicroft passed up a golden opportunity after being played in by Wilson's quick free kick.

Ten minutes later Roberts was just off target with another free kick before strong defending from Cox allowed her to muscle Thornicroft off the ball as the Weymouth forward broke into the box.

The hosts final chance then fell to Ellia Webb who, after Bassett appeals for a handball went unanswered, could only shoot wide when under pressure from Jasmine Kennedy, who had made a good recovery run to be in position to hassle her opponent.

Bassett thus were able to hold on for a victory that sees them pull within five points of champions Poole Town. Wood and his team will be hoping to narrow the Dolphins' margin of victory to just two points when they host Shaftesbury in their final league fixture at the start of April. In the meantime, Bassett will be engaged in friendly action against Frampton Rangers next week with the possibility of a League Cup quarter final to follow that.

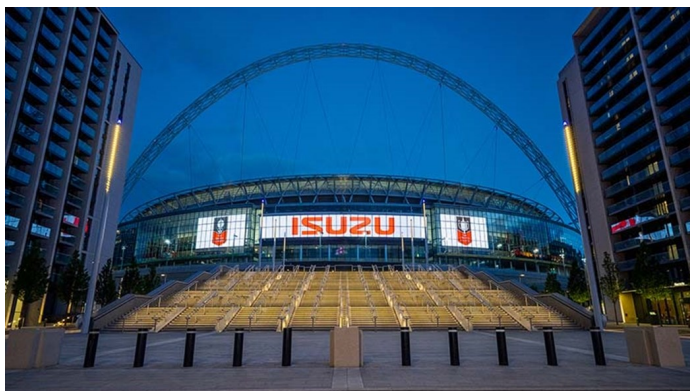
