Editorial & RWBTFC News

Welcome to Abingdon United

Good afternoon and a warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Abingdon United for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture. We hope all those from Abingdon who have made the trip today from Oxfordshire enjoy their stay with us this afternoon and we wish them a safe journey home.

After five consecutive games on the road it seems an age since we were last at home here against Brimscombe & Thrupp over a month ago. In today's programme there is something of a catch up on match reports with all five away games plus the Brimscombe game included in the programme. There has also been a lot going on in the world of non-league football to catch-up on. This includes the changes to be made at Step 3 and Step 4 next season announced recently which are covered in this week's article from the Non-League Paper.

Looking at today's opponents, Abingdon sit just above is in the league table and the two sides have met once already this season in the league at Abingdon back in December on a day to forget for Bassett as we were thrashed 6-1 in what I consider to be our worst performance of the season, albeit against what was a very good young Abingdon side. Hopefully we can improve on our last performance against today's opponents here today.

We are on something of a grim run since the turn of the year and haven't won in the league since mid-December when we returned from Ascot with all three points following a 1-0 win. We have now lost 8 of our last 9 league games with our solitary point in that period coming away at Longlevens. Hopefully today will see a change in fortunes as our current form is relegation form and, but for the points we put on the board in the first half of the season, we would probably be embroiled in a relegation battle by now. We are still not completely safe and could do with a few more points on the board and hopefully that will start today. It will be tough here against a very good side and our remaining fixtures to the end of the season see a number of other tough games. Our cause has not been helped by our squad having its strike force stolen by Highworth in their quest for promotion. Interesting to see whether Lewis and Rory will be given the chance to lead the line next season in the Southern League. I have long been an advocate that we shouldn't be playing players at this level but after our experiences this season with players being enticed to both Highworth and Wantage perhaps my views need to change if we are to compete at this level? Certain clubs in chasing the dream have created a situation that has made it very difficult for clubs like ourselves who have no player budget to be competitive.

Of those five games on the road the only one I witnessed was the Floodlit Cup game against Flackwell Heath. There were probably better things I should have been doing on such a cold night on my birthday, but I was hopeful of progress in the cup we should have won last season so made what for me is a relatively short trip to Flackwell. No birthday present for me from Sam and the lads. On the night, for the second time this season, I came away from Flackwell saying that they were one of the best sides we had played all season and if he can keep the same squad together next season I suspect Marcus Richardson may be lifting the UHlsport Hellenic League trophy in Season 2018-19.

F.A. Vase

Well done to Thatcham Town on making it through to the semi-finals of the FA Vase with their 1-0 win at Melksham in a game played in front of a bumper crowd of in excess of 2,200. Despite the defeat I suspect the Treasurer of Melksham was the only one at the club still with a smile on his face that evening. Melksham and also Bradford Town have done the county of Wiltshire proud in this prestigious competition this season and well done to both clubs. Similarly, well done to the other two UHlsport Hellenic League sides, Bracknell Town and Windsor, who made it through to the quarter finals. To have three teams in the last eight of this competition is a fantastic achievement for the league.

Editorial & RWBTFC News

The big news in the UHlsport Hellenic League this week was the subsequent sacking of the management team at Bracknell by email following their quarter-final defeat. Clearly, like Highworth, Bracknell are desperate for promotion and were obviously concerned that they might not achieve it without a change in manager. Will be interesting to see how they perform from here until the end of the season. Despite the confidence up the road I still think there are still going to be some twists and turns in the promotion race between now and the end of the season.

Development Team

Since the last programme the Development Side have played three games, losing narrowly away at Devizes and Cricklade but winning 3-2 at home against title and promotion chasing Shrewton United which was a fantastic result for Paul and the lads. The Development Side have certainly had a much better season than last, and it is good to see some of the young players now getting a chance with the First Team.

Sunday Team

The Sunday team have now slipped behind Eldene but are still in the running for promotion to the top division in what looks to be a straight fight between them and Highworth Town for runners-up spot behind Eldene. The title is still possible, but it will need Eldene to start dropping points for that to happen.

