Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Tonight's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Wiseman Floodlit Cup tie against Clanfield 85. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Oxfordshire, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening and that this evening you will witness an entertaining cup encounter between two sides who are going well in their respective divisions.

Clanfield 85 currently sit top of Division One and look a good bet to get promoted to the Premier Division at the end of this season. No doubt they will be keen to test their Premier Division credentials here this evening in this cup tie. Whilst the two sides have not met too often in recent seasons, in our early years in the Hellenic League Clanfield were regular opponents for Bassett and over the years the two sides have met 43 times. Our record against Clanfield over the years is pretty impressive with 28 victories to our name, eight draws and just seven defeats in those 43 previous meetings. Our last meeting was another cup fixture back in Season 2020-21 when we were 2-0 winners in the League Cup. A report from that game is included in tonight's programme.

Well our interest in the FA Vase is over for another season but Sam and the lads gave it one hell of an effort to try and make history and secure a spot in the Fourth Round for the first time last Saturday. In my opinion Bridgwater were one of, if not the best side, to come to Bassett in many a season, and to take them to a sudden death penalty shootout was a tremendous effort by the lads. We fell just short in the end in that penalty shootout after it finished 2-2 at the end of 90 minutes thanks to that late equaliser from Alan Griffin. Fine margins and penalties are always a cruel way to lose a cup tie. The one consolation for me from losing in the shootout was that there was more than one player who failed to score from the spot, it is always so hard for the player concerned where there is just one player who misses their spot kick.

Our loss on penalties on Saturday came just three days after being on the right side of a penalty shootout as we defeated Highworth Town in the Wiltshire Premier Shield after it had again finished 2-2 at the Elms. At the time of writing our semi-final opponents are still unknown but joining us in the last four are Swindon Supermarine and Westbury United with the fourth place set to be either Chippenham Town or Swindon Town who have yet to play their quarter final tie.

Saturday sees the First Team home once again with Pershore Town our visitors

The Development Team are back in action on Saturday when they entertain Pewsey Vale on the 3G in a league fixture in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League.

The Women's side were at home on Sunday when they entertained bottom of the table Ridgeway. Whilst they have lost every game this season, Ridgeway have been losing by less goals in recent week's and Bassett knew they needed a big win to bridge the goal difference gap that currently exists from the other top sides having secured big wins over Ridgeway. Bassett secured the three points with a 6-0 win but probably needed a few more goals in order to get closer to league leaders Poole. All the side can do now is keep winning and hope that Poole and Stockwood Wanderers drop points along the way. Bassett have the chance to do just that to Stockwood on Sunday when the two sides meet.

The U18's had a good result last Thursday here at the GBSG becoming the first side this season to take points off the league leaders Bristol Manor Farm following a 1-1 draw. They are home again this coming Thursday when they entertain bottom of the table Bradford Town.

Enjoy the game and hopefully we will be celebrating progress to the next round of this midweek cup competition to keep our season alive on three fronts.

Opponents History Clanfield 85



Clanfield Football Club was founded in 1890 and for many years played in the Witney & District League. Two years were spent in the North Berks League in the 1960's and for 1967-68 season the club joined the Hellenic League.

Clanfield's first game in the Hellenic League was on the 19th August 1967 against Hungerford Town in front of an attendance of 146. In 1969-70 the club won the Hellenic Division One Championship and were promoted to the Premier Division for the first time.

In 1971-72 they missed out on the Runners-Up position only on goal average but went on to secure the Runner-Up spot for the next two seasons also winning the Premier Division Challenge Cup in 1973-74. In 1974-75 the Club reached the Final of the Oxfordshire Senior Cup. The first game ended in a draw after extra time, but Pressed Steel won the replay. 1975-76 saw a repeat of the Cup run to the Final but again Clanfield ended up losing Finalists. After a great period through the 60s and 70s they were relegated to Division One at the end of the 1979-80 Season. However, the Club soon bounced back finishing in second place the following season. At the end of the 1984-85 Season they were once again relegated to Division One where they have remained ever since.

The Club re-entered the FA Vase in 2006 when Buckingham Athletic were visitors to Radcot Road, in a game Clanfield won 1-0. The club won the Jim Newman Memorial Cup in 1978 & 2018 and have been finalists in recent staging of the same event and won the Faringdon Memorial Cup in 1996-97 and 2016-17. Season 2010-11 saw the club finish in fourth place in Division One West and narrowly miss out on promotion to the Premier Division.

