# From the Youth Section

## Under 15 and 18 Blues into North Wilts League Cup finals

Royal Wootton Bassett Town will have two representatives in this year's North Wilts League Cup finals after the Under 15 and 18 Blue teams were victorious in their semi-final encounters.

However, there was extra time heartbreak for the Under 16 Blues, who will be unable to make it three league cup crowns in a row.

The Under 15 Blues edged a thriller against plucky Division Two opponents Castle Combe Colts, who fought Bassett all the way. The teams shared six goals in normal time, with Kevin Prouse (2) and Harry Farrow scoring for Bassett. Otis Lewis then popped up with the winner in extra time to seal victory by the odd goal in seven.



They will now face Swindon Supermarine J in the final after they defeated Division One champions FC Chippenham Youth White 5-4.



Meanwhile, the Under 18 Blues bounced back from their Wiltshire Youth Cup final defeat with a 3-1 triumph against Division Two champions-elect Highworth Town Juniors H, giving them another shot at silverware. Bailey Gallagher led the way with a brace while Charlie McCuish completed the scoring.

They will take on Division Two Stratton Juniors Pumas in the final after they defeated Cirencester Town 4-1. Bassett have already beaten Stratton this season, prevailing 3-2 in the

last four of the Wiltshire Youth Cup.

The Under 16 Blues' final four clash with Cirencester Town Centurions was a classic, though, unfortunately, Bassett were unable to advance.

They trailed Cirencester 2-0 at half time. But two goals from Luca Robinson and a further strike from Marshall Thompson put Bassett ahead, only for the Centurions to conjure up a late equaliser. Cirencester then went on to score twice in extra time to seal a 5-3 victory.

In league action, the Under 12 Blues recorded a vital victory in their fight for survival in Division Two. Away against Hungerford Town Juniors Black, they produced an outstanding team display, ultimately sealing the win thanks to Finlay Hyde's late brace. His first came from the penalty spot before he slotted home following great build up play from Caden Jefferies and Sam Smith.

## Welcome to Longlevens

A warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Longlevens for this final UHlsport Hellenic League fixture of the season and thank you for the great half time cake on Wednesday evening. Once again we have an early finish to the season with the final game in the first week of April, although this is not the earliest we have ever finished our fixtures, having ended our Season in 2016-17 with a game on April 1<sup>st</sup>. Since the turn of the century we seem to have lost a month off the end of the playing season. Whilst we ended our first ever season in the Hellenic on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 1989, we then went 12 years where the season always ended in May, Season 1994-95 being the longest when we finished on 22<sup>nd</sup> May. Longlevens pulled one back from the penalty spot for what looked a very soft penalty from where I stood but the referee didn't have one of his better nights, as I am sure today's visitors will testify to having one player and their manager sent off by the referee. We could and should have won by a lot more but did come under quite a bit of pressure in the second half but held out until the end, which has not always been the case on our travels this season. Special mention to Danny Langford who I thought had an excellent game and also the skipper Gio Wrona who played a couple of sublime passes over the top to Danny in the first half and certainly deserved his goal on the night, even though it was helped with a little bit of a deflection. Hopefully we can replicate that result here today and end the season with three wins on the bounce.

## Holmer Green Game

Well done to Sam and the lads for an excellent result last Saturday against one of the in-form sides in the division. As Sam said in his recent notes our home form is good this season and if only we could have replicated that on our travels we would be challenging for promotion to the Southern League. # Visitors - Tourist Information

## Introduction to Longlevens

Longlevens, originally Longleavens, is a suburb of Gloucester.

## Interesting Facts

Gloucester owes its name, strategic location and much of its layout to many centuries of Roman occupation. The first settlement was a military fortress at Kingsholm established in the late 40s or early 50s AD. It developed into one of the chief settlements in Roman Britain.

After the Fall of Rome, Gloucester was captured by the Anglo-Saxons following the decisive battle Dyrham in 577. The Mercian king, Osric of Hwicce, founded an abbey dedicated to St Peter on the site of today's Cathedral. By the tenth century, Gloucester continued to be an important centre in the Kingdom of Mercia, and was famously re-planned and re-fortified by Queen Aethelflaed (daughter of Alfred the Great) as a defense against the marauding Danes (recommend that you catch the brilliant Vikings on Amazon Prime to see what they were like!).

