# Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

### GOOD AFTERNOON

welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Hereford Pegasus. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Hereford, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

Today's game was scheduled to be an away fixture and producing a programme for a game today was certainly not booked into an already tight schedule of league, cup and business meetings so once again it is another late night getting another edition out.

Well what a great result that was on Tuesday night against Mangotsfield United, quickly avenging our FA Cup defeat in our opening game of the season. That is now three wins from three in the league so far and a fantastic start to the new season. Whilst Sam will no doubt be pleased with the result but also I suspect another clean sheet. If you can remain tight at the back, with players who can create something out of nothing at the other end, you are destined to win more than you lose.

Our record against Hereford Pegasus is an even one with both teams having won 10 games in the 26 previous meetings between the two sides. We improved our record to restore parity after we did the double over Hereford Pegasus in 2022-23. Match reports from both those games is in today's programme. Hereford Pegasus currently sit 14th in the table having won one, drawn one and lost two of their opening four games. Last season a run of six unbeaten games to finish the season saw Hereford Pegasus end the season in eighth place.

The Development side have made a decent start to the season winning two of the three games they have played so far. A 6-2 opening day win over Shrewton United was followed by a 4-2 away defeat to Wroughton. On Saturday they returned to winning ways with a 5-0 away win against a side that they had lost to three times last season. Today they are home to Larkhall Development on the 3G who are unbeaten after their opening two games, defeating the reigning champions Trowbridge Town 3-1 and then drawing with Frome Collegians in midweek. With us having beaten Frome Collegians 5-0 last week the Development Team management will be hopeful of continuing their good start to the season. This season the Development side are permitted to enter the Wiltshire Senior Cup and they have been drawn at home to Blunsdon in the FA's most prestigious cup competition whose winners include the like's of Swindon Town. This game means that the First Team's Floodlit Cup game against Swindon Supermarine Development, a side who are involved in Junior football, is now pushing back a couple of days to Thursday 14th September.

The Women's side get their league season underway in just over a week's time when they travel to Purton. No doubt the Women's side will be eager to get their campaign up and running with the positive vibe currently running through Women's football as a result of the Lionesses doing so well in the World Cup..

Enjoy the game and hopefully we will be celebrating another win to maintain our100% winning start in league games this season.

## **Opponents History**

### **Hereford Pegasus**



In 1955 when Noel Watkin oversaw the Herefordshire County Boys. There was a great team bond, so when the County fixtures were through, the team asked if they could stay together and

Pegasus Juniors came into being, taking the name from the famous amateur side of the era.

It was inevitable that players would move on to higher grades of football and many did that with distinction. Pegasus Juniors original members Jack Perks and Bob Pasley remained, they proudly gained membership into the Hellenic League in 1978 and established a club house in Hereford.

In 2005 Pegasus Juniors opened their new ground at Old School Lane with funding from The Football Foundation, Football Association local trusts and directors. The facilities have continually been improved since with grant funded work in 2013 replacing the perimeter fence, upgrading the car park and extending the clubhouse. 2019 saw our biggest project to date, with the installation of a state-of-the-art artificial turf pitch along with upgraded LED floodlights.

In 2010 the club decided to move its first team to the West Midland (Regional) League for season 2011/12 as the Hellenic League was, at the time veering, in an easterly direction. The highlight during our eight

seasons in the West Midlands was undoubtedly finishing as runners up with 100 points in a high scoring season. More recently an exodus of senior players led to a very young team finding themselves at the wrong end of the table.

Joint Managers Mick Panniers and Dave Cadwallader came together in the dugout to lead the team as we came back 'home' to the uhlsport Hellenic League for 2019/20 in Division One West. Following two Covid curtailed seasons, Mick stepped away from management with a move 'upstairs' in a Director of Football role. 'Caddy' along with Mark Hibbard were then appointed as Joint Managers for the 2021/22 season.

Having finished 4th in Hellenic League Division 1 at the end of the 2021/22 season we took part in the first ever Play Offs at Step 6. In the semi-final we travelled to Clanfield, winning 4-0 and setting up a Play Off Final against Worcester Raiders at Sixways Stadium. Scoring within the first 20 seconds of the final set us on our way to a memorable night, going on to win the game 3-0. The final whistle signalled jubilant scenes throughout the team and travelling support. We had secured promotion back to Step 5 and a place in the Hellenic Premier Division for the 2022/23 season.

In addition to the Promotion, it also meant a return to the F.A Cup for the first time in seven years. Our first season back in the Premier Division was a creditable one achieving an 8th place finish.