The Club have recently adopted a positive youth policy. The Under 18 Team have won the Allied Counties Youth League Central Division and las season their County Cup Competition. The previous season, 2016-17 the Under 17 Team won the Oxfordshire Invitation Youth League Division B whilst the Under 16 Team won their County Cup Competition.

For the 2020-21 season former player Jamie Butt alongside Chris Blakley and Martin Staddon continued as the first team management, with Gary Brown joining them. The season was looking very positive but again was curtailed by the Corona Virus Pandemic.

There was a management restructure for the 2021-22 season with Andy Lyne joining the club as the first Director of Football. Chris Blakely and Martin Staddon stood down from their First Team commitment and the club thanks them both for all their effort over their time with Jamie. Following a nasty injury whilst playing elsewhere, Jordi Mulvany returned to the club as First Team Coach. The season was a success for the club as Clanfield finished third in Division One, losing out in the semi final to Hereford Pegasus who went on to secure promotion in the final against Worcester Raiders. They were also losing semi-finalists in the Challenge Cup as they went out 1-0 to the eventual winners Cribbs FC.

For the 2022-23 season Craig Connor stepped into the First Team Assistant role after deciding to step away from the rigours of playing. The club enjoyed success in the pre-season retaining the Jim Newman Trophy and winning it for the third time in recent years beating. Cropredy 8-1 in the final. Clanfield finished the season in fourth place, securing a Play-Off berth for the second season running this time against Milton United. This time the Robins lost out on penalties, with Milton going on to secure promotion on penalties over Hartpury University.

The coming season sees Shaun Morgan joining the coaching staff as Jamie and Craig continue at the helm. Preseason has been promising with the club winning the Jim Newman Trophy for the third year running. The club wishes the players and managers all the best for the season.



Ben has developed into a reliable defender with good pace and solid tackling and has earned his starting place in the team.





Saturday 8 May 2021 Bassett rock Robins to march into last eight

Clanfield 85 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2

After an indifferent run of form in the latter half of their group stage fixtures, Royal Wootton Bassett Town bounced back with an impressive display in their Bluefin Sports Hellenic League Challenge Cup last sixteen tie away against Clanfield as Sam Collier's side deservedly triumphed 2-0.

First half goals from Rhys Wells and TJ Bohane proved enough for Bassett to book their place in the quarter finals as they neutralised a Clanfield side who, on the basis of their group stage form, were very much a threat



The Robins had won all six of their fixtures, racking up 25 goals while conceding just six times.

But they were silenced by Bassett, who produced arguably their most complete performance of the competition.

Across the entire pitch, Bassett were impressive.

The back four were solid, offering the hosts little as Clanfield had to wait for the game's closing stages before mustering a chance of note. Bassett's midfield controlled proceedings, with Chris Taylor dictating play. Meanwhile, up front Bohane's hold up play stood out with the enegertic Wells and



Zac Skinner causing problems with their clever running.

Wells was the player who broke the deadlock, producing an assured finish on 23 minutes - his fifth goal of the Challenge Cup campaign - after beating the offside trap and latching onto a Skinner through ball.

Bohane then doubled Bassett's advantage as half time neared, producing a neat finish following good build up play involving Taylor and Matt Berry-Hargreaves to take his personal tally for the season to ten goals.

A Bridge too far again as Bassett suffer sudden death agony

After In each of the last three seasons Royal Wootton Bassett Town have enjoyed record-setting (and subsequently record-equalling) runs to the FA Vase third round. Alas, in each of those years, Bassett have gone no further.

After heartbreak against Hamworthy United and penalties pain against Corsham Town, Bassett can add to that list a gut wrenching 6-5 sudden death shootout defeat against Bridgwater United, the Somerset side triumphing on a misty December afternoon at the Sustain Stadium after a dramatic game ended 2-2 after 90 minutes.

In fairness, to Bassett the draw at this stage of the competition for three consecutive years has not been especially kind. While having home advantage for each game, Sam Collier and his team have encountered - and ultimately come up short - against three of the best step five sides the south west has to offer. Hamworthy and Corsham both went on to reach the Vase semi finals, with the Hammers also claiming the Wessex League title and Corsham narrowly missing out on a promotion playoff appearance.

Bridgwater, despite the recent turmoil surrounding the controversial sacking of long-serving manager Dave Pearse, were of the same mould. The Robins - flying high in the Western League Premier Division - had reached at least the Vase fourth round three seasons running, with a fifth round appearance last year.



The tie was therefore never going to be easy.

Again Bassett were resolute. They gave everything they had and showed they can compete with the best teams this level of football has to offer. Again, however, Bassett narrowly lacked the formula - or the slice of luck - needed to get past their opponents.