Gloucester Cathedral was used as a location for Hogwarts in the Harry Potter film Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.

Longlevens was severely affected by the July 2007 floods, which caused Horsbere Brook which runs through the village to flood many homes and roads.

## Famous Residents

Former England cricket captain Alastair Cook, whilst associated with Essex, was actually born in Gloucester. Another cricketer from Gloucester is David Lawrence who played in five Tests and one ODI for England from 1988 to 1992.

Former England rugby player Mike Teague was born and raised on a farm a few miles outside Gloucester and he attended Churchdown School.

## Nearest railway station

Nearest Railway station is Gloucester Railway station which is 3.1 miles from the ground.

## Nearest Pubs to Ground

The nearest pub to the ground appears to be the Wheatsone Inn which is on the A417 road, described as no-nonsense chain pub with a menu of traditional British dishes and a family-friendly vibe. Heading into town then the next nearest pub is the Great Western which is described on the internet as a friendly little pub, with nice pub food and good atmosphere all round.

## Things to Do in Gloucester

There is plenty to do in the city of Gloucester itself. The top tourist attraction in the city is the spectacular Gloucester Cathedral. The cathedral has a stained glass window containing the earliest images of golf. There is also a carved image of people playing a ball game, believed by some to be one of the earliest images of medieval football.

Another place to visit is the Jet Age Museum. Dedicated to the preservation of Gloucestershire's rich aviation heritage, the museum tells the story of the Gloster Aircraft Company, focussing on the first Allied jet flight.

If military history is more your thing then the place to visit is the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum which tells the 300 year history of the Gloucestershire Regiment who have been present at many of the turning points in British History; battles in the American Revolutionary War, defeating Napoleon, the defence of Dunkirk and fighting the spread of communism in Korea.

If there is a need to keep the other half happy with a bit of shopping before the match then the place to head for is Gloucester Quays. A shopper's paradise, the Quays is home to designer and high street fashion brands, including more than 60 top names such as All Saints, Calvin Klein, Jaeger, Osprey, Fat Face, White Stuff, Joules, Cath Kidston, Jack Wills, Nike, L.K. Bennett, Ted Baker, Next, Skechers, Pavers, Quba, Levi's, Clarks, Crew Clothing and an M & S Outlet, and is now one of the fastest growing outlets in the UK.

## Bassett outlast Levens to make it two on the bounce

**Saw Mills End, 3rd April 2019**

Royal Wootton Bassett Town recorded a 2-1 victory away against relegation battling Longlevens in their penultimate Hellenic League Premier Division fixture of the season.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town set up the chance to finish their Hellenic League Premier Division campaign with a hat-trick of victories after they saw off Longlevens 2-1 in their penultimate game of the season.

Goals either side of half time from Gio Wrona and Elias Youssef did the damage as Sam Collier's side recorded a deserved triumph against a team they will meet again in three days' time in a quirk of fixture scheduling.

It was a fine result too as, despite their lowly league position, Longlevens have been in good form recently, finding this at seemingly the right time as they seek to battle against the drop.

But Bassett ensured they were second best on this occasion, a dubious second half penalty from Shaun O'Connor not being enough for them to take anything from the game.

The visitors got off to a fast start and had a string of early chances. After just six minutes Longlevens 'keeper Kane Winman was forced to claw over the bar after a Wrona free kick took a deflection on its route towards goal. Mark James then nearly scored from the resulting corner but his powerful header was cleared off the line by Jonty Welch.

A dipping Wrona volley flew narrowly over on sixteen minutes before he teed up Brad Pagliaroli, who went close. Pagliaroli, scorer of two in the win over Holmer Green on Saturday, followed that up by shaving the bar with a powerful strike.

Finally, on 22 minutes, Bassett got the goal that their early pressure deserved. And it came through the lively Wrona. Bassett up well with Pagliaroli, his shot from the edge of the area caught a deflection and found its way past Winman.

Longlevens' best opportunity of the opening period came on the half hour mark when Welch saw a snatched effort almost squirm past Gary Aulsberry. But aside from that the hosts appeared largely toothless.

