GOOD AFTERNOON

and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, for our fifth home league fixture of the season. I bluow like to welcome all that have travelled up from Dorset. the

coaches, players and supporters from Weymouth women's team who are experiencing their first visit with us here at the Sustain Stadium.

We have yet to visit Weymouth with the away fixture due to be played on Sunday 10th March. So this is our first ever meeting at any level let alone a women's fixture against Weymouth and we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and have a safe journey home.

The Women's team have now played four away games since my last programme notes. wav back in December, when we hosted Westbury in the Wiltshire Cup. We won comfortably on the day to progress to the quarter final, where we were given an away tie to Swindon Town. This game was played a couple of weeks ago at Devizes in atrocious conditions of driving wind and rain, and it showed me what a strong squad we have in what was a very good performance. Losing 6-0 to a team playing two levels higher was no disgrace but what was a disgrace was

how we had to travel 45 minutes to play at Green Lane in Devizes with a 4pm KO. Admittedly, yes we were asked if we could reverse the fixture to play on our pitch, but unfortunately we were asked too late with three men's fixtures already scheduled on the pitch within the week.

Sadly the most disappointing part of the day was the fact the kick off had to be put back until 4pm, as both teams were unable to warm up in time, with a game still being played on the pitch. And to cap off a farcical day and with a storm clearly brewing, the floodlights were not turned on early enough, leading to the referee having to ask for them to be switched on. Which sadly resulted in another 10 minutes of commotion as the Wilts FA staffs were nowhere to be seen.

I have not been to be at the last three away games (Frome, Shaftesbury and Stockwood) as I have agreed to go to Holland and be an assistant coach to our U12 yellows, so felt spending time with that team on Sundays would help prepare me and the boys, but I'm very pleased we have been able to pick up three wins and keep up the pressure on Poole.

I hope you enjoy the game this afternoon and hope that Adam and the team can produce another top performance to secure another three points from the match.

Sunday 4 February 2024 Super six as Bassett swat aside Stockwood

Stockwood Wanderers 1
Royal Wootton Bassett Town 6

Royal Wootton Bassett Town put distance between themselves and third place Stockwood Wanderers with a thumping 6-1 away against their fellow South West Regional Women's Football League Division One East high-flyers.

Adam Wood's side made a lightning fast start and were 2-0 up after ten minutes courtesy of two goals seemingly no more than sixty seconds apart.

Leading scorer Hannah Gulliver opened the scoring, tapping in at the far post from a Laura Jefferies corner.

Her goal was then instantly followed by a second courtesy of Maddy Elliott - currently Gulliver's closest rival for the golden boot. From the kick off, Holly Baker stole possession in midfield and unselfishly picked out Elliott who shot beneath home 'keeper Jenna Lou Bedford.

Although 7-2 winners when the teams met earlier in the season in the Women's FA Cup, Bassett knew Stockwood would pose a threat. And the hosts almost pulled one back after Toni Blenkinsopp seized possession and fed Lauren Phillip. Blenkinsopp then got on the end of her cross but struck narrowly wide.

Gulliver then hit the crossbar before

Stockwood were able to pull one back midway through the half. Kate Whitmarsh helped on Grace Phillips' free kick delivery and Erin Vowles was on hand to steer home at the far post.

That ushered in a five minute spell when Bassett were on the ropes as Millie Powell denied Vowles an equaliser before somehow keeping out Phillip after she had danced past three defenders.

Bassett soon restored their two goal lead though. On 32 minutes Holly Baker applied a neat finish following good set up work from Laura Jefferies to produce what was a much needed goal given the short spell Stockwood had enjoyed.

The score would remain 3-1 until just before the

hour mark when Caily Morse split the home defence open and Libby Davies latched onto her pass before keeping her cool for her ninth of the season

Bassett soon had a handful as Davies returned the favour. Morse made a darting run which Davies picked up on, feeding her strike partner with a fine pass before Morse did the rest.

The visitors were now in control of the match and creating multiple chances.

However a rare opening did fall to Vowles but she shot over from a Phillip cross.

Davies then made it six with her second of the afternoon. Her initial effort after bringing down an Honor Fraser struck the bar. But Bedford was unable to snaffle the ball, allowing Davies to put the rebound away.

The result lifts Bassett five points clear of Stockwood with a game in hand still to play. And with only four games remaining for Stockwood, including the return fixture against Bassett and an away visit to Poole Town, a top two finish is now firmly in Bassett's hands.

The frustration is that, while enjoying such a strong season, Bassett may still be denied promotion given that only the division champions are guaranteed to go up.

Poole have just two games left - both at home - and if the Dolphins win those Wood and his team are very likely to have to settle for second even if they record maximum points the rest of the way.

Bassett can only control what happens to them though - and this victory was a big step towards achieving what they need to do to keep alive their promotion hopes.

Weymouth FC Women were founded in the summer of 2020, and in a Covid shortened first season in the Dorset league, we finished as league runners up, losing just once in our first season.

Powell is a young goalkeeper entering her third season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development

Laura Jefferies A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

Neve Johnson Johnson is a talented young defender who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.





Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign - her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.



Ellie O'Nions A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working leftsided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.



Entering her sixth season with Bassett team. Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital Mollie Smith player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. An accomplished defender who combines the physical side of the game with an assured calmness in possession, she will be looking to further continue her development with Bassett while also studying at Loughborough University.