Ladies Team

Second half braces from Laura Gammon and Hayley Huckin secured a 4-0 victory against St. Nicholas Reserves in the last outing for Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies as they made it thirteen wins out of thirteen in the South West Women's League Eastern Division.

Vets Team

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Veterans advanced to the regional semi-finals of the FA's People Cup after finishing runners-up in the first-round event held at the Swindon Link Centre. In its fourth season of running, the five-a-side competition, which covers eighteen categories and is open for all to enter, takes place over three rounds, with the finals taking place at St George's Park. And Bassett's Vets side are now tantalisingly close to reaching the final. They booked their place in the semi-final after winning four, drawing one and losing just a single group game. Beginning with a 3-0 victory over Happy Mondays thanks to goals from Steve Shaw, Gavin Cook and Carl Johnson, they were held to a 2-2 draw in their second match as Shaw notched a brace. Adam Cinquegrani and Shaw scored to seal a narrow 2-1 triumph, which was followed by an agonising defeat by the same score in a game which saw Martin Ohrland give Bassett the lead. Progression to the knockout stages was then confirmed with 4-1 and 3-2 triumphs. In the penultimate group match, Ohrland scored twice with Shaw and Cinquegrani also on target. Earning victory in the final group contest were Shaw (2) and Cinquegrani. An Ohrland brace sealed victory by the odd goal in three to book his team's place in the final, which was lost by the same score despite Bassett having taken the lead through Cook. The regional semi-finals take place over the weekend of the 24th and 25th March.

Opponents - History

Abingdon United • Club History



The club was formed in 1946 when a group of ex-service men decided that the town could support two football clubs. The first meeting to form the club was held in the local Anchor Public House on the bank of the River Thames, as there were no club facilities. They joined the North Berks League and within two seasons had won its Charity Shield. The following year 1953/54 they won the league and cup finalists

The club had its sights on higher things and five years later entered the Hellenic League. Since then it has remained in this league and during this time had success in the lower divisions. In 1965/66 they won the Division One Challenge Cup and the following season were the cup finalists.

No further honours came the clubs way until winning promotion in 1976/77 to the Premier Division. After a struggle at this level, relegation back to Division One came after four seasons. With a more ambitious approach, the club bounced back into the Premier League where it has remained ever since. It also won the Division One Cup in the same promotion year. Senior status was achieved in 1985 allowing it to be eligible for the F.A. Vase, County Senior Cup and in 1989 entered the F.A. Cup for the first time.

A Members Room, Function Room, Covered Stand and Floodlighting have been completed in recent years to improve the off pitch facilities. 1996/97 has seen the club complete its 50th season and it's most successful. United won the final of the Berks and Bucks Senior Trophy and also winning the League's Floodlit Cup. The highest ever league position was attained when finishing as Runners Up in the Hellenic Premier Division. The following season again saw success come to Northcourt Road with retaining the County Senior Trophy, Hellenic League Reserve Championship and Allied Counties Youth League winners.

2001 saw the construction of new changing rooms, together with turnstiles, to the Northcourt Road Ground and 2005 saw the construction of a new 150-seater stand and a covered stand. The club clinched promotion to the Southern League in season 2005/06.

In season 2013/14 Abingdon re-joined the Hellenic League in the Premier Division after voluntarily resigning from the Southern League. Relegated to the First Division West the 2015/16 season the club bounced back to the Premier Division last season.

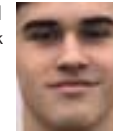

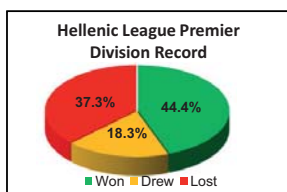
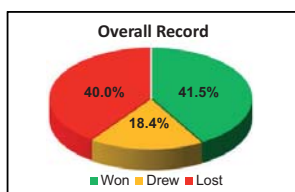

And ten minutes later the game could have been over, but Carl Evans shot narrowly off target after shaking off the attentions of Luke Kavanagh.