Their task then got harder two minutes after the restart when Youssef took advantage of a poor clearance from Winman and made no mistake.

With Bassett seemingly in control though, Longlevens got a lifeline ten minutes later when awarded a soft penalty. O'Connor was in no mood to pass that opportunity up either, and he confidently drove the spot kick down the middle.

That set up an exciting finish, with Longlevens forced to throw men forward to try and salvage at least a point.

And on 72 minutes Brad Martin was a whisker away from equalising with a stunning volley from the edge of the area

At the other end, Bassett almost grabbed a third as Ollie Long nearly diverted a Gio Wrona corner into his own net, while Carl Evans headed straight at Winman from the ensuing set piece delivery.

There was still time for some late drama. But unfortunately for Longlevens it resulted in them being reduced to ten men as Luke Kavanagh was dismissed for dissent after his colourful response to receiving a yellow card. Manager Craig Martin joined him in taking an early bath as he too was sent off. The teams now go again on Saturday.

For Bassett, it's a chance to make it three wins on the bounce and move past the fifty point mark that they last recorded in 2014-15. And victory will match the record number of points - 52 in 2000-01 - they have recorded in a Hellenic Premier Division campaign.

Meanwhile, for Longlevens it's the first of a crucial final five games as they aim to escape the potential relegation zone. Plenty to play for then. It therefore should not be a dull end-of-season encounter.

## Sam Collier's Royal Wootton Bassett cruise to 4-2 victory over Holmer Green in Hellenic League Premier Swindon Advertiser, Sunday 31st March 2019

ROYAL Wootton Bassett Town cruised to a 4-2 victory over in-form Holmer Green as they look to end their indifferent Hellenic League season on a high.

After kick-off was delayed for an hour due to Holmer being stuck in traffic on the M4, Bassett wasted no time in asserting their dominance, pinging the ball around their visitors before finally getting a reward midway through the first half.

Danny Lachacz put Bassett in front before a second-half equaliser threatened to undo Bassett's hard work.

But further goals from Brad Pagliaroli and one from Forest Green Rovers loanee Elias Youssef pushed Bassett four goals in front and only a late reply from their visitors saw any change to the score-line.

Manager Sam Collier highlighted his side's ability to control the ball as one of the key reasons behind his team ending Holmer Green's 10-game unbeaten run.

He said: "It was a bit frustrating because we didn't know how long kick-off would be delayed for and we were waiting around for quite a while.

"But we came out of the traps quite quickly and scored early on, so I was pleased.

"We had long, long spells of possession in the first half and we still didn't really look clinical in front of goal, even though we must have had about 80 per cent of the ball.

"But we got the first goal and I knew we'd been in that situation before where we've gone 1-0 up and been comfortable in games and then not won it.

"We got them in at half-time, praised them and said well done, that's the best you've played in six or seven weeks, but there's still a long way to go and they're quite a physical side."

With a clinical second-half performance under their belts, Collier was delighted that they were able to produce such a performance against one of the most in-form teams in the division, despite a shaky start to the second 45.

He said: "We came out in the second half and were absolutely rubbish for ten minutes. They scored and we lived up again and had a 20-minute spell where we tore them apart.

"Regardless of whatever level you're at, if you go unbeaten for ten games, you've got something about you.

"There are not ten poor teams in this division, let me tell you, so they've obviously had some good teams in there, but we've turned up today and dismissed them, so that's very pleasing."

Elsewhere, Fairford Town were narrowly beaten 2-1 away at Brackley Town Saints.

Meanwhile, in Division One West, Pewsey Vale went down 2-1 at home to Kidlington Development while New College were comfortably beaten 11-0 away at Almondsbury.

# Our History

## Royal Wootton Bassett Town FC • Club History

Situated six miles from Swindon, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Football Club was first established in 1882, making the club one of the oldest in Wiltshire. The club's early achievements came in the Wiltshire Senior Cup, making the final in both 1902-3 and 1903-4, although losing both. The club folded for a period pre-World War 1 before re-forming in the Calne & District League when it began playing at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground which had been donated by a local dignitary for sporting activities within the town and opened in 1930.