Kelly Nightingale Nightingale is a versatile player capable of playing in either defence or midfield who joins Bassett this season. She brings significant experience playing at a higher level too having spent most of the last decade with sides in the FA Women's National League. Burridge

Burridge is an exciting young attacking midfielder who joins Bassett this season. A player who knows how to find the back of the net, she joins from Ashton Keynes Youth, where she starred over the course of the past two seasons for their successful Under 16s side. In 2021-22 she scored ten times as her side finished runners-up in the Gloucester County Girls' League, before firing a hugely impressive 26 goals as her team went one better last season. Burridge has also represented Highworth Town Under 16s where she netted four times in six games last season.



Amber Egerton Having joined in 2014-15, Egerton is one of Bassett's longest-serving players. She is a versatile player who will play anywhere she is asked and will always give 100 percent for her team. A dynamic, energetic midfielder, Egerton will also chip in with a few goals and assists. In 2019-20, she was a hugely impressive performer. An ever-present, she scored twice and was joint winner of the team's Players' Player of the Year award prize. She previously won that award in 2015-16 and 2016-17 and is a three-time winner of Bassett's Manager's Player of the Year prize (2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17). Injuries limited her appearances in 2021-22, but Egerton bounced back last year, playing 21 times and scoring twice. Overall, since Bassett entered the South West Regional Women's Football League in 2017-18, she has played 91 times, registering 12 goals.

Dennis Green



Natalie Goodright Goodright is a midfielder who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. She is a player who, despite still being young, possesses plenty of experience playing at a higher level. Having featured largely for their Development team, Goodright was primarily a Swindon's First Team player in 2022-23, appearing 19 times and scoring once in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West. A goalscoring midfielder, Goodright found the net eight times for Swindon's Development team in 2017-18 and four times a year later. Her strong performance also earned her first taste of first team football, making 14 appearances across those two campaigns. She was then named Swindon's Development team Manager's Player of the Year in 2019-20 after registering five goals in ten games in a season in which she also made a further two two first team appearances. Goodright continued to mainly feature for the Robins' Development side over the next two seasons, scoring twice in six games in 2020-21 and three times in 16 appearances in 2021-22 when she also played in five first team games.

Jasmine Kennedy Kennedy is a talented young central midfielder who is entering her second full season with Bassett's Women's First Team. She enjoyed a standout 2022-23 campaign in which she was Bassett's joint-leading appearance maker, playing 23 times and earning the Manager's Player of the Year award. Kennedy made her Women's First Team debut at the end of the 2021-22 season, making two appearances from the bench. She was in and out of the starting eleven at the beginning of last season, but quickly established a starting role thanks to her performances.

A repeat of the scoreline when the teams met in Wiltshire back in September, the game followed a similar pattern too with Bassett leading 2-1 at the break before pulling away from Frome after the restart.

On this occasion though Bassett had to play from behind with Frome taking an early lead as Keira-Leigh Underhill headed in from a corner.

Bassett saw a double chance go to waste shortly after as Libby Davies forced a parry from Sophie Billet with Hannah Gulliver shooting wide from the rebound.

And the visitors almost found themselves 2-0 when Karen Perkins rose to meet another dangerous corner but, fortunately for Bassett, she didn't get enough on her header to trouble Millie Powell's goal.

After an indifferent start to the match, Maddy Elliott's 27th minute equaliser eventually settled Bassett down. She calmly slotted home after Davies' clever flick helped on a cross from Player of the Match Honor Fraser.

That goal began a spell of significant Bassett pressure. And after Holly Baker passed up the chance to put her side ahead, Kelly Nightingale soon enough made it 2-1, tapping into the net after Billet could only palm away a Gulliver free kick. While remaining in the ascendancy until the interval, Bassett had to make the do with a slender half time lead.

Manager Wood would perhaps have been fretting that his side weren't further in front as Frome had two fine chances early in the second half.

Alice Starr was first to threaten but shot straight into Powell's arms. The Bassett 'keeper then did brilliantly to deny Martha Peet, racing off her line to smother after the Frome forward found herself through one-on-one.

But after surviving those scares, Bassett eventually pulled away from Frome. Shortly after Fraser struck narrowly wide, some trickery from Davies opened up space for Gulliver to shoot and she extended Bassett's lead to 3-1 with a superb effort into the top corner.

Involved in two goals, Davies more than deserved to get her name on the scoresheet. But, despite four further chances falling her away, it seemed as though it wasn't going to be her day. However, early in stoppage time she poked home after Billet failed to hold onto a Gulliver free kick. Davies then teed up Jasmine Kennedy who bundled home Bassett's fifth.

The result takes Bassett above Stockwood Wanderers on goal difference and closes the gap to leaders Poole Town to nine points with three games in hand still to play.

The destination of the title - and thus automatic promotion to tier five - is set to go to one of Poole, Bassett and Stockwood. And with Bassett and Poole still to play their season series against Stockwood, those four games could go a long way to determining who finishes in that position.

Green was unfortunate not to get on the scoresheet when she smashed an effort against the post.

But Aly Topping was able to as she picked up the pieces after Morse's path to goal had been denied.

A fine solo effort from Lucy Goodright then completed the scoring and a solid afternoon's work.

An extremely tough test against Swindon Town awaits in the last eight. But Bassett will will give it all that they have and will be eyeing up an upset to earn a semi final place when they take the field for the tie in late January.