## Royal Wootton Bassett Town 3 Hereford Pegasus 0

Royal Wootton Bassett Town leapfrogged Hereford Pegasus, moving up into seventh in the Hellenic League Premier Division, with a convincing 3-0 home victory.

Extending their league winning streak to four games, Sam Collier's side were in control of the match throughout, comfortably coming through an important game as Bassett fight for their highest ever league finish.

All the damage was done in the first half thanks to an unlikely trio of scorers as both full backs and a goal-shy midfielder found the net.

Kai Robinson was the player to get things going. In 119 previous Bassett appearances, the hard-working midfielder had scored just once. It was therefore little surprise that he wheeled away with joy after bundling home following a Matt Jones corner.

That goal came after just ten minutes.

Bassett had to wait until the end of the half to extend their lead though - but scored twice just before the break to make it 3-0.

Right back Scott Chilcott added the second. Approaching his 50th Bassett appearance, this was his first goal for the club and it completed a well-worked move.

Chris Taylor played forward to Jones who sprayed a fine pass to Louis Spalding who whipped in an excellent cross that was just out of reach of forward Matt Bennett. The ball fell to Chilcott at the far post though, and he made no mistake with a composed finish from a tight angle into the far corner.

Spalding then completed the scoring. Grabbing his sixth of the campaign - an impressive tally for a left back, he headed home from a Bennett cross after the veteran forward had raced onto Bailey Gallagher's through ball in the right channel..

First half goals from Bailey Gallagher and Alfie Presley earned Royal Wootton Bassett Town a vital 2-0 away win at Hereford Pegasus as Sam Collier's side completed a season double over their top half rivals.

Despite a 3-0 home win against Pegasus just three weeks ago, Bassett knew they would have to be at near to their best in the return fixture to take anything from the game.

And while not a perfect display, Bassett's performance proved enough for victory and an impressive eight league clean sheet.

Bassett took the lead just after the quarter hour mark in fine style as Gallagher produced a trademark cut inside from the left and curled a delightful shot from range into the top corner.

After a relatively even first half, it looked as though the visitors were going to go into the break with the slenderest of leads.

But Presley gave Bassett some breathing room, coolly slotting beyond home 'keeper James Behan when played through one-onone

The 2-0 advantage that gave Bassett then proved to be enough.

Bassett now sit five points ahead of Pegasus with a game in hand still to play. At this stage in the season, that should hopefully be enough of a gap to ensure Bassett finish above the Hereford-side.

The result also keeps Bassett in lockstep with Roman Glass St George - who they will need to get ahead of to claim a top six placing..

Pickering is a highly-rated young goalkeeper who joins Bassett this season from Melksham Town. A player who has represented Willshire at Under 18 level, his performances helped Melksham Under 18s finish as unbeaten winners of the Willshire League Floodit Division in 2018-19. That year he also made his debut for Melksham Reserves in the Willshire Senior League Premier Division before serving as their first choice 'keeper in each of the last three seasons, as well as being backup for their first team in the Southern League.



Louis Spalding Highly talented full back entering his 2nd season with Bassett. Skilful, quick, an outstanding defender & a player who always looks to get forward. Was named Manager's & Players' Player of the Year following a standout debut season. Played 47 times, scoring a hugely impressive 10 goals, including a long range stunner in the FA Cup against Reading City, a last minute winner at home against Tuffley Rovers & a brace away at the same opponents. With Swindon Town as a youth, before joining Cirencester on loan in 17-18 making 11 appearances, before signing with the Centurions after his release from Swindon. With Cirencester in 18-19, featuring 38 times for the League runners-up in Southern League Div 1 South. He then joined Swindon Supermarine, appearing in 38 games in the curtailed 2019-20 Season, 10 matches a season later and 4 times in 21-22.

Harry Walters Full back who is quick, keen to get forward, impressive on the ball and a solid man-marker who made an impressive impact after making his First Team debut last season. Made his first appearance in senior football with Stratton Juniors in 2020-21, featuring 12 times for them in the Wiltshire League Premier Division. He started the subsequent campaign with Stratton before transfering to Bassett, playing 14 times as the Development team were crowned Wiltshire League champions. Continued to impress with the Dev side at the start of last season, and it wasn't long before Sam Collier drafted him into the First Team squad. Made his debut in a Floodlit Cup win against Cribbs and went on to make 19 appearances.