Early successes included winning the Calne & District League in the 1930-31 Season, having finished runners-up the previous season, and then again in 1934-35. Following a move up to the Wiltshire League Division 2 promotion was earned again the following season and the team then remained in the top division in the county until the outbreak of war.

After the war Wootton Bassett Town F.C. recommenced in the County League with limited success until 1958-59 when they won their first Wiltshire League title. In 1987-88 the Wiltshire League Division 1 title was won, elevating the club into the Hellenic League, where they have remained ever since. The club finally won the Wiltshire Senior Cup in 1998-99 and repeated this achievement in 2000-01. The club have had three spells in the Hellenic Premier and gained promotion back in 2012-13.

Since the onset of the new millennium the club has expanded significantly, with the establishment of a thriving Youth Section, Ladies Section, Veterans team and Sunday side. The club now operates 27 teams from under 7s upwards. All play their games at the relocated Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, which opened in the summer of 2015. This growth led to the club being awarded Charter Standard Development Club status by the Football Association in 2008 before this was upgraded to Community Club status a year later. Wootton Bassett Town FC was the first club in Wiltshire to achieve this. International ties have also been established with Dutch amateur side FC 's-Gravenvand.

Season 2018-19 sees Sam Collier in charge of the First Team.



# View from Our Opponents

## Match Report, Saturday 30th March 2109

### Royal Wootton Bassett Town 4 Holmer Green 2

With most of the Holmer team incarcerated on the westbound M4 by Reading for 90 minutes without moving, I (having with Rob Shed travelled via Oxford, having been forewarned) used the one-hour delay to read the amazingly well-produced and extremely informative programme. The very new facilities at The Gerard Buxton Ground are immaculate and extensive. But the pitch, although well grassed, was surprisingly bumpy. When the teams were announced it was evident that the home team were very experienced, including Aulsberry in goal and Bohane on the bench who have "been there and done that" at a higher level. Holmer by contrast fielded a new debut-making 'keeper in George Hall, and Harrison Holbrook gained his first start after a good 30 minutes against Lydney. The sparsely inhabited bench included young Conor Stables who would later also make his first team debut.

With Kotwica, Riley, Stone, Britton, Wilson, and Adeyileka unavailable for various reasons, the gulf in Step Five experience between the two teams was considerable. But apart from 15 minutes, immediately after battling back level (and how often has this happened) The Greens contributed impressively to an entertaining and open game. Bassett took the lead on 21 minutes. A free-kick was allowed across the goalmouth, and Lachacz forced the ball home at the far post. Holmer's best attacking moments involved Dean Powles, and Hall proved adept at coming out to deal with dangerous situations on more than one occasion. **HT 1-0**

The first quarter-hour of the second half saw Holmer get a foothold in the game, down the slope. After Dean Munday had out-jumped the home defence 3 times with no reward, and Bassett conceded a string of fouls, The Greens drew level on the hour. A mistake in the home defence was seized on by Holbrook, who advanced and beat Aulsberry who got both hands to the ball but couldn't keep it out. Just as Holmer should have been consolidating this impressive fight back, they showed the lack of awareness at this level that has let a promising situation slip so many times. After Hall had produced another good save, Town scored on 62 and 68 minutes through Pagliaroli to regain the lead. Stables came on at right-back on 70 minutes with Michael Duffy, who had deputized well for Wilson alongside Munday, moving to left-back. Bohane had come on for Bassett after their second goal, and he was involved in the move that led to Youssef – on loan from League Two Forest Green Rovers – adding Town's fourth on 74 minutes as well as Pagliaroli's second which was the home team's third. Anthony Tyson came on for James Burrell and was cautioned for an unnecessary tackle almost immediately. But The Greens did get back into the game again, and a good finale to their game was rewarded late on. After Munday had brought an acrobatic save out of Aulsberry from close range, Powles received the ball back from Holbrook and emphatically scored at the near post to reduce the deficit to two goals. Holmer thus ended the match on the front foot, but Bassett closed to within one point with this win which saw The Greens drop one place. Town, not surprisingly with Bohane and Pagliaroli now having 36 goals between them, have scored 15 more than Holmer. But The Greens' defence is better, with one less goal conceded in one more game. Yet again young players coming in to the team did not let the club down, quite the contrary. And with Ryan Parsons and Matt Wooster both having good games, in the view of some the latter being the most accomplished player on show, half the side is 20 or under.