Having survived that scare, the hosts proceeded to place the Bassett goal under siege in search of a late leveller.

Much to Bassett's chagrin, it arrived with less than a minute to go.

Having seen a shot blocked moments earlier, Turner ended up reacting quickest when Dan Lawrence was only able to parry a Shaun O'Connor strike, with the substitute chesting down before firing into the roof of the net.

While couples celebrated the Feast of Saint Valentine, Royal Wootton Bassett Town were left alone, sodden and humiliated as they fell to a dismal 4-0 loss away against near neighbours Fairford Town on a miserable February evening.

Eight games in a row have now been lost in the league, with it being two whole months since Bassett last claimed a point.

Where once they had hopes of cementing a place in the top half come season's end, they are now staring at another mediocre lower mid-table finish.

To add further insult to injury, this was only the fifth league win in 2017-18 for Fairford - a team embroiled in a battle to stay out of the bottom four - and was their most comprehensive so far this season.

10 Man Bassett Contain Abingdon in Tight Match

Northcourt Road, 22nd March 2003

Bassett have taken another step towards safety after holding off Abingdon United in a closely fought nil-nil draw. Performances from Jason Hillier, Mark Macek and a remarkable effort from Chris O'Connell earned Bassett a point. I say a remarkable effort from Chris O'Connell because this was his first appearance for the Bassett Town first team since he was involved in a horrific car accident two years ago. To come back and play was remarkable, but to play outstandingly in your first full game back is even more so. O'Connell was to be involved in some of the key action in the game and in the ninth minute nearly created a goal when Mark Vaughan connected with his free kick but Abingdon 'keeper Carl Wilkins dealt with the shot easily. Two minutes later, a Bassett attack led to a twenty yard Tony Macek shot being parried by Wilkins and on the follow-up Gary Ashford's six yard effort was somehow tipped on to the post and out of play by Wilkins.

The game was very evenly matched but Abingdon never really looked like troubling Jason Hillier in the Bassett goal. In the twelfth minute, a short Dave Beaven free kick was played to Dean Moss but Moss hit the ball miles over the bar. Both teams exchanged chances with Bassett looking the most threatening in front of goal. On 26 minutes a Danny Clayton cross looped over Wilkins head but Gary Ashford couldn't connect with the ball at the far post. Abingdon had another chance in the 29th minute when Dean Moss fired a shot from the edge of the area but Jason Hillier dealt with it well.

Bassett began to sit on the back foot and another Abingdon chance went beggingly wide when Mark O'Hara struck his free kick just past the post. Dave Beaven had a chance for Abingdon two minutes from time when his shot from 25 yards skidded up just in front of Jason Hillier but Hillier dealt with the bounce well to collect the ball. Beaven again troubled Hillier – this time on the stroke of half time when Hillier easily saved his shot from the edge of the area. The scores were tied at the break with both teams playing well but neither team controlling the game.

The second half again was to be tight with the Bassett defence keeping Abingdon out. Bassett were being put under pressure in the first few minutes of this half and nearly went a goal behind when a Pete Moss header looped over Jason Hillier from a corner but the outstretched Tony Macek got a hand to the ball to tip it over. Pete Moss again troubled Bassett this time in the 57th minute when Mark Simpkins cleared Moss' shot off the line after Moss had rounded Jason Hillier. Five minutes later Bassett made their first change when Justin Hyde got his first taste of action since playing against Didcot Town in mid-February as he replaced Neil Bridges. Bassett continued to open up the Abingdon defence only for some slack passing to halt attacks. In the 66th minute Mark Vaughan spotted a hole in the Abingdon defence only for his intended pass to Gary Ashford to go into touch. Tempers began to start to flare and in the 73rd minute Bassett had Stu Hemsley booked for pulling an Abingdon midfielder to the ground. From the resulting free kick, Pete Moss hit just wide from a Dave Beaven ball which he had put in after his free kick rebounded back off the Bassett wall. Bassett again nearly opened up the Abingdon defence twelve minutes from time when good play from Chris O'Connell and Mark Vaughan earned Bassett a corner although Justin Hyde and Gary Ashford were waiting for the ball in the box. Two minutes later Bassett were reduced to ten men when Stu Hemsley was given his marching orders and a second yellow card for a professional foul. This led to a nervous last ten minutes for Bassett as Abingdon began to fire all cylinders. First, from the resulting free kick following Hemsley's dismissal, Jason Hillier was forced to tip over Abingdon substitute James Organ's twenty-five yard free kick. Bassett then brought youngster Ben Jarett on for Gary Ashford to give Bassett some fresh firepower up front. Mark Simpkins again saved Bassett three minutes before stoppage time when he headed a Pete Moss header off the line. Moments later, Jason Hillier was forced into action once more when he saved an Andy Marriot header comfortably. Bassett made their final change on the stroke of full time when Mark Hammond replaced Damon Sefton. Bassett had secured a point with a solid performance.