The better team on this day, Bridgwater therefore extended their fourth round streak to four years - albeit after an almighty battle.

Bassett had led after just ten minutes. Captain Adam Corcoran delivered the goods, wrong-footing Isaac Finch in the Bridgwater goal by deflecting Louis Spalding's right-footed shot into the net after the visitors had only half cleared from a corner.

After going behind Bridgwater quickly got on top. But despite having lots of possession, they failed to eke out many real opportunities as Bassett's defence held firm.

They did come awfully close to an equaliser when Harry Horton's header rattled the post, with Rob Brown pulling off a fine reaction save to prevent the ball diverting in.

George King also fired narrowly over with a firm drive from outside the area, while the impressive Jay Murray shot just over from an acute angle.

Bridgwater's pressure eventually paid off though as Bassett's resistance was broken on the stroke of half time when Horton's powerful effort from the edge of the box flew past Brown.

Having scored just before the break, Bridgwater then went ahead immediately after the restart as King thumped in from similar range to Horton.



Bassett almost generated a quick reply though Finch was equal to a Sam Packer header after he rose to meet Bailey Gallagher's cross.

Forced to chase an equaliser, the game opened up and the teams exchanged chances as the second half progressed.

Tom Llewellyn struck just wide of the post from range for the visitors before Bridgwater were fortunate an Alfie Presley drive struck the back of a defender, veering out of harm's way. Jason Quick then headed over, while Connor Waldon placed wide.

Time appeared as it was not going to be on Bassett's side. But in injury time salvation arrived, the hosts' efforts to get back on terms rewarded when substitute Alan Griffin bundled in a header from a corner.



That meant spot kicks - and, if the crowd thought the drama was done for the day they were mistaken.

Penalties started in a relatively routine manner as Scott Chilcott and Ben Griffiths both converted.



But Finch then saved from Griffin and Tom Llewellyn scored to give Bridgwater an early break.

Bailey Gallagher and Jack Thorne put away their teams' third round of kicks before Jack Hobson-McVeigh scored to open up the fourth.

With time running out though, Bassett still needed a stop to get back on terms - and they got it as Brown denied Jake Llewellyn.

Alfie Presley and Murray then kept their nerve, forcing sudden death.

It didn't start well for Bassett though as Tommy Ouldridge ballooned his kick over the bar - but Brown bailed his team out, saving from Morgan Williams.

After Connor Waldon and Horton were successful it was then Finch's turn to play hero, keeping out Jowan Partridge's effort.

Quick then stepped up for his team's second match point and - breaking Bassett's hearts - he found the net.

Another year, another successful Vase run. But, once more, the third round proves Bassett's stumbling block.





Entering Royal Wootton Bassett Town began their series of three consecutive cup ties with victory on penalties against local rivals Highworth Town in the Wiltshire Premier Shield quarter finals.

Sam Collier's side edged the shootout 4-3 after the game finished 2-2 at the end of 90 minutes, an eventful final quarter of the match having produced three goals and a red card.

With FA Vase third round ties to play on Saturday, giving its scheduling the Premier Shield fixture may perhaps have been of secondary importance for both teams as they prepare to aim for success on the national stage.

But with a semi final place at stake guaranteed to be against higher level opposition, it was a game well worth trying to win. Victory ultimately belonged to Bassett.

In the opening half it was Highworth who were the more creative. But the hosts failed to find a breakthrough.

And when Bassett were awarded a penalty on the half hour mark, Jack Hobson-McVeigh made them pay, coolly slotting his spot kick past Connor Johns and into the back of the net.

It took until twenty minutes to go for Highworth to grab their first equaliser, with Josh Davis getting a toe to Riegan Cook's free kick and steering in at the front post.

That set up a hectic finish.

Jowan Partridge struck a fine effort from the edge of the box, his first senior goal restoring Bassett's lead. However that didn't last long as Michael Miller quickly made it 2-2.

Bassett also had to deal with going down to ten men with Dave Bampton dismissed for a lunge shortly before Miller struck.

Fortunately for Bassett, Highworth did not have enough time to make the extra man count meaning penalties were needed to settle the tie.

And in the shootout Bassett held their nerve to triumph.

Highworth were unable to take advantage of having the first kick as Davis saw his penalty saved by Rob Brown.

There followed seven successful penalties, with Tommy Ouldridge, Alan Griffin, Bailey Gallagher and Josh Timbrell scoring for Bassett and Dan Grieve, Cook and Tom Griffiths converting for Highworth.

That left it up to Miller to keep his side in the tie, but Brown kept his effort out to give Bassett victory.