# Our Visitors History

## Longlevens AFC • Club History



The Club, in its current format, was founded in 1954. We initially played in the North Gloucestershire League, but currently we operate in the UHlsport Hellenic League, the Gloucestershire Norther Senior League and the Stroud and District League.

Unfortunately, our facilities at the Club HQ fell some way short of the standard required for the next step up, but we had a breakthrough when the City Council created a new venue, at Saw Mills and in season 2011/12, although we had finished outside of the automatic positions for promotion, we were admitted to the Gloucestershire County League. At this point, we must give great credit to E. G. Carter and Company Limited, our major sponsors, because, without them, we could not have got Saw Mills up to the required standard and I am happy to say that they are still the major force for the improvements that we have subsequently made – so "Thank You" Carters, as they are locally referred to!

We run four male adult sides, a Ladies side and we have also implemented a more structured Youth Section and we are pleased to say that we are recognised as a Charter Standard Development Club. Special mention here to Dennis Barnsley who has done so much work in respect of the Youth Section and the Charter Standard.

We had spent more than forty years trying to reach the County League, but amazingly, within three years we had gained promotion to the UHlsport Hellenic League. In our first season, in the County League, we finished halfway, but having started poorly in our second season an incredible unbeaten run of 26 League games saw us win the League, although, due to our lowly position, pre-Christmas, we had not thought of applying to the UHL Hellenic League, but the following season we were cruised to the title by 17 points and also won the Les James League Cup, and we were duly promoted into the UHlsport Hellenic League – and again – more thanks here to Carters for helping us upgrade Saw Mills to the required standard.

So, in 2014/15 we started another new phase for the Club, in Division One West of the UHlsport Hellenic League and what a start! We won the Division at the first attempt, so after three consecutive titles and two consecutive promotions, we found ourselves in the Premier Division and last season recorded our highest League position, but we recognise the difficulties of facing sides that have a history and an infrastructure that is vastly superior to ours – but, hopefully we will continue to 'punch above our weight'.

Last season, James French, our First Team Manager for ten years, decided to step down, to give himself more time to spend with his wife and daughters. He also played for the Club before stepping into management, but I'm not sure we have a precise start date for him – all I can say that he has been a magnificent servant of the Club and I am glad to say that we have not lost him completely. At the same time, our then Chairman, Chris Bishop, also decided to step down to enable him to follow outside interests. 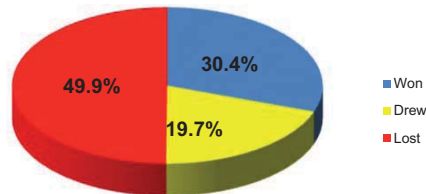

# From The development Side

## 30th March 2019

The big match of the weekend was the final quarter final tie in the Fountain Trophies Cup which saw in-form league leaders Wroughton take on Purton for a place in the semi-finals. Whilst Wroughton started as favourites they would have been mindful that Purton had done a league double over them last season and had also beaten them once in the league in January, Wroughton's only defeat since the 10<sup>th</sup> of October. William Backhouse with his 17<sup>th</sup> of the season put visitors Purton in front, but Shane Hibbert equalised for Wroughton. Trowbridge went into the game on an eight-game unbeaten run whilst Shrewton United had won their last three games and there was to be a dramatic finish to the game. Trowbridge had twice led through goals from Jake Sainsbury and Joshua Hard, the latter hitting his 21<sup>st</sup> of the season, but twice they were pulled back by the visitors Shrewton, Shrewton then went in front for the first time but then in the very last minute of the game Jordan Gullis scored an equaliser for the home side to ensure the points were shared and both teams extended their unbeaten runs by one more game. The Shrewton goals came from Charlie Jackson, Ronan Clancy and Charlie Utterson. Trowbridge remain in seventh spot but Shrewton climbed a place above Corsham Town Reserves as a result of the point this afternoon.