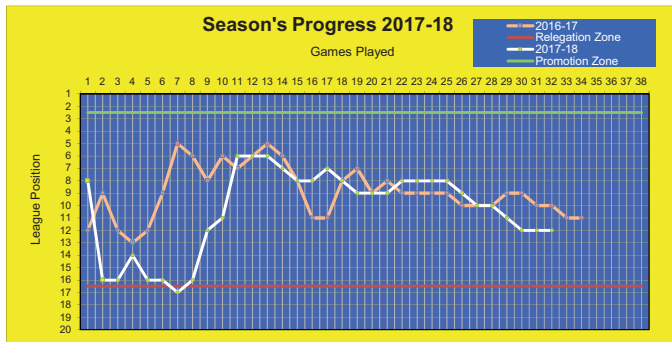

Royal Wootton Bassett Town FC • Club History

Situated in the small market town six miles west of Swindon, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Football Club was first established within the town in 1882, making the club one of the oldest in the county of Wiltshire. The club's early achievements came in the prestigious Wiltshire Senior Cup, making the final in both 1902-3 and 1903-4, although both ended in defeat. Wootton Bassett Town F.C. folded for a period pre World War 1 before re-forming in the Calne & District League when the club began playing at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground which had been donated by local dignitary Major Gerard Buxton for sporting activities within the town and opened in 1930.



Early successes included winning the Calne & District League in the 1930-31 Season, having finished runners-up the previous season, and then again in 1934-35. Following a move up to the Wiltshire League Division 2 promotion was earned again the following season and the team then remained in the top division in the county until the outbreak of war.

After the war Wootton Bassett Town F.C. recommenced in the County Senior League with limited success until Season 1958-59 when they won their first Wiltshire League title. In 1987-88 the Wiltshire League Division 1 title was won, elevating the Club into the Hellenic League, where they have remained ever since. Season 1987-88 also saw the club again reach the final of the Wiltshire Senior Cup but that first win remained elusive. That changed in 1998-99, however, when the Club defeated Pewsey Vale 3-2 in the final at the County Ground and success was again achieved in Season 2000-01 when Shrewton were defeated 2-0 in the final. The First Team, having finished runners-up in Division One West in Season 2012-13, currently play in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League, at Step 5 of the Football Pyramid.

As well as the First Team the Club has always run an adult Development/Reserve team. Since the onset of the new millennium the club has also expanded significantly, with the establishment of a large thriving Youth Section and a very successful Ladies Section. The Ladies side recently did the "double" of being cup winners and securing promotion in the same season. The latest addition to the Club has been the establishment of a Veterans team, so the club now operates 26 teams from under 7s upwards. This growth led to the club being awarded Charter Standard Development Club status by the Football Association in 2008 before this was upgraded to Community Club status a year later. Wootton Bassett Town F.C. was the first club in Wiltshire to achieve this. International ties have also been established, with three Youth Section teams touring Holland annually since 2001. This has led to a relationship with amateur side FC 's-Gravenzande, who are based near The Hague.