Adam Corcoran Bassett's current longest serving player and captain, now entering his 12th season with the club, having reached the 300 appearance mark last season. An imposing central defender-with the ability to also play at full back when needed - who is composed on the ball and dominant in the air. A Cirencester Town Academy graduate, he initially joined Bassett in 2011-12 after brief spells with Fairford Town and Caline Town. He quickly established himself as a key part of Bassett's defence, and in 2012-13 helped the team to promotion from Division One West. After a brief spell with Shivenham, he re-joined Bassett in the summer of 2015 and has been with the club since. He is a player whose performances have seemed to get better and better over time too. The 2021-22 campaign was without doubt his best in Bassett colours, with the defender going on to earn both Manager's and Players' Player of the Year awards. A quality striker of the ball and danger at set pieces, he has also contributed 15 goals in his 316 Bassett appearances.

Started his career with Swindon Town, captaining their youth team before going on to make 4 First Team appearances in 2002-03. After his release in the summer of 2004, he joined Conference side Tamworth and during a 4-year spell at the club received a call-up to the England National C team. After spending 2008-09 with Worcester City he moved to Supermarine in the summer of 2009 and was part of their squad that reached the FA Cup 2nd round. Has played at the highest level in his home country too. Moved to Germany in 2016 and played as high as the fifth tier with Dusseldorf West and SC Union Nettetal. Initially joined the club at the start of the 17-18 season and was one of Bassett's leading appearance makers that year, playing 36 times and scoring once. His performances over 43 games in 22-23 earning him joint Manager's Player of the Year honours. Has played 132 times for Bassett, scoring twice. Initially joined Bassett from Wantage Town, with whom he gained Southern League experience during the Alfredians' difficult 16-17 campaign.

In all he made five appearances, winning man of the match on his debut against Abingdon United. A year later he scored six goals in 17 Development team appearances and was again named as Manager's Player of the Year. Came through Swindon Towris youth system but never made a first team appearance. Released by Swindon after loan spells at Chipenham and Cirencester in 17-18. Started the 18-19 campaign with Hungefrod before moving back to Cirencester where he spent the majority of the next 2 seasons. Played 6 times for Bassett in 20-21, scoring 3. A season later, he featured 41 times, scoring 7. Injuries frustrated him last season, but still made 30 appearances, contributing 5 goals.

Flynn Walters Promising young forward who made his Men's First Team debut last season. Skillful, with good pace and an assured finisher, he was a part of the Under 18 Floodlit team who finished as Wiltshire League Floodlit Division runners-up in each of the last two seasons. He registered twice in 13 games for the U18s in 2021-22 before playing a more significant role in 2022-23 as he scored eight times in 21 games. His performances saw him earn a place in the club's senior Men's sides last season too. Walters featured five times for the Development team and made his First Team debut as a substitute against Chipping Sodbury Town, scoring the final goal to cap at 41 victory.

Cultured midfielder with the ability to change the outcome of a game. Re-joins Bassett having moved back to the UK after a period abroad. A tenacious player with clever movement, an eye for a pass and a willingness to take opponents on, he is capable of turning the game from defence to attack very quickly, Initially joined Bassett in 2011 from Highworth, where he had been a key feature of their successful reserve team. After a strong start to the 2011/12 season, he left for then-Southern League Abingdon Uld. There he played a vital role in helping them survive relegation. In the summer of 2012 he moved to Circnester Town. With the Centurions he featured 21 times, scoring 4 goals but returned to Bassett the following season, making 13 appearances and scoring once, before moving to Shrivenham for 2014/15. He was back with Bassett a season later, scoring 4 goals in 40 appearances before adding 6 in 32 games in 2016/17. In 2017/18 - his last full season with Bassett - he registered his best haul of goals yet, scoring ten times in 22 matches. Overall, Packer has played 159 times for Bassett, scoring 31 times.



Connor Waldon Waldon is a well-travelled forward with professional experience who joins Bassett this season. A player who came through the ranks at Swindon Town, Waldon made eight appearances for the Robins - including three starts - between 2013 and 2015. He also had numerous loan spells during his time at Swindon, including in the National League with Tarmworth, Gloucester City and Brackley Town. Following his release, Waldon joined Swindon Supermarine (where he had also been on loan), and over the course of three spells with Marrise Isosord 34 goals in 73 matches. Waldon has also had spells with Mangotsfeld United and North Leigh in the Southern League while he has featured for Highworth Town, Shrivenham and Chipping Sobbury Town in the Hellenic League.

As a player, Griffin is an assured finisher, strong in the air and capable of effectively holding up the ball. He made a prolific start to his playing career with Corsham in the Western League, and soon moved onto Southern League football, plying his trade with Cirencester, Chippenham, Gloucester City, Mangotsfield Utd, S. In 2018-19 he hit 26 goals for Cirencester as they finished runners-up in Southern League Division One South. Joined Bassett after splitting the 2019-20 season between Melksham Town and Malmebsury Victoria. Griffin also has prior managorial experience having spent time in charge of Malmesbury.