They did it the hard way though having had a man sent off in the first half and playing a large proportion of the game with just 10 men. It was 1-1 at the break but two unanswered second half, despite being that one man down, ensured Ludgershall took all three points. On target for Ludgershall were Sam Walsh, Lewis Pickernell with his fifth goal of the season and Liam Courtney. The Corsham Town Reserves goal came courtesy of Darrin Moss. Ludgershall remain in 10<sup>th</sup> spot whilst Corsham drop a place to 5<sup>th</sup> as a result of the defeat.

A side who are in great form of late are Malmesbury Victoria Development who went into their home game with Marlborough Town on a four-game unbeaten run. In contrast visitors Marlborough Town were without a win in five games. Back in August Marlborough had won the home game 5-0 but were unable to do the double as they went down 3-0 to a resurgent Malmesbury side who went 9<sup>th</sup> in the table as a result of the win, their highest position of the season. Leading 1-0 at the break through a Joe Tranter effort, Gareth Jones then added a second, scoring for the fifth consecutive game and taking him to eleven for the season, before Sam Jenner headed in a third to complete another fine win for the young Malmesbury side.

Two sides who were much in need of a win met for the first time this season when Football ID hosted Cricklade Town. Football ID went into the game without a win in eleven games while Cricklade had gone five games since they last tasted victory. In a high scoring encounter Football ID edged it by the odd goal in five to end their winless sequence and extend Cricklade Town's to six games. Fred Porter bagged a brace and leading scorer Kyle Poguelms hit his seventh of the season for Football ID, with Jonathan Peachey-Score and Sam Broadbank on target for Cricklade. The win lifted Football ID to within a point of Marlborough Town and with bottom side Pewsey Vale Development to play twice will be confident of putting a good run together to end the season.

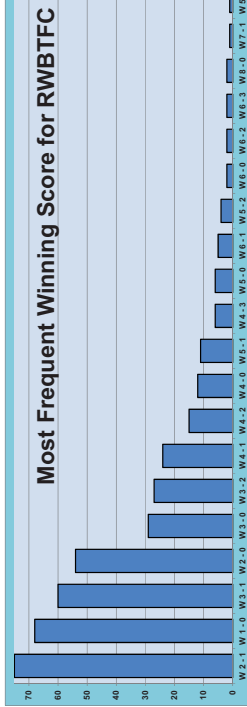

# Moonraker



Welcome to final Moonraker of the season and it has been something of a strange week with a few managerial departures from Wiltshire based sides. The most dramatic of the departures came at Step 4 where Melksham Town manager Kieran Baggs handed in his resignation after a midweek defeat to Cinderford all but ended their play-off hopes. Baggs resigned from his post in the early hours of March 29 after posting a short statement on social media, which noted differences of opinion between himself and members of the board as one of the key reasons behind his exit. With several senior first-team players also leaving, caretaker manager Luke Ballinger was forced to spend his Friday and first part of Saturday dipping into Melksham's Reserve and Under 18 teams in order to field a side in their Southern League Division One South match at home to AFC Totton on Saturday. In the end they were able to field 10 players and put in a credible performance eventually going down 3-0. To not field a full side in a Southern League game but hopefully some of those players who decided not to play on Saturday will come back this week and see the season out. No doubt budgets and ambition will be somehow behind this somewhere, but Melksham will bounce back, and no doubt do well again next season in the Southern League.

The other managerial casualty this week was at Sydenhams Wessex Premier League Step 5 side Bemerton Heath Harlequins Rae Hughes stepped down on Wednesday after two years at the helm. Bemerton are currently in the bottom two and facing relegation after a 4-1 defeat last Saturday against league leaders Sholing. Interesting to see whether former Amesbury manager Dave Coker is the next manager at Bemerton having managed them at a youth level before.

At the upper end of the National League System, Chippenham Town lost on Saturday to relegation threatened East Thurrock, going down 2-1. They trailed 2-0 at one point and whilst they pulled one back through Karnell Chambers, who turned and slotted a shot inside the post, they could not find an equaliser despite putting the home side under great pressure. Judging by Saturday's report in the Swindon Advertiser Sam's old man was not in a good mood on Saturday night, accusing some of his players of being on the beach.