The club now play their games at the fantastic New Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, which was opened in the summer of 2015 and with the Royal title now included within the club name, the Club continues to thrive as a key part of the community of Royal Wootton Bassett. Season 2017-18 again sees Rich Hunter in charge of the First Team as the Club looks to better its highest ever position in Non-League football the 11th place finish achieved in Season 2014-15. The Club will again be entering the F.A. Cup and F.A. Vase with the Development side playing in the Wiltshire County League.

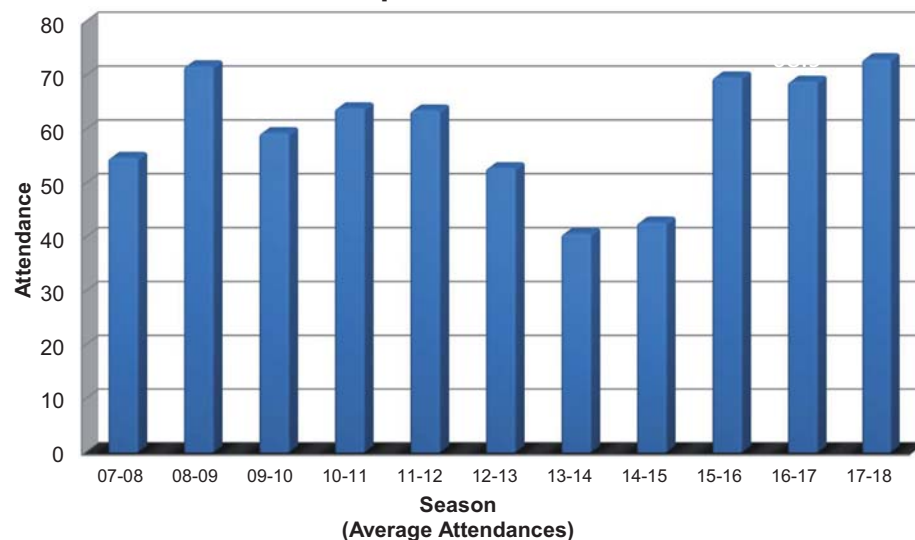

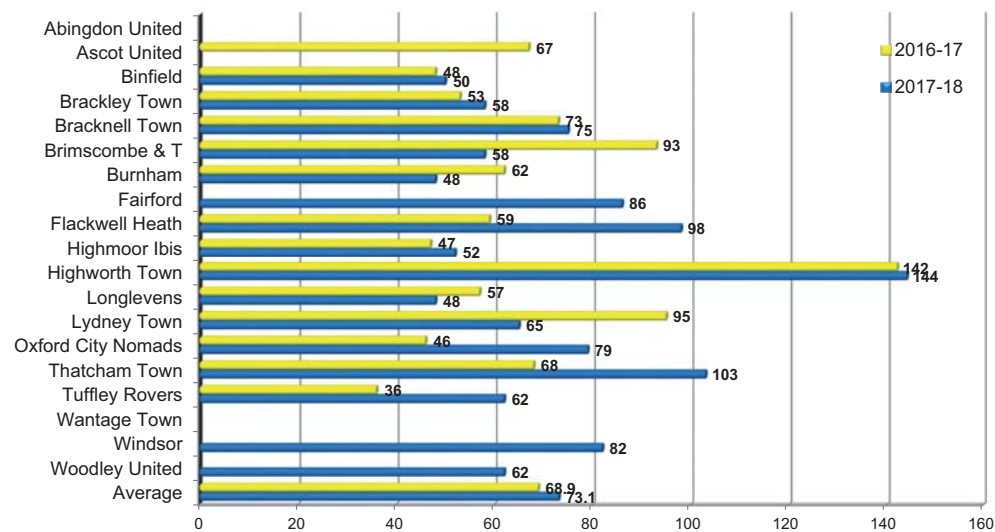

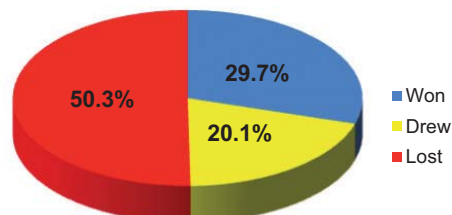

It's the biggest shake-up in the Non-League game since 2004... and now the FA has revealed what it might look like.