Sam Collier (Manager) Bassett manager since taking the role in January 2018. In 2018-19, his first full season in charge, he guided the team to 10th in the Hellenic Premier Division - at that point, the club's highest ever finish. Bassett exceeded that record last season with a 5th place finish. Bassett have also set records in national cup competitions under his stewardship, with Collier's sides equalling the club's best FA Cup run in 2020-21 and going further than ever before in the FA Vase, reaching the 3rd round in both 2021-22 and 2022-23. This is Collier's 2nd job in management after he served as Shrivenham player-manager from 2014 to 2015. As a player, he has made 159 appearances for Bassett, scoring 71, finishing as top scorer in 2009-10, when Bassett earned promotion to the Hellenier Premier Division, and 2010-11. Collier has played in almost every other position for Bassett - including as goalkeeper, making a last mirute penalty save in 2022-23 to preserve a point against eventual champions Cribbs. During his playing career, he also featured for Purton, Abingdon United, Cirencester Town, Wantago Town and Thatcham Town among others.





A SUNNY weekday morning, a little before 9.30am and a corner kick away from Wembley Stadium, Hanwell Town are opening up their ground for assessment.

It's part of the intensive drive to look in depth at all Step 3-6 grounds in the National League System by the end of October, with National League clubs to get the same treatment later in the season.

The NLP has been invited along to see what we'd traditionally know as a ground grading in action.

Launched at the end of July, the FA and Premier League have joined forces to launch the Stadium Accreditation Programme.

For the first time since ground grading was introduced over 15 years ago, the process has been digitalised with a new tool called StadiumPower.

Think of this process as a giant audit of Non-League grounds to essentially answer the questions: What have we got? Where are the challenges and areas of need? And, crucially, how can funding be best utilised?

"Up until now, although many will be surprised at this, there has been no central database capturing not just facility information but also the nuances around it," Mark Harris, chairman of The FA's Stadium Accreditation sub-committee, tells The NI P

"So digitalisation will give us a central database of facilities. It will allow us to identify areas of non-compliance but, more importantly, look at common areas of non-compliance.

"It's about identifying big issues that can then be linked to funding. I don't want to set any hares running but, as an example, if we found there were high numbers of perimeter fencing not compliant for whatever reason, that enables a business case to be put together to talk to funding partners like the Premier League Stadium Fund and say: There is a common need here. Let's look at whether we should focus some funding on the bigger problems club face.

"It is not there as a bigger stick to beat clubs with. It's to bring transparency and also ensure impartiality."

That and consistency are key. Previously, grading at Steps 1-4 was handled centrally by The FA, with Steps 5 and 6 overseen by leagues themselves.

Naturally, and understandably, that has led to a variation across the country.

Stadium Accreditation assessors – 25 of them all trained together – are now undertaking the

mammoth task to visit around 820 individual National League System grounds.

As part of this year one assessment, at least 400 individual items at each stadium are being recorded — of those, 160 linked to the ground grading criteria for 2023-24.

There are nine sections to be filled in by the assessor, accompanied by a league observer.

It starts with general information like ground details and who uses the pitch. Then entrances and exits, clubhouse details, how big is the clubhouse and how many can it hold. Spectator information and capacities, standing and seating.

Others areas include Medical & Safety, Pitch & Floodlights, Transport & Parking, Media & Broadcast

With the app, photos and videos can now be taken and instantly uploaded to give a literal picture of what each ground has.

A key part of this fact-finding information will link into those extras. The FA can get an idea of suitable ground stock for England youth games as well as to aid the exploding growth of women's football to help clubs get permanent bases. Likewise, it will help the FA Competitions team at Wembley HQ with their planning.

Women's Super League games require an antidoping room. Is there one available? It all goes into the app.

An important note, nothing in respect to the actual grading criteria has changed. But the in-depth collection of data will be reviewed by The FA's now monthly-meeting Stadium Accreditation Sub Committee.

"It may well be that arising from this first round of inspections that it actually highlights some changes we may need to think about making to criteria going forward," Harris says.


StadiumPower will allow clubs to keep tabs on their own improvements, give transparency on other clubs and there will be a public-facing element so the everyday fan can see what facilities they may attend.

Another feature of the app will be a stadium simulation tool where a club can, at the click of a button, see what work is required should they be promoted to the level above.

"This is about trying to move the mindset from compliance to opportunity," Harris says.

Nearly three hours on and there are still areas to be looked at, measured and photographed. But it's another one ticked off the list with the vision for a stronger Non-League game at the end of it.