At Step 3, Salisbury kept their play-off hopes very much alive with a 7-1 thrashing of bottom side Staines Town, who have already been relegated. It wasn't all one way as having equalised Staines had a penalty which they spurned and after that Steve Claridge's side found their scoring boots to run out comfortable winners. Daniel Young put Salisbury in front when he tapped in a cross from the right on 12 minutes before Staines levelled with the best goal of the game, a powerful shot from Matt Bremford from 25 yards. It remained 1-1 at the break with that penalty having been missed. Staines spirited resistance was finally undone four minutes after the break when Daniel Fitchett scored a second for Salisbury. Further goals from Chris Shepard (2), Luke Hopper (2) and Matthew Partridge completed the scoring for a rampant Salisbury side who will really fancy their chances in the play-offs. Swindon Supermarine had a good 2-1 home win over Walton Casuals thanks to goals from former Royal Wootton Bassett Town player Henry Spalding and Conor McDonagh. Despite having a man sent off Walton pushed hard for an equaliser but found Josh Hill in the Supermarine goal in fine form.

While all the drama at Step 4 was at Melksham this week, Highworth Town's season is having a disappointing end after a good start in their first season at this level, On Saturday they went down 3-1 at Cinderford Town, Swindon Town loanee Jordan Young with the Highworth goal. Highworth were still in it until the final stages, the third Cinderford goal coming in injury time.

Elsewhere at Step 5, whilst we were winning impressively against Holmer Green, Westbury were picking up a point in a 1-1 home draw with Bridport and Bradford Town secured an excellent 4-0 away win at Hengrove.

In the Wessex League at Step 6, Amesbury remain on course for an immediate return to the Premier Division at the first attempt with a 4-0 home win over Whitchurch United. Laverstock & Ford did not have such a good day, going down 5-2 at home to second placed AFC Stoneham. In the UHlsport Hellenic League West Division New College once again were on the wrong end of a double figure score, losing 11-0 at Almondsbury. Pewsey Vale lost narrowly at home against Kidlington Development, 2-1 the score here. In midweek Malmesbury Victoria went second in the table with a fine 5-0 home win over Cirencester Town Development to keep their promotion ambitions alive. There are some big games coming up involving the top three here and it is all still to play for. In the Western League Corsham are third after a narrow 1-0 home win over Welton Rovers. After an important 1-0 home win on Saturday over Bishops Sutton, Chippenham Park remain in relegation trouble after they lost by the same score in midweek to Welton Rovers. On Saturday Calne Town went down 3-1 at Chard, Devizes beat Longwell Green 4-2 and Warminster Town had an excellent 4-0 home win over bottom side Bristol Telephone. ## Diary of Wiltshire League Division One Title Winning Season - Wootton Bassett Town 1987-88

Taken from scrapbook of match reports from newspapers (mainly Wilts & Gloucestershire Standard) maintained by Paul Harrison.

### Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> February 1988 Wootton Bassett Town 6 Calne Town Res 0

#### Headline: Real knockout especially for the referee

Wootton Bassett's latest league game in their title pursuit proved to be a real knockout - especially for the referee. Only five minutes of the second half of the match had elapsed when the referee was knocked out by the ball. Despite treatment he was not fit enough to continue and had to be replaced by the senior linesman for the remainder of the match.

But Bassett continued their pursuit of the Division One title following last week's Senior Cup semi-final success by defeating Calne Town Reserves 6-0. Bassett immediately stamped their authority on the game in the 4<sup>th</sup> minute. A ball won by Harrison, and combined work between Frost and Thomas, found York who opened the scoring for Bassett. The lively running of the Bassett front three of Thomas, York and particularly Frost, ably supported by Harrison and McKay continued to create chances. But it wasn't until the 35<sup>th</sup> minute that a good pass from Vines found McKay and his accurate shot beat the Calne keeper to put Bassett further in the lead. But they were not able to increase their lead and went in at half time 2-0.

In the second half, when the game eventually got restarted, Bassett continued to press a rather unimpressive Calne side, who did not offer much resistance to Bassett's pressure. Rees in the Bassett goal had spent most of the afternoon as a spectator with only back passes from his own defenders to contend with. Bassett's persistency nearly paid off 15 minutes into the second half when Vines was unlucky to see his shot hit the post. York also had a shot saved, and all that in the space of about 5 minutes, but still the score remained at 2-0.