From 2018/19, an extra division will be added at Steps 3 and 4.

The FA's Leagues Committee has released provisional Step 3 and 4 league boundaries ahead of next season's National League restructuring.

At their meeting on February 6, the Committee decided the principles to be applied when allocating clubs at the two steps.

The Committee decision was taken after hearing the results of two exercises, the first using the tables at the end of last season (2016/17) and the second based on the tables as of January 2 2018.

It is emphasised by the FA that, for the time being, this is a guide only and they have deliberately not included names of clubs because the full allocation can only be made when the identities of the constituent clubs are known.

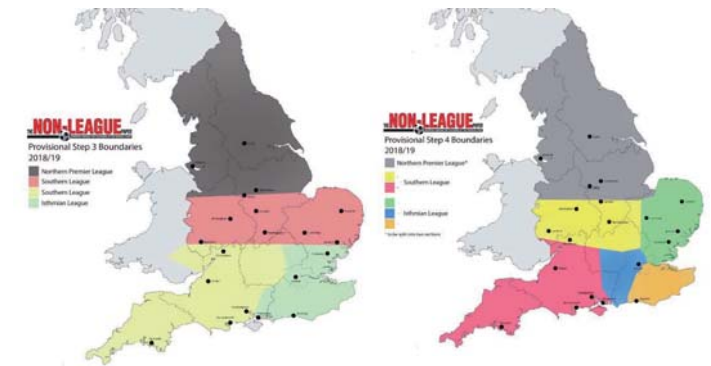
It is clarified that this is for season 2018/19 and the make-up of clubs in future seasons may alter this approach.

At Step 3, the decision is to implement a north division, a central 'band' from the east coast to the west of Birmingham, together with south west and south east divisions, as shown in The NLP's graphic below.

The Southern League is to administer the pink and yellow areas, the Isthmian League the green area and the Northern Premier League to administer the area coloured black.

At Step 4, the seven areas will be divided as shown in The NLP's graphic below. The Isthmian League has responsibility for the green, blue and orange areas, the Southern League administers the yellow and pink areas and the Northern Premier League in the area coloured black.

The Northern Premier League is calling a meeting of its clubs to decide whether to remain with a north/south split or to change to an east/west allocation.



Youth Section Round-up

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Under 12 Blues brought a seven-game winless run to an end with a stunning 5-3 away victory against Cirencester Town Centurions.

Bassett threw the form book out of the window as they saw off a title contending Cirencester side, who had lost just one league contest going into the game.

Five different scorers were on hand to secure victory for the visitors as Jack Blunt, Noah Cranswick-Coates, Alec Gawthrop, Louis Godwin and Leo Neve all found the net.

The win lifts Bassett two places to seventh in North Wilts Division One. And, after a flying start to the campaign descended into a difficult run that saw them claim just two draws from seven games over the winter months, here's hoping it provides the confidence needed to see them finish the season with a flourish.

Elsewhere, three title chasers also secured important victories.

A hard-fought 2-1 triumph against Stratton Youth saw the Under 18 Blues leapfrog their opponents into second place in Division One. Harrison Gough and Thomas Legge were on target for Bassett, who clawed their way within a point of leaders Malmesbury Victoria Youth, who they face next week.

It was a straightforward afternoon for the Under 15 Blues as they hit thirteen without reply past Croft Junior Blue. Nonetheless it was still a vital win for Bassett, who were playing their first league game since the end of November thanks to recent cup commitments and postponements. They are now within a point of Swindon Supermarine R, with both teams having played eight games.

Against Croft Nat Bell led the way with a hat trick, while Thomas Pitt, Billy Saunders and Daniel Warre all notched braces. Michael Gilder, Landon Golding and Jack Lancaster completed the scoring.

A 3-0 triumph for the Under 13 Blues against Croft Junior Blue means that three wins from their final five games will guarantee them the Division Two title. Michael Clifton scored twice and Taiga Matsushima once as they recorded a fourth successive victory.