With 15 minutes of the game remaining, York latched onto a mistake by the Calne defence and beat the keeper to score. It was York again 5 minutes later who found the industrious Harrison with a very good ball, and Harrison made no mistake in extending Bassett's lead even further. Further goals by Harrison and Ackrill in the last four minutes gave Bassett a comfortable 6-0 victory.

Although Bassett had knocked a rather unimpressive Calne side for 'a six', this was not a good display by Bassett, who are capable of playing a lot better. Next week Bassett finally get to play Sanford in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Round of the Ghia Senior Cup away at Sanford, kick-off 2pm. Bassett Reserves are at home to Dunbar Wills Res in a Div 3 league fixture, kick-off 2.30pm.

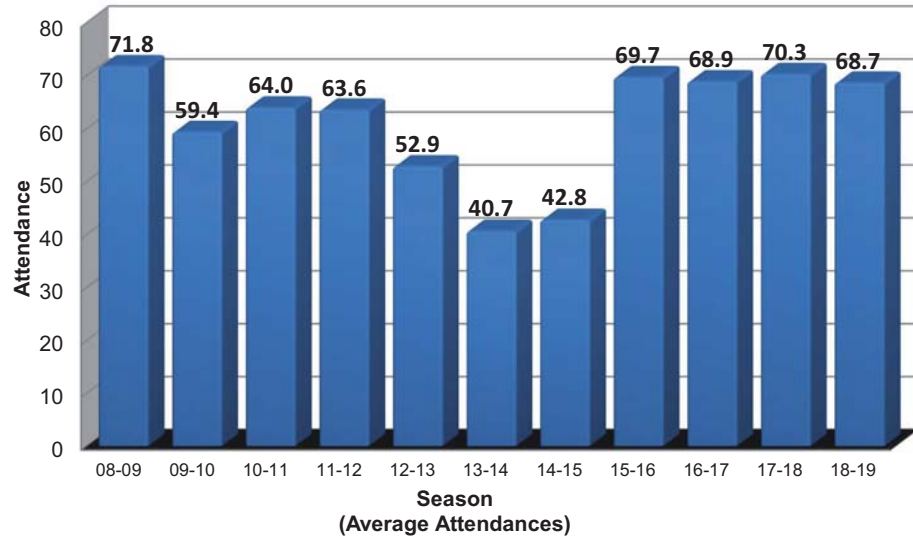

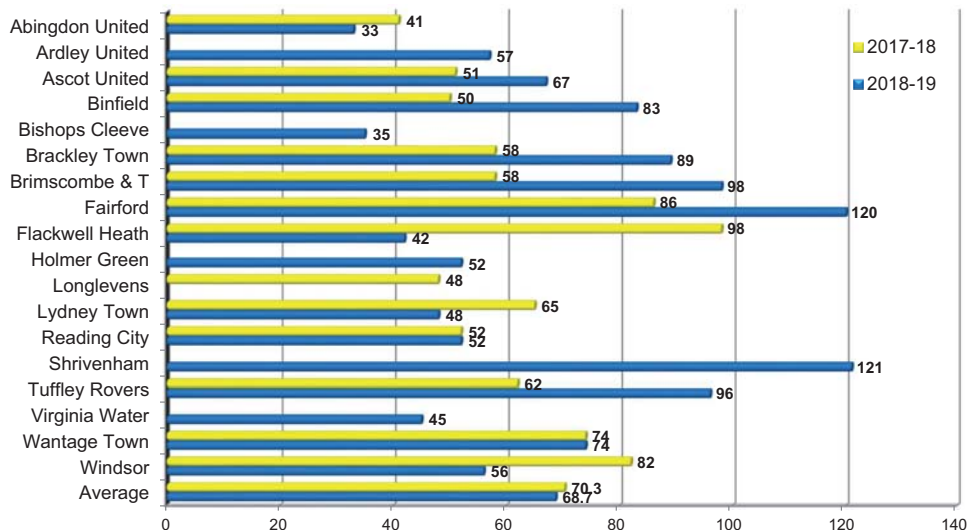

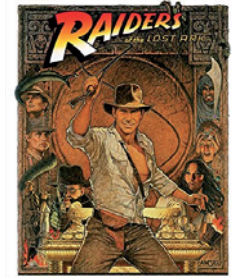