Bassett host their nearest rivals South Cerney, who sit second, eighteen points behind with four games in hand, next week.

The Under 16 Blues, meanwhile, ran third place Robins close for the majority of their Division Two contest, before falling to a 3-1 loss.

Also defeated this weekend were the Under 14 Yellows (0-12 against Lambourn Sports Juniors), Under 13 Yellows (1-5 against Marlborough Youth Colts) and Under 12 Whites (0-5 against Ferndale Rodbourne Rebels)..

On Saturday, the Under 12 Girls fell 2-0 away against AFC Corsham, while, on Sunday, the Under 12 Whites lost 6-1 against Ferndale Rodbourne Rebels. Also beaten were the Under 14 Yellows, who were defeated 5-0 by FC Calne Blue.

Bassett were thankful that the diminutive midfielder had failed to find the target, with the two-goal deficit something they still had a chance of overturning.

But that meant they would need to take the game to Brimscombe, making themselves more exposed defensively.

That almost cost them just two minutes after the restart, a give-and-go between Blackie and Pitt opening them up before the former found the outside of the post with his shot.

Following a fine diving save from Lawrence to keep out a Pitt free kick, Bassett launched a counter of their own, which led to them hitting the woodwork as Waldon, played in by Callum Wright, went for power over placement.

Shortly after, Bassett's profligacy was punished for a third time. Sloppy defending cost them on this occasion. A Pitt right-wing free kick evaded all in the box, but Pates was able to salvage possession in the left corner. Under little pressure, he recycled the ball, which fell for Blackie, who had all the time in the world to turn and easily pick out the bottom left corner.

A glimmer of hope arrived within two minutes as Wrona's pass split the Brimscombe defence and Waldon coolly slotted past Gale.

Yet for all the additional men they threw forward and pressure they sought to apply, that was to be their lot. Indeed, they were unable to register another shot on target the rest of the way, the best they managed coming through Hibbert, who directed a low 20-yard strike just wide, and Withers, who planted a header from a Tony Joyce cross inches over the bar.

Fortunately, further punishment was not forthcoming either, though Reeves did twice narrowly pass up opportunities to extend his haul for the afternoon in the closing stages.

Clinical finishing condemns Bassett

A 3-1 home loss against Brimscombe and Thrupp made it seven losses in a row for Royal Wootton Bassett Town.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town racked up a seventh defeat in a row as a clinical display of finishing from visitors Brimscombe and Thrupp condemned Sam Collier's team to a 3-1 defeat.

While the loss meant that their miserable run of form continued, there were positives for Bassett's interim manager to take from the game as his side created enough chances to be in with a realistic shot of taking a share of the spoils.

But a lack of composure in front of goal coupled with the visitors' fine finishing put paid to those hopes.

The Gloucestershire outfit were two goals to the good at the break thanks to Harrison Reeves' precise drive and a fine curling effort from Ollie Pitt. Both teams then struck the woodwork in the opening minutes of the second period, before Sam Blackie fired in on the turn to further extend Brimscombe's advantage. Lewis Waldon managed an instant reply, but Bassett were unable to claw their way back into the game afterwards.

And that would have left Collier frustrated given how vulnerable Brimscombe's shaky defence appeared against the pace of the hosts' forward trio of Lewis Waldon, Shane Hibbert and Ryan Withers.

Waldon, in particular, caused them a great deal of difficulty and should perhaps have put Bassett in front on ten minutes when he chased down Gio Wrona's towering ball over the back of the defence in the left corner. After gaining possession, Waldon cut inside, putting Chris Greenhough on his backside in the process, but seemed to rush his shot as he blasted over.

How Bassett needed that to have been a goal. Particularly as seven minutes later, Brimscombe provided the first instalment of their finishing masterclass. The opening goal of the game stemmed largely from Bassett's failure to clear their lines, and a quick ball in over the top and slip on the slick surface from Wrona was enough to give Reeves the time he needed to steady himself and arrow an emphatic strike beyond Dan Lawrence.

The goal didn't really affect the balance of the contest though as the sides appeared relatively evenly matched. Brimscombe were vibrant and tough to contain going forward, yet remained susceptible at the back.

And another ball in behind them presented Waldon with another chance on the half hour mark. This time collecting possession in the right corner, the forward danced past Chris Pates before seeking to squeeze a shot beyond Ashley Gale from a tight angle, which the visiting 'keeper was able to repel.

A sense of déjà vu soon befell Bassett as Brimscombe replied six minutes later with their second. This time they punished Bassett on the break, with a through ball played for Pitt to race onto in the left corner before the forward steered a delightful curler into the top right corner from the left edge of the area.

Their advantage could even have been three going into the break but an unmarked Reeves snatched at a header from Nathan Marks' cross to the far post moments after Hibbert had fired over at the other end following a poor defensive clearance.













Bassett responded well and were actually on top for a prolonged spell. They came within inches of equalising too as Richie Saunders saw a header come back off the inside of the post.

Chippenham Town's season has not gone to plan and they are now seriously involved in a relegation battle. With all Saturday's games being postponed on Saturday night Mark Collier's side sat in 19th place in the table, just one place above the drop zone. They remained four points above Poole Town, the top side of the bottom three relegation places, with both sides having played 31 games ahead of Tuesday night's game against Gloucester City.

Salisbury are looking like they will secure the second automatic promotion place in the Evo Stick Southern League South West Division behind champions in waiting Taunton Town. They trail Taunton by 11 points but they are themselves 7 points ahead of third placed Evesham United with two games in hand as well. Steve Claridge will surely be confident of joining Taunton at Step 3 next season? Swindon Supermarine have slipped down to 9th place in the table but at the time of writing were just one point outside the play-off places. Temporary manager Lee Spalding will be hoping that Supermarine can repeat their performance in their last game when they defeated Shortwood United 5-1 when they meet AFC Totton on Saturday, weather permitting.

Melksham Town chairman Darren Perrin was delighted to see so many people at Oakfields for the club's recent FA Vase quarter-final with Thatcham Town - even if the outcome of the afternoon did not go the hosts' way. After expecting a crowd of 2,000 at the Vase showpiece, the support proved greater than expected as 2,208 spectators came through the turnstiles. On the pitch, it wasn't Melksham's day as the visitors snatched victory with a strike in the 90th minute to deny Melksham a spot in the semi-finals. Both Melksham Town and Bradford Town have done the County of Wiltshire proud with their performances this season in this prestigious national competition and will no doubt seek to use the prize money and gate money from their runs to enhance their chances of climbing the pyramid. In the league Bradford Town sit in 3rd place with Melksham one place behind but four points back with both sides having played 25 games. Bradford are also level on points with second placed Willand Rovers and there is a good chance that one of these Wiltshire sides may achieve promotion come the end of this season.

Another side looking good for promotion are Highworth Town in the UHlsport Hellenic League. With just seven games to play Highworth are four points clear of second placed Thatcham Town having played one game more with the two sides yet to meet each other at Highworth. There are still lots of big games to be played and Bracknell Town are still in the mix with some six games in hand over the leaders but Highworth must be confident of being at least one Wiltshire side promoted to Step 4 come the end of the season. In the Wessex League the highest placed Wiltshire side are Bemerton Heath Harlequins in 10th place some 17 point off the promotion places and with little chance of going up. The other Wiltshire side, Amesbury Town are involved in a relegation bottom and are currently second from bottom.

At Step 6 Laverstock & Ford remain in the promotion picture but are four points back on second placed Christchurch. The other Wiltshire side, Downton sit mid-table. In the Western league Westbury United are looking good for promotion. They currently sit in second place, one point behind eladers Keynsham Town with both sides having played 30 games. Devizes Town, Chippenham Park, Calne Town and Malmesbury Victoria all sit mid-table and will almost certainly be playing at the same level next season. Warminster Town are in a relegation battle, currently second from bottom two points ahead of Sherborne Town.
